

- 1975-North Sea Oil, Situation in NI-Domestic Terrorism
- DTI-Anthony Wedgewood Benn-who is protecting UK's vital installations? (Critical National Infrastructure)




Industrial Security Officer

- Role of the ISO introduced to act as liaison between the security service and those industries not on the top tier of the Critical National Infrastructure
- Normally SB officers/mostly P/T role
- Flag up any problems/difficulties in security to service
- Provide industry with up to date threat assessments

IMPACT

- City Centre areas suffer significant structural damage

- Combined ISO/CTCPO role full time






Counter Terrorism Security Advisor (CTSA)

SUICIDE BOMBING BEGINS

- 1 attacks American Embassy.
- 63 killed 120 injured.
- 23/10/83 American Marine barracks 241 killed 300 injured.
- Military facilities and personnel principal targets



HAMAS

- 16/04/1993 Sahar Tama Nabulsi detonates car bomb near bus station and restaurant
- Thus begins a wave of suicide attacks(7)
- 18/4/94 Yitzhak Rabin announces withdrawal from Palestinian territories
- 1996 Suicide attacks recommence change political climate.
- Public places such as bus stops, restaurants are favourite targets.



Al Qaeda

1998 Al Qaeda and their affiliate groups learn from the experience of Hamas and Hezbollah and realise how effective suicide bombings/missions can be as a political tool Planning of 9/11 begins.








