




IBM Content Navigator is a collaborative and mobile content experience


- Business user access to all documents

ECM UI development framework

- Build on open standards
 - Dojo, JavaScript, HTML5, CSS, Java ...
- Visual components
 - Use in multiple containers
- Extensible and pluggable
 - ECM and third party
- Consistency
 - IBM OneUI OOTB look and feel
- Benefits
 - Change or extend Navigator UI
 - Rapid ECM enablement of other environments (e.g. Case, Portal, Sharepoint,...)
 - Cross ECM product adoption over time
 - OneUI promotes interoperability across IBM solutions in the same desktop
 - Developer skills accessible


 Personal frequently access documents, folders, searches and teamspaces


Browse

- Access the root folder and subfolder tree of both CM8 and P8
 - Global view of repository organization
 - Drag and drop from folder to folder
 - Drag and drop from desktop to folder

Document information


- A "quick view" of the document and its context
- View thumbnail and document properties
 - Many document types (Office, PDF, Image,...)





Document viewing previewing and annotating

- Multi document tabbed viewer
- Side by side and top and bottom views
- Navigate a list of documents from the viewer
- E.g. a folder contents or search result
- Configurable viewer options
 - Seamlessly uses the correct viewer for each document type
 - OOTB options for each repository
 - CMOD transform to PDF
 - Preview
- Third party viewer plugins

Saved searches list

 Users can access search templates or recently opened search templates

Search builder


 A search builder allowing you to build search templates from object classes and item types

Sharing searches

 Creators and owners of search templates can assign security to search templates to determine who can view and edit search templates


Text search

 Full-text search is supported using CSS and LCSE text search on P8 and NSE and Oracle text search on CM8.



Content Navigator workflow

- Provides a view into P8 workflows
 - Supports Application Spaces Process Roles and filtered Inbaskets
 - OOTB Content Navigator Launch and Step processors
 - Supports launching workflows though Workflow Subscription mechanism
- Provides a view into CM Doc Routing workflows.
 - Supports Worklist selection and work items display
 - Work items have standard workflow actions for doc routing
 - Work Items also expose standard authoring actions






- Collaborative document management for a project or team

- Benefits

 - Repository taxonomy and rules still apply





Project start

Supporting information Document Authoring Change of team Project complete

- Select teamspace template
- Configure for your project
- Add existing documents
- Select initial team members
- Assign roles

- Teamspace searches give participants access to supporting documents
- e.g. Templates, policies and procedures, reference information
- New documents authored using types defined by the teamspace
- Teamspace roles simplify new document and folders security
- Teamspace folder structure guides consistent organization
- Team members' rights constrained by their role in the teamspace

- Recruit additional team member into the project roles
- Remove participants who leave the project or complete their participation
- Publish final deliverables outside of the teamspace

Teamspaces and the repository taxonomy

- Documents and folders are managed in the repository
 - Repository document classes and items types are used for all folders and documents
 - All business processes, records and retention rules which apply to the repository apply to teamspaces too
 - Teamspace folders are hidden from repository level browsing
- Benefit
 - Teamspaces are not silos of information
 - Teamspaces obey corporate taxonomy rules
 - Documents can participate in many teamspaces and wider business processes





ICA ENTERPRISE SEARCH

Navigator/ICAwES functional integration


- Provides enterprise search integration using IBM Content Analytics (ICA)
- Built as a ICN plug-in
 - Type-ahead
 - Synonyms
 - Term/"hit" highlighting
 - Thumbnails
 - Navigation/facet search
 - Cross-repository search
 - Search documents, multiple repositories and other sources
 - Repository document actions (checkout, send-to, favorite, ...)
- Limited use license of ICA included allowing search collections for P8 and CM8
- Full capability supported if ICA license purchased






Contrasting search use cases

Search CM8, P8, CMOD



- Repository RDBMS and text search
 - Multiple searches active
 - Saved and shared searches
 - Search collection updated transactionally

Search any ICA text search source




- ICA text search with analytics
 - Dynamic searching
 - Facet drill down
 - Dynamic summary and highlighting
 - Result analytics
 - Search collection updated by crawling



Content Navigator UI: Configuration


- Interface customization
 - Title, labels, icons, plugins
- Desktops
 - Customizable UI views/roles
 - Specify repositories, layout, menus, etc. per desktop
- Viewer mappings and menus
 - Custom viewers can be supported
 - Administrators can customize any menu and/or toolbar
- Plug-ins
 - Allows for new actions and services to be added to the UI
- Benefits
 - Many application use cases can be configured instantly through desktops
 - A single deployment of Navigator supports multiple desktops




Navigator "Desktops" are applications





External data services

- OOTB UI functionality
 - Applies to add document, checkin, modify properties, search
- External choice lists
- Dependencies between properties
- Set default or dynamic values
- Property value and format validation
- Dynamic properties
- External services are provided with user id, current action, browser language
 - Enables context sensitive data

External data services benefits

- Why it useful
 - External reference data and rules can be used without changing the Navigator UI. A major enabler for using OOTB Navigator
 - Data interaction is live as the user types. This improves application data integrity
- Where does it apply
 - In the Navigator UI, applications using the toolkit and also the Mobile application
- Examples
 - Lookup the manager or the user in LDAP
 - Lookup an invoice in ERP
 - Lookup an customer in CRM



Architecture/Design: Mobile


- The Navigator mobile application is built for iPad running iOS5
- Mobile application is designed similarly to web browser design
 - It leverages the mid-tier services and provides a native Objective-C model API similar to the JavaScript model API used on the desktop web application
- First version will only support simple use cases:
 - Browse
 - Ability to navigate the folder structure in CM8 and P8.
 - Search
 - Ability to access stored searches in CM8 and P8 and OD folders.
 - Adding content via the camera and photo library in CM8 and P8.
 - EDS is supported, so the same choice lists visible in the desktop web application are available on the iPad.


