Internationalization Selling Summary

What is Internationalization?

Internationalization (also abbreviated as 118N) is the process in which a product is made capable of providing support for international operating systems and for the end user's natural language. Internationalization is an increasingly important requirement to our multi-national customer base and helps enable global adoption of Rational products.

The Four Levels of Internationalization

Rational has internally classified products into four levels of increasing functionality to the international user. They are defined as follows:

- Level 1: English versions of Rational products The user can install and use the English versions of our products. They can only enter English characters in fields & artifacts.
- Level 2: English versions of Rational products The user receives the English versions of our products. They can enter either their local character set or English in the fields and documents. In addition, the products recognize their local date and time formats and the local numbering and currency conventions.
- Level 3: English versions of Rational products. The product is ready for localization. It would be very straight forward and cost effective to localize a product that has reached level 3.
- Level 4: Localized versions of Rational products. The product is fully localized which means the user receives a product that has a translated user interface, on-line help and documentation.

Officially Supported Languages in the Rational Suite version 2000 Release

- Level 1: Dutch and Traditional Chinese
- Level 2: German, French, Italian, Swedish, Japanese and Simplified Chinese
- Level 3: All the products in this release are Level 3 compliant except for the testing products

Rational Suite version 2000 Installation on an "Unsupported" Language Operating System

All other users can also install Rational Suite v. 2000 and the software will work equally well, but they will see a message box at install that gives them the option of overwriting .dlls with English .dlls or allows them to cancel the install and load the

correct .dlls for their language. The message box also lists which files are affected. On the next page you will see a screen shot of the help topic that tells users what to do if they get this message.

Frequently Asked Questions

Q: What internationalization level is Rational Suite version 2000 (Windows)?

A: Rational Suite version 2000 is at internationalization Level 1 for Dutch and Traditional Chinese and level 2 for German, French, Italian, Swedish, Japanese and Simplified Chinese. Level 2 compliance means that users can install the English product on their local operating system. They will see the English user interface, error messages, online help, and so on, but they can enter their local characters into all the fields, documents, forms, and reports. There is no support for the use of double-byte characters in pathnames. The software will also use local sorting and case conventions. In addition, the software will recognize their local date, time, currency and numbering formats. Rational Suite version 2000 is classified at level 3 with the testing products exception. Additionally, there are plans for a fully localized (level 4) release of Rational Suite version 2000 for Japanese in late summer of 2000.

Q: What internationalization level is ClearCase 4.0?

A: Rational ClearCase for Windows 4.0 is Level 1 compliant. That is, users install the English product on their local operating system and it will work as if it were on an English operating system. They will only be able to enter English characters.

Q: Can a team use two languages at once (i.e. a requirement is written in French, a defect is submitted in German) or does the team need to standardize on one language?

A: A team can use English and the language of their operating system. We don't test between all languages.
