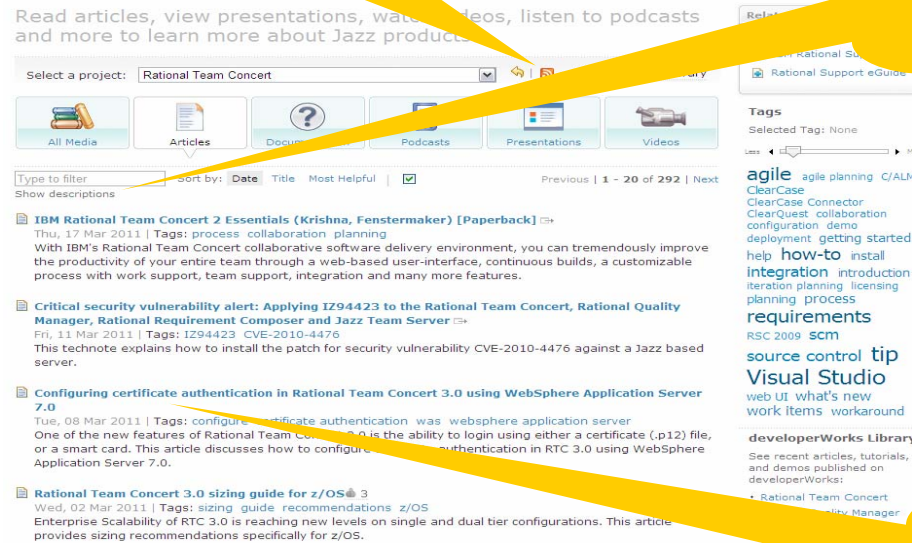

If a stream is owned by a team you can restrict delivery of changes to certain roles of users of this team. You could have the developers in one team that owns the Dev stream. You could have certain roles in another team that owns one or several of these other streams. You could have more than one additional team too. Users with certain roles can be allowed to deliver to the stream owned by a certain team. I can't look into the details right now but I think this is a way to do what you want. Ralph

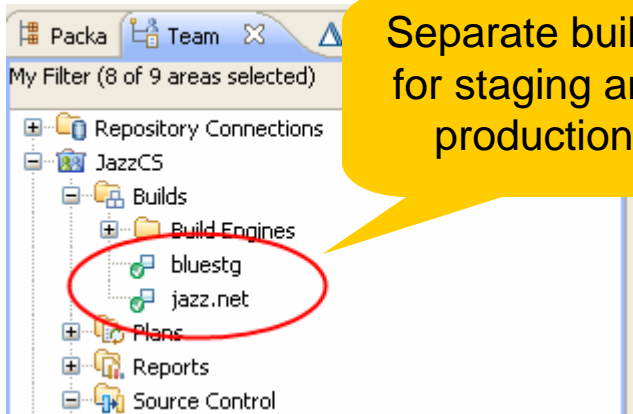
SCM: Overview of Jazz.net Development Process

Multiple streams are used to manage our staging and production deployments

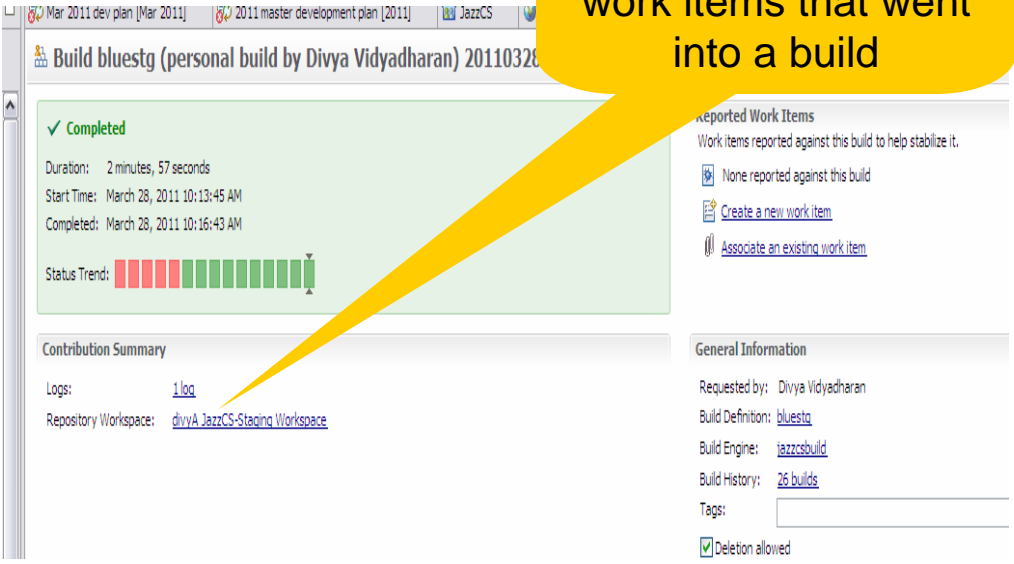


Team members' repository workspaces flowing to multiple streams
