### Product overview

WebSphere® Business Services Fabric version 7.0, an extension to WebSphere Process Server, creates and manages modular, dynamically assembled, extensible business processes. It organizes BPM plus SOA infrastructure into re-usable, flexible modules called intelligent Business Services, then assembles these modules at run-time based on the current business situation and policy. Each module's life cycle is separated from umbrella core processes – and each other – making the manageability of complex BPM projects easier while significantly lowering TCO. Fabric also extricates and makes accessible to business users prolific, formerly hard-coded process variability, enabling governed change at the speed of business, not a change ticket. In addition, modularization enables new functionality to be added to a process without changing or redeploying the core process, providing for rapid time-to-market for new business initiatives. Fabric enables enterprises to realize the original SOA vision of architectural flexibility and reuse – saving time and money while creating a more agile business environment.

The WebSphere Business Services Tool Pack provides the design-time environment and tools for assembling business services for service-oriented architecture (SOA) applications.

The WebSphere Business Services Tool Pack provides you the tools to maintain, manage, and govern services meta-data, subscribers, policies, and governance processes. It enables domain-experienced software architects to create, publish, and manage industry-specific business service models and business policies. The WebSphere Business Services Tool Pack consists of the WebSphere Business Services Composition Studio and WebSphere Integration Developer applications.

- The WebSphere Business Services Composition Studio is an assembly tool that contributes the Business Service Perspective to WebSphere Integration Developer. It enables developers to assemble business services, create business policies, and simulate the dynamic assembly of business services.
- The WebSphere Integration Developer provides a complete toolbox for assembling and integrating composite solutions.
