### Immediate Access to Requirements Information

By assigning attributes to each requirement, Fado can easily understand requirement priority and can query the database for specific views. "Rational RequisitePro gets all the requirements in one place. I can sort by priority and assign attributes and tracking numbers to individual requirements," he said.

Using tracking numbers, Fado separates sub-project from master project requirements and Phase 1 from Phase 2 requirements. "After a change is made to a requirement, I can quickly see its effects on individual parts of the product, the master project and sub-projects using Rational RequisitePro's traceability trees. I also use RequisitePro for future planning purposes. It helps me understand which requirements will be implemented in Phase 1 versus six months down the road in Phase 2."
