2) The registration screen is fairly straightforward. Note that it contains three very important items that you need to make sure you record for future use:

- The first is your email address. By the way this is set up, what you enter here becomes your "IBM login ID" which you will need to use each time you login in the future.
- The second is your password. This combines with your "IBM login ID" to secure entry each time you login.
- The final item is your display name. Your display name is what everyone will see and know you as while you are participating in developerWorks. You'll probably want to select something that is recognizable, for you and/or your company, as well as the other Ace Independent Grocer & Retailer members.

3) When you are finished, move to the bottom of the page and select "Register and take me to my profile"...



6) A profile is important within developerWorks, as it provides you with an identity. You should fill in whatever information you are comfortable with. Bear in mind that others may be able to see what you have entered.

7) Now that you registered within developerWorks, it is time for you to let me know you are active. To begin this process, you need to find me via a profile search, which you can start by entering my name (Peter Harris) in the "Profiles by Name" search field as shown:



8) You should now see a list of "Peter Harris" that have joined developerWorks. Please click on me as shown...



9) You will now see a screen that looks like this. At this point, you need to colleague me so that I know you are active within developerWorks. Go ahead and select "Invite to my network" as shown. (You can do this for other folks as well).



10) You will see the following screen. Just go ahead and hit "Send invitation" and I will be notified.



11) Upon receiving your request, I will add your screen name to the Ace Independent Grocer & Retailer group member list. When this has been completed, you will be notified via email at the address that you entered within your developerWorks profile. This will likely take 24-48 hours. Now is a good time to move around within developerWorks and when you're finished, be sure to log out.

12) After you receive notification from me, you will want to log in and see the Ace Independent Grocer & Retailer. Like you did in Step 1) above, go to the same url, but this time, click on "Sign in", and be sure to use the IBM login ID and password that you entered from the previous steps.
