If the 'Generated Langage' field is assigned the value 'D' in the Library Definition screen, the generated source code undergoes the following modifications:

Modification in all generators :

Deletion of the following clauses:

AUTHOR DATE-COMPILED

DATA RECORD followed by the list of records LABEL RECORD

The BLOCK xxxx RECORD clause when the blocking factor is zero.

Unisys 2200 variant:

Recognition of BINARY - BINARY SYNC RIGHT and PACKED DECIMAL usages.

ADT and ADC operators for the retrieval of the machine date:

Addition of a test to allow the modification of the century default value ('19').

OLSD Screens and Client Components:

Request for help documentation via the input of a character: test on the first character of the field.

OLSD Screens:

Deletion of OBJECT and SOURCE COMPUTER paragraphs except with a Tandem variant.

Batch Programs:

- EXA operator generates an INSPECT verb.

IBM OS variant:

VSAM files: recognition of the VSAM-STATUS status in the SELECT clause and description of the corresponding working.

F20: end of program via GOBACK instead of STOP RUN

DOS VSE variant:

- retrieval of the current date via an ACCEPT order and no longer via the CURRENT DATE field.
