The amount of engineering asset data and the collaboration between stakeholders will need to be managed and executed in a much more superior way









Systems Engineering methods and data control is critical in building the virtual plant, optimizing handover and managing the plant information throughout its lifecycle



- Mitigate project risk (on-time, on-budget) through effective Systems Engineering
- Enable 'continuous' information and data sharing considering respective requirements from various stakeholders.
- Break down traditional information silos and reduce rework
- Reduce risk along the lifecycle by improving configuration, information & knowledge management
- Introduce Enterprise Asset Management early in the process
