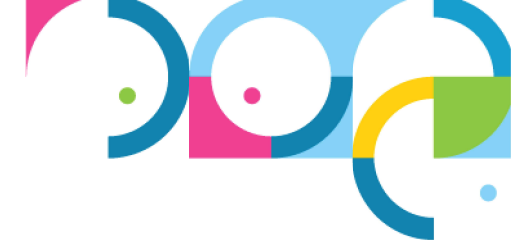

## Better Trash [folder] management



- Generate reports regarding deleted messages across all users
- “Exempt” selected users from deletion activities altogether
- Also, choose whether users can specify and delete a single message, or delete all messages by emptying the Trash folder

- Limit size of inbound messages

# Over-the-wire mailbox transfer during onboarding

- Data transition into LotusLive Notes “Hybrid” is performed by IBM today via an “out-of-band” NAS-based import process with a defined encryption and “manifest of content” format
- Utilizes an Import Server-based approach for staging data, providing mail file hygiene (including anti-virus) before introducing the mail files into our multi-tenant hosting environment
- IBM SWG Business Controls requires an auditable process with specific requirements for handling customer data and delineation of customer and IBM responsibilities (think “chain of custody”)
- Our December 2011 release introduced “over the wire” mail file transfer via secure FTP
- Suitable for smaller data volumes → 250GB per customer per batch maximum
- Attractive to customers outside the US due to high cost of courier service and logistical complexities



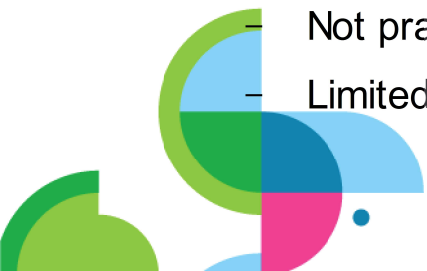
## Over-the-wire mailbox transfer during onboarding

### Current process

- On-premises mail files are “on-boarded” into the service by means of a network attached storage (NAS) device
  - Pros
    - Most effective way to migrate large amounts of data into the LotusLive Notes service
  - Cons
    - Not well-suited to smaller migrations or situations which require fast response times
    - Effort to manage a physical device; shipping costs; geographic concerns (international shipping complexities)

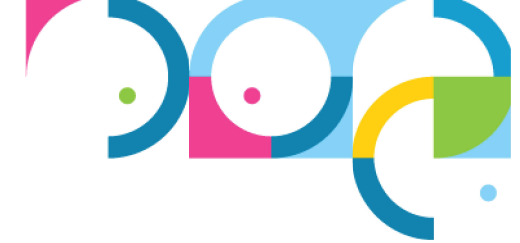
### Secure FTP-based data transfers (NEW!)

- Extends the current data transfer ISSL offering to allow more customers to get onto the service securely over-the-wire
  - Pros
    - Well-suited to smaller migrations, flexible, no shipping costs or physical device management
  - Cons
    - Not practical for large migrations, no guaranteed transfer rate (shared bandwidth, traffic shaping)
    - Limited to 250GB of total active data per customer and only available to Hybrid LotusLive customers



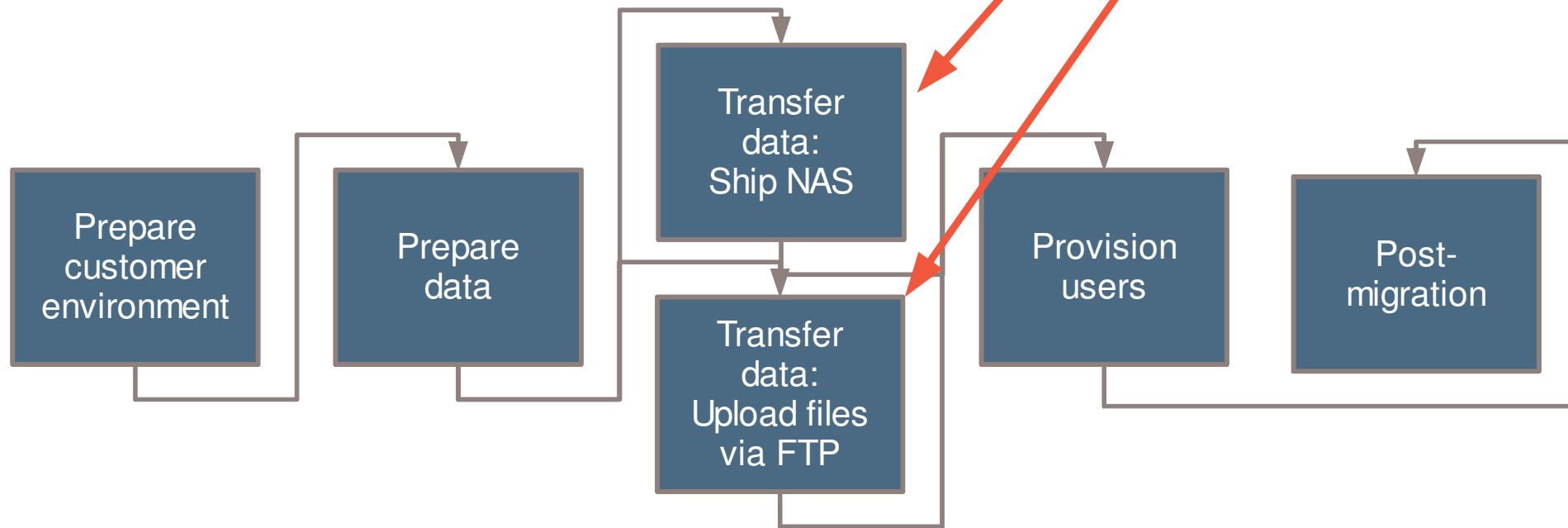


## Mailbox transfer during onboarding

▪ Over-the-wire, secure FTP

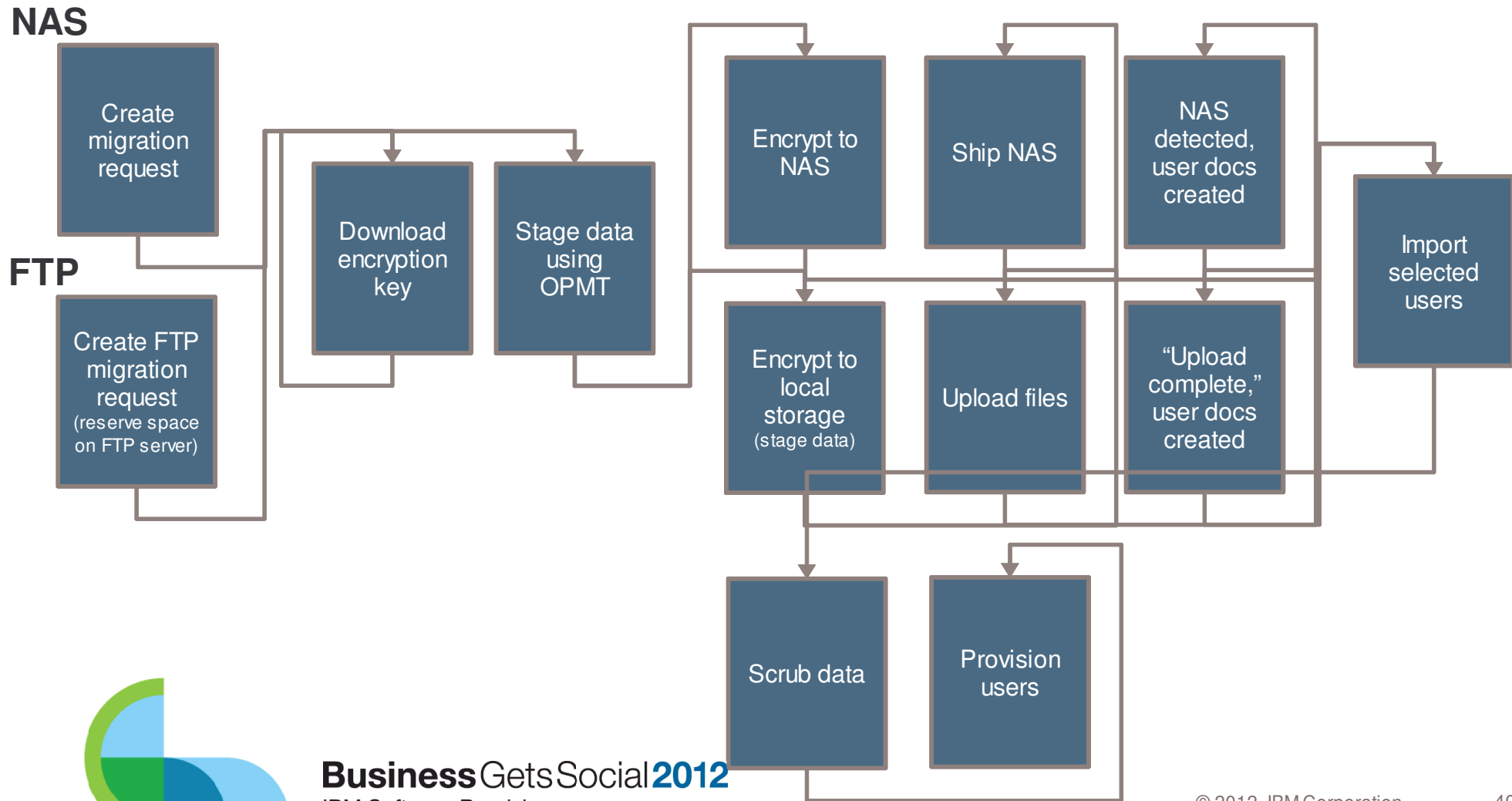




## Over-the-wire mailbox transfer during onboarding



- Comparison of transition flows

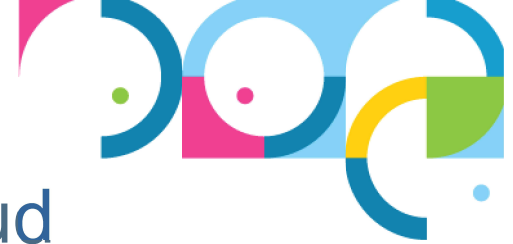

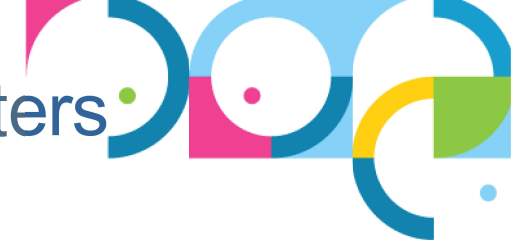
