Owners of Rose XDE Developer for Java Who Use Rose Pro J

(This guidance also pertains to <u>former</u> owners of Rose XDE Developer for Java whose entitlements have <u>already</u> been converted to Rose Developer for Java)

Summary: if you use Rose Pro J your replacement product will be Rational Systems Developer. (Optionally, you could pay to trade up to Rational Software Architect) Rational Systems Developer is already available to you via Anticipatory Access and you may begin to adopt it at any time. You do not have to worry about migrating any of your Rose XDE Developer for Java or Rose Developer for Java entitlements because over time, the entitlement issues will resolve themselves as part of the maintenance renewals process.
