Summary: if you use XDE Developer for Visual Studio as packaged in XDE Developer Plus your replacement products will be Rational Software Modeler or Rational Systems Developer plus Rational Modeling Extension for Microsoft® .NET and (optionally) PurifyPlus for Windows. The combination of Rational Software Modeler (or Rational Systems Developer) plus Rational Modeling Extension for Microsoft® .NET is designed to be used in combination with Visual Studio 2005 and .NET Framework 2.0. (In its latest generation of model driven development products, IBM Rational has elected not to introduce back-level support for Visual Studio 2003.)

These replacement products are already available to you via Anticipatory Access and you may begin to adopt them at any time. You do not have to worry about migrating any of your Rose XDE Developer Plus or Rose Enterprise entitlements because over time, the entitlement issues will resolve themselves as part of the maintenance renewals process.
