## Installing DCF Databases

#### Installing DCF Databases

## To install the DCF databases in your Lotus Notes Workspace, follow these steps:

- Open the Notes Workspace tab where you want to create the DCF database icon.
- 2. Right click in your Notes Workspace and select Open Database....
- Enter G01ZCIDBS003 in the Server field and click Enter. Notes
  populates the Database list with databases available on the specified
  server.
- 4. Select the support folder and then click Open.
- 5. Select the swg folder which contains the DCF databases for Tivoli.
- 6. Add each database individually (Technotes, Techdocs, Archives, etc.)

Note: You can only select and install one database at a time, so repeat this process as necessary to install the DCF databases you need.

If the preceding steps for adding the DCF database result in an error message about being unable to locate the server, use the following information to manually create a connection document to the DCF databases:

#### What is a DCF?


 DCF stands for Document Control Facility. DCF is a Notes-based content management application. However, when you hear someone refer to a DCF they mean:

- DCF document
  - Technote
  - Techdoc
  - Download
- Knowledge Entry
- KE
- A DCF is information or a download that is relevant and of high quality that has been placed in one of IBM's Knowledge Databases to assist customers with answers to questions or solutions to problems, or to provide additional information that is meaningful for our customers as it pertains to our products.

#### Search DCF using keywords






#### Searching DCF databases

- For Lotus Notes v8.5.1 FP5, you must use the "and" separator between keywords
- For later versions of Lotus Notes (v8.5.3, for example), you do not need to use "and" between keywords
- For all versions, the usual search rules still apply for "or"
- The more keywords used, or the more specific keywords you can use, the fewer documents will be returned.






#### Search DCF using a few keywords – 333 returns








#### Search DCF using a few more keywords – 27 returns







#### Search DCF using more specific keywords – 1 return








Searching Techdocs is very similar to searching Technotes, except that this is a search for documents that reference product information documents. Forum / Discussion Groups,

Online Publications, Product Information, and White Papers.



Searching Downloads is very similar to searching Technotes, except this search is for documents that reference downloadable product code, like Tool/Utility or Update files.






#### **Archives Database**



- Archives DB includes both Deleted and Archived Documents
  - Deleted Documents get purged after 14 days
  - Archived Documents remained archived indefinitely



- Provides a passthru to the DCF Database

#### To start using the tool you will need to load the Microsoft .Net Framework from the following link:






#### **CAST**

- What is CAST?
  - Comprehensive Archive Search and Submission Tool
  - Searches multiple types of information (e.g. APARs, PMRs, technotes)
  - PMRs are available longer than 1 year after closure (unlike CCWIN or RETAN searches)
- Registration is required
