

IBM Tivoli Storage Manager Express for Exchange automates the data protection of mail servers running Microsoft Exchange with online backups of Exchange Server databases and transaction logs to IBM Tivoli Storage Manager Express server storage.

IBM Tivoli Storage Manager Express for Microsoft SQL provides online, hot backups and restores of Microsoft SQL Server databases. It communicates with a centralized backup server and its disk storage, which holds the backed-up data. As a result, you can perform online backups of the primary components of your SQL Server

environment easily and efficiently, including master databases, user databases and transaction logs.

Back up your files and documents in real time

Spreadsheets, presentations and word processing documents that your staff worked on most recently are valuable business data that can go unprotected for long periods of time when backups are performed at scheduled intervals. Because mid-sized businesses have a greater percentage of their data on notebook and desktop computers than large enterprises, backing up this data is especially important.

files that are on desktops, notebook
computers, file servers and mobile
devices. You can specify as many as

three target backup areas for highpriority files: a local disk, a file server and an IBM Tivoli Storage Manager server. These areas capture every save of a file when it occurs to help protect against corruption, file loss or system loss. Tivoli Continuous Data Protection for Files also:

- Creates versions of separate copies of the files to facilitate date-based restore
- Auto-manages the local backup target area as a pool with a configurable size, deleting old versions to make room for new versions
- Includes the option of specifying a remote file server or Tivoli Storage Manager for off-machine protection when a user is connected, so real-time backup still occurs
- Provides offsite copies of backup data for vaulting, auditable disaster recovery plan, tape and media management

This can help control your storage administration costs.
