The current US WEST customer information system is not set up to deliver all of this information. Logica developed software that allows US WEST to automate the information transfer and manage specific types of customer data, without divulging proprietary customer information to co-providers.

Through requirements documents and in-person requirement review sessions, US WEST expresses the necessary changes to their existing software. From there, Logica determines how these changes will affect the CSRM project. Walker and her project team have simplified the process of tracking requirement changes and sorting requirements by specific criteria with Rational RequisitePro's database and traceability features.
