Chapter 2. Assembling the sequence diagrams

Most of the sequence diagrams provided in this book are too large to be shown on a single letter-sized page. The diagrams are broken up across pages and can be assembled to produce a complete diagram.

Each figure that makes up a diagram has a caption that indicates the name of sequence diagram and the page number of the figure. If the diagram is larger than a single letter-sized page, a pair of numbers appear in parentheses after the caption. Here is a sample caption:

Figure 1. ApplyOrderAdjustments sequence diagram, 2 of 4 (1,2)

The numbers in parentheses at the end of the caption indicate the row and column position of page when laying out all pages of a sequence diagrams in a grid. The following diagram indicates the position of pages when laying them out for assembly:

(1,1)	(1,2)
(2,1)	(2,2)
(3,1)	(3,2)
(4,1)	(4,2)

Sequence diagrams that span multiple pages have markings on each page that show where the pages overlap. Horizontal and vertical lines indicate where the page overlaps with one other page. Corners indicate where two or more pages intersect. The following sample diagram has the overlap markers on the page circled:

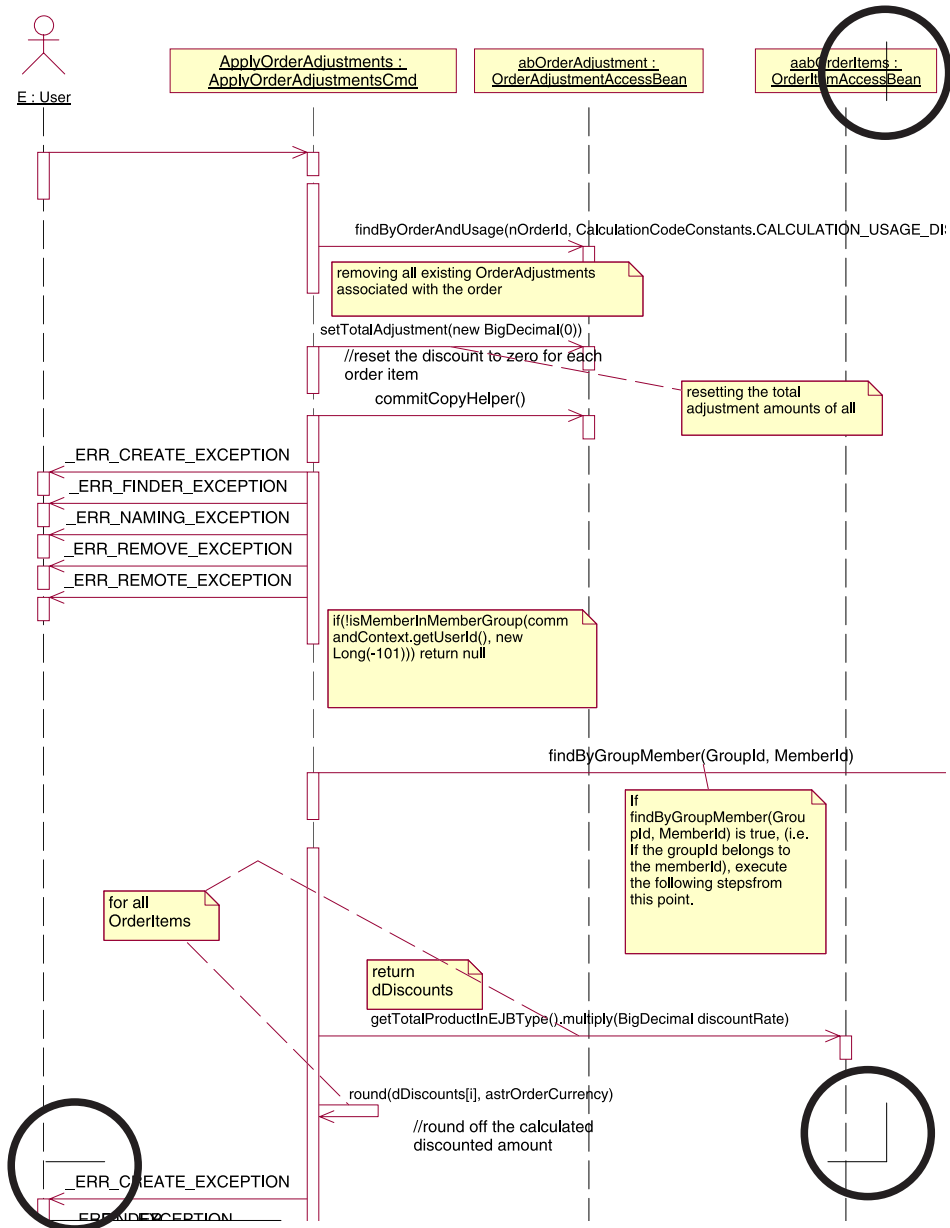


Figure 1. Sequence diagram showing overlap markers

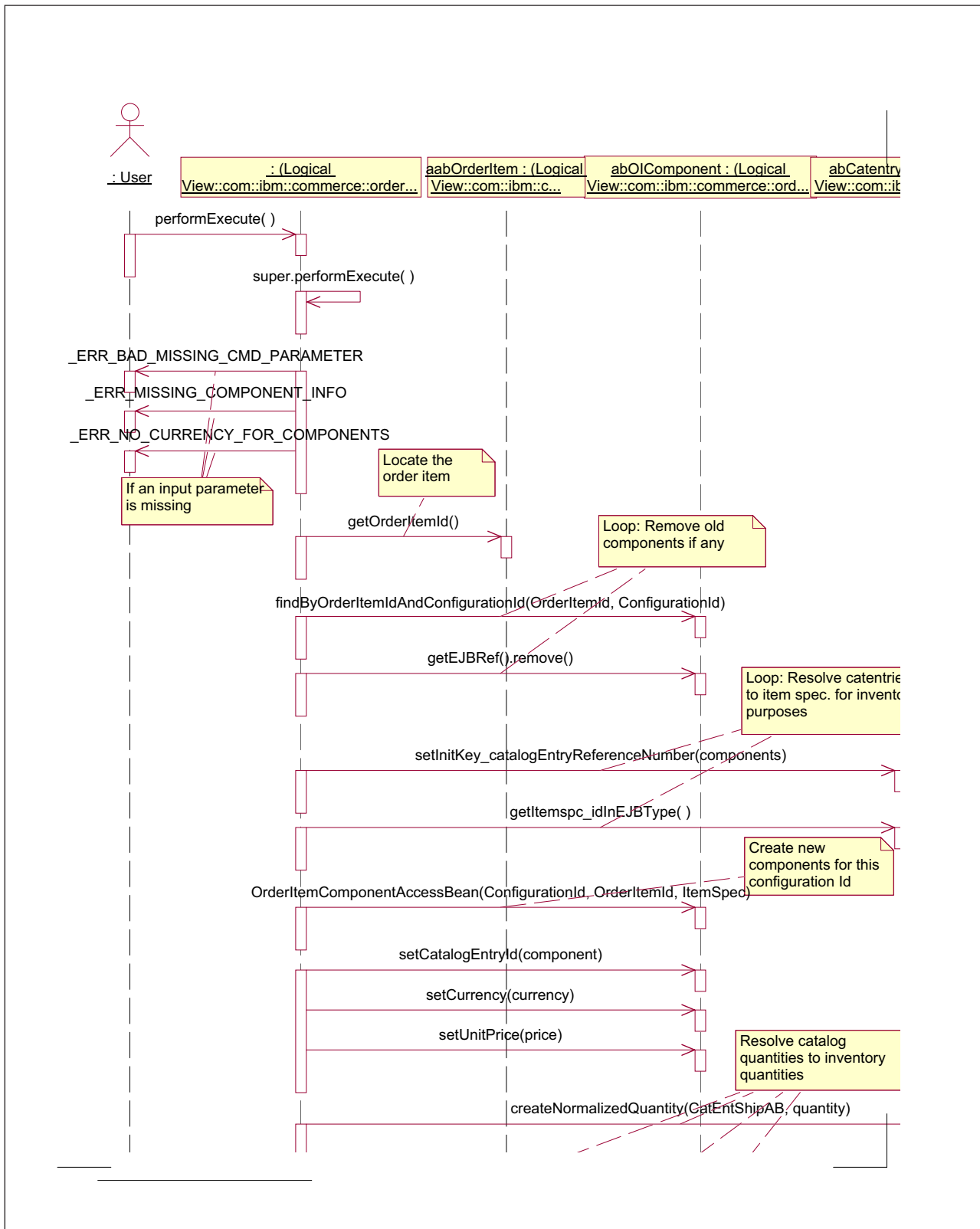


Figure 2. AddOrderItemComponents sequence diagram, 1 of 4 (1,1)

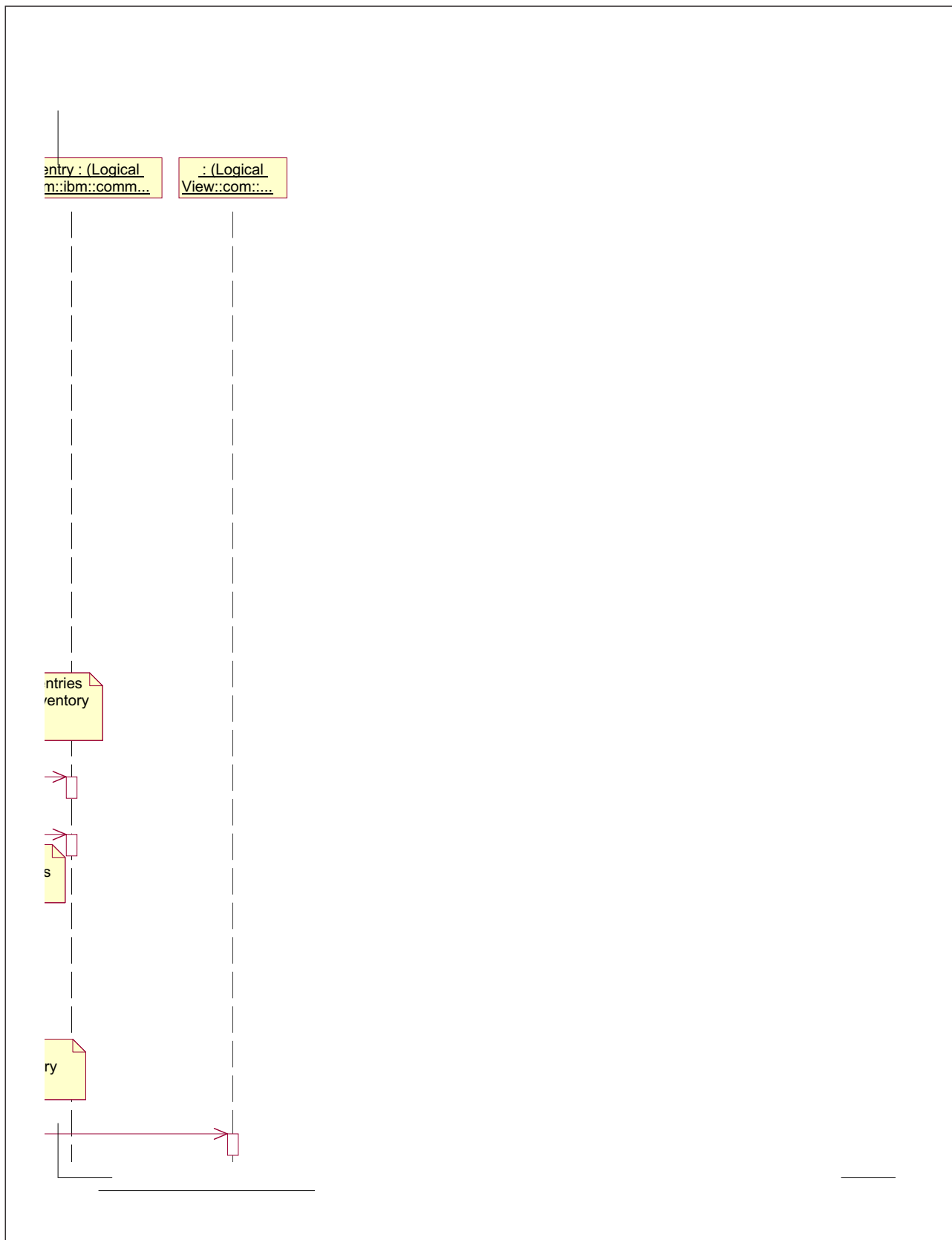


Figure 3. AddOrderItemComponents sequence diagram, 2 of 4 (1,2)

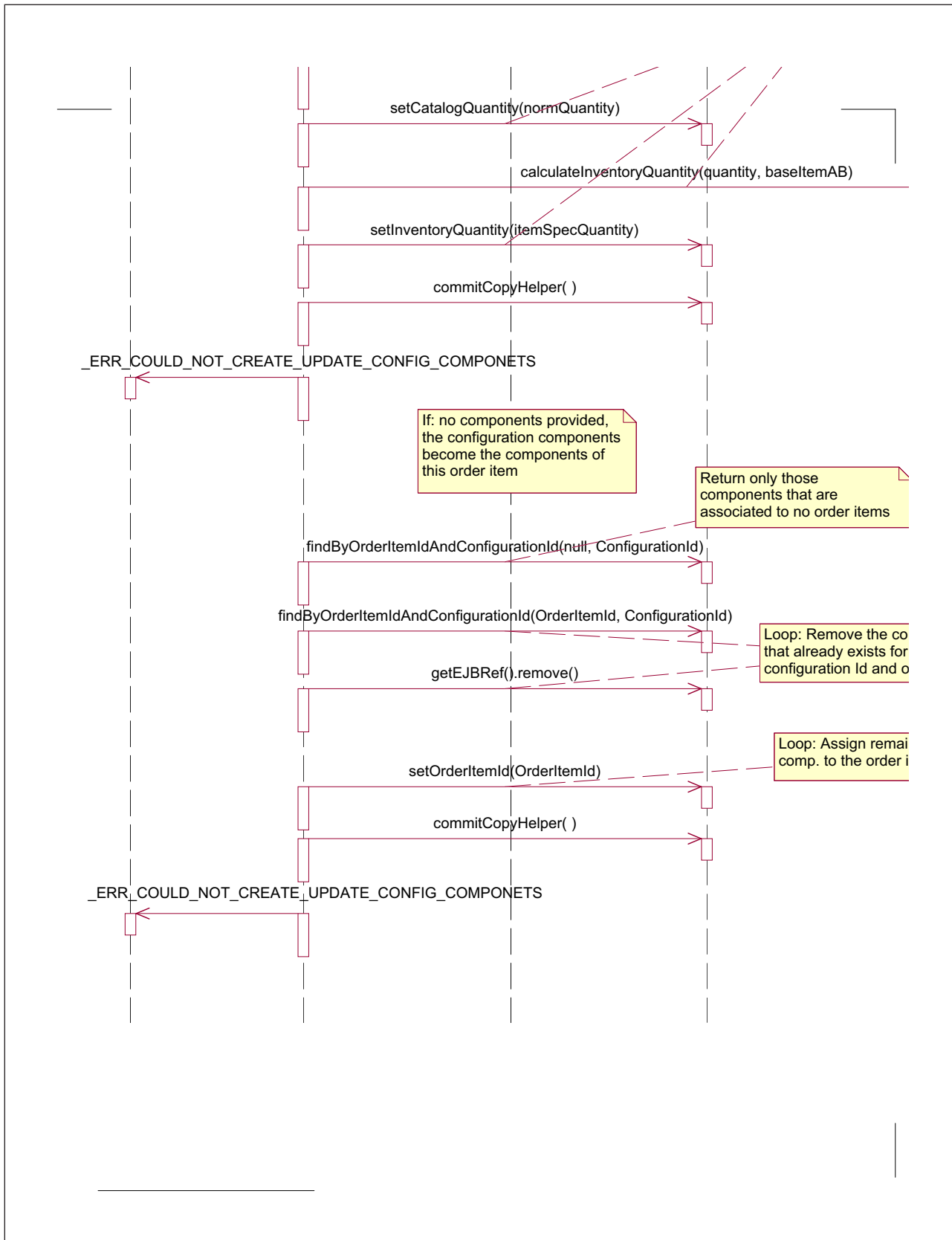


Figure 4. AddOrderItemComponents sequence diagram, 3 of 4 (2,1)

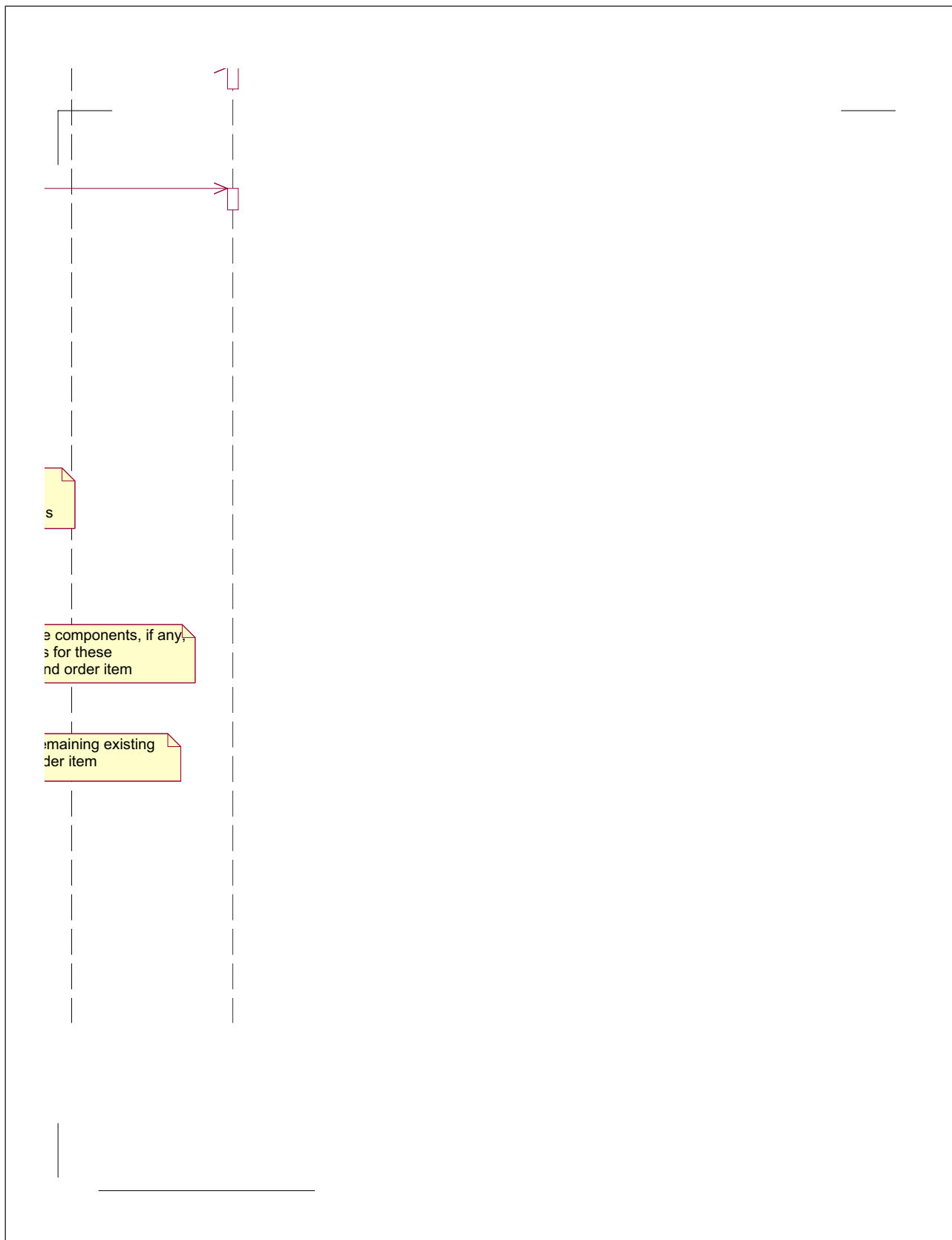


Figure 5. AddOrderItemComponents sequence diagram, 4 of 4 (2,2)

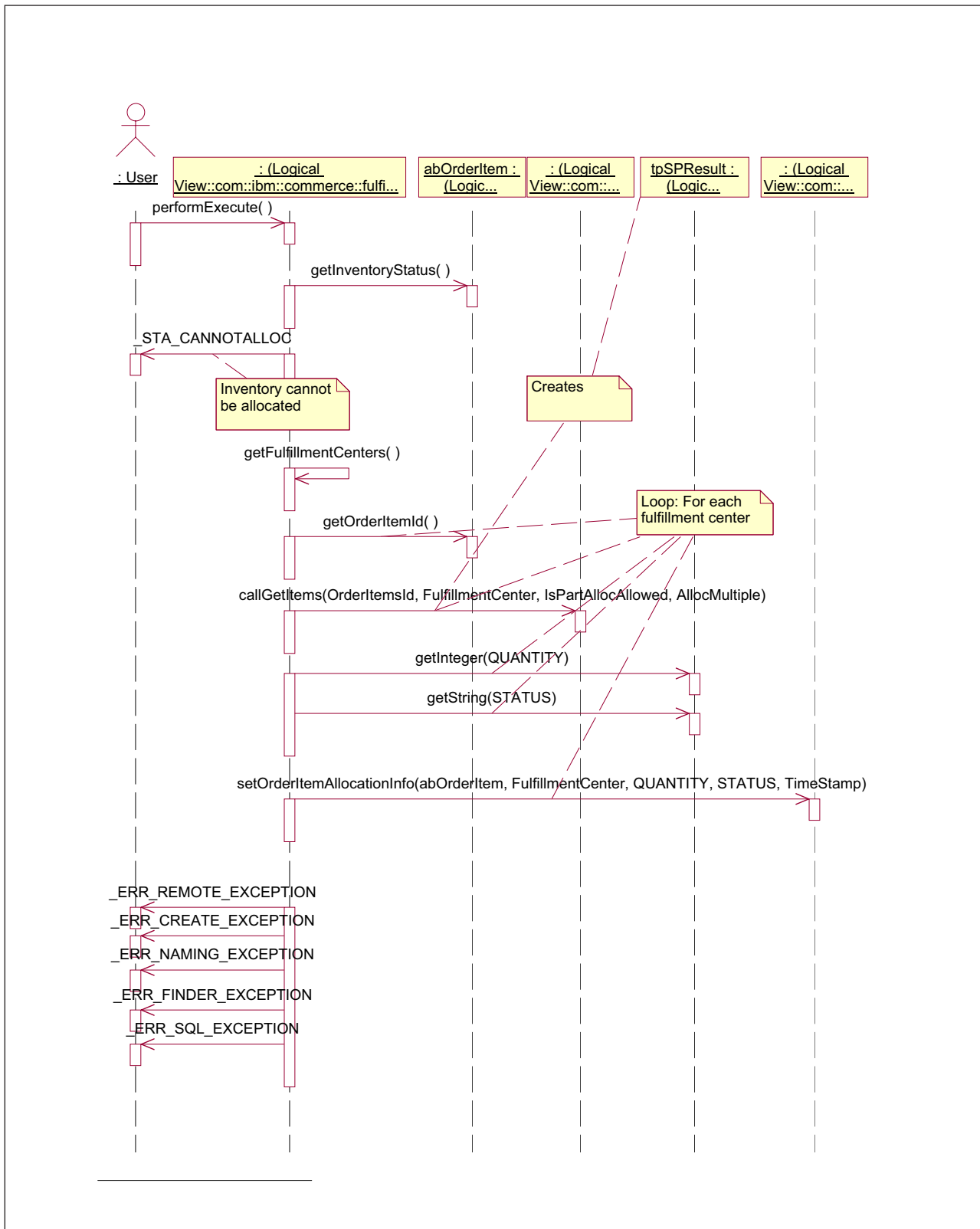


Figure 6. AllocateExistingInventory sequence diagram, 1 of 4 (1,1)

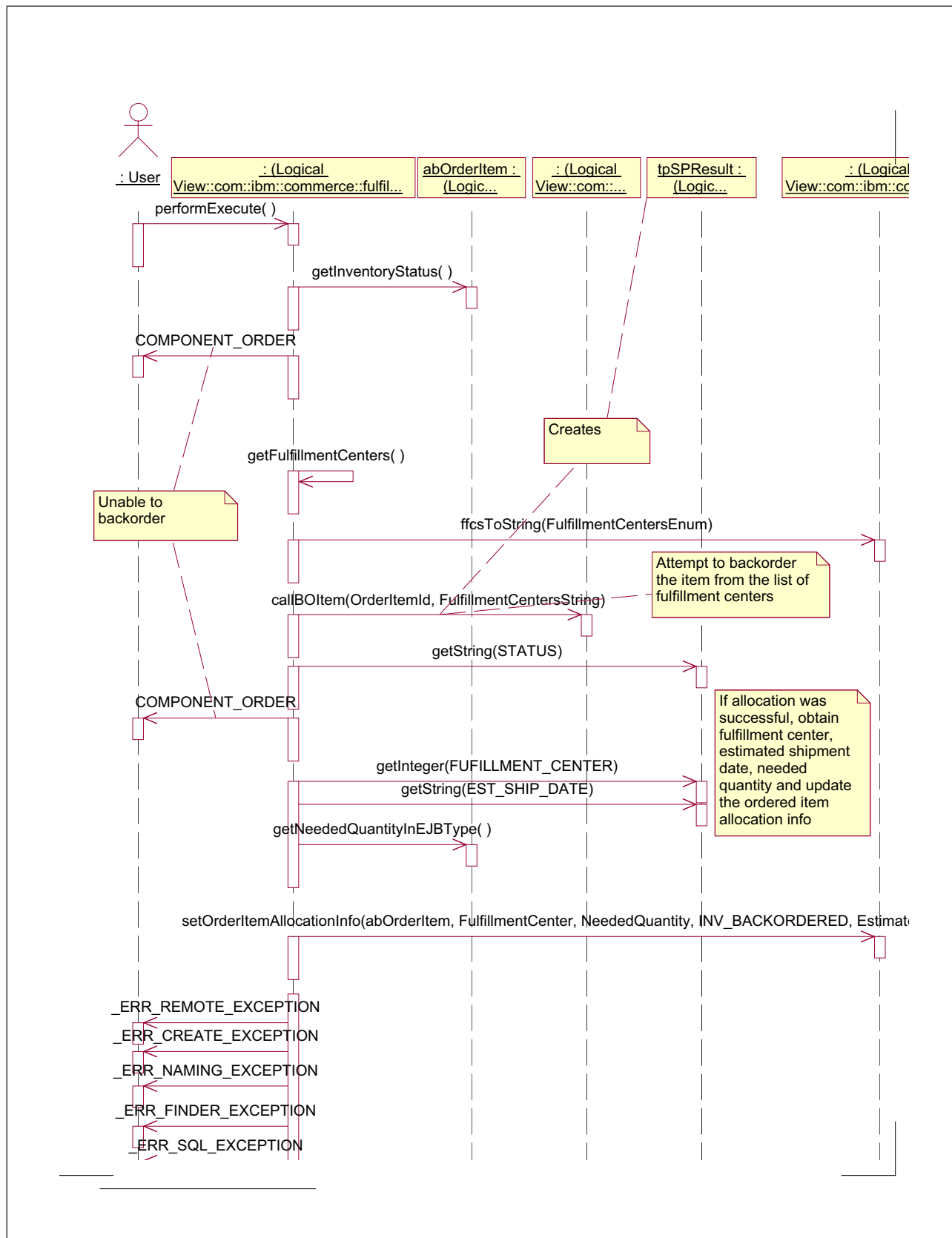


Figure 7. AddOrderItemComponents sequence diagram, 2 of 4 (1,2)

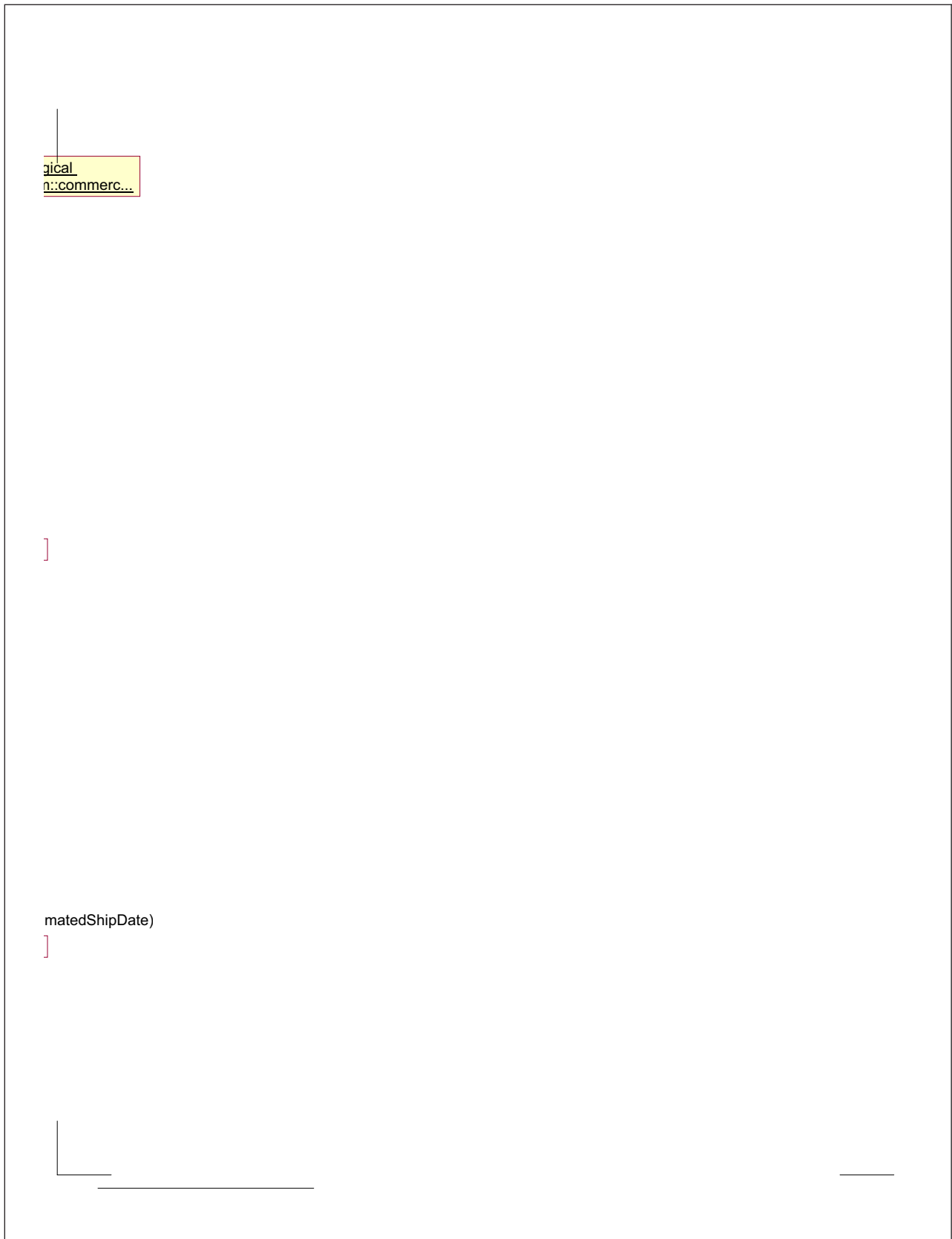


Figure 8. AddOrderItemComponents sequence diagram, 3 of 4 (2,1)

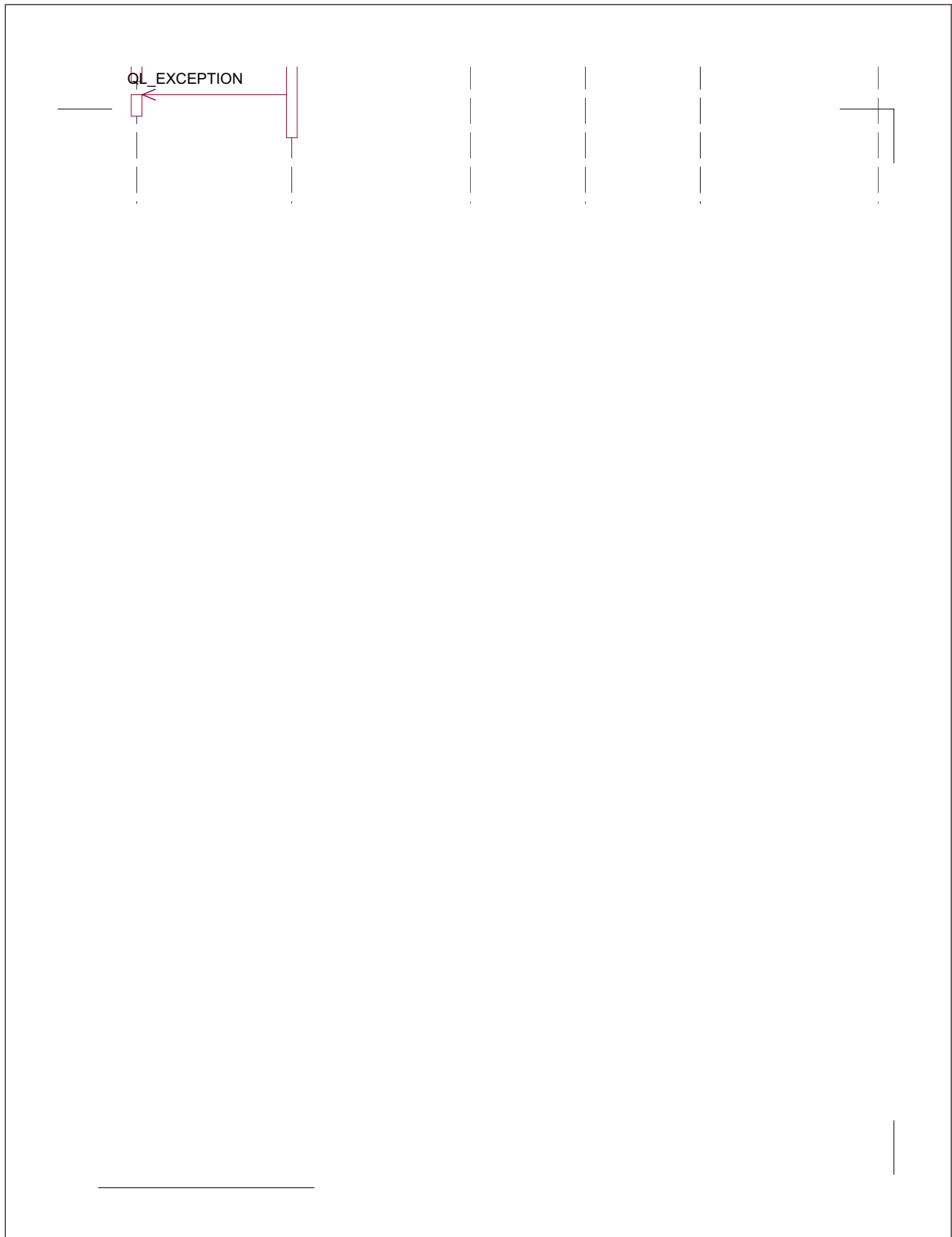


Figure 9. AddOrderItemComponents sequence diagram, 4 of 4 (2,2)

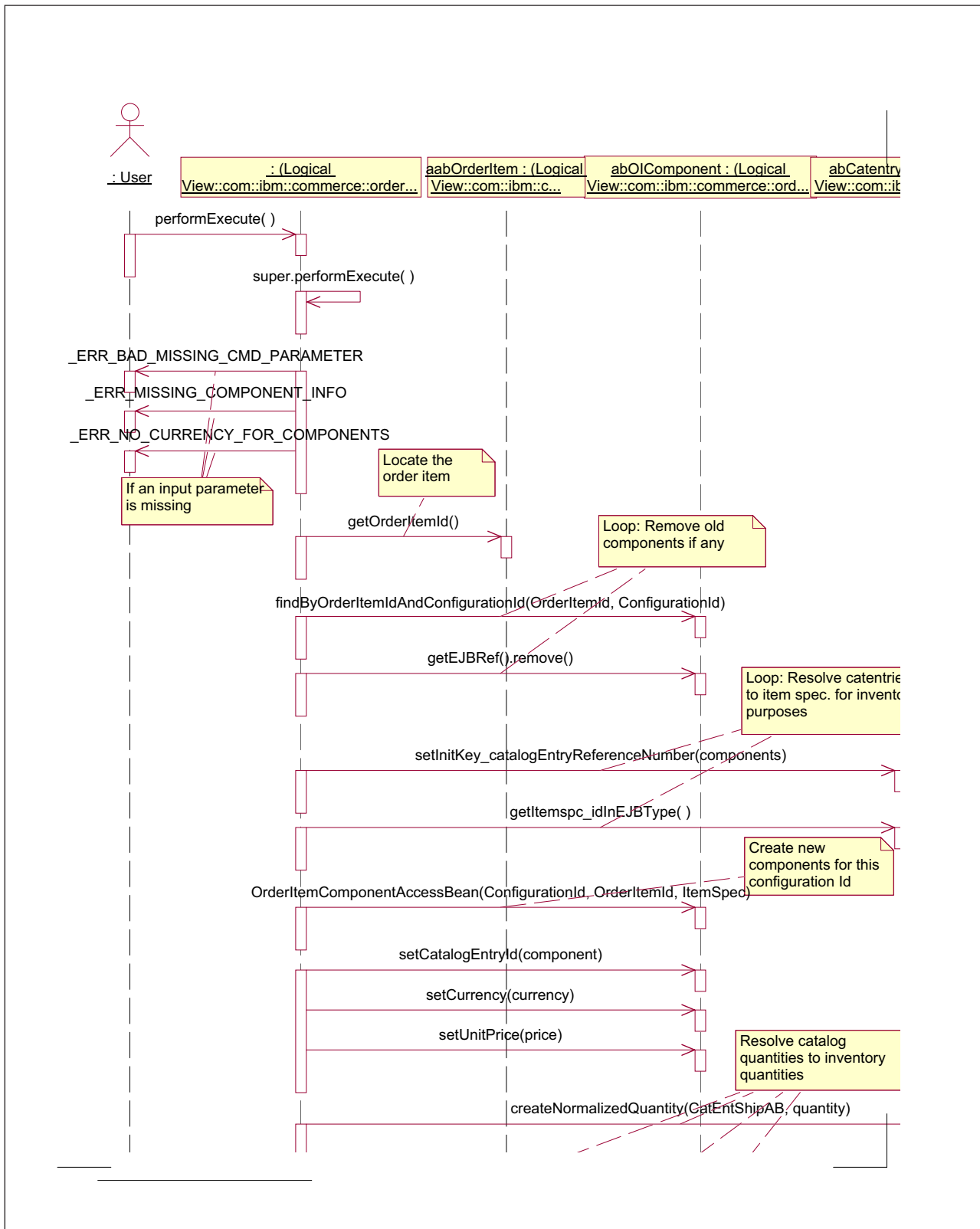


Figure 10. AllocateExistingInventory sequence diagram, 1 of 1 (1,1)

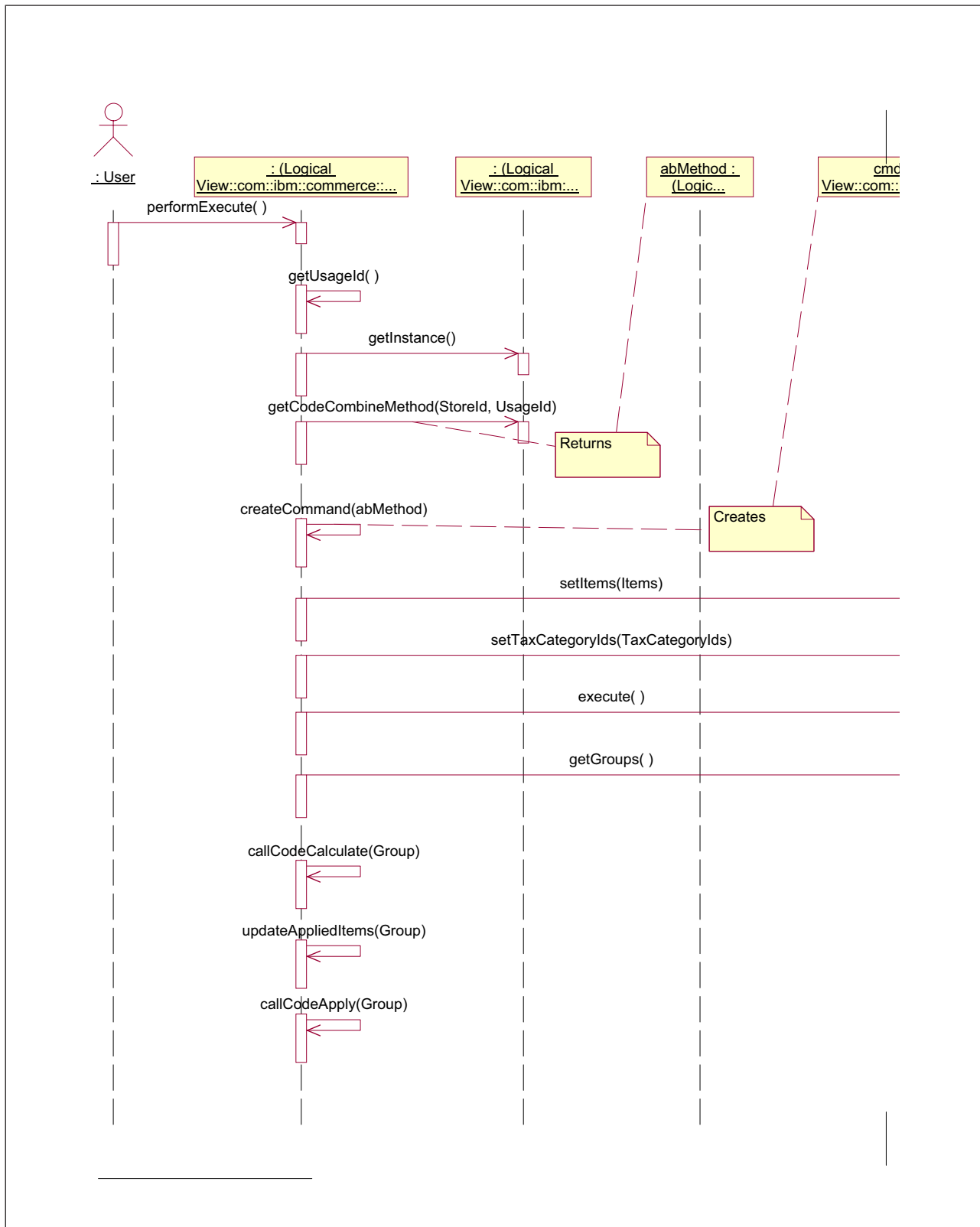


Figure 11. ApplyCalculationUsage sequence diagram, 1 of 2 (1,1)

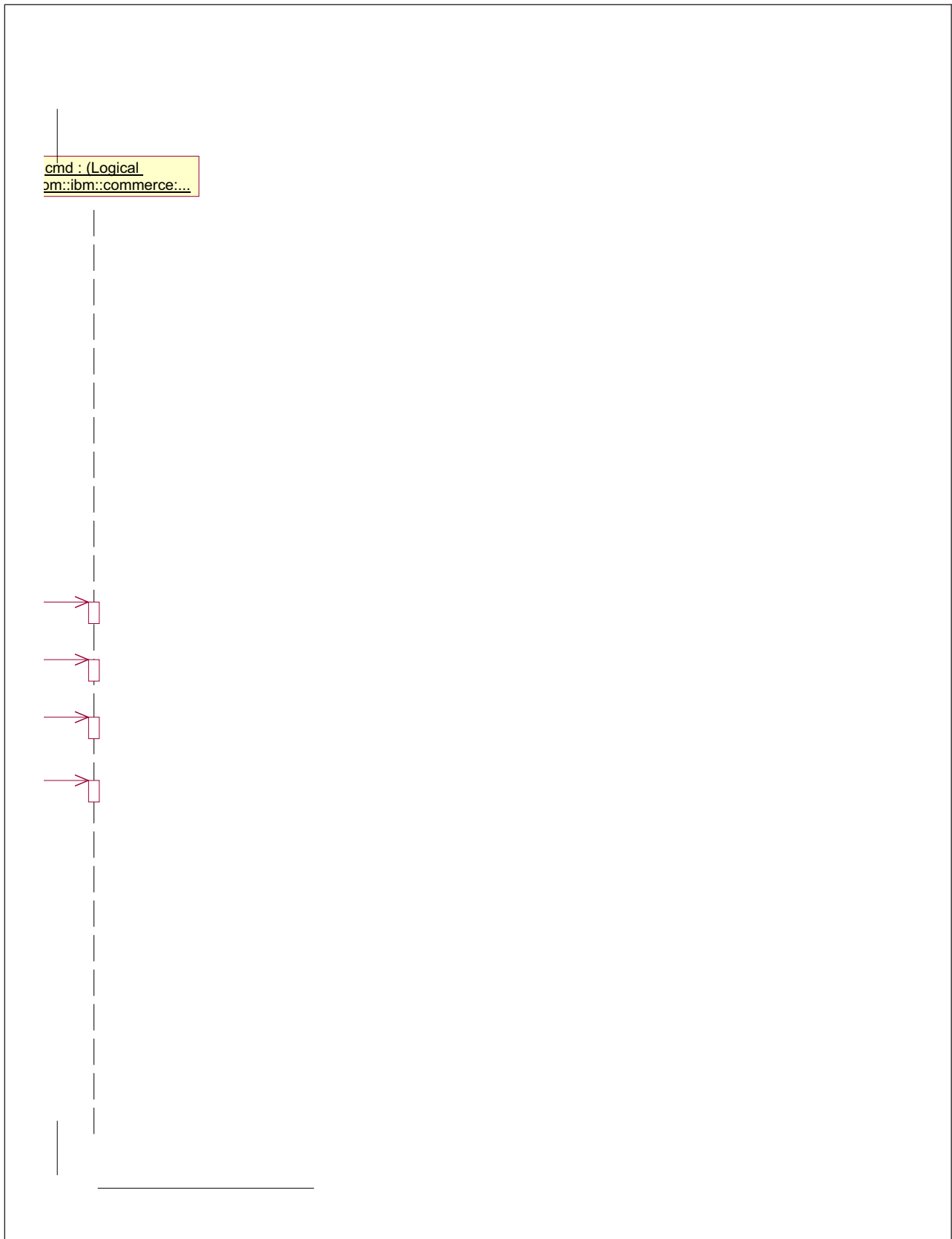


Figure 12. *ApplyCalculationUsage* sequence diagram, 2 of 2 (1,2)

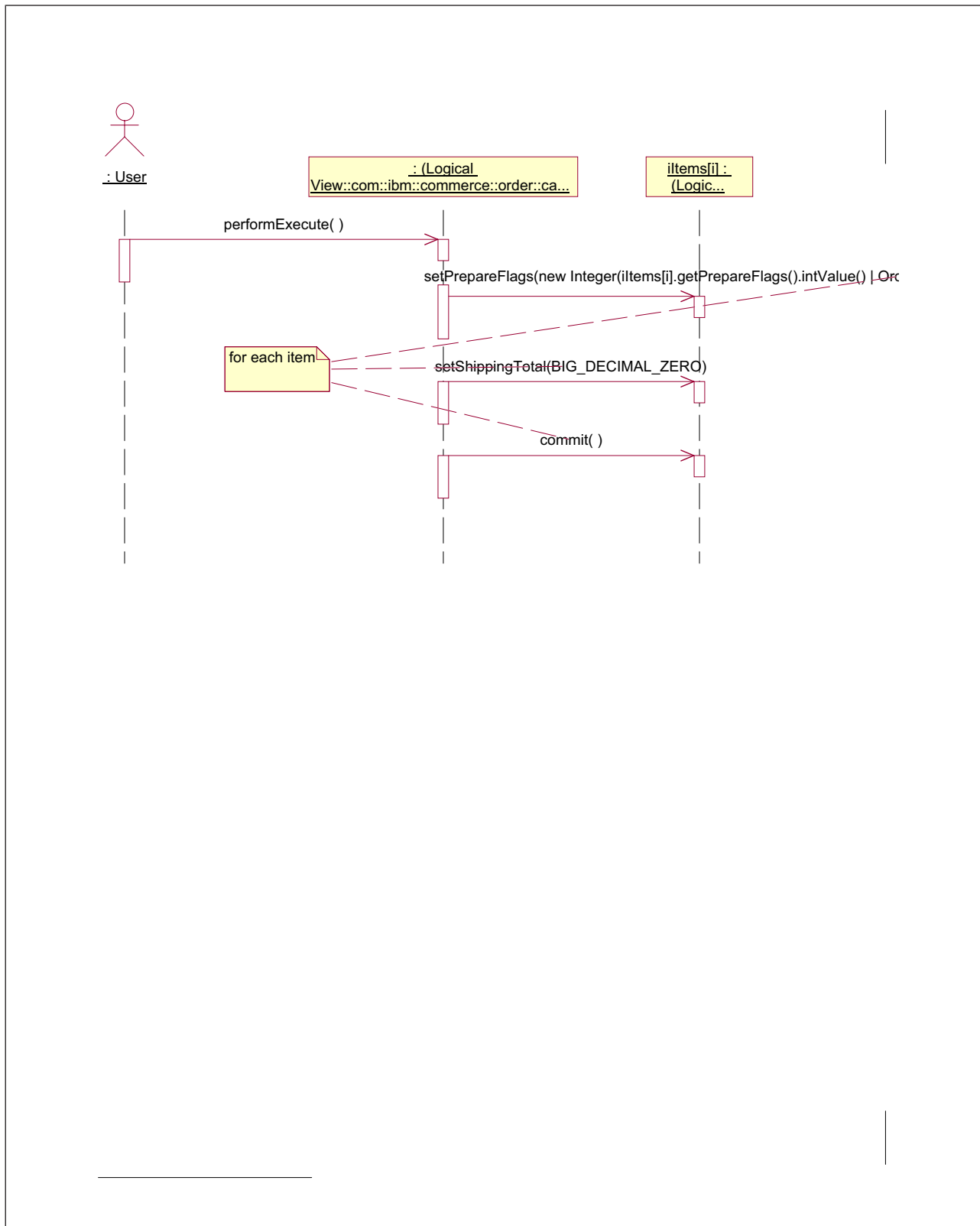


Figure 13. ApplyShippingChargebyCarrier sequence diagram, 1 of 2 (1,1)

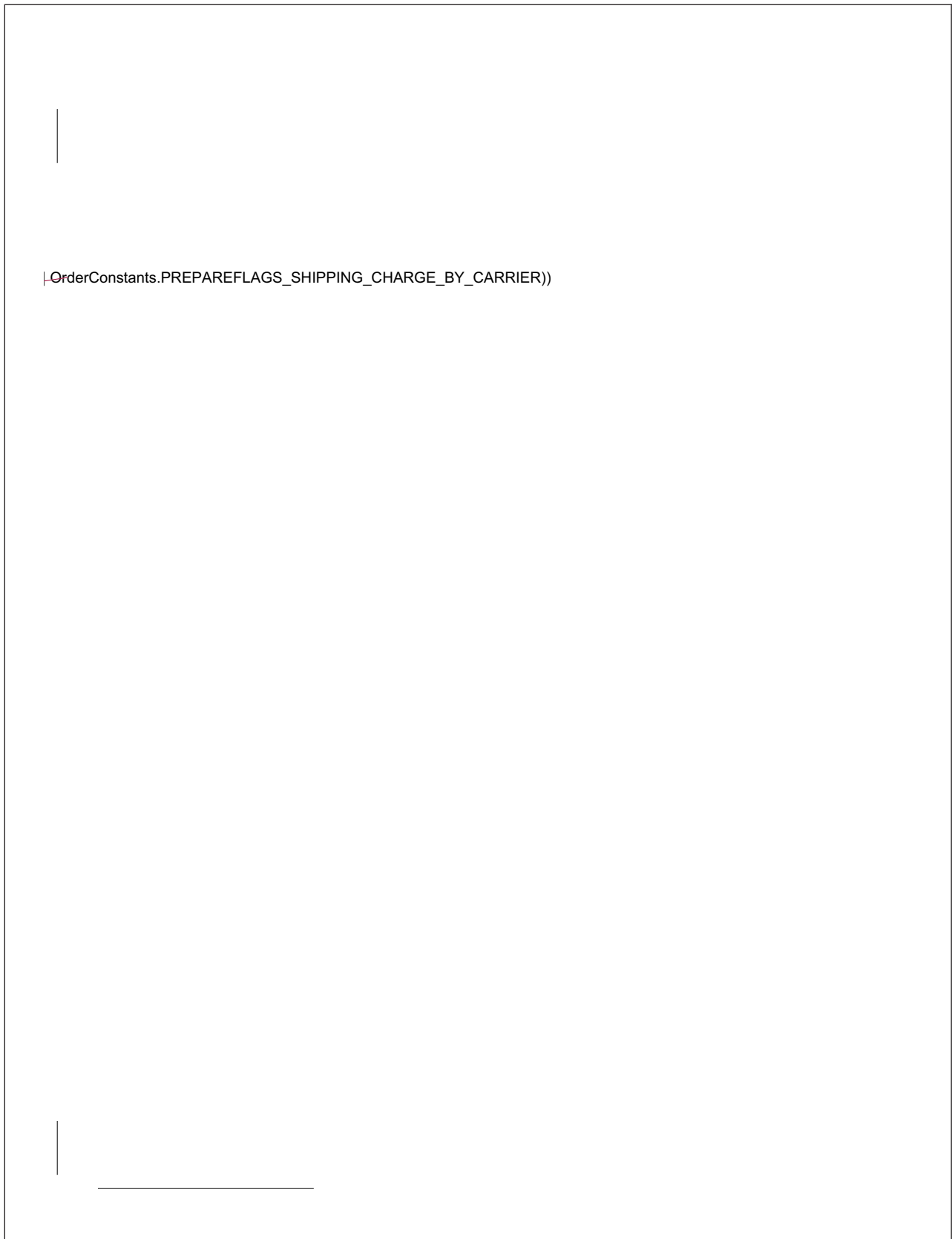


Figure 14. *ApplyShippingChargebyCarrier* sequence diagram, 2 of 2 (1,2)

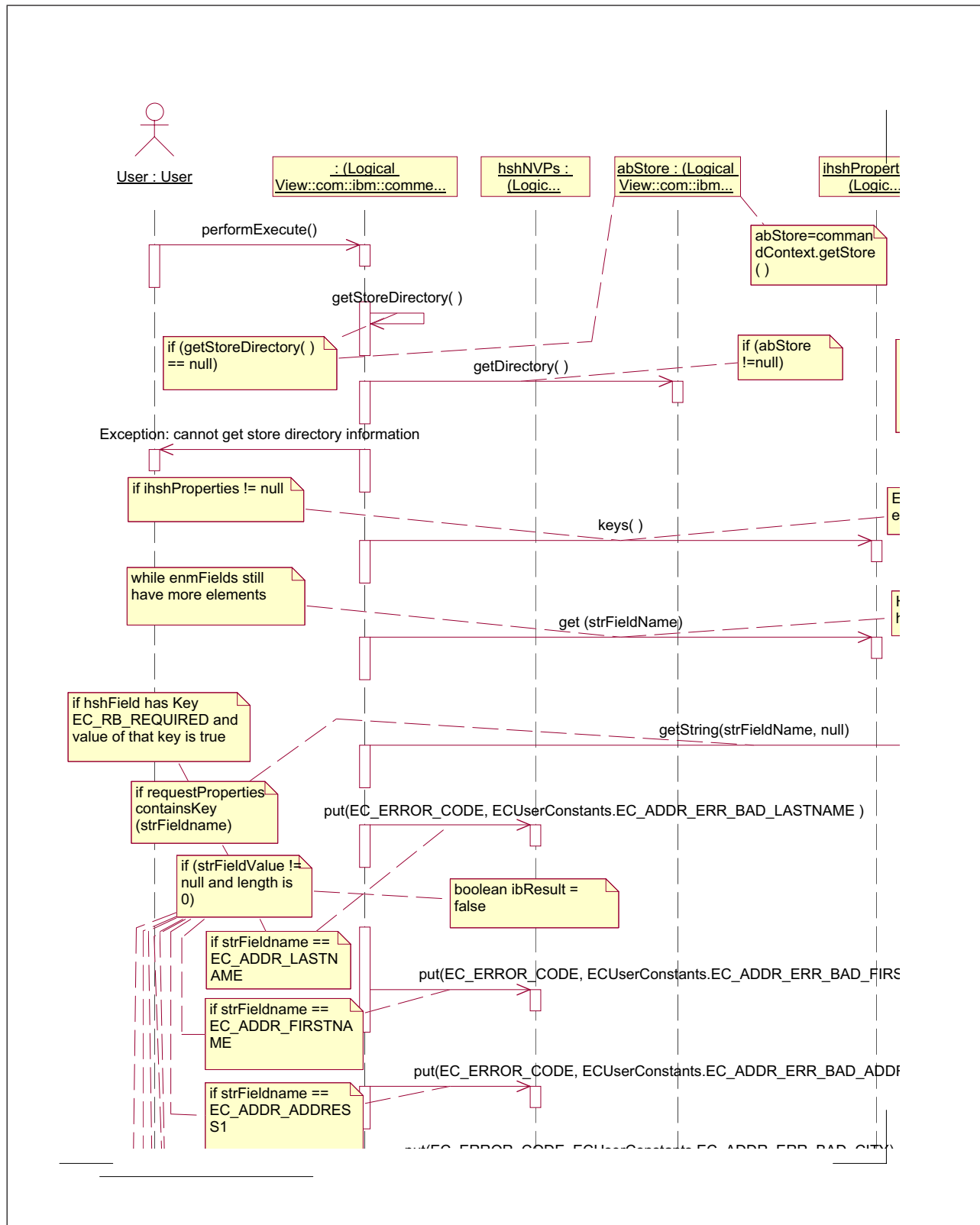


Figure 15. AuditAddress sequence diagram, 1 of 4 (1,1)

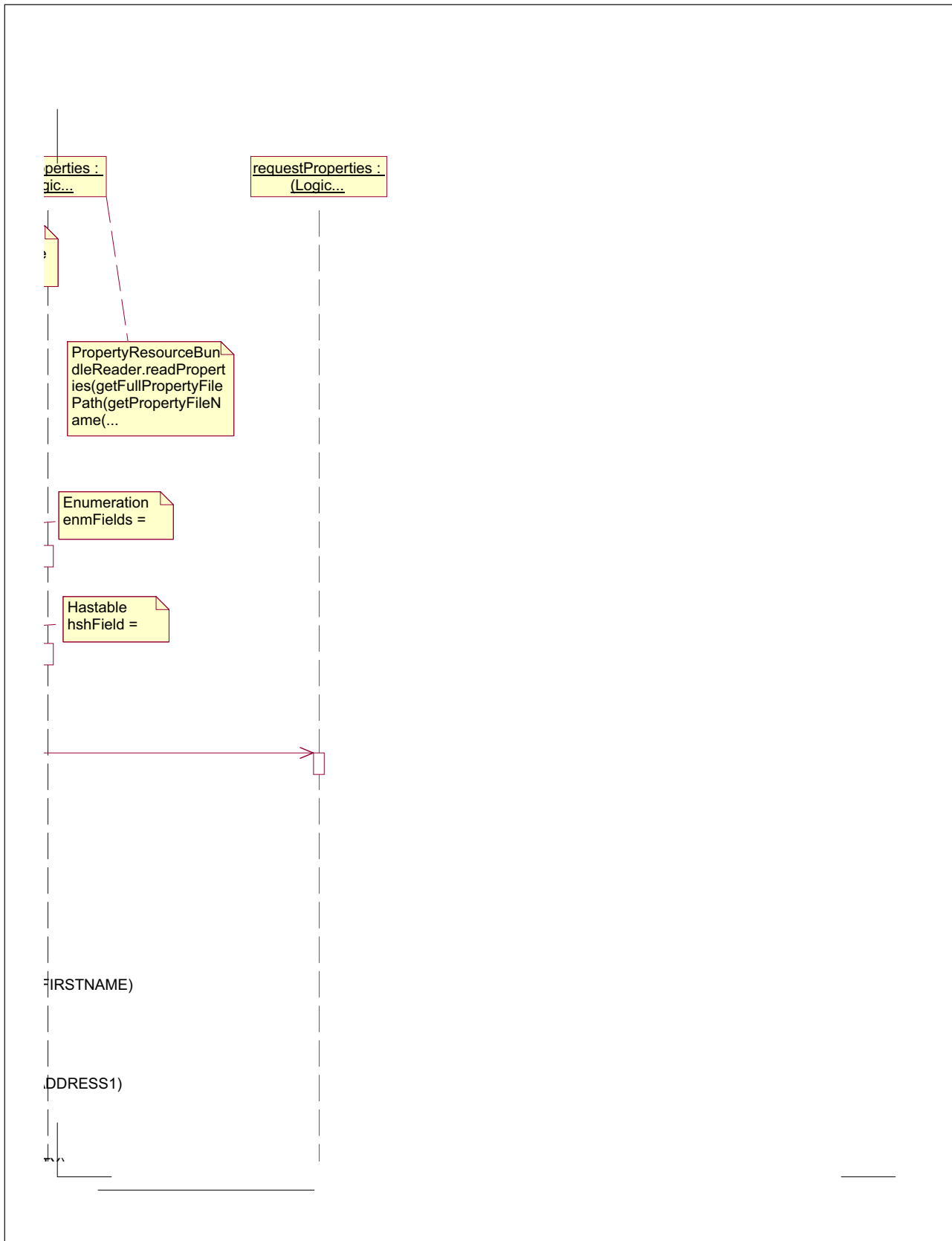


Figure 16. *AuditAddress* sequence diagram, 2 of 4 (1,2)

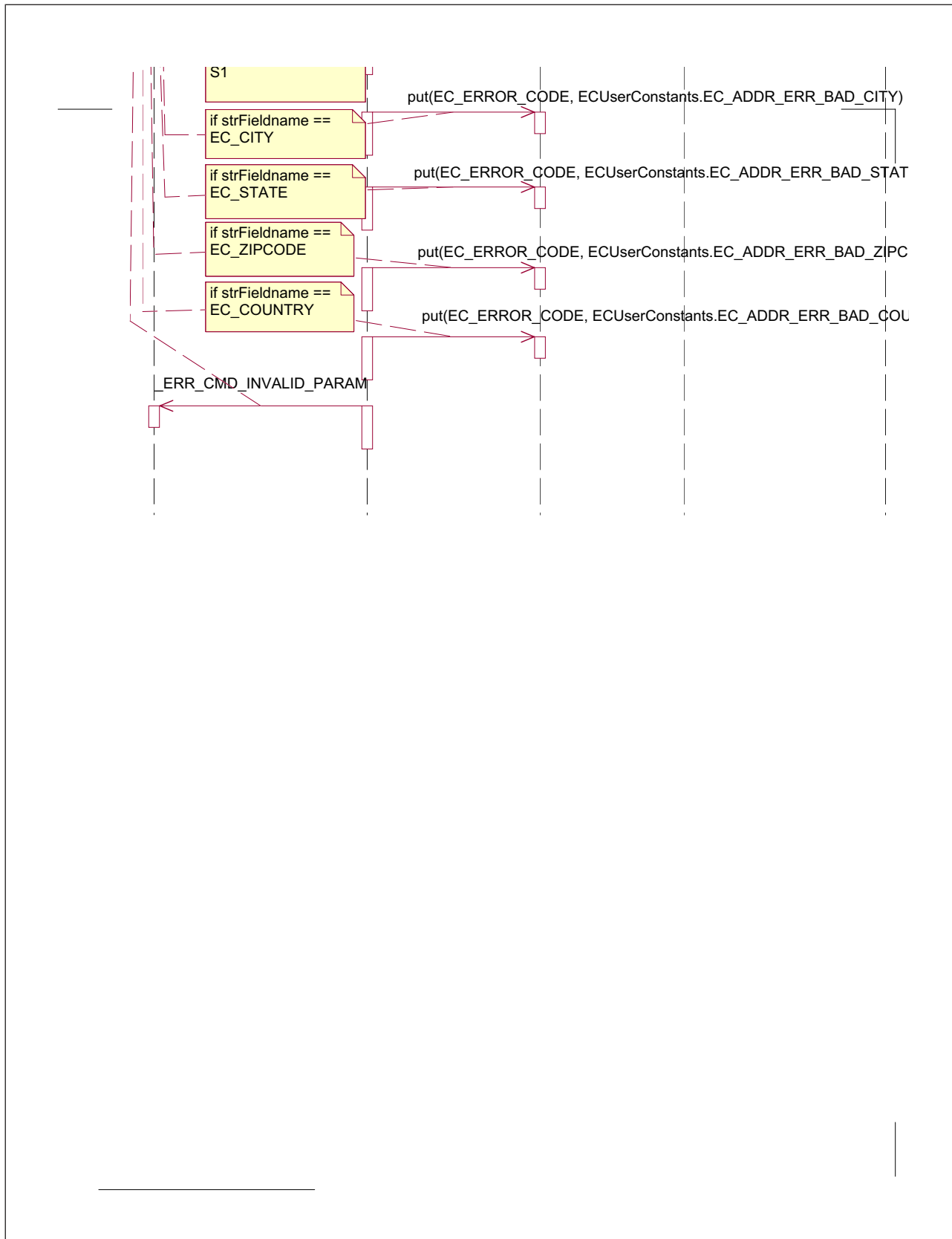


Figure 17. *AuditAddress* sequence diagram, 3 of 4 (2,1)

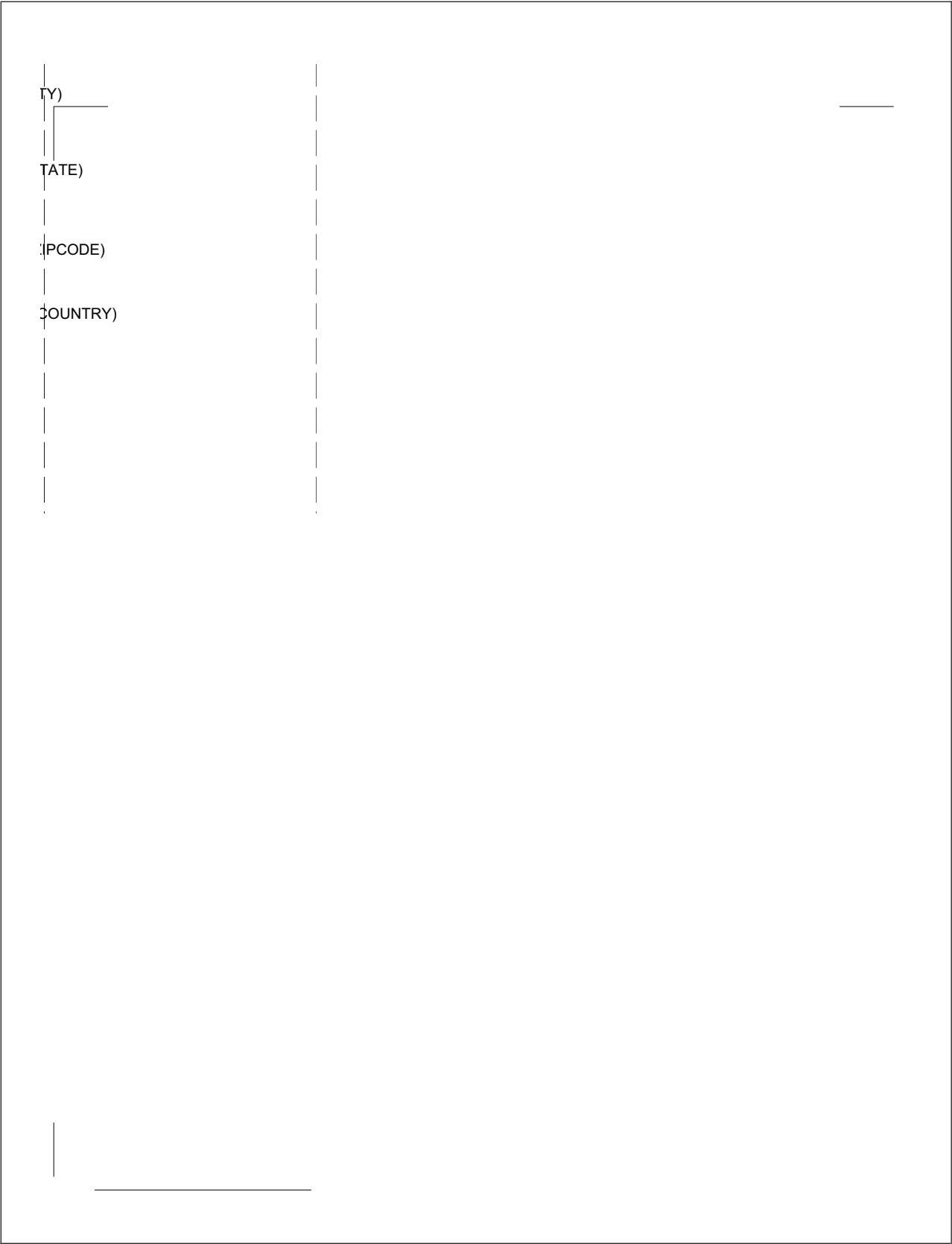


Figure 18. AuditAddress sequence diagram, 4 of 4 (2,2)

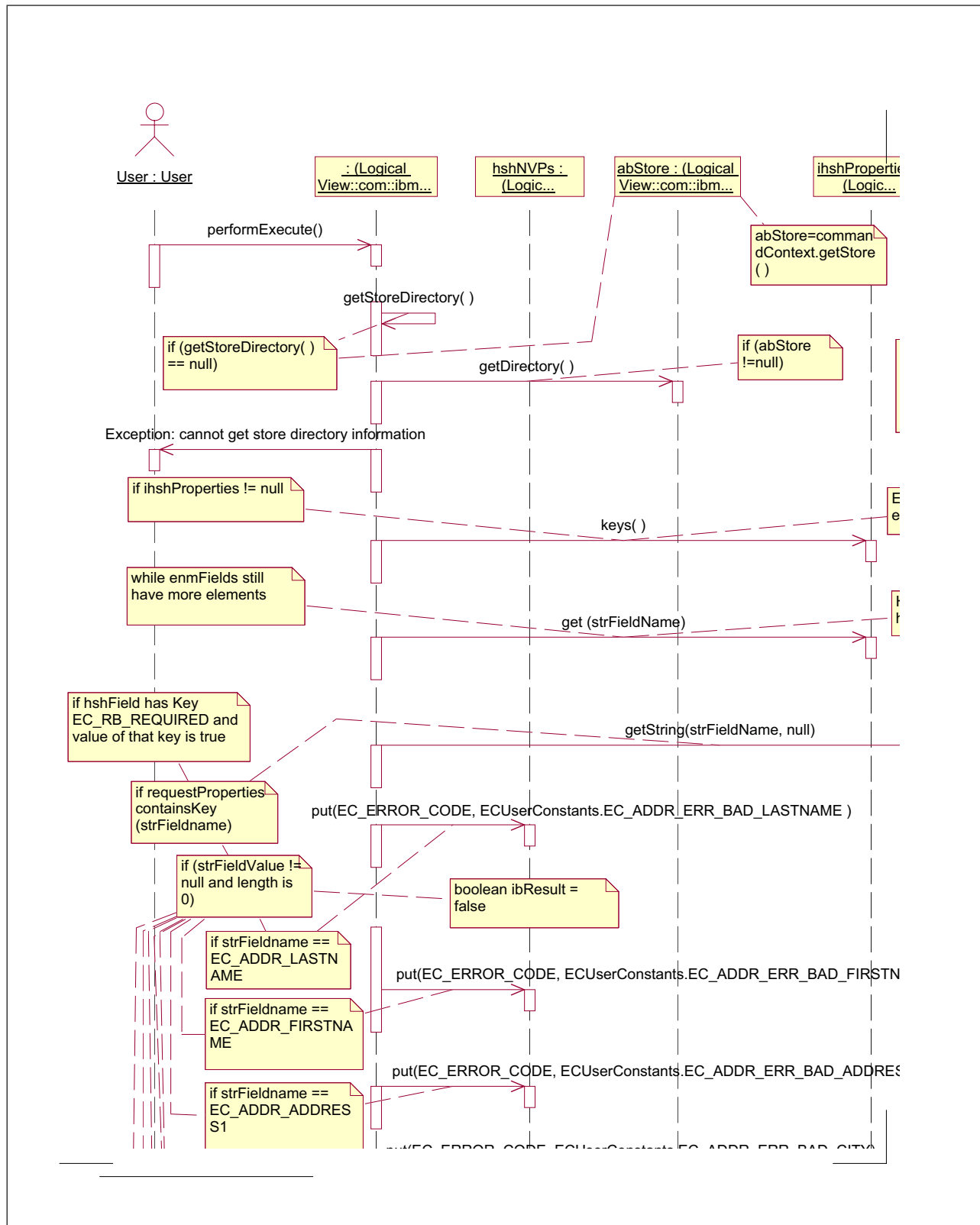


Figure 19. AuditBase sequence diagram, 1 of 4 (1,1)

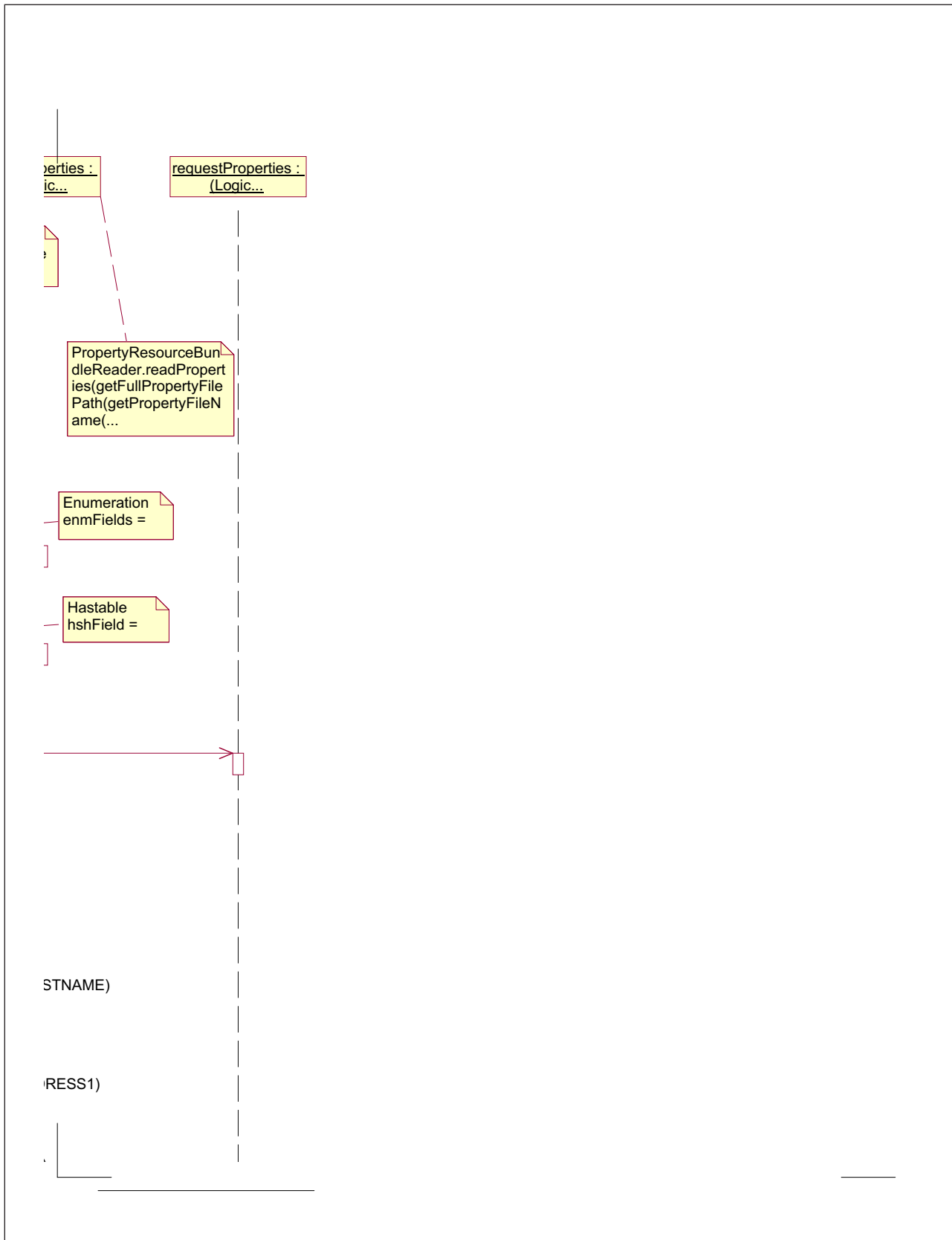


Figure 20. AuditBase sequence diagram, 2 of 4 (1,2)

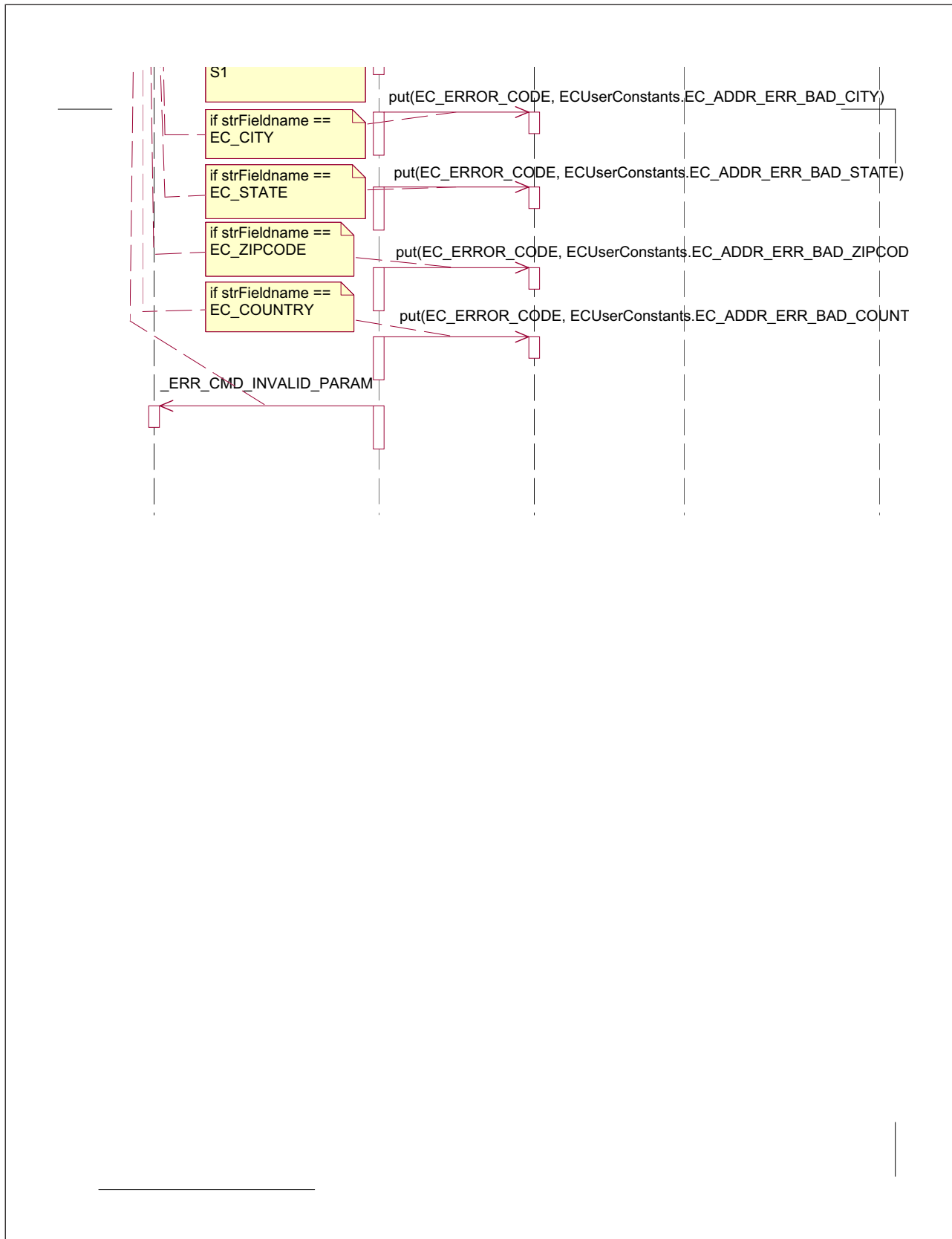


Figure 21. AuditBase sequence diagram, 3 of 4 (2,1)

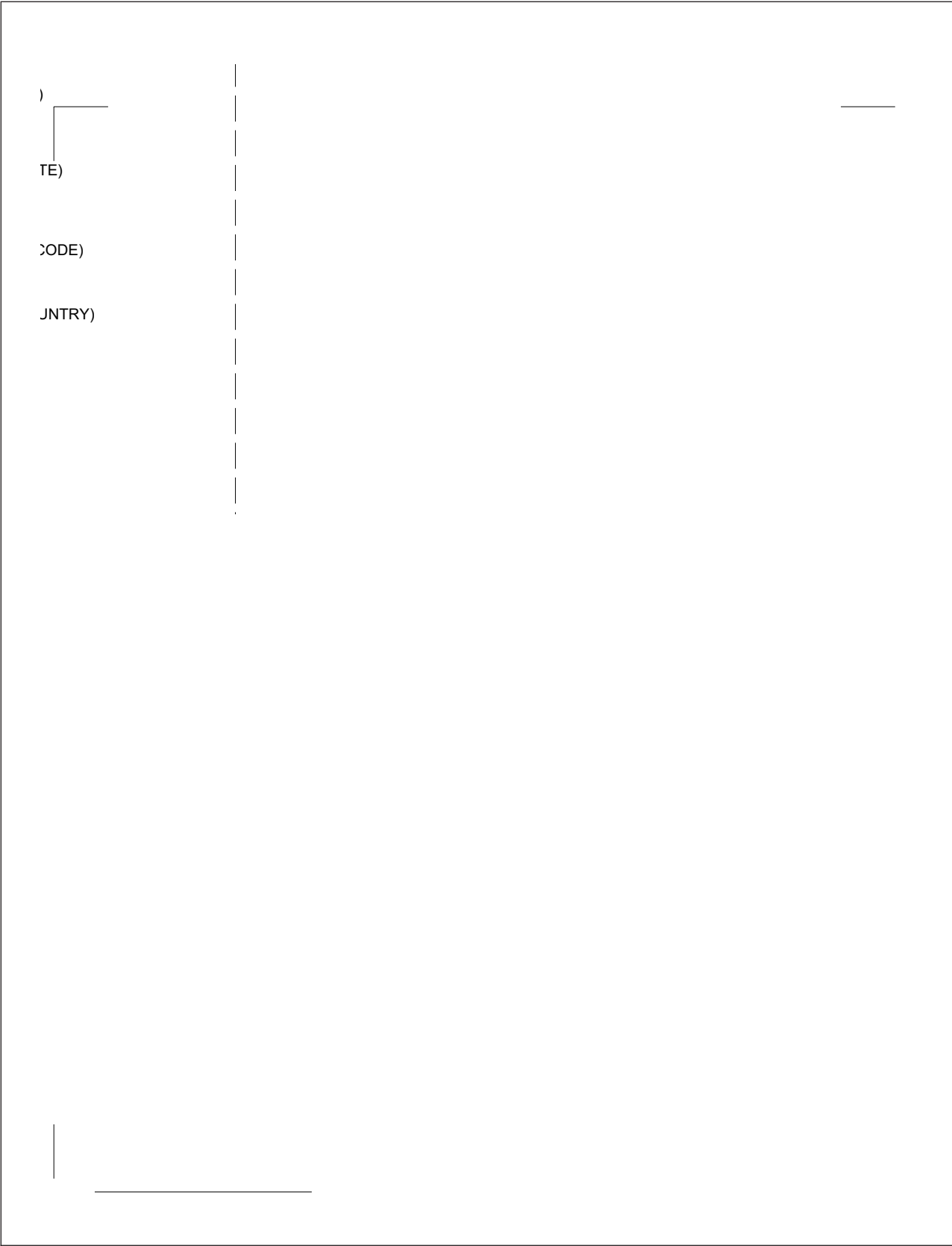


Figure 22. AuditBase sequence diagram, 4 of 4 (2,2)

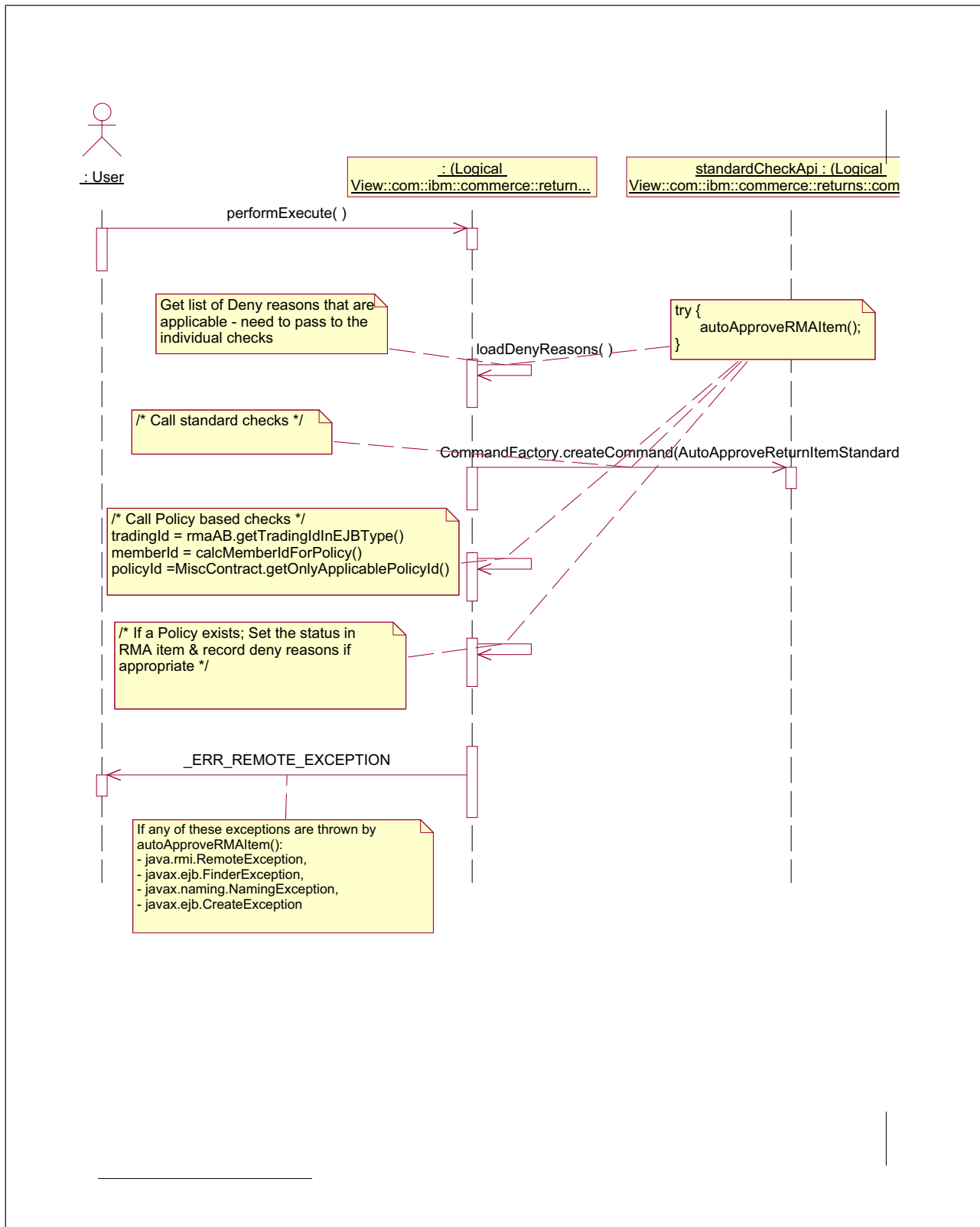


Figure 23. AutoApproveReturnItem sequence diagram, 1 of 2 (1,1)

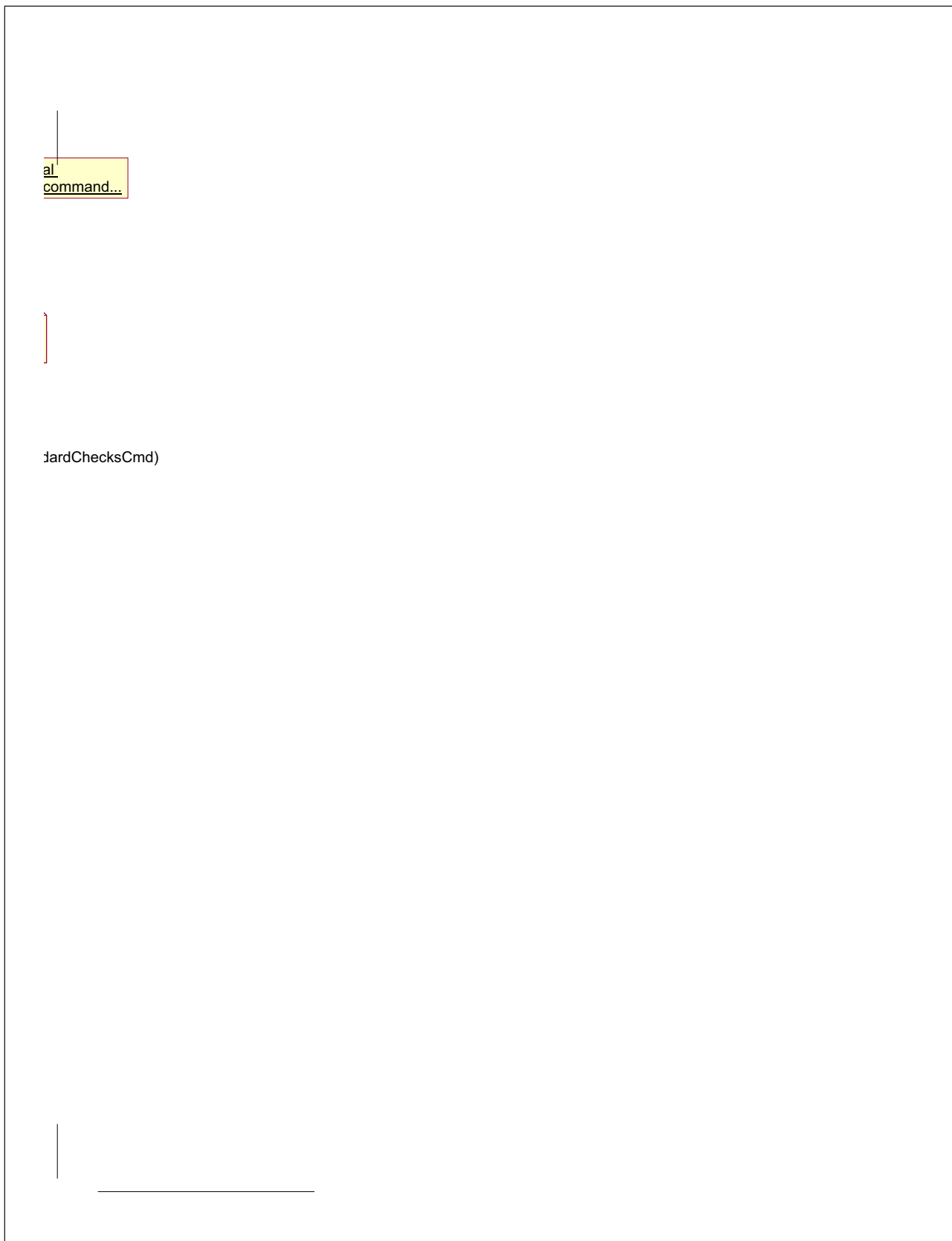


Figure 24. AutoApproveReturnItem sequence diagram, 2 of 2 (1,2)

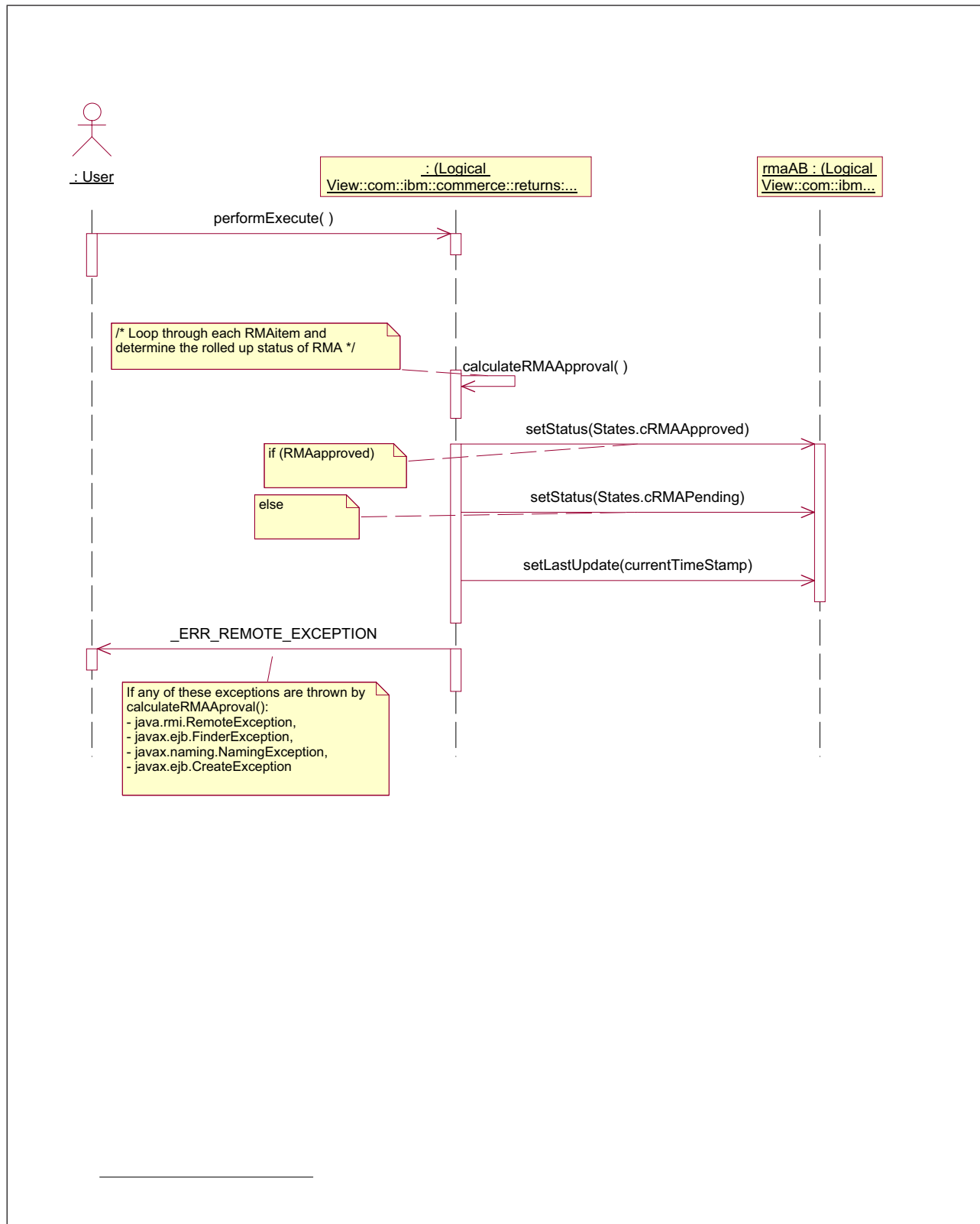
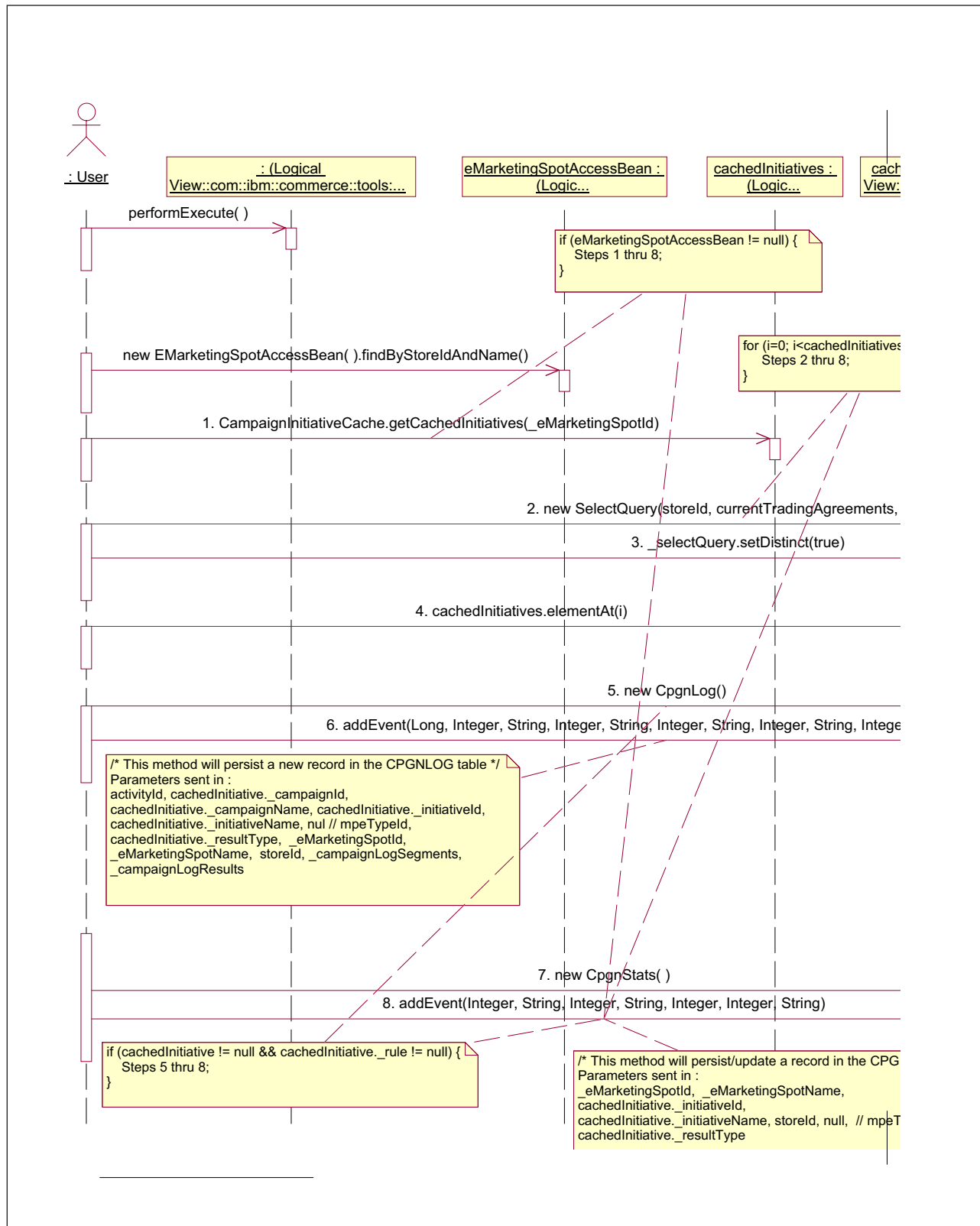


Figure 25. CalculateRMAApproval sequence diagram

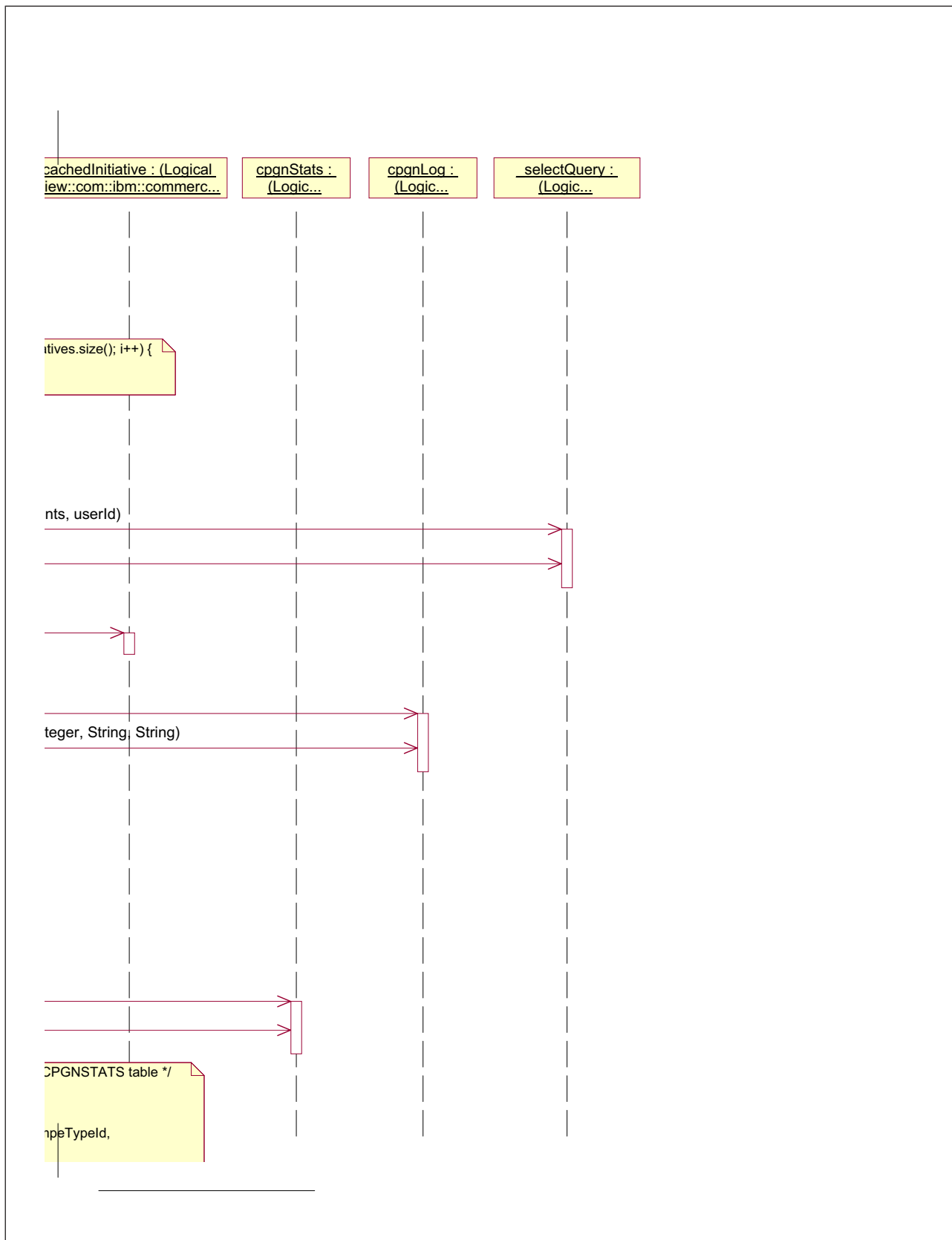


Figure 27. CampaignInitiativeEvaluate sequence diagram, 2 of 2 (1,2)

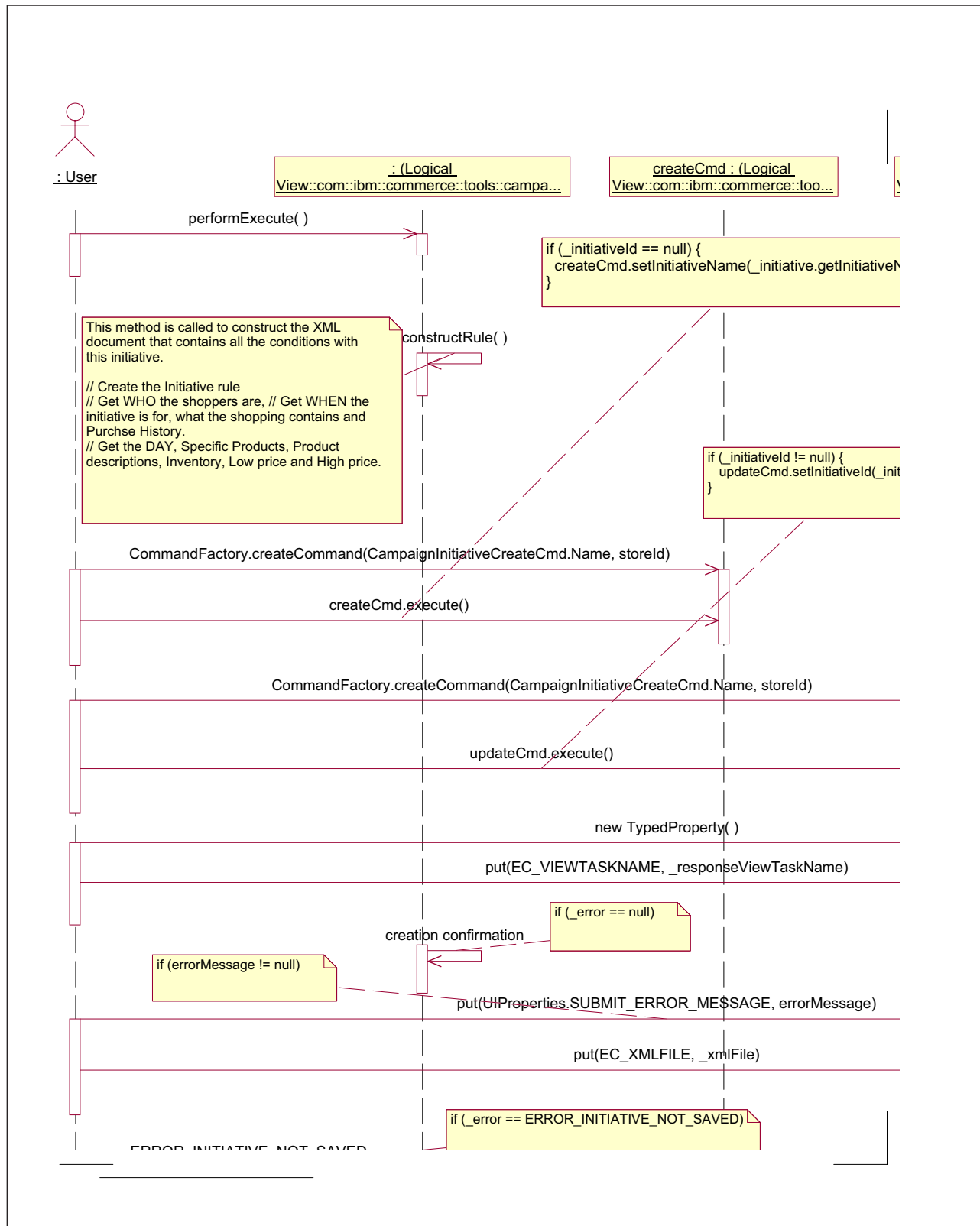


Figure 28. CampaignInitiativeSaveController sequence diagram, 1 of 4 (1,1)

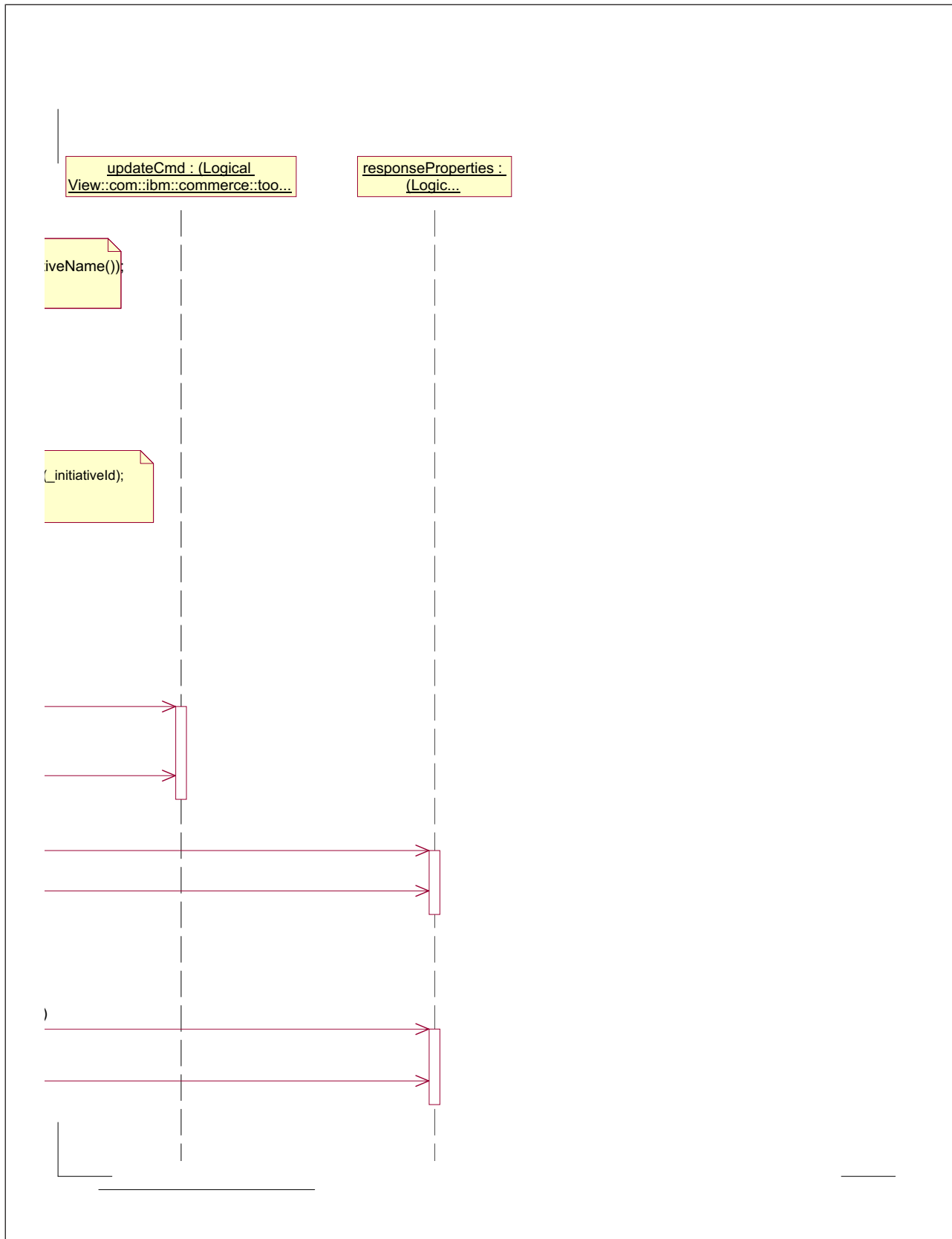


Figure 29. CampaignInitiativeSaveController sequence diagram, 2 of 4 (1,2)

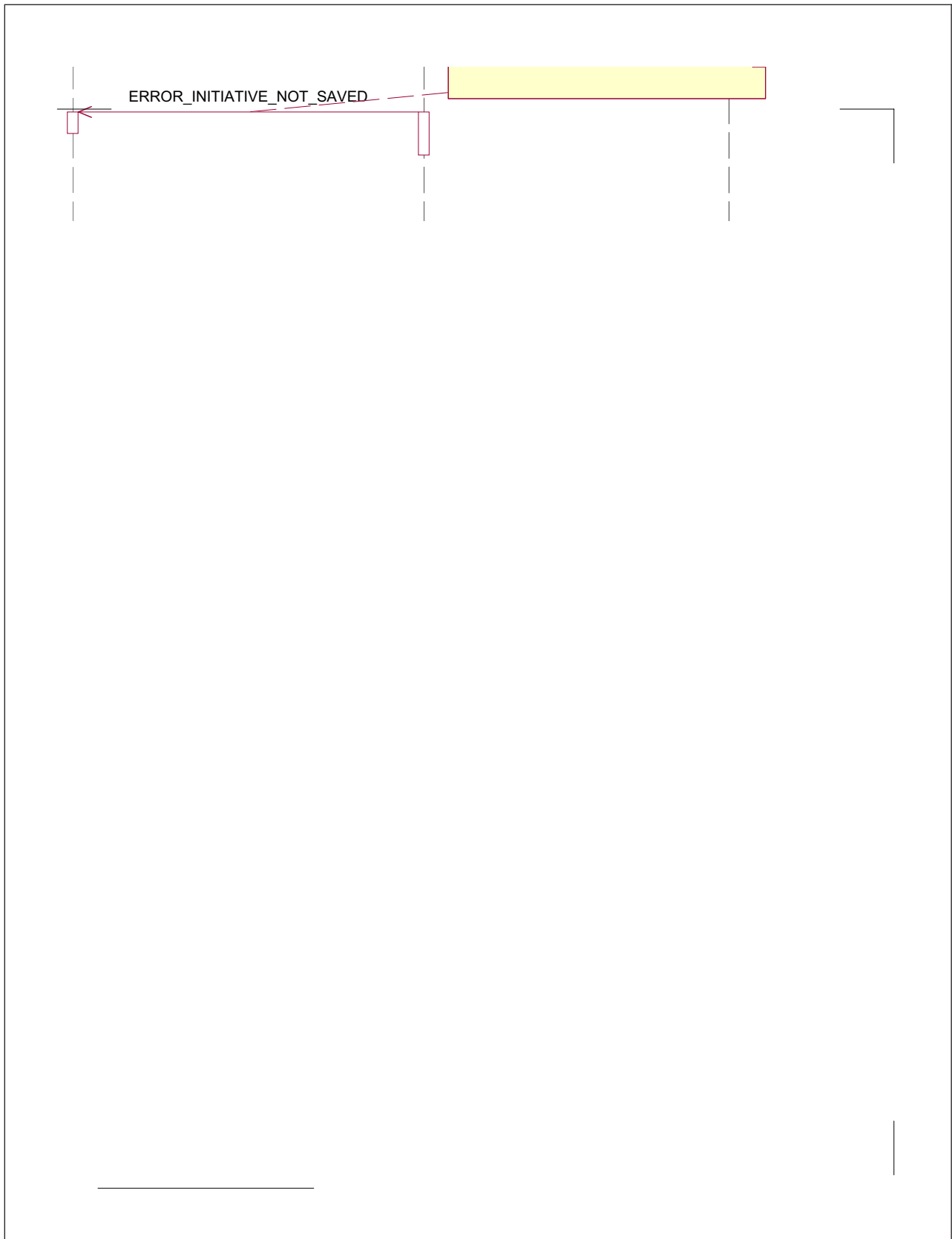


Figure 30. CampaignInitiativeSaveController sequence diagram, 3 of 4 (2,1)

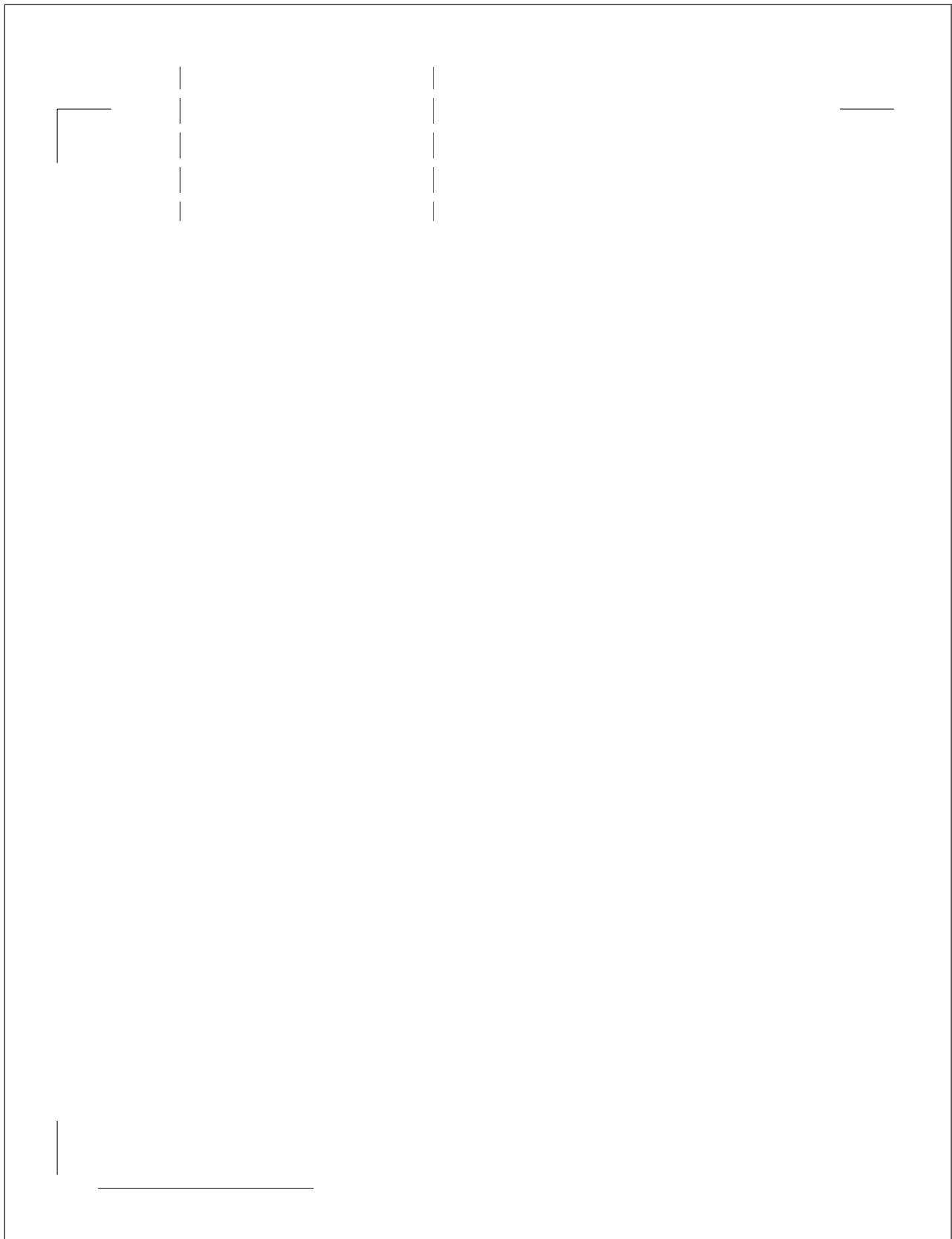


Figure 31. CampaignInitiativeSaveController sequence diagram, 4 of 4 (2,2)

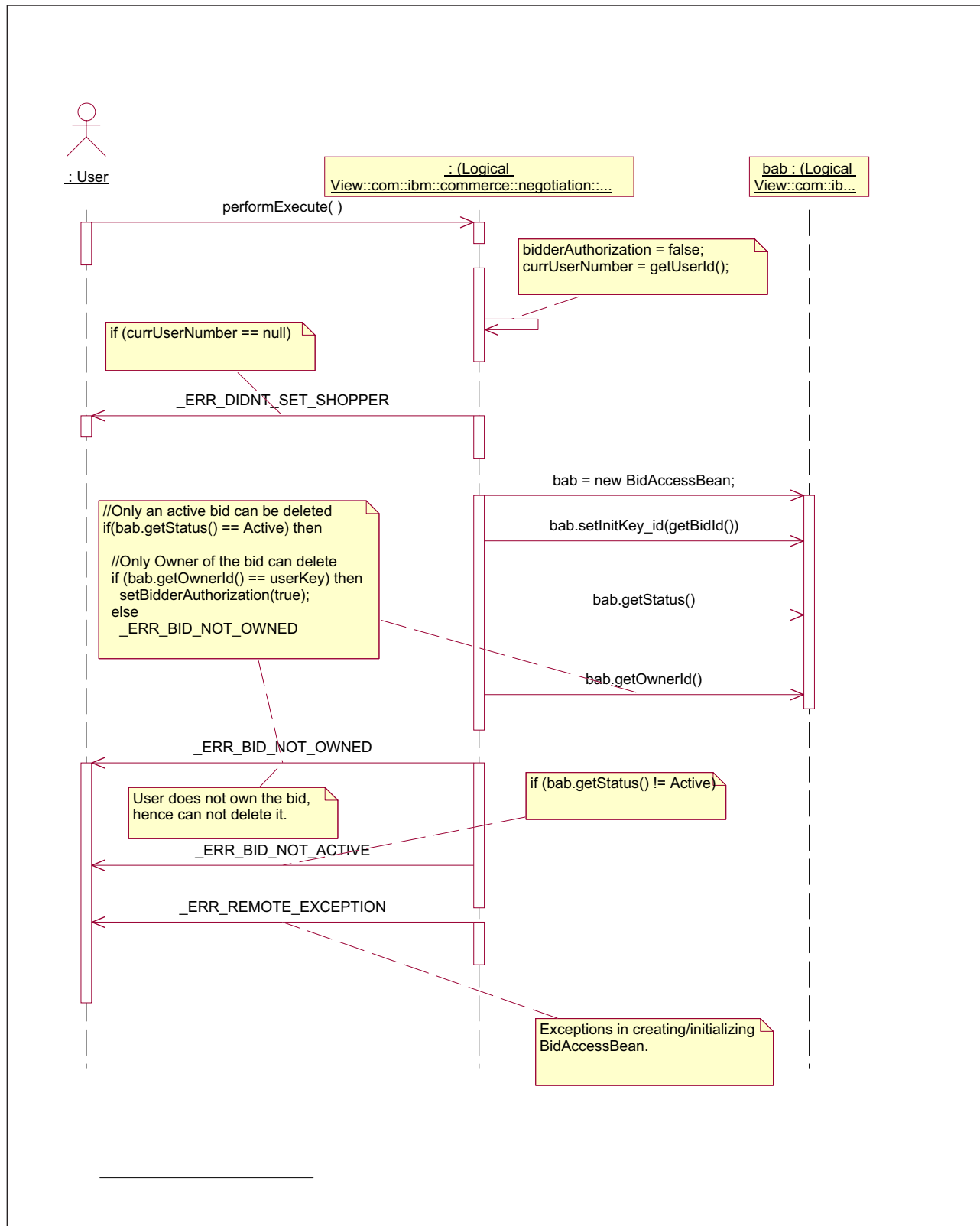


Figure 32. CheckBidDeleteAuthorization sequence diagram

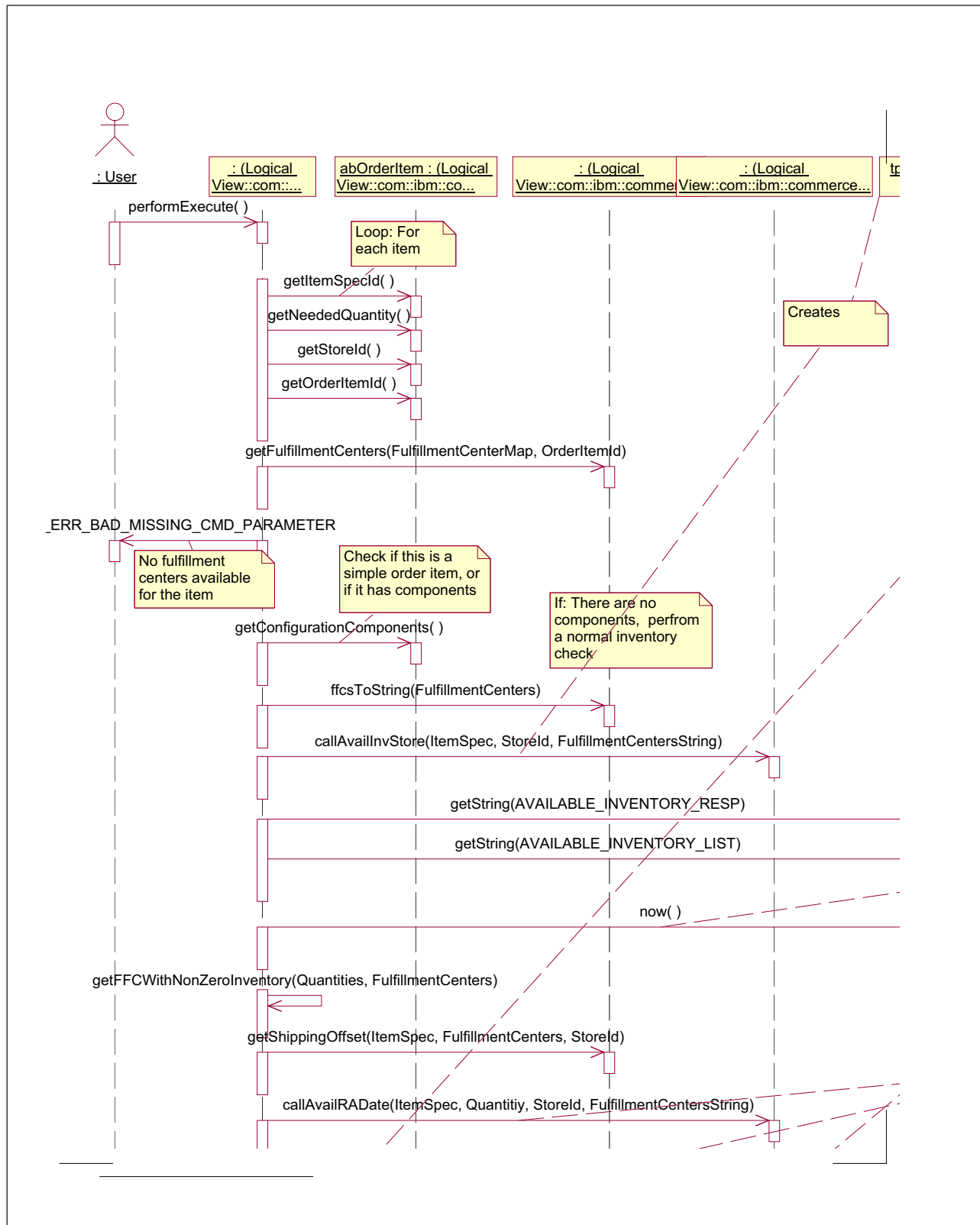


Figure 33. CheckInventoryAvailability sequence diagram, 1 of 9 (1,1)

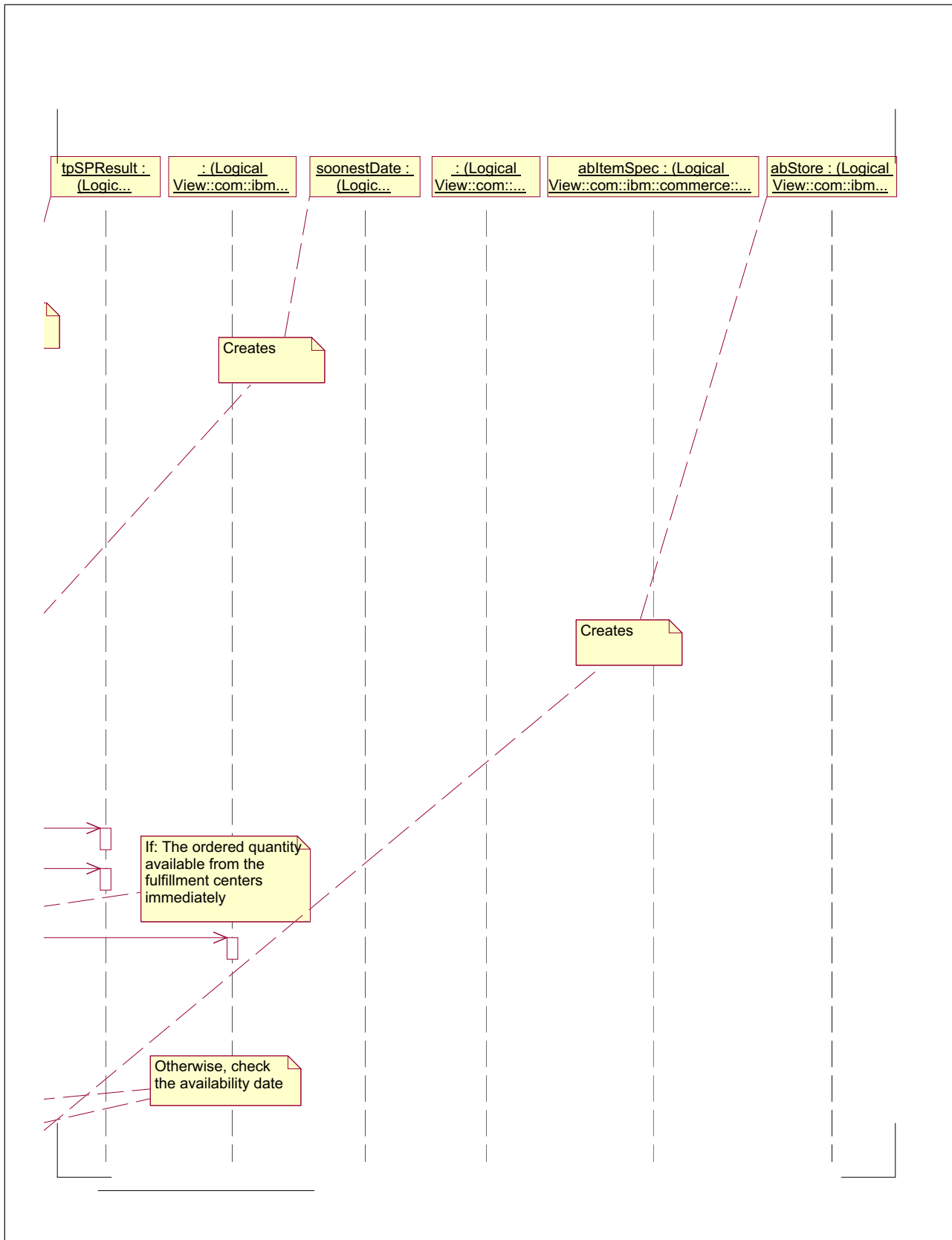


Figure 34. CheckInventoryAvailability sequence diagram, 2 of 9 (1,2)

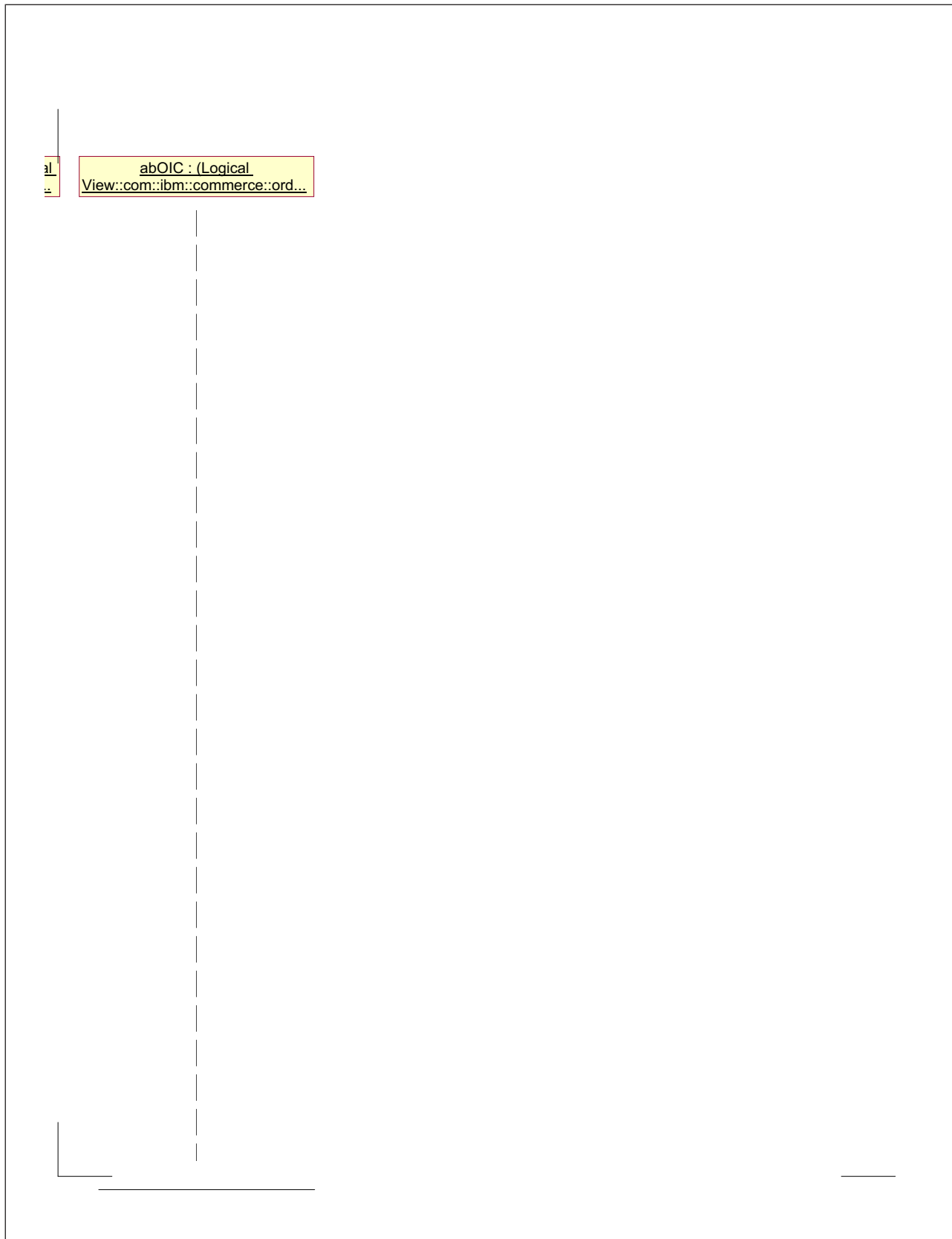


Figure 35. CheckInventoryAvailability sequence diagram, 3 of 9 (1,3)



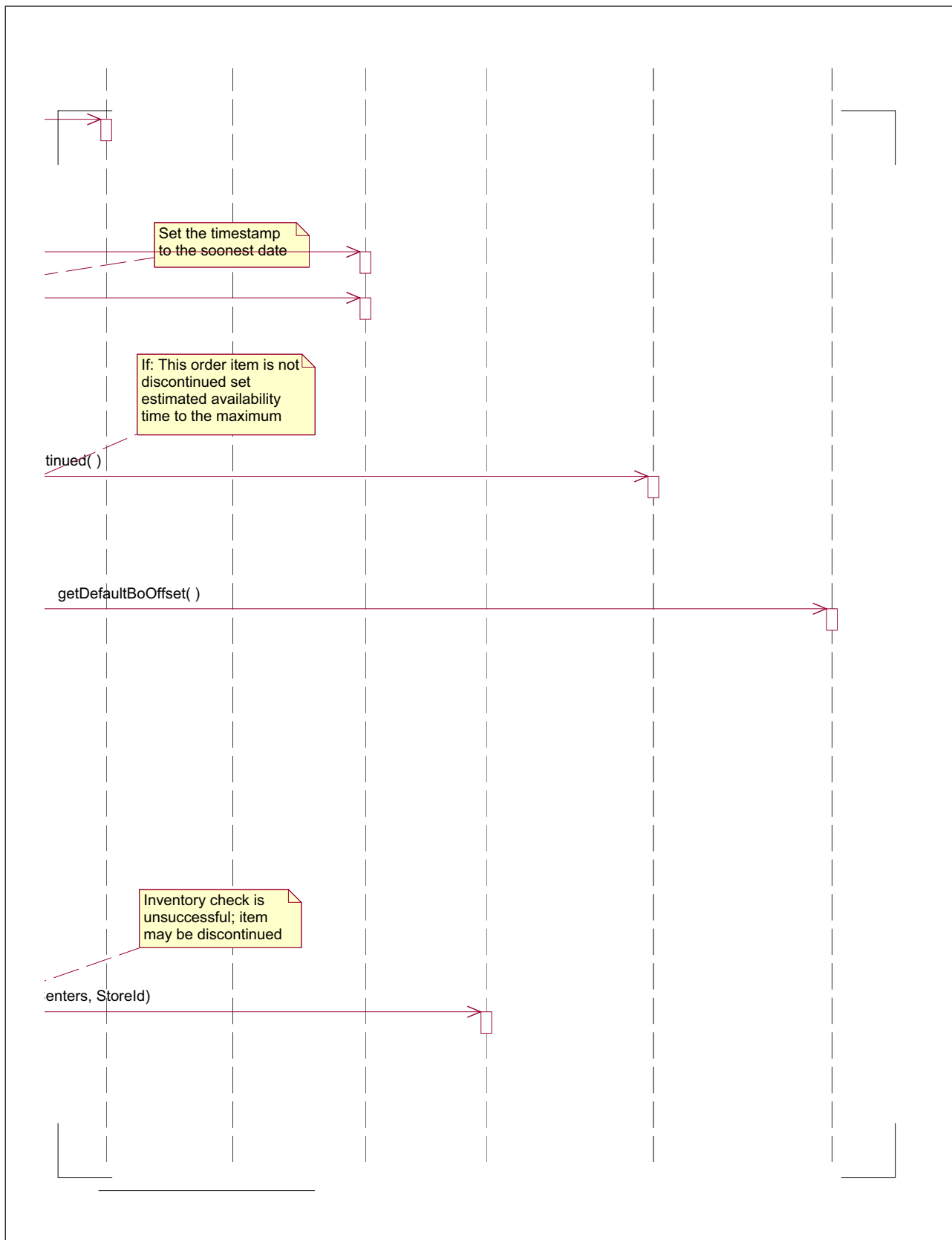


Figure 37. CheckInventoryAvailability sequence diagram, 5 of 9 (2,2)

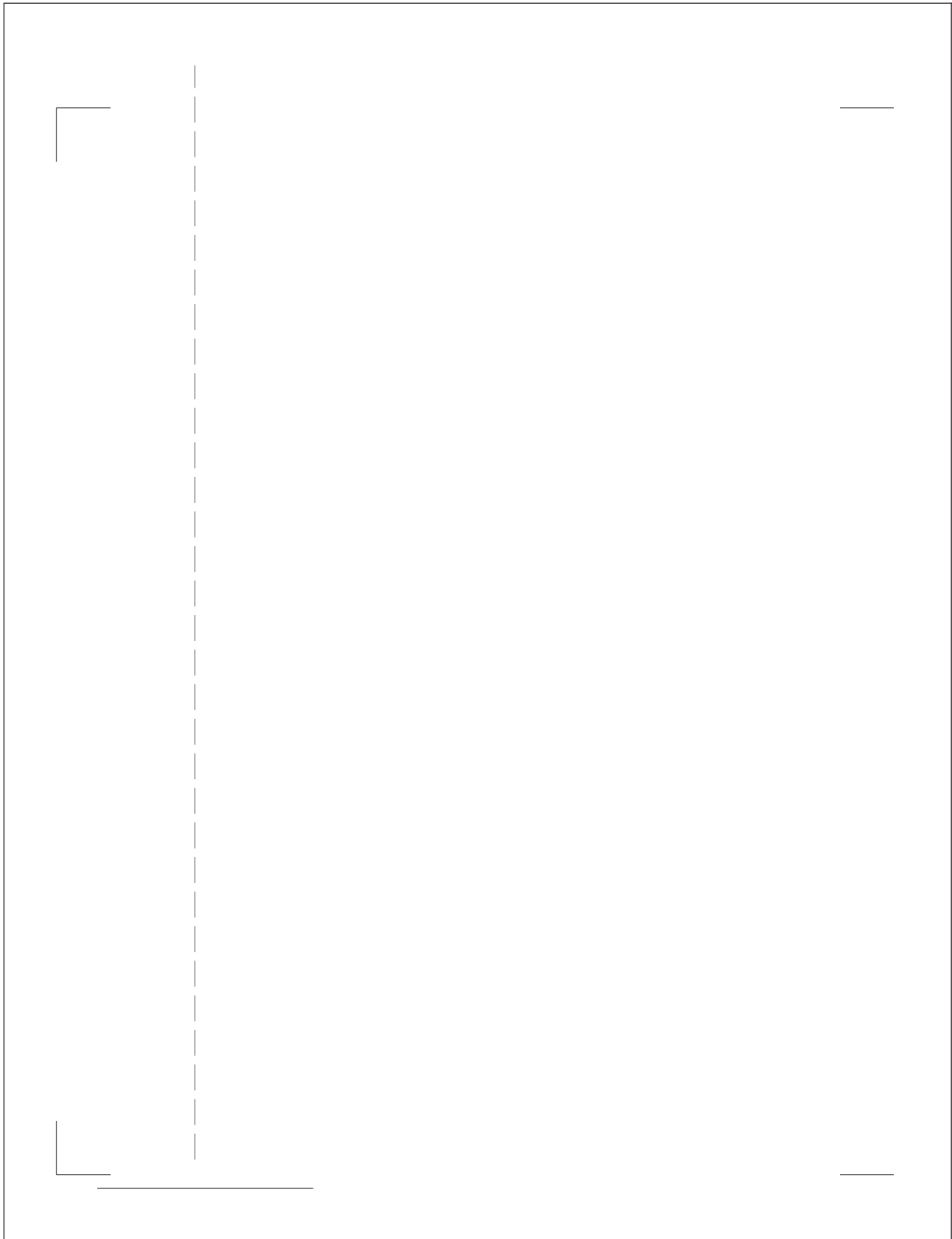


Figure 38. *CheckInventoryAvailability* sequence diagram, 6 of 9 (2,3)

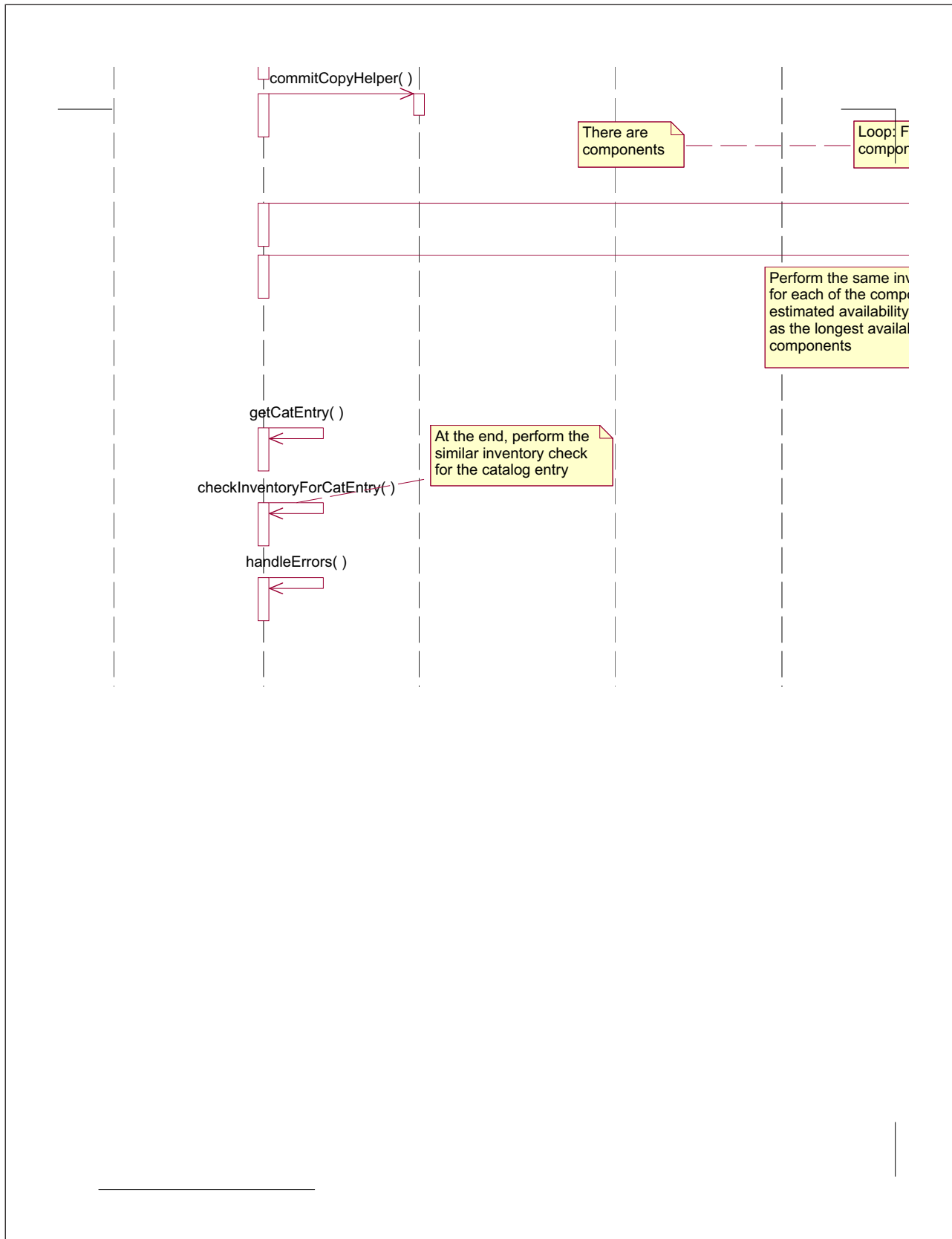


Figure 39. CheckInventoryAvailability sequence diagram, 7 of 9 (3,1)



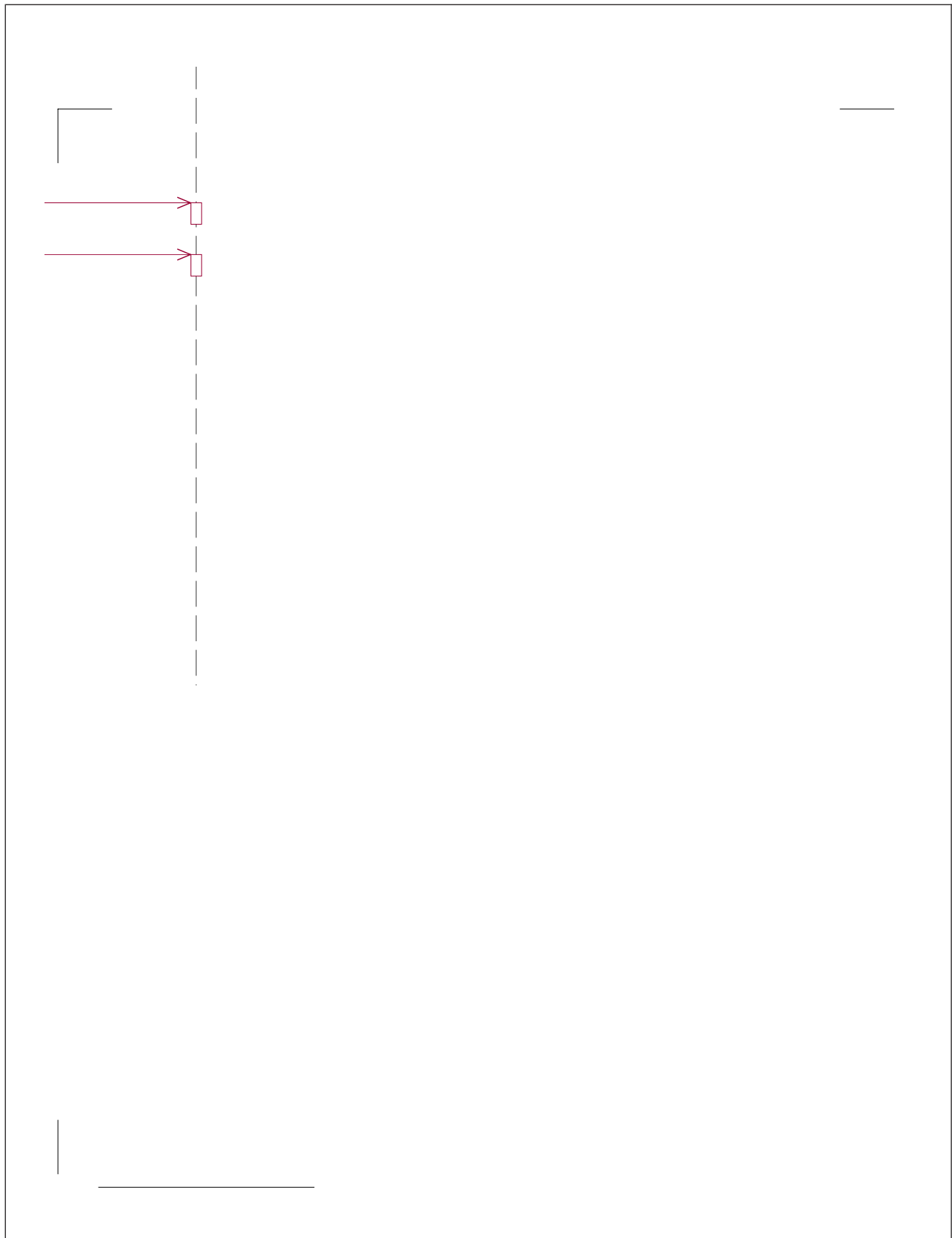


Figure 41. CheckInventoryAvailability sequence diagram, 9 of 9 (3,3)

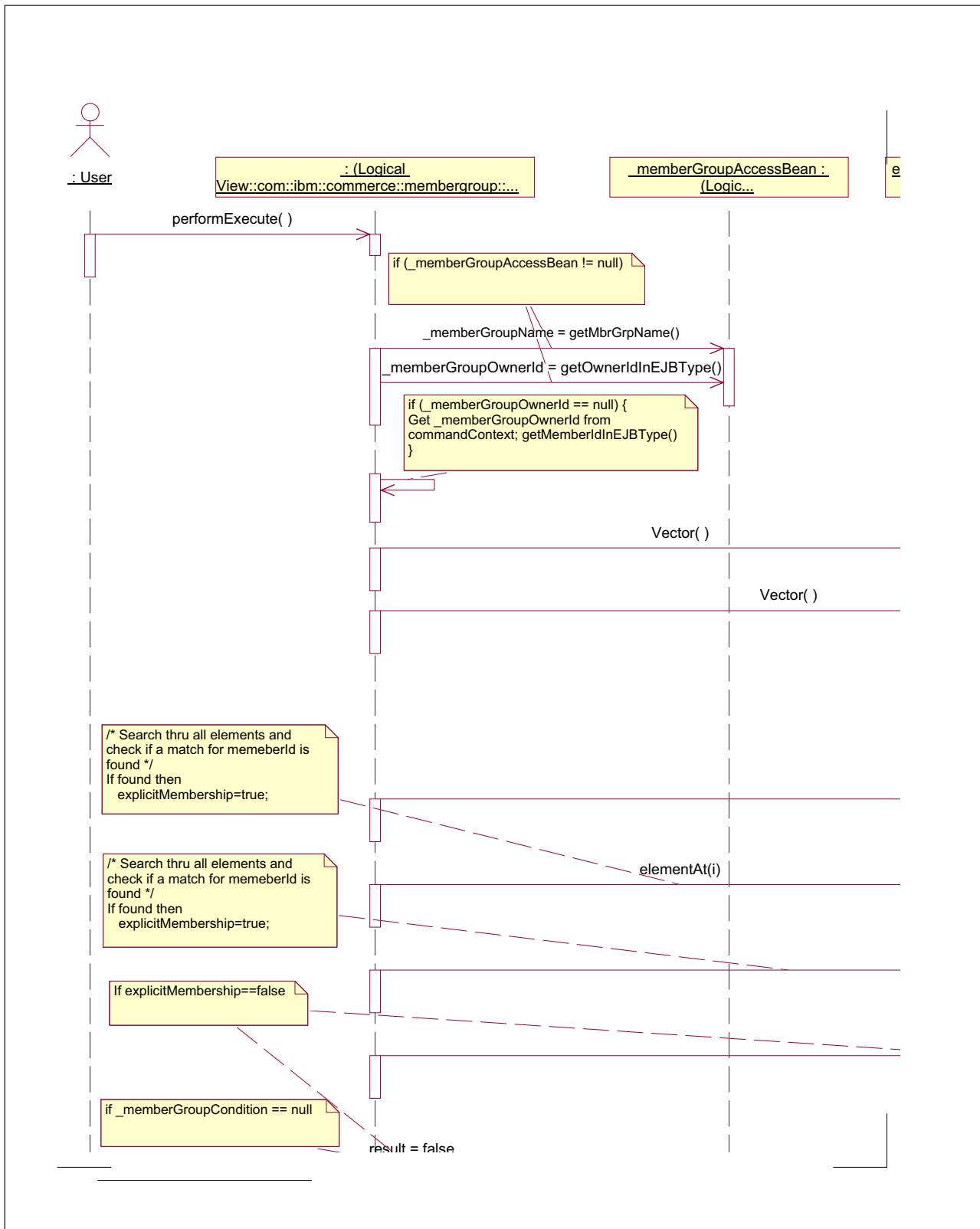


Figure 42. CheckUserInMemberGroup sequence diagram, 1 of 4 (1,1)

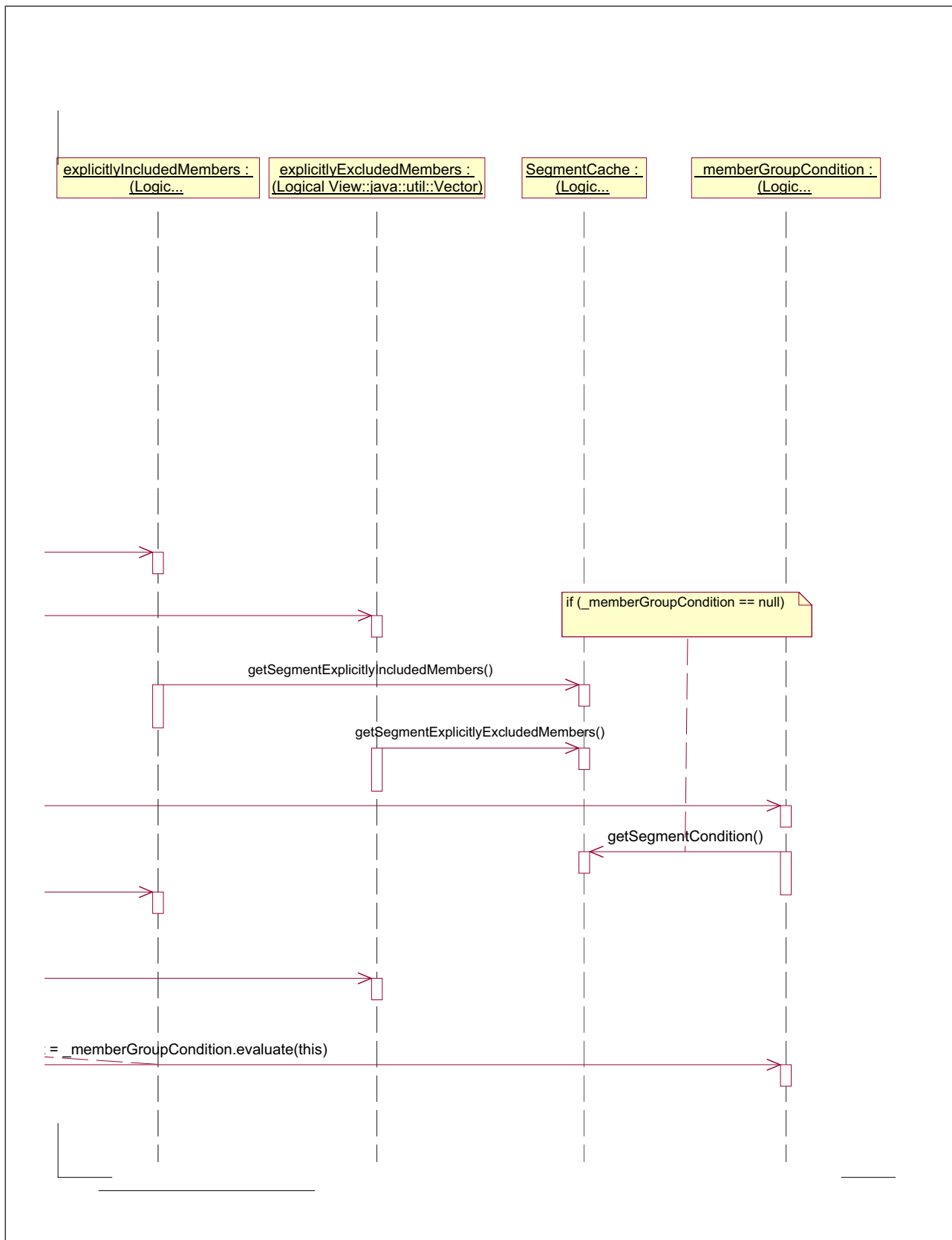


Figure 43. CheckUserInMemberGroup sequence diagram, 2 of 4 (1,2)

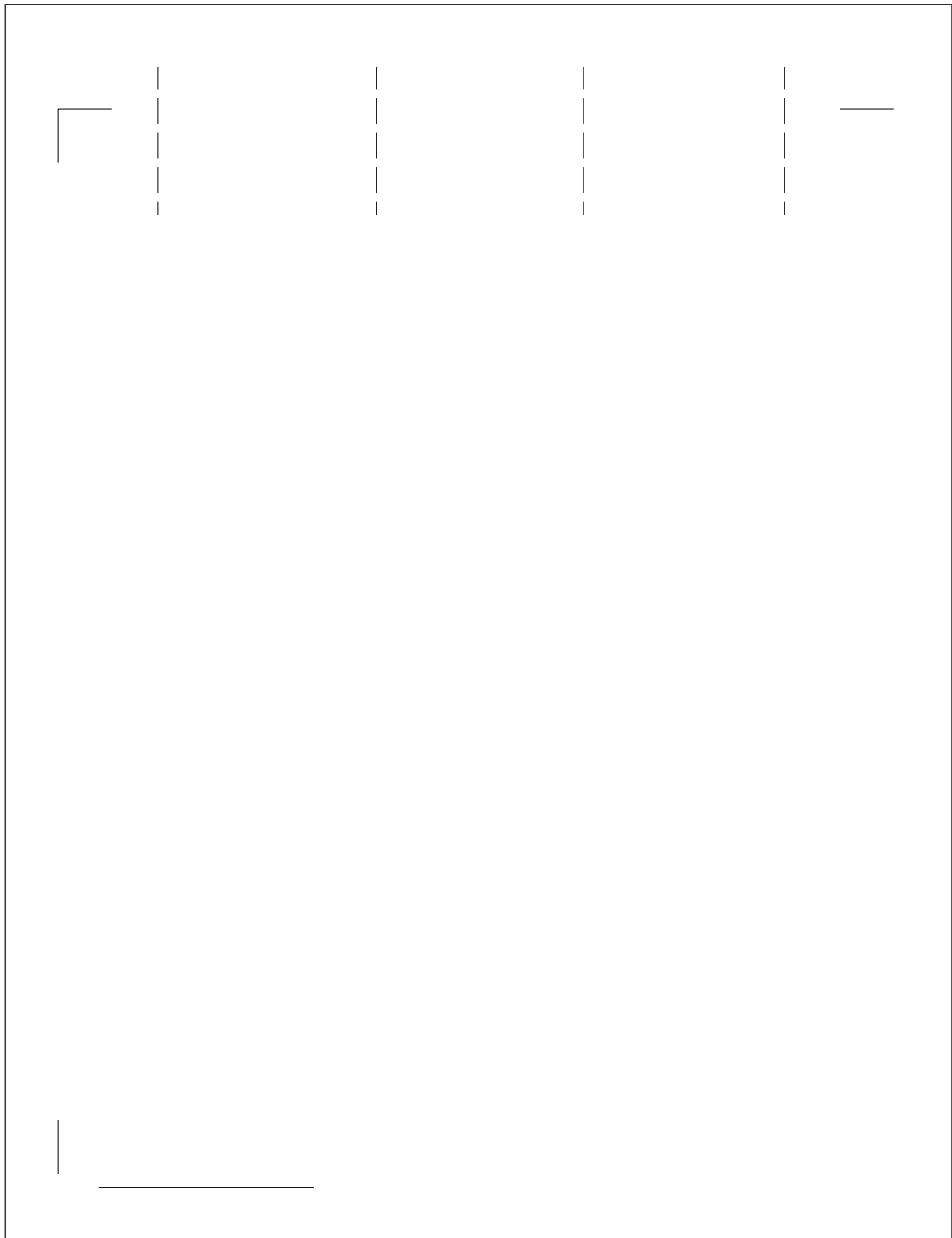


Figure 45. CheckUserInMemberGroup sequence diagram, 4 of 4 (2,2)

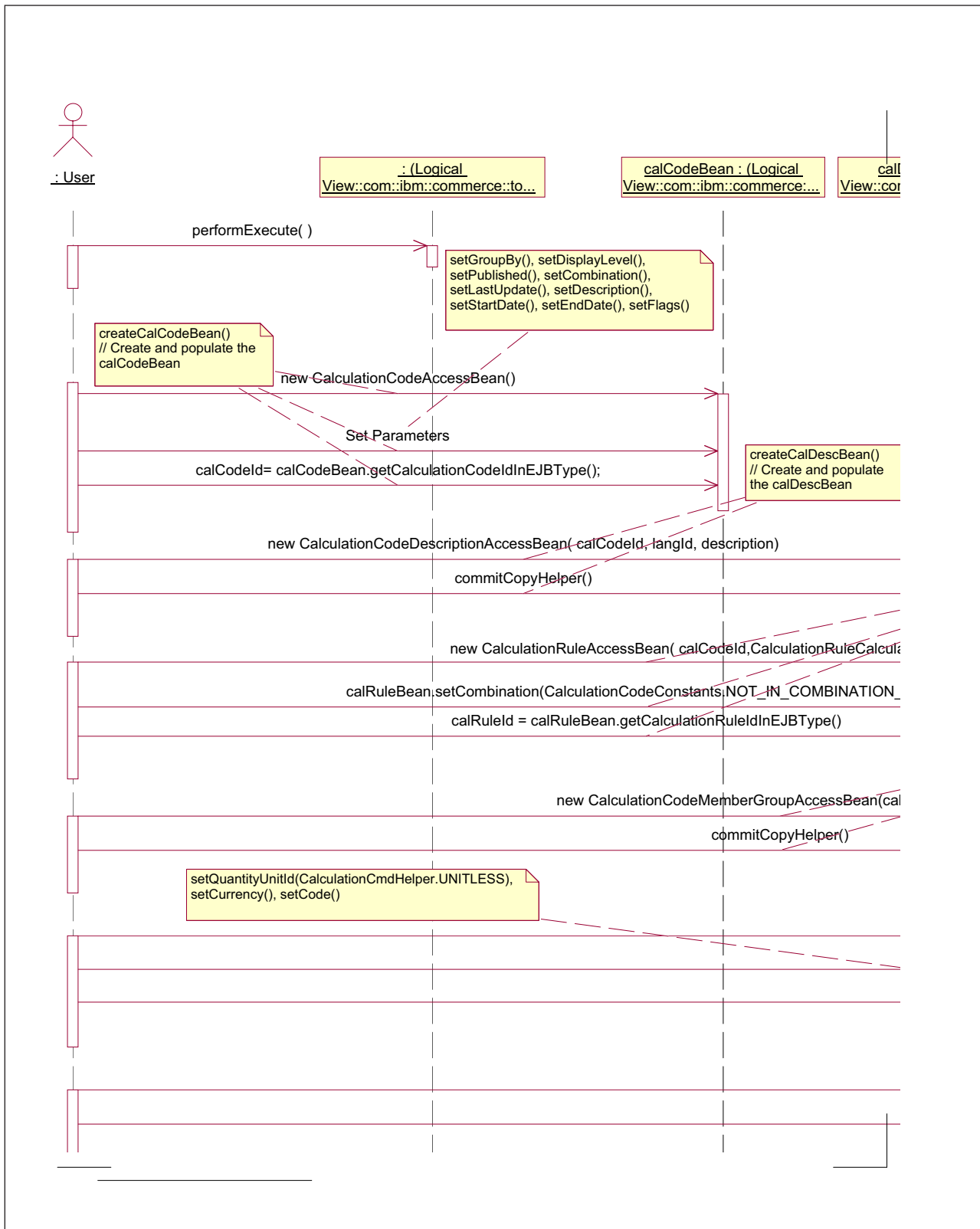


Figure 46. CreateDiscount sequence diagram, 1 of 8 (1,1)

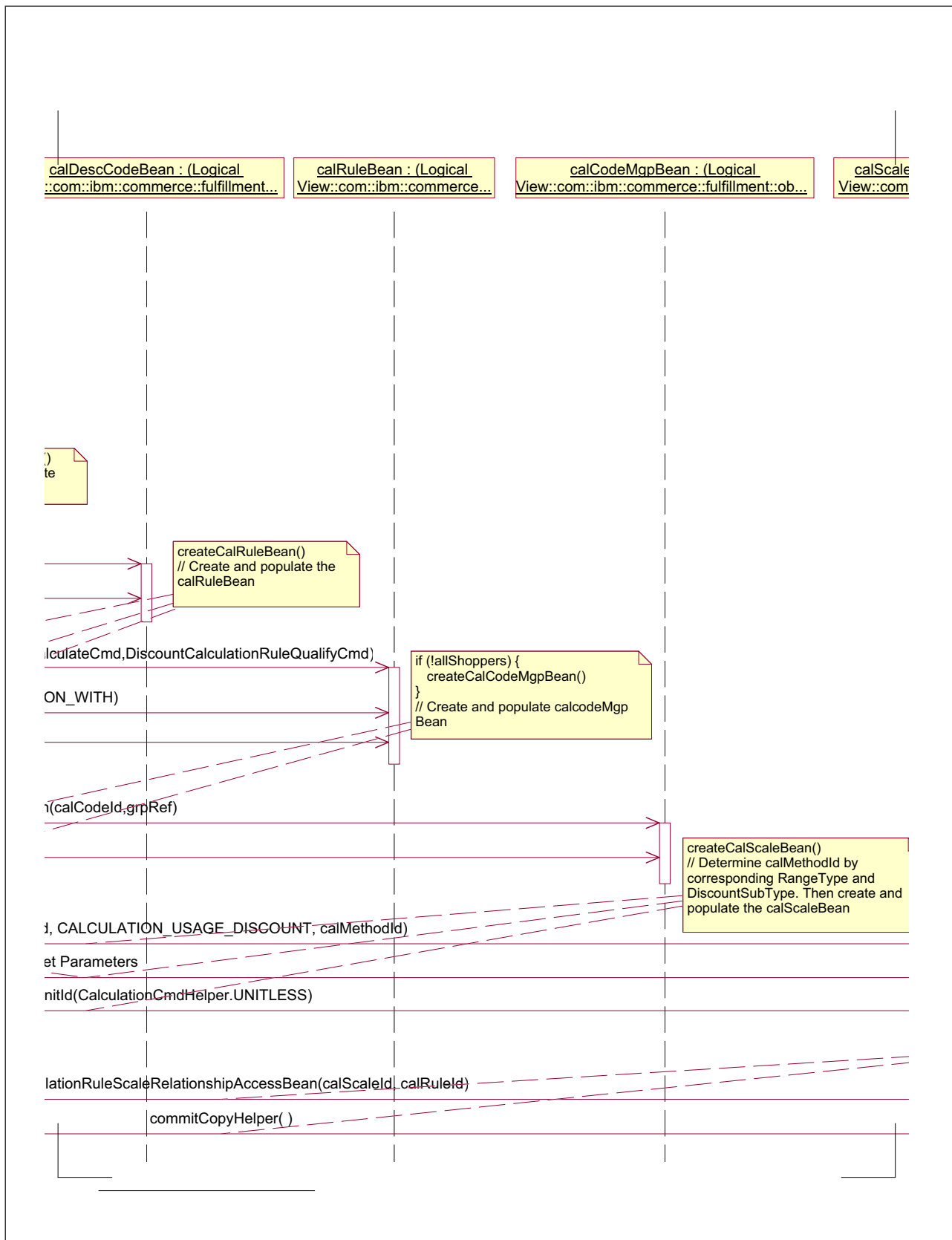


Figure 47. CreateDiscount sequence diagram, 2 of 8 (1,2)

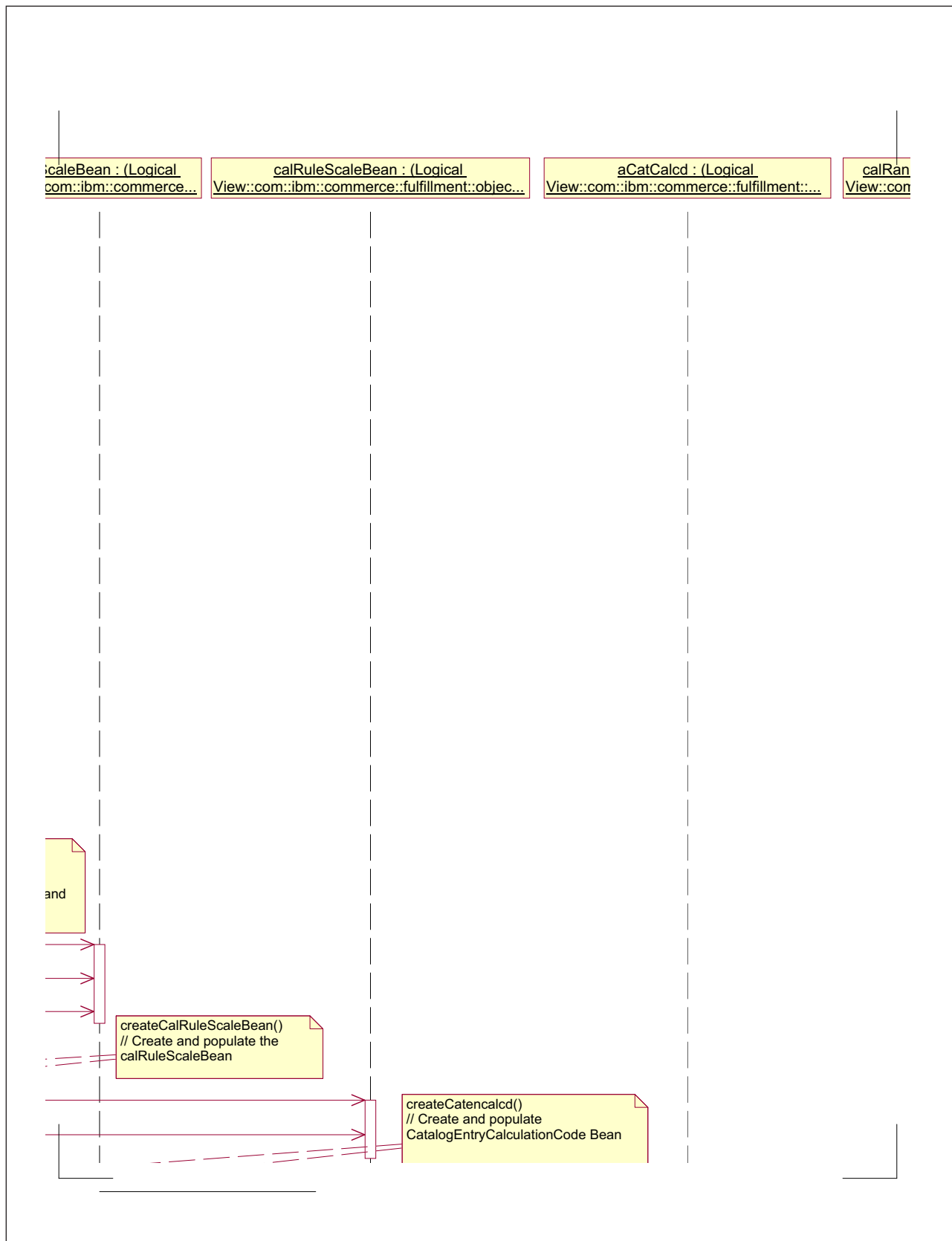


Figure 48. CreateDiscount sequence diagram, 3 of 8 (1,3)

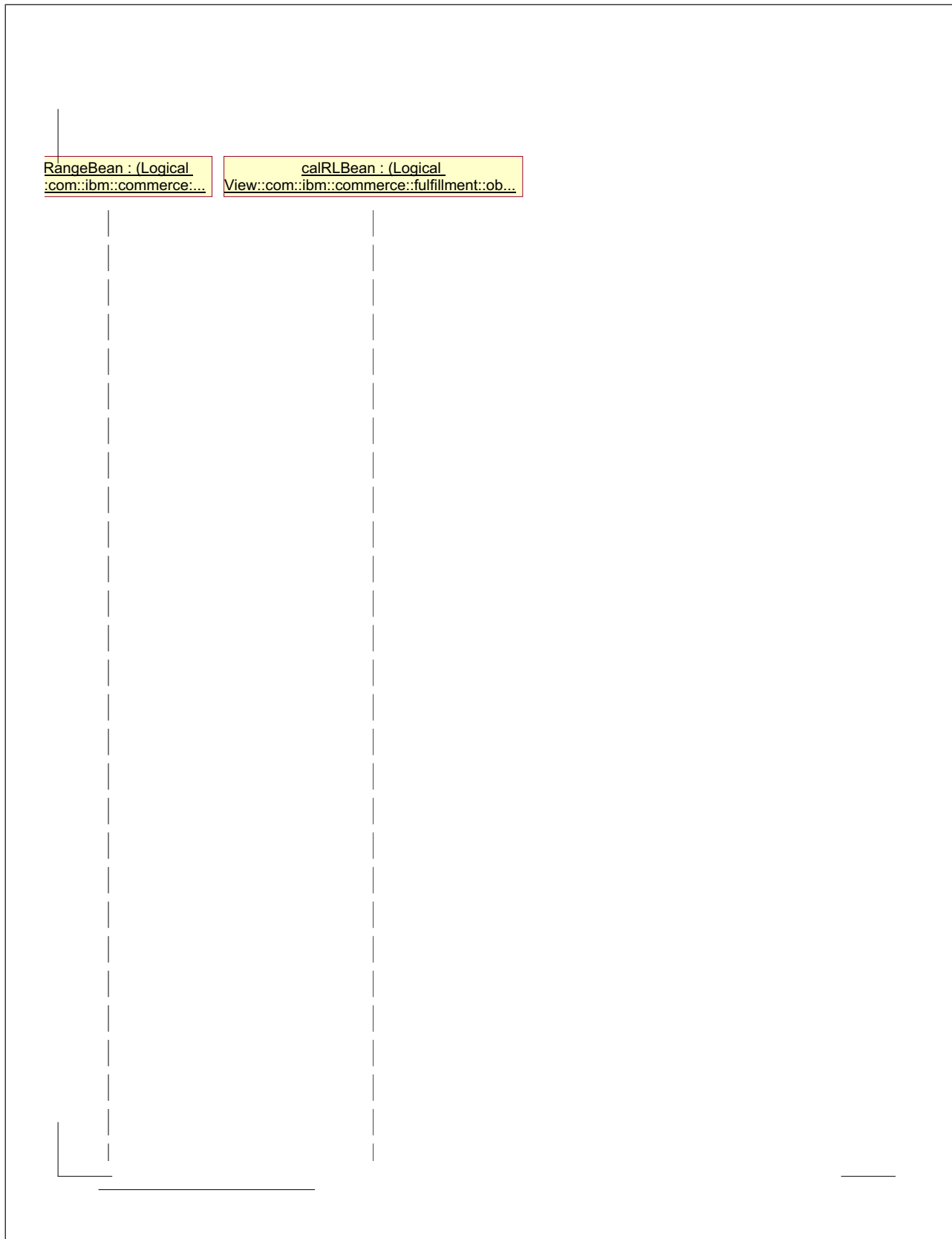


Figure 49. CreateDiscount sequence diagram, 4 of 8 (1,4)

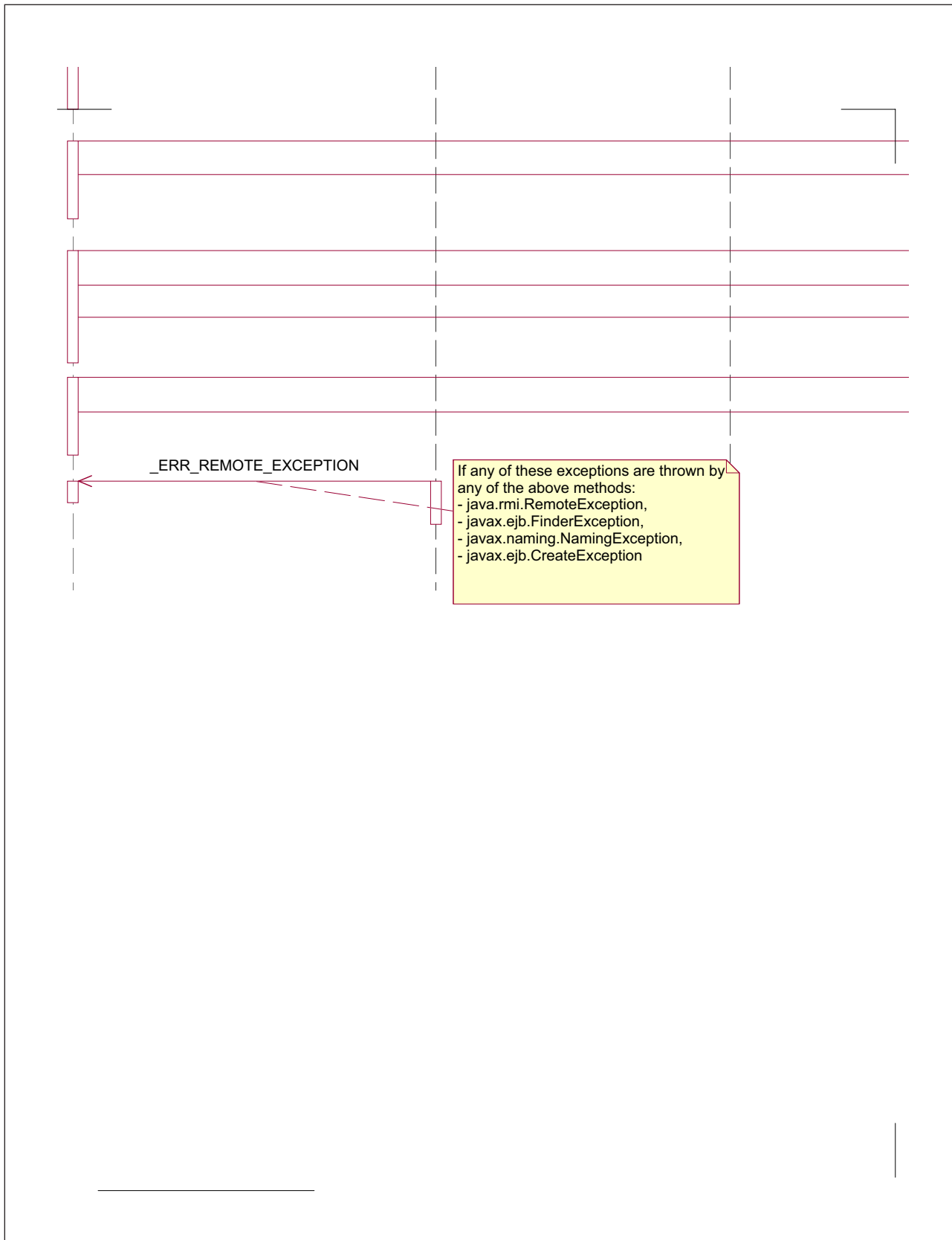


Figure 50. `CreateDiscount` sequence diagram, 5 of 8 (2,1)

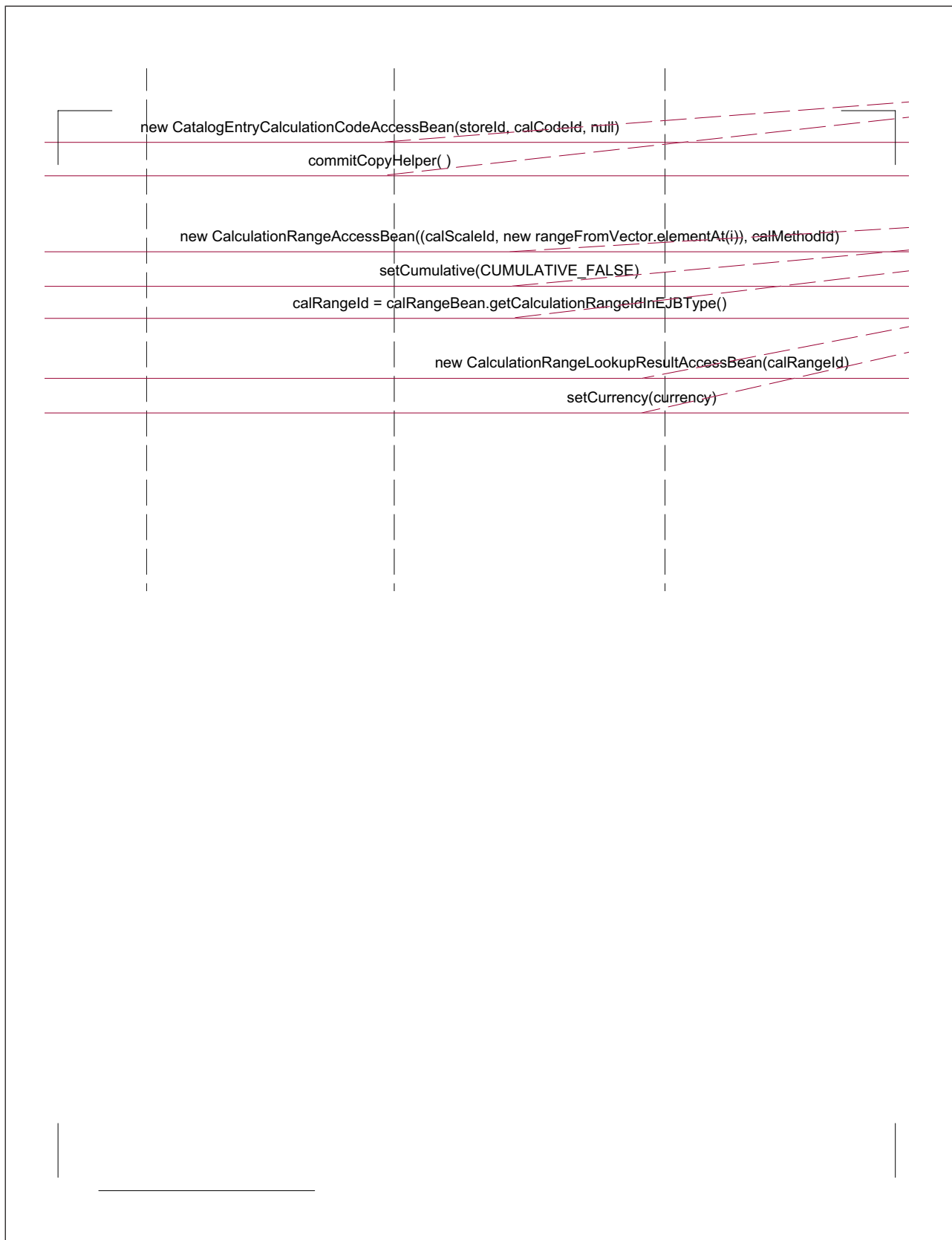


Figure 51. CreateDiscount sequence diagram, 6 of 8 (2,2)



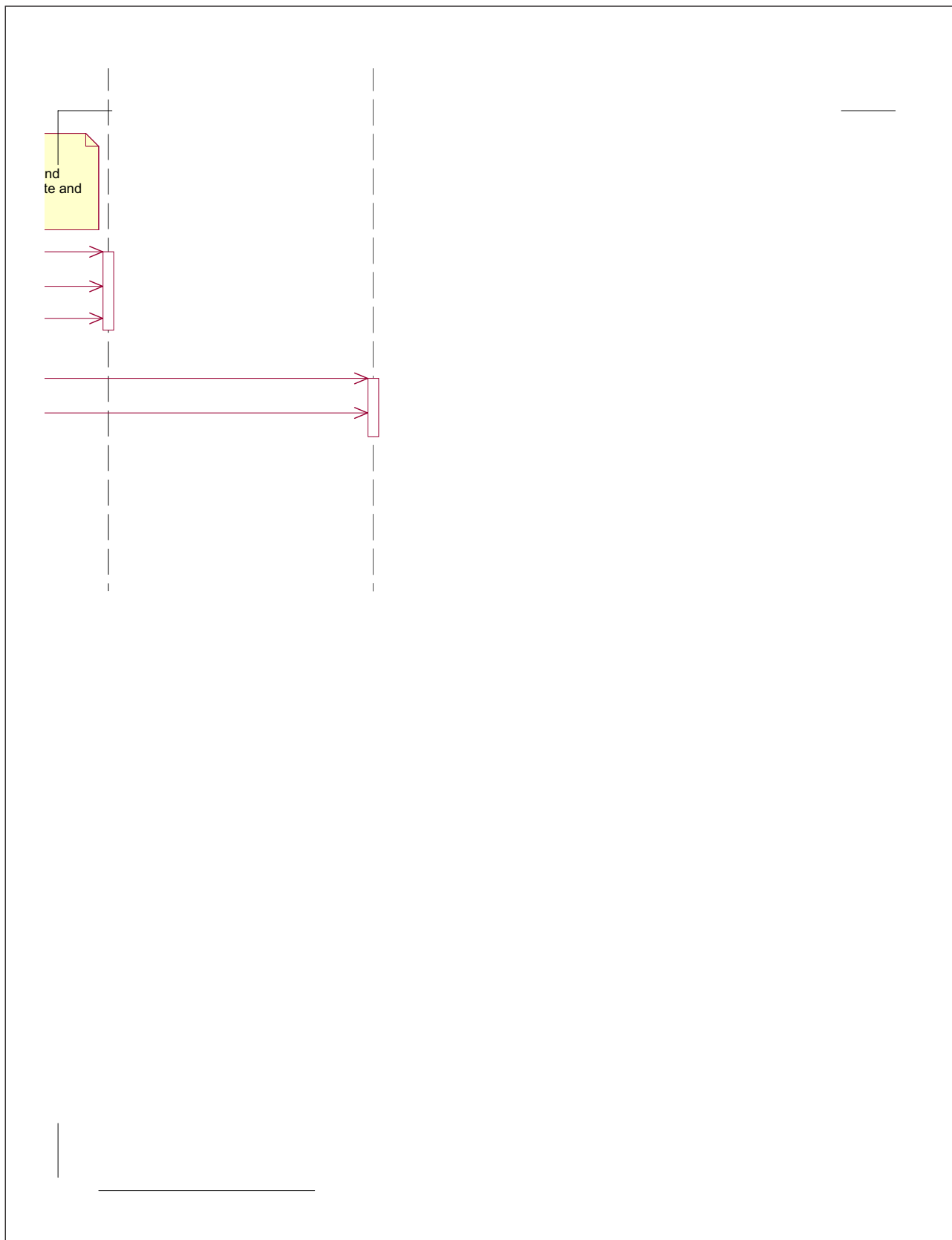


Figure 53. `CreateDiscount` sequence diagram, 8 of 8 (2,4)

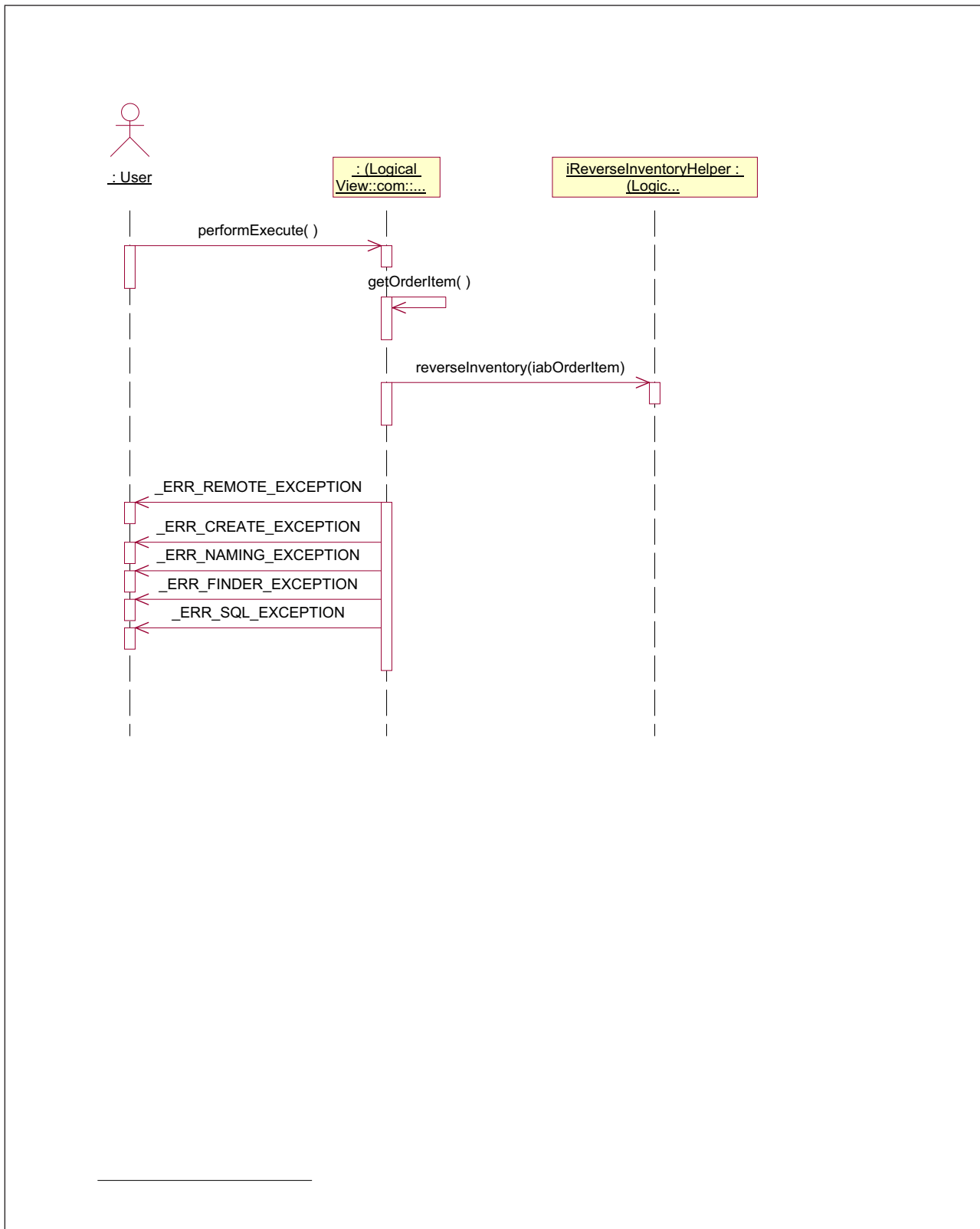


Figure 54. DeallocateExistingInventory sequence diagram

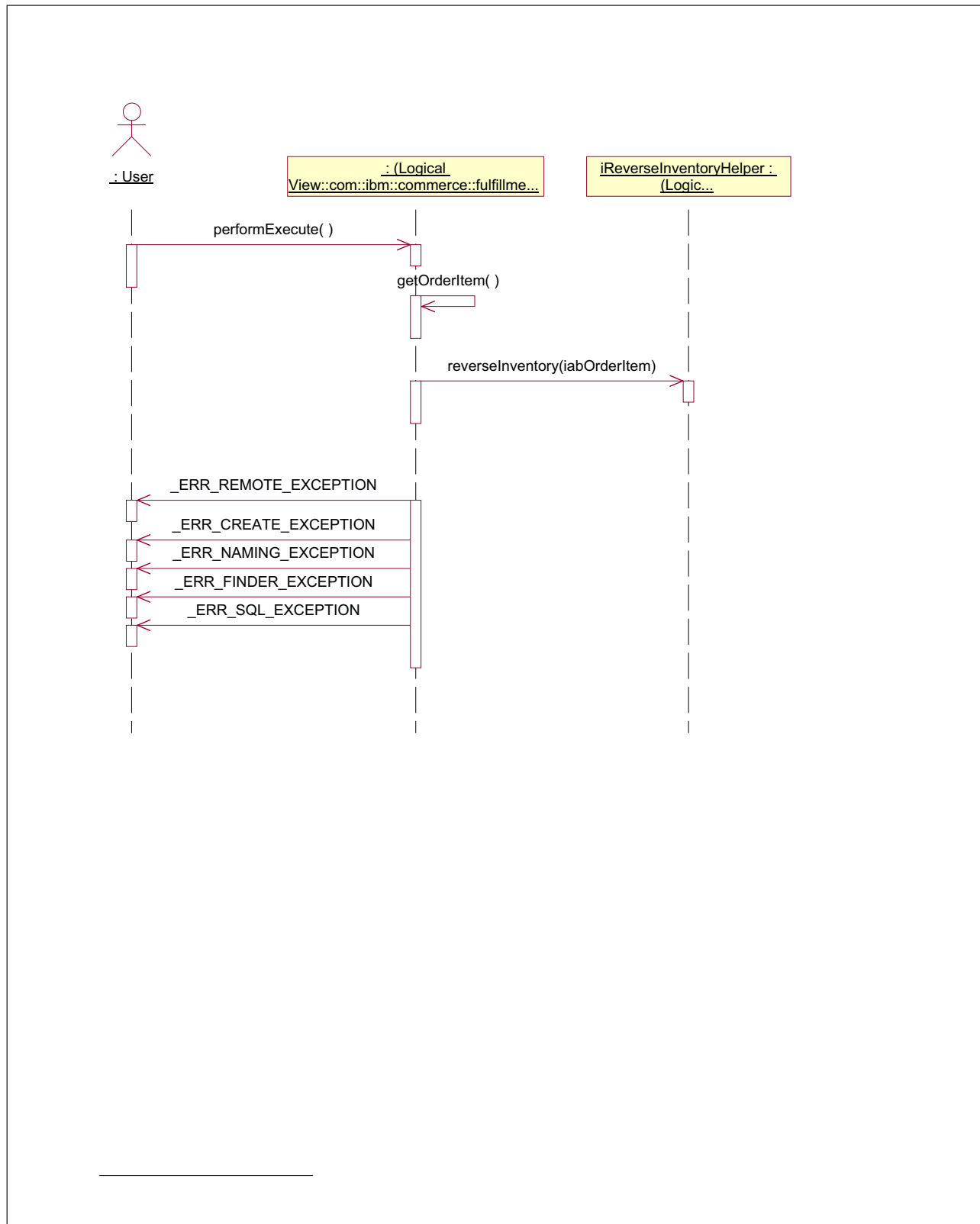


Figure 55. DeallocateExpectedInventory sequence diagram, 1 of 2 (1,1)

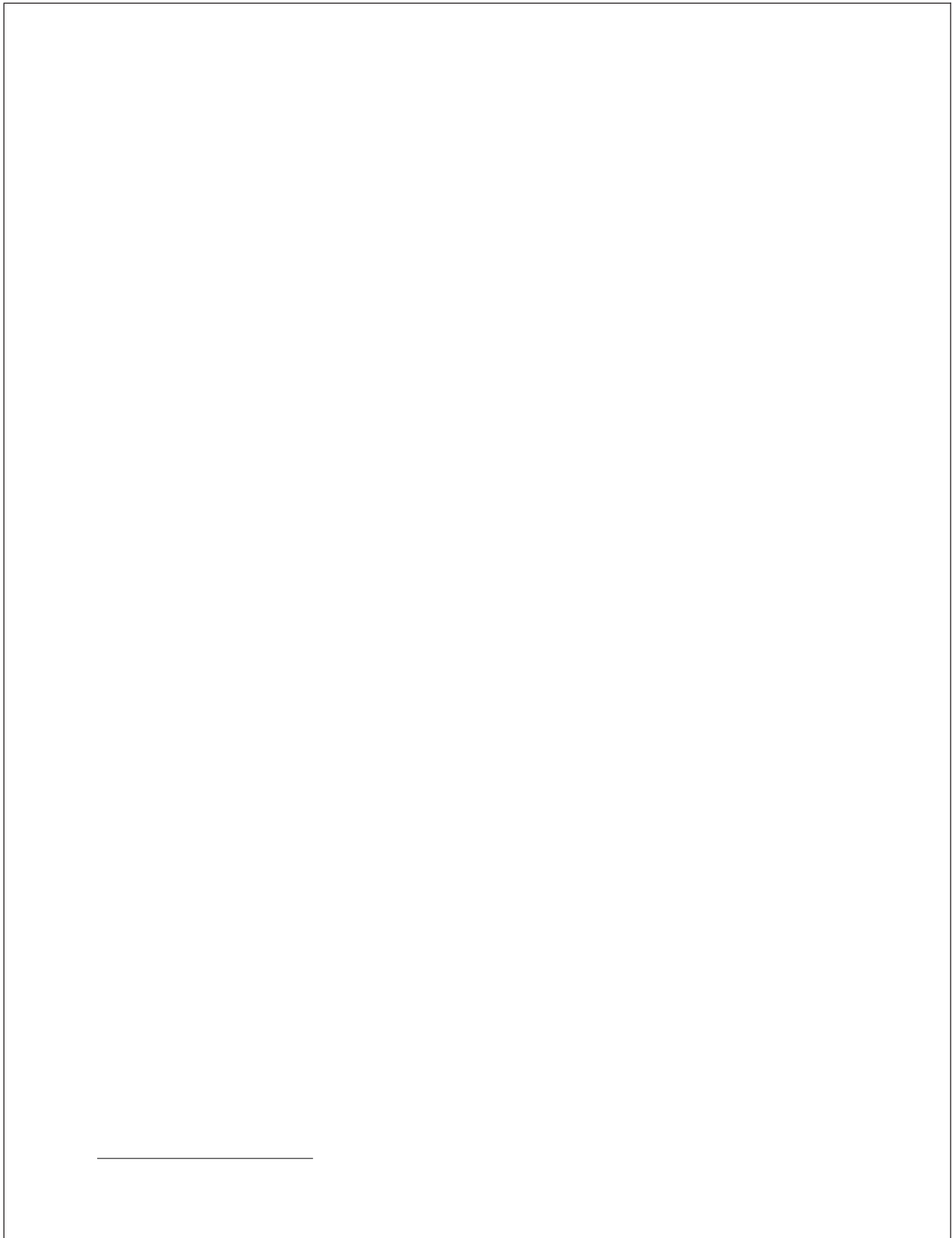


Figure 56. *DeallocateExpectedInventory* sequence diagram, 2 of 2 (1,2)

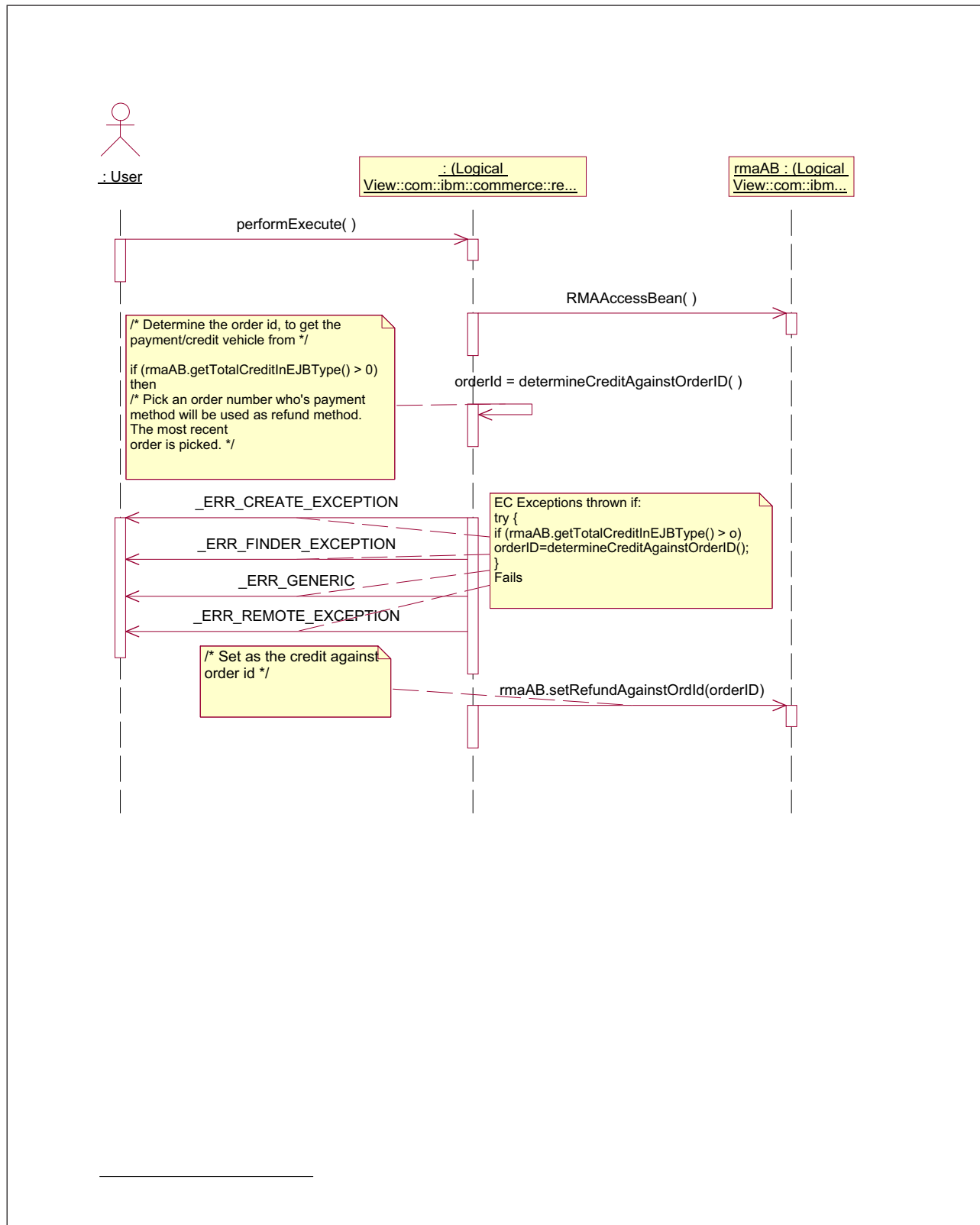


Figure 57. DetermineReturnCreditVehicle sequence diagram

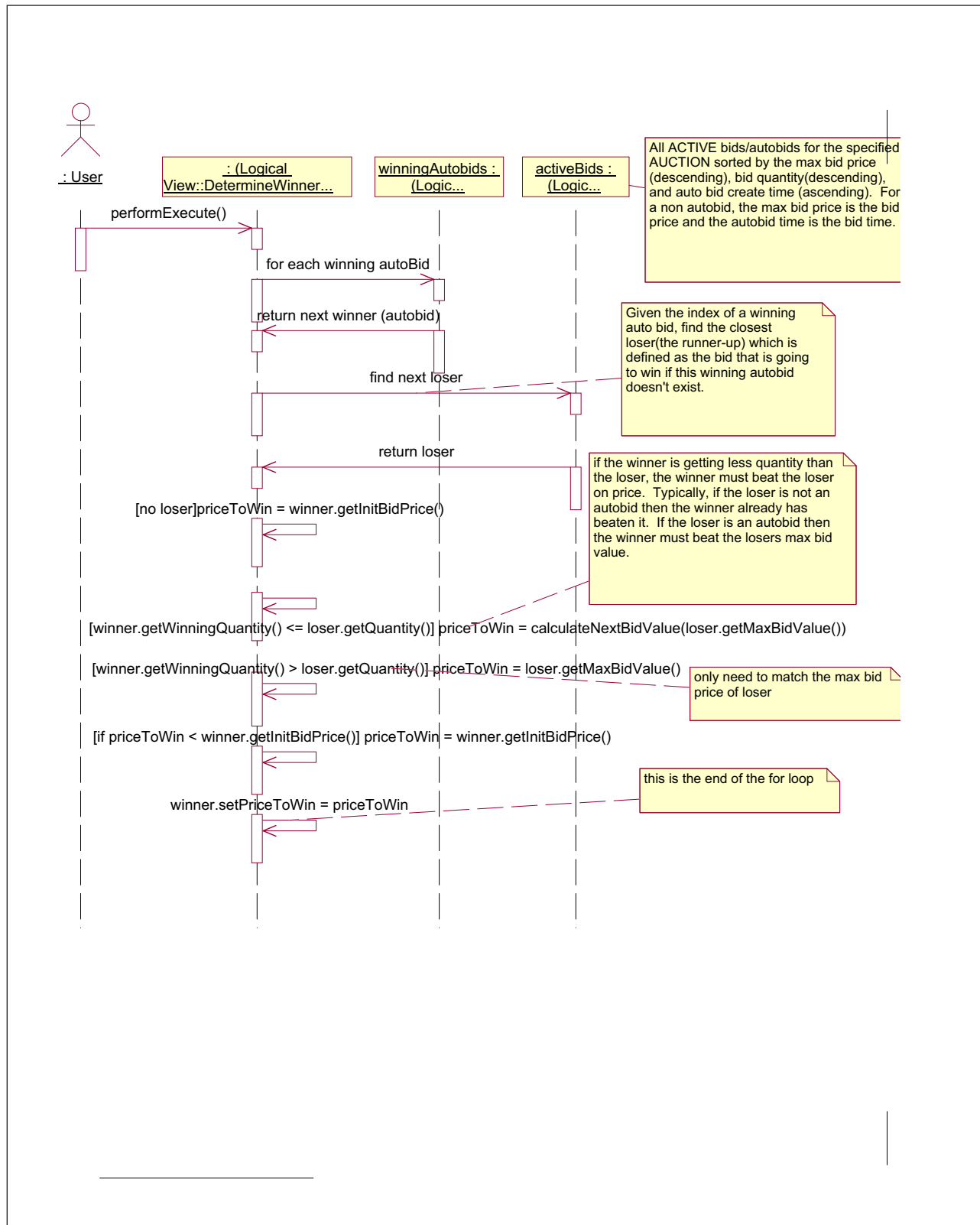


Figure 58. DetermineWinners sequence diagram, 1 of 2 (1,1)

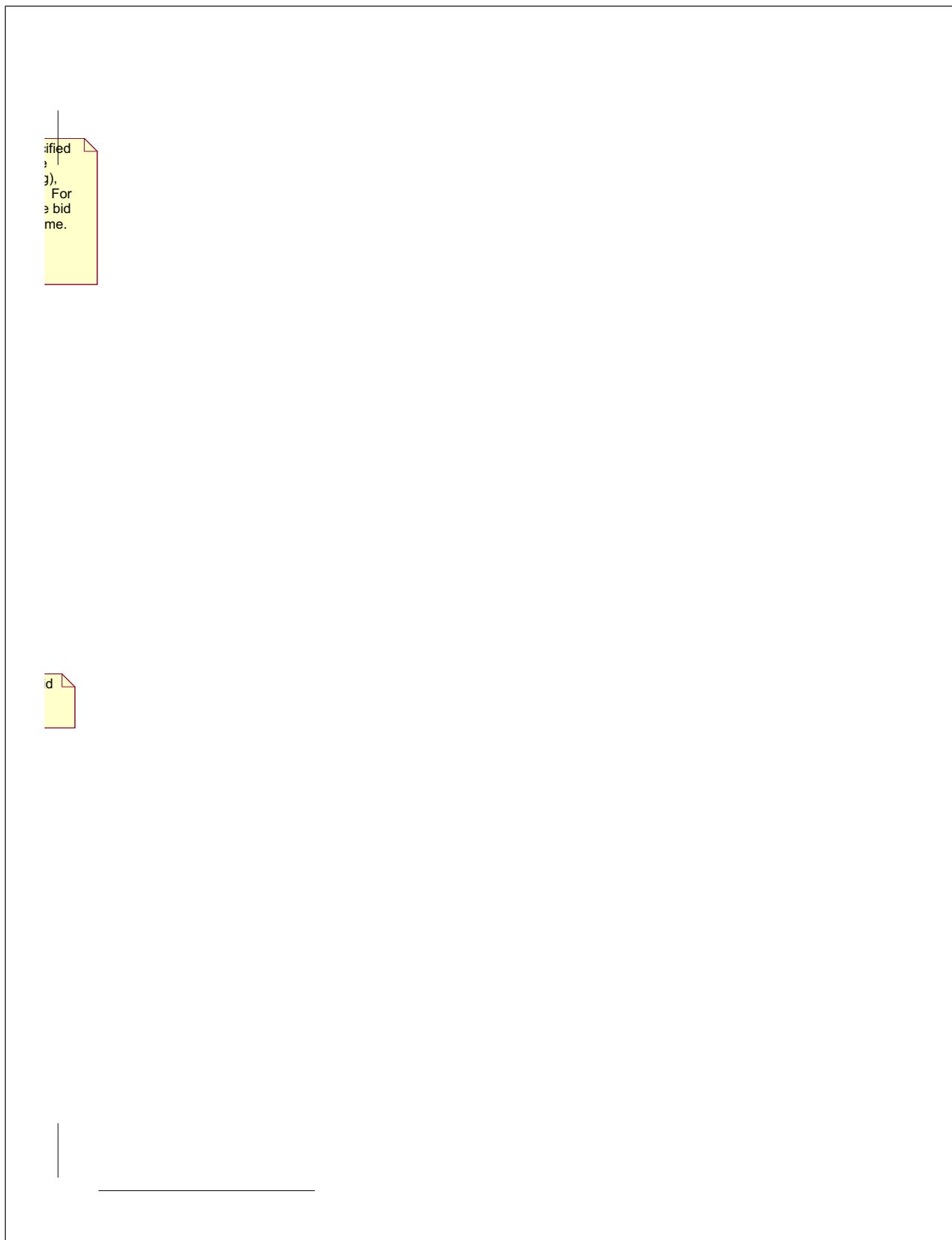


Figure 59. *DeallocateExpectedInventory* sequence diagram, 2 of 2 (1,2)

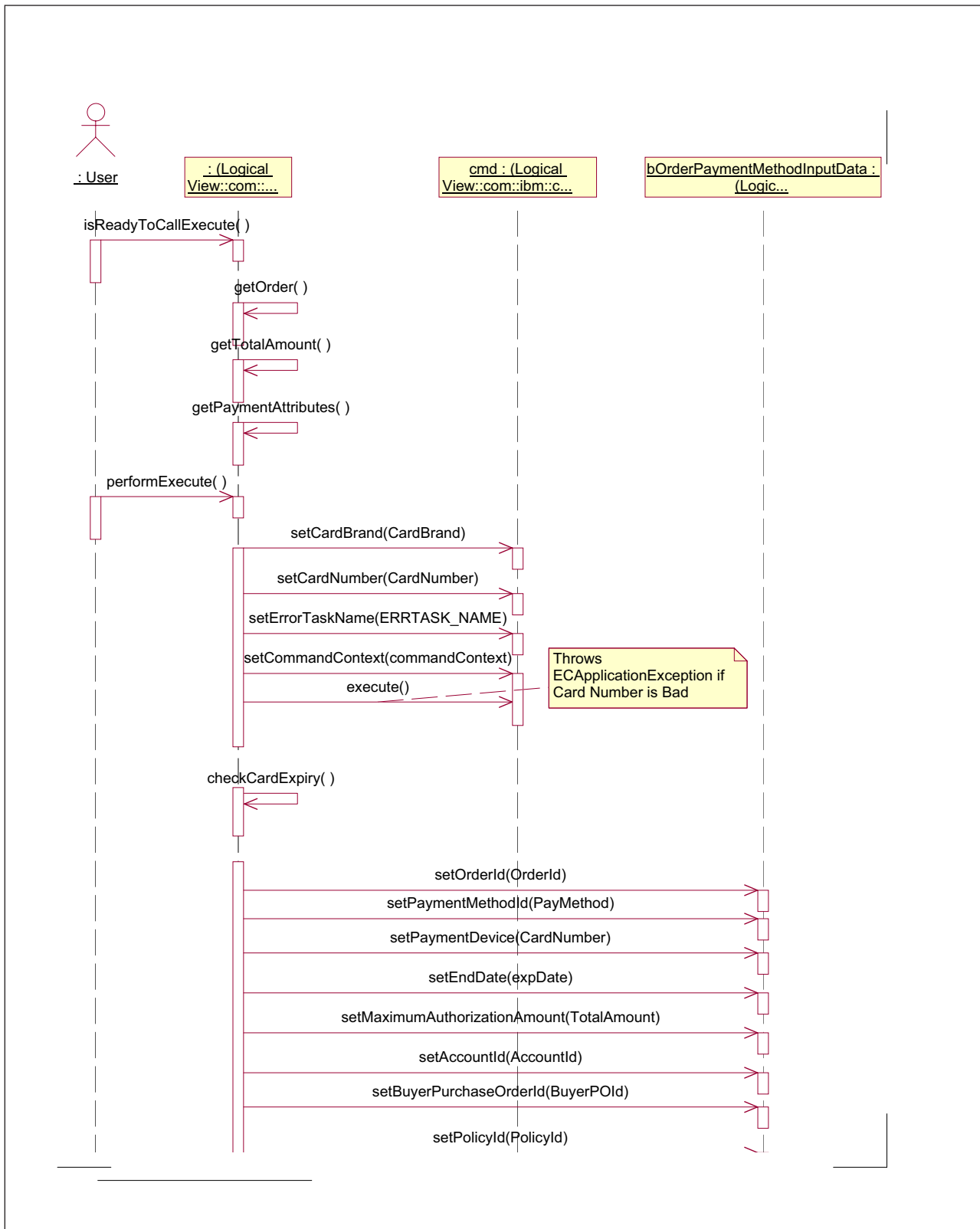


Figure 60. DoPaymentTest sequence diagram, 1 of 4 (1,1)

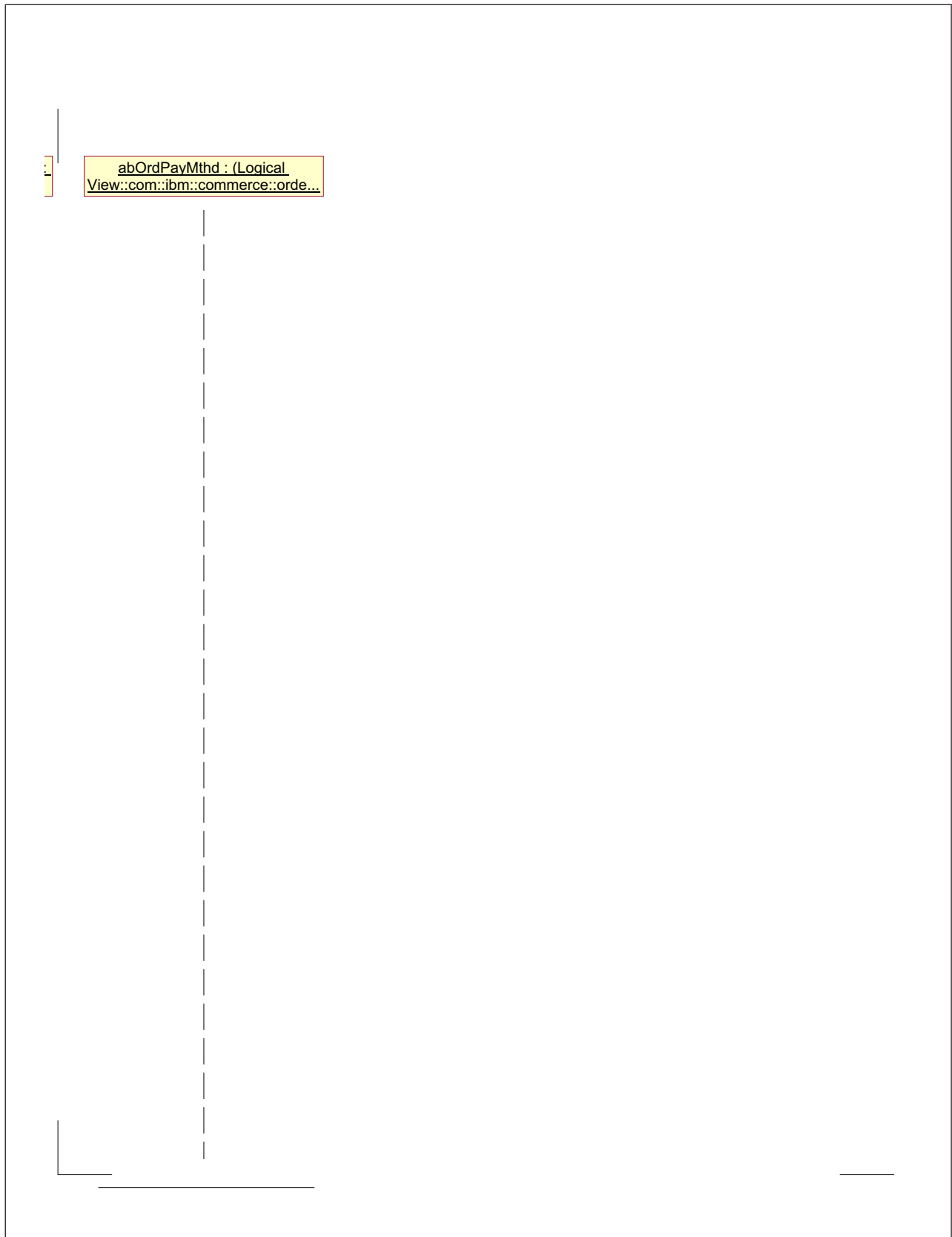


Figure 61. DoPaymentTest sequence diagram, 2 of 4 (1,2)

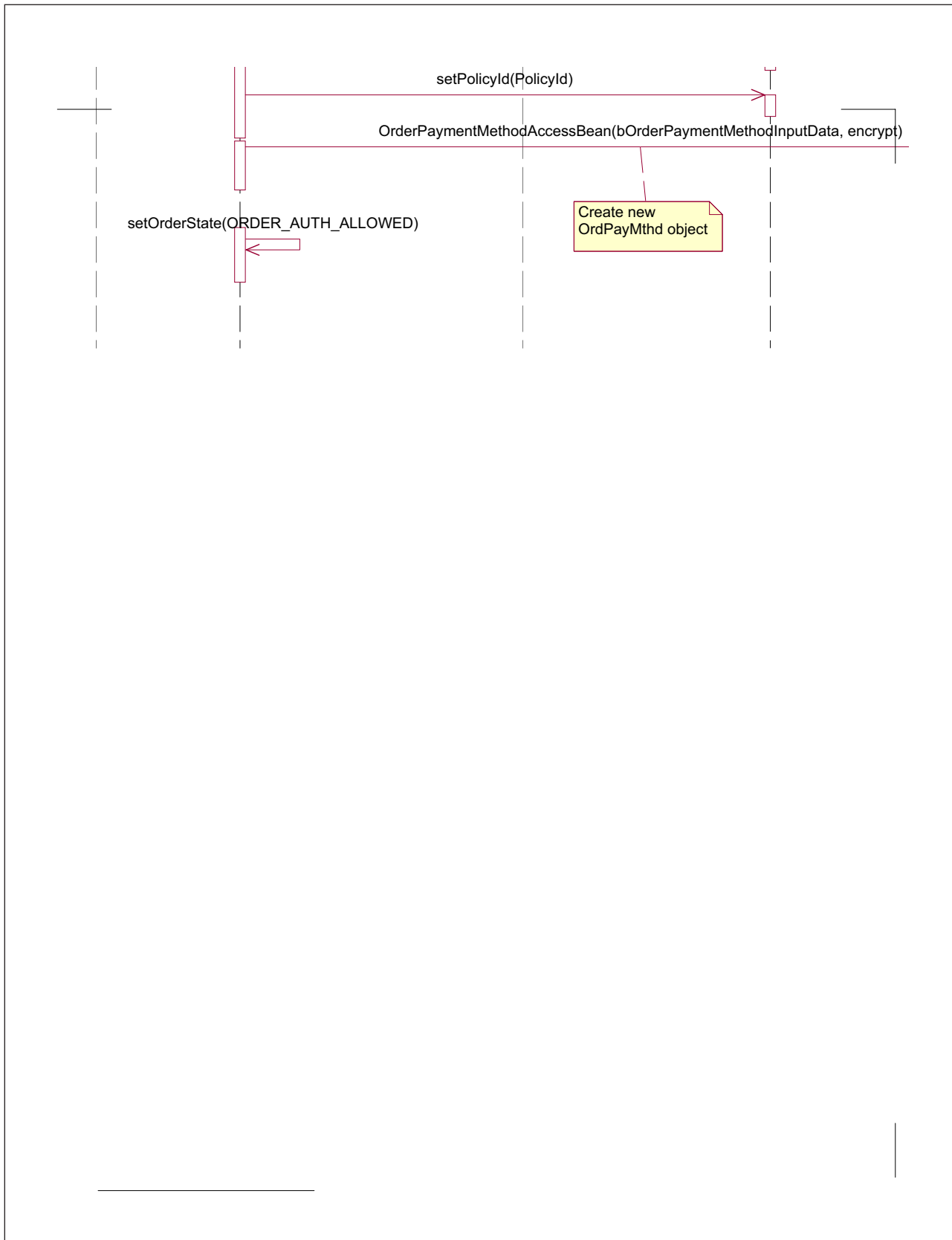


Figure 62. DoPaymentTest sequence diagram, 3 of 4 (2,1)

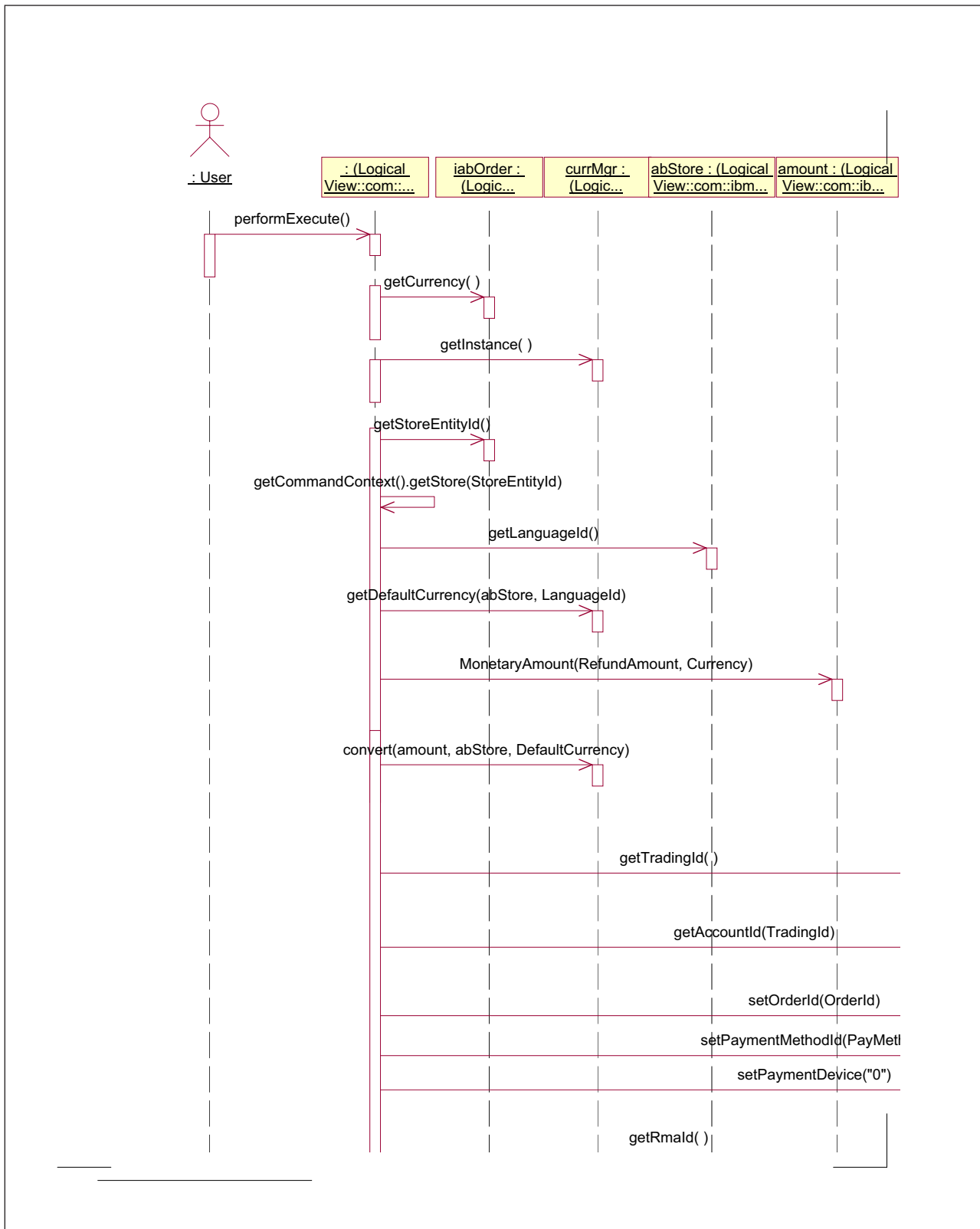


Figure 64. DoRefundTest sequence diagram, 1 of 4 (1,1)

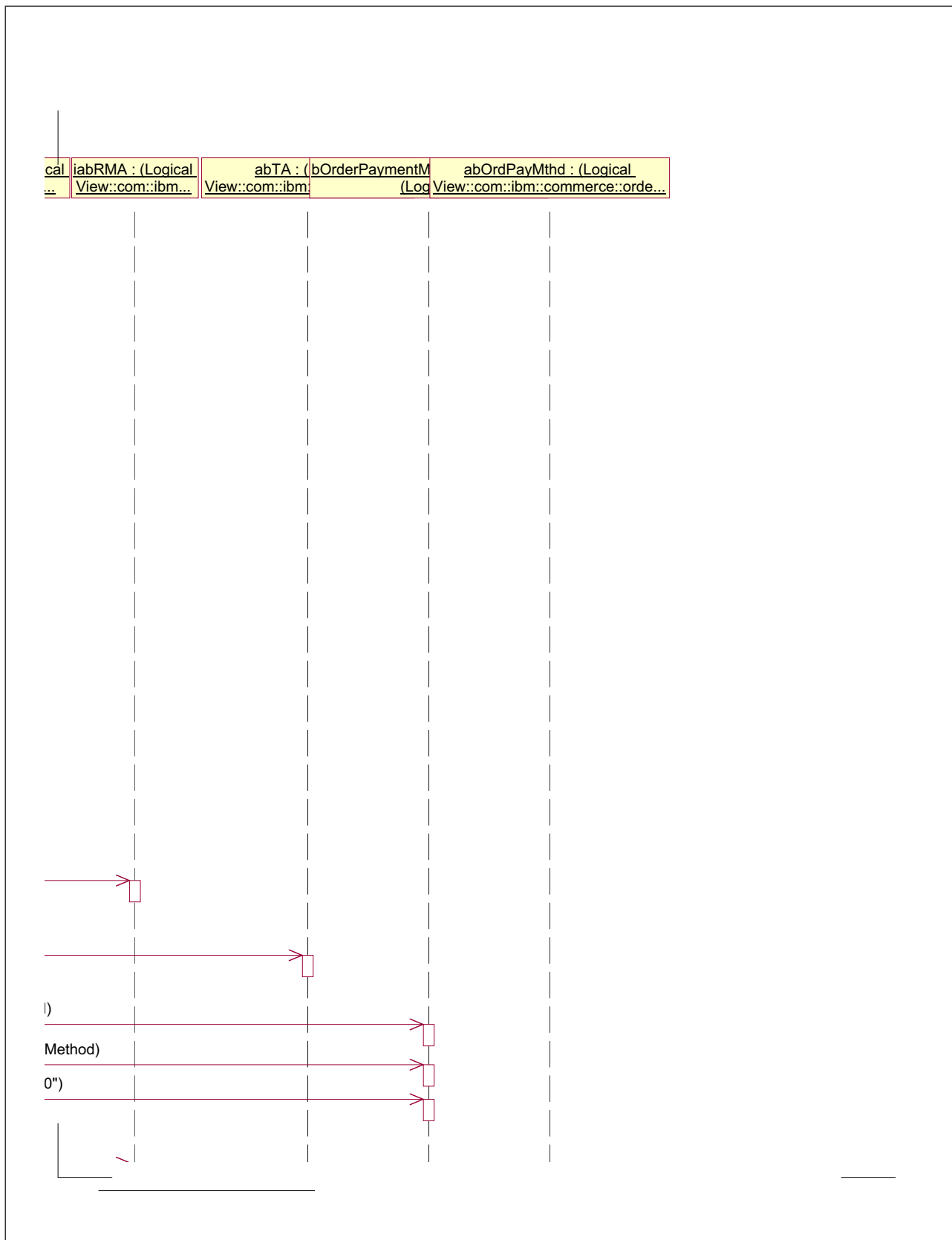


Figure 65. DoRefundTest sequence diagram, 2 of 4 (1,2)

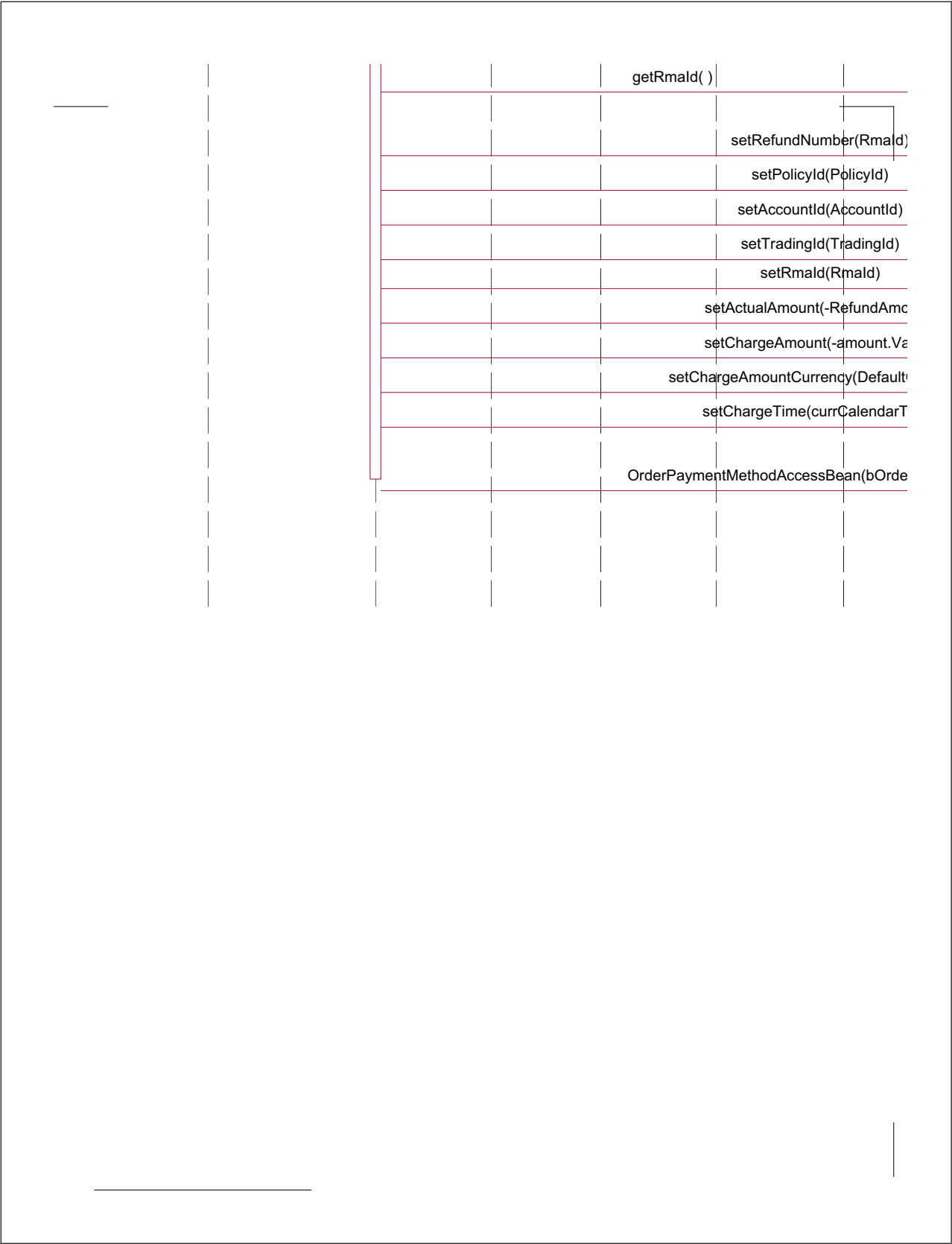


Figure 66. DoRefundTest sequence diagram, 3 of 4 (2,1)

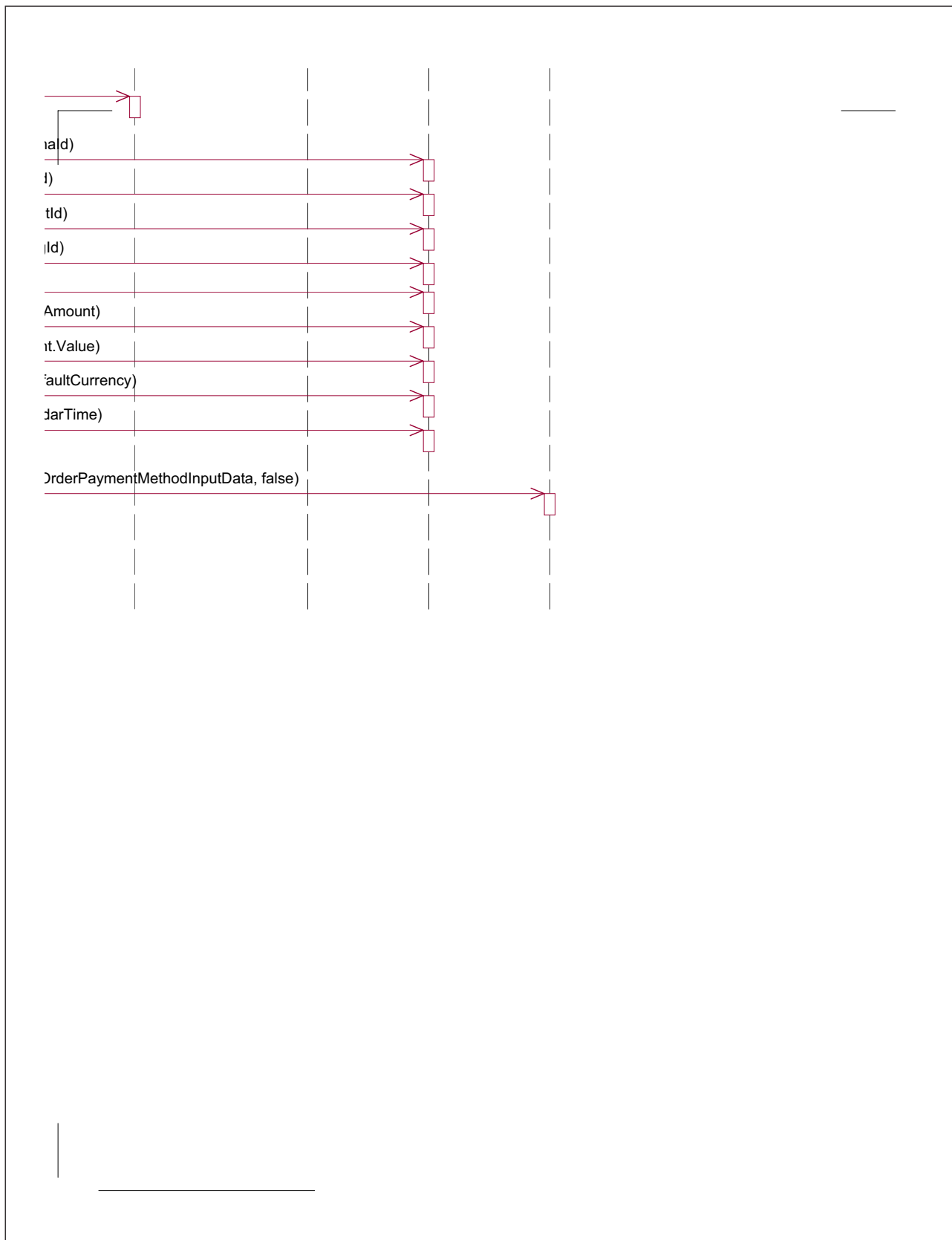


Figure 67. DoRefundTest sequence diagram, 4 of 4 (2,2)

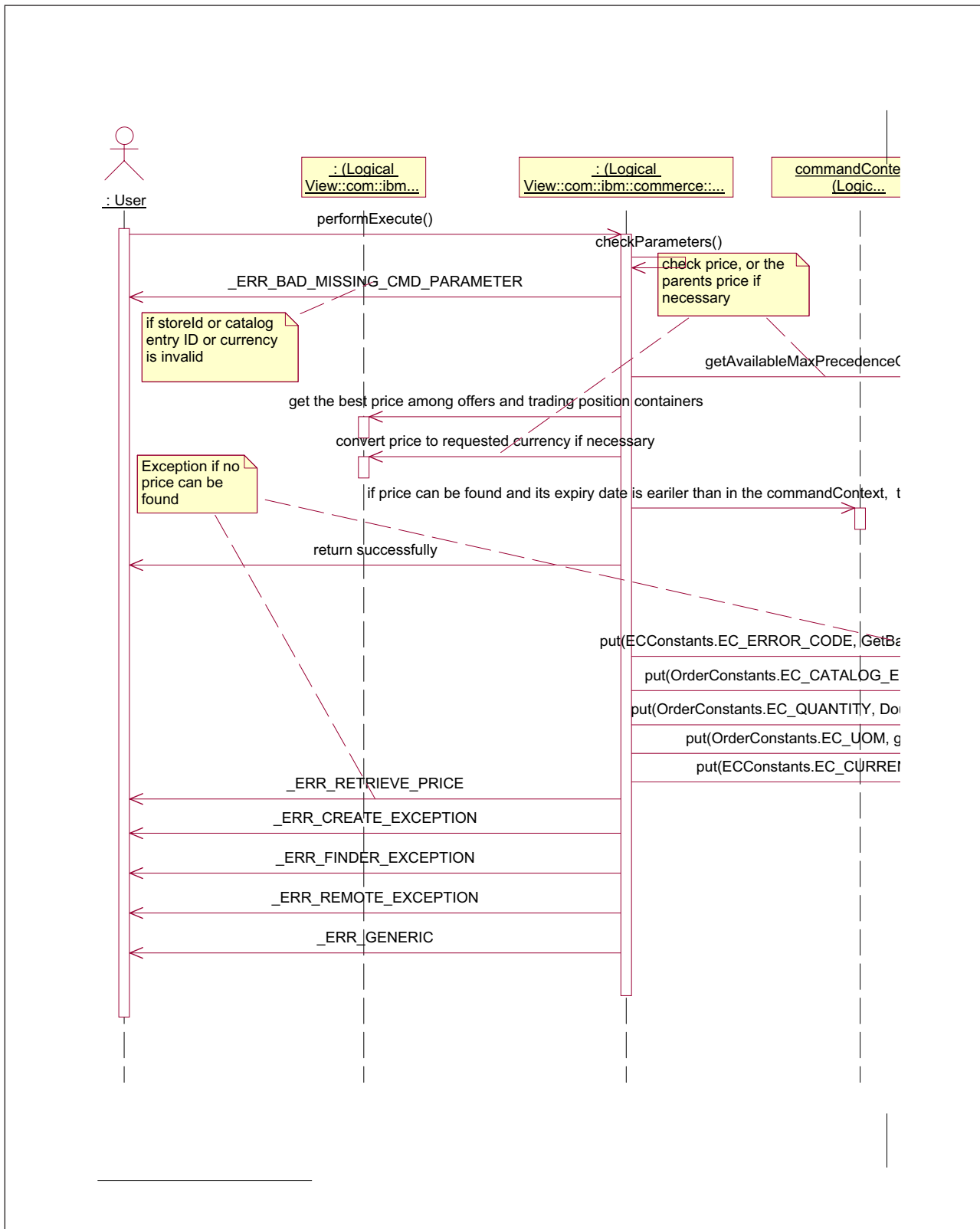


Figure 68. GetBaseUnitPrice sequence diagram, 1 of 2 (1,1)

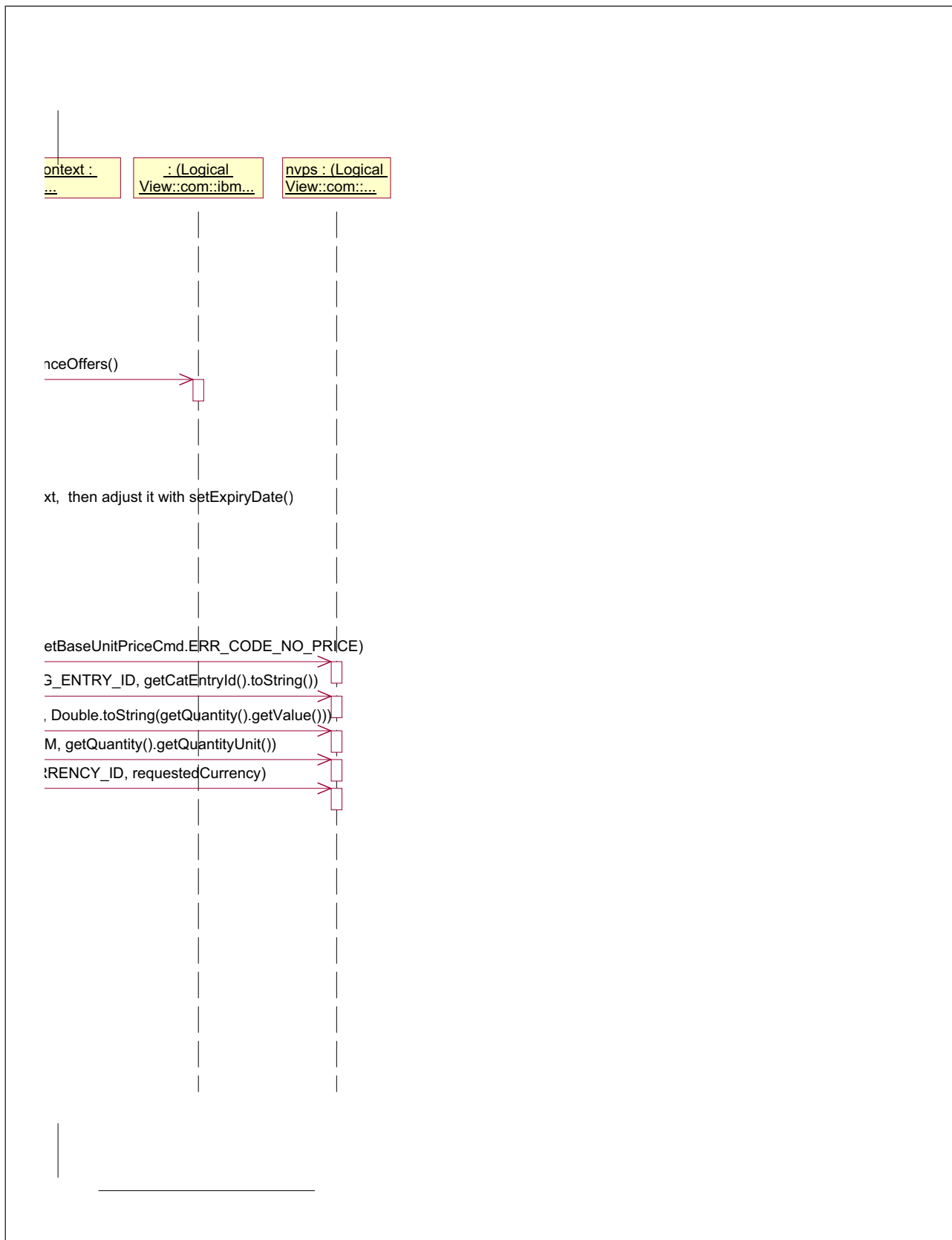


Figure 69. GetBaseUnitPrice sequence diagram, 2 of 2 (1,2)

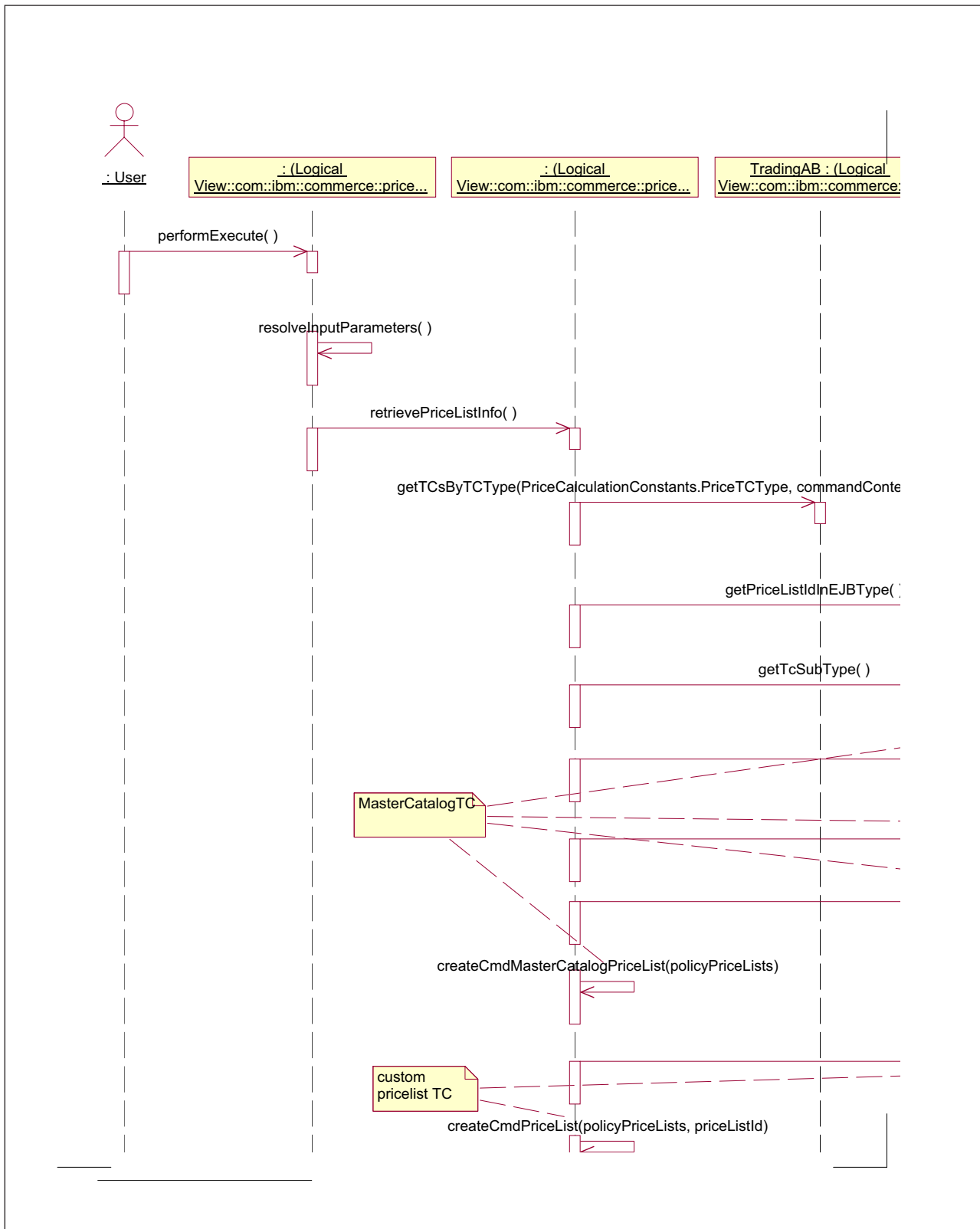


Figure 70. GetContractUnitPrice sequence diagram, 1 of 20 (1,1)

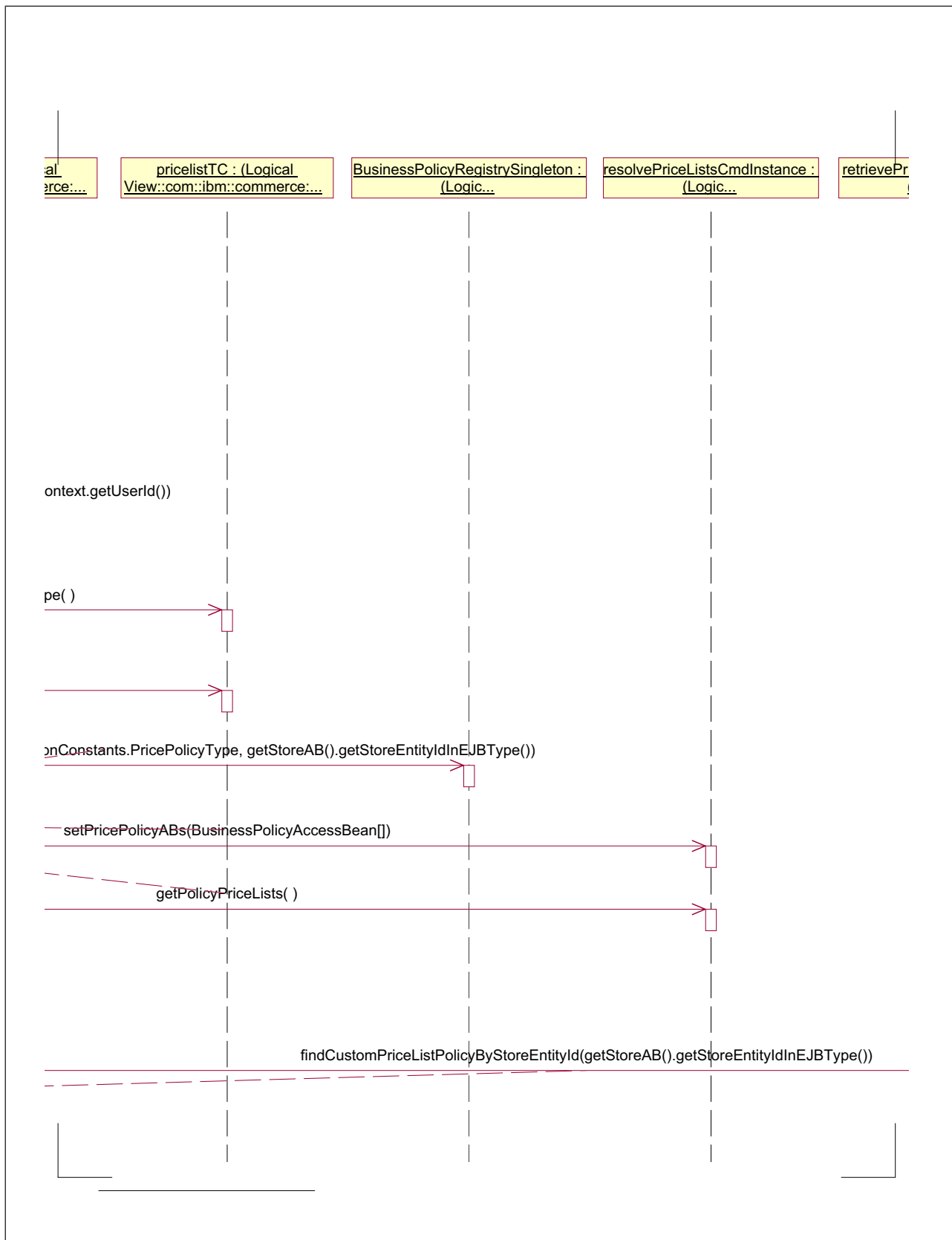


Figure 71. GetContractUnitPrice sequence diagram, 2 of 20 (1,2)

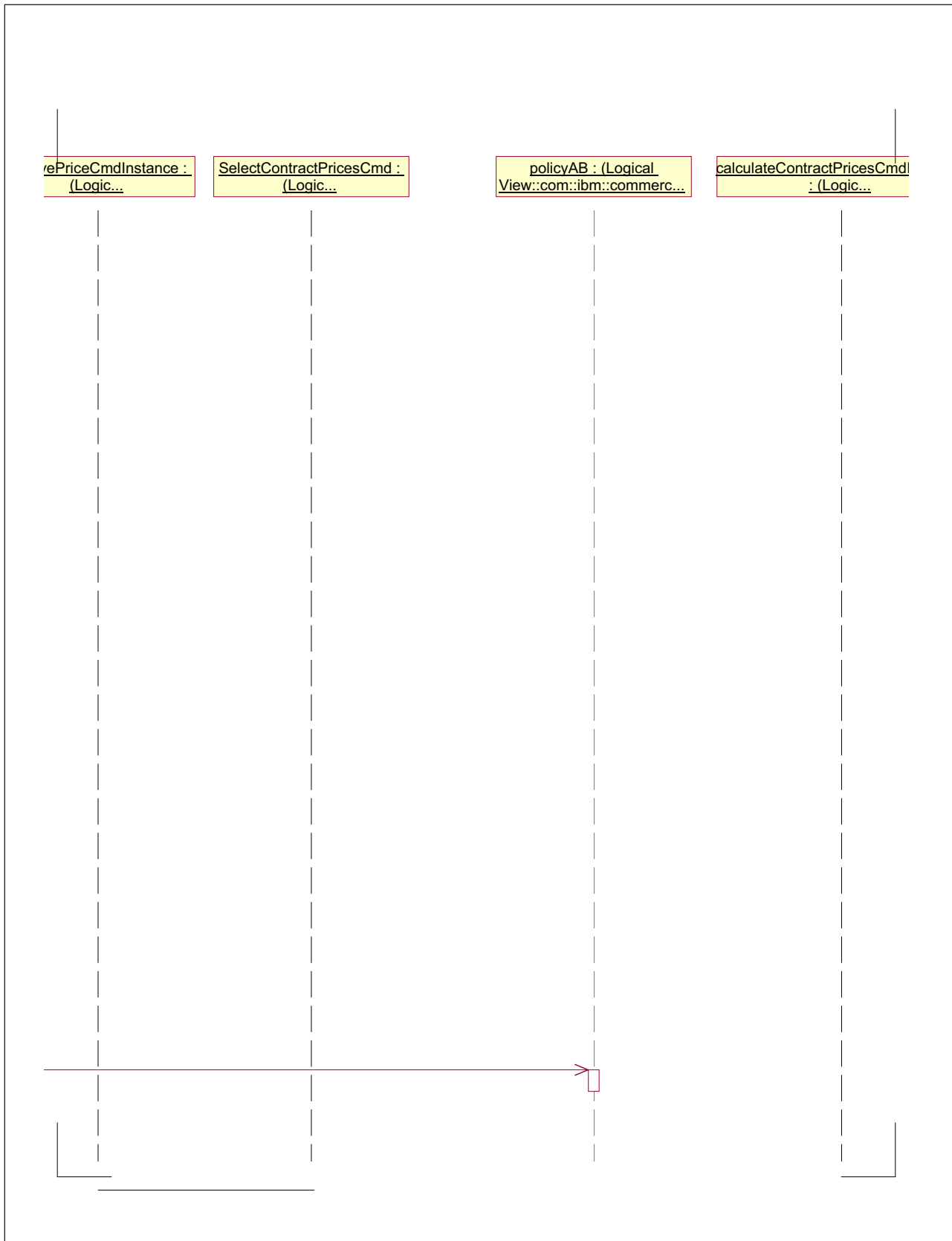


Figure 72. GetContractUnitPrice sequence diagram, 3 of 20 (1,3)

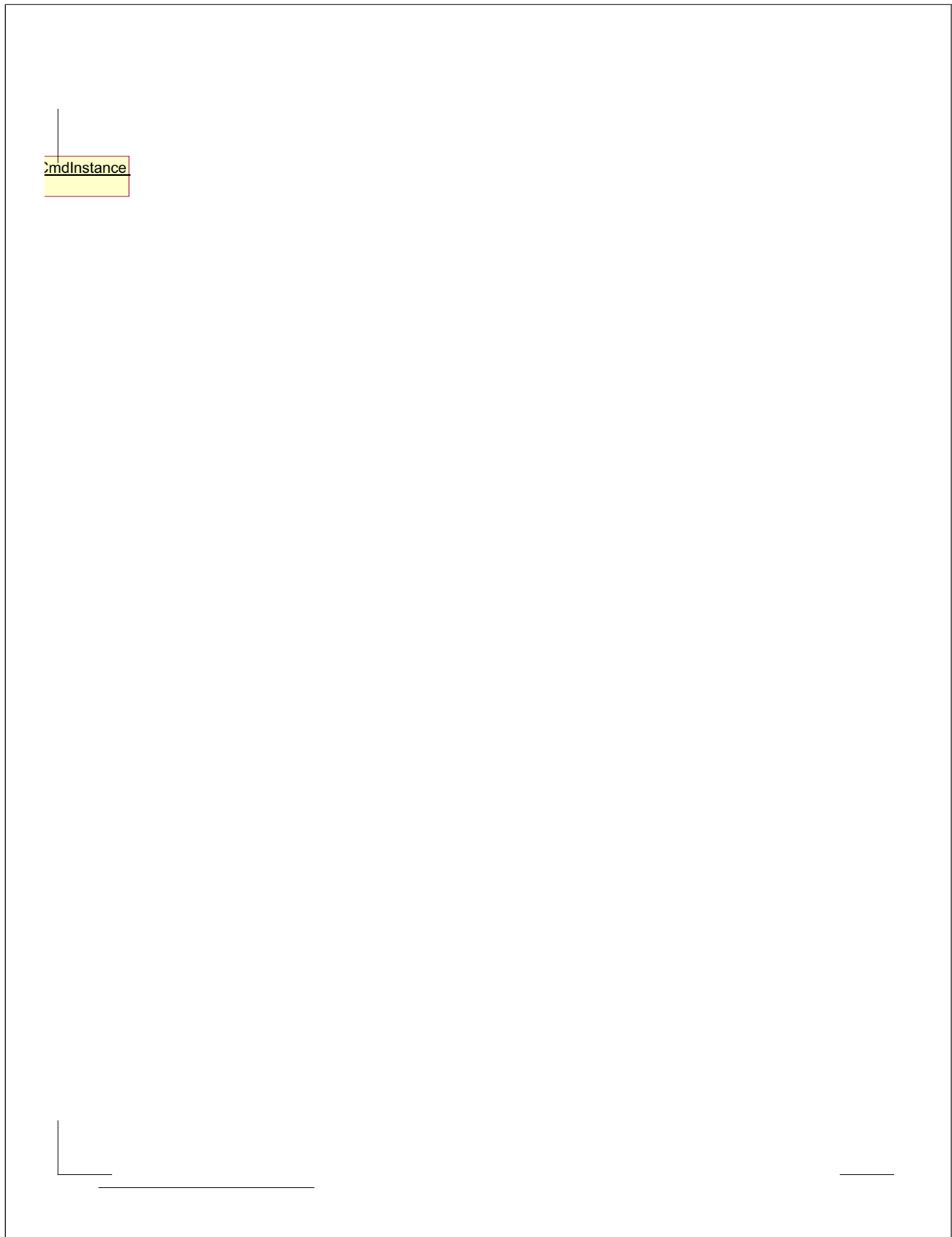
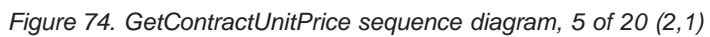


Figure 73. `GetContractUnitPrice` sequence diagram, 4 of 20 (1,4)



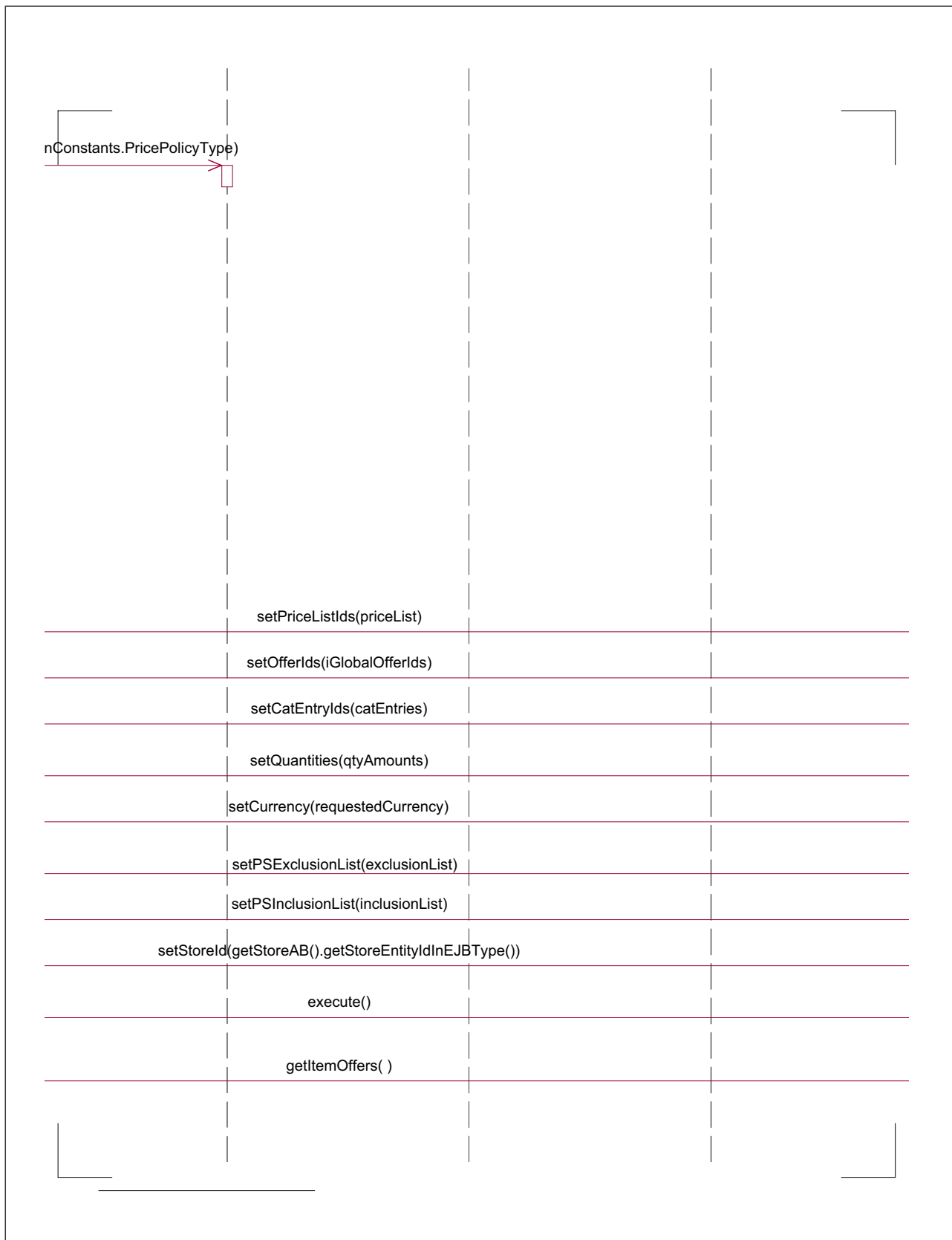


Figure 75. GetContractUnitPrice sequence diagram, 6 of 20 (2,2)

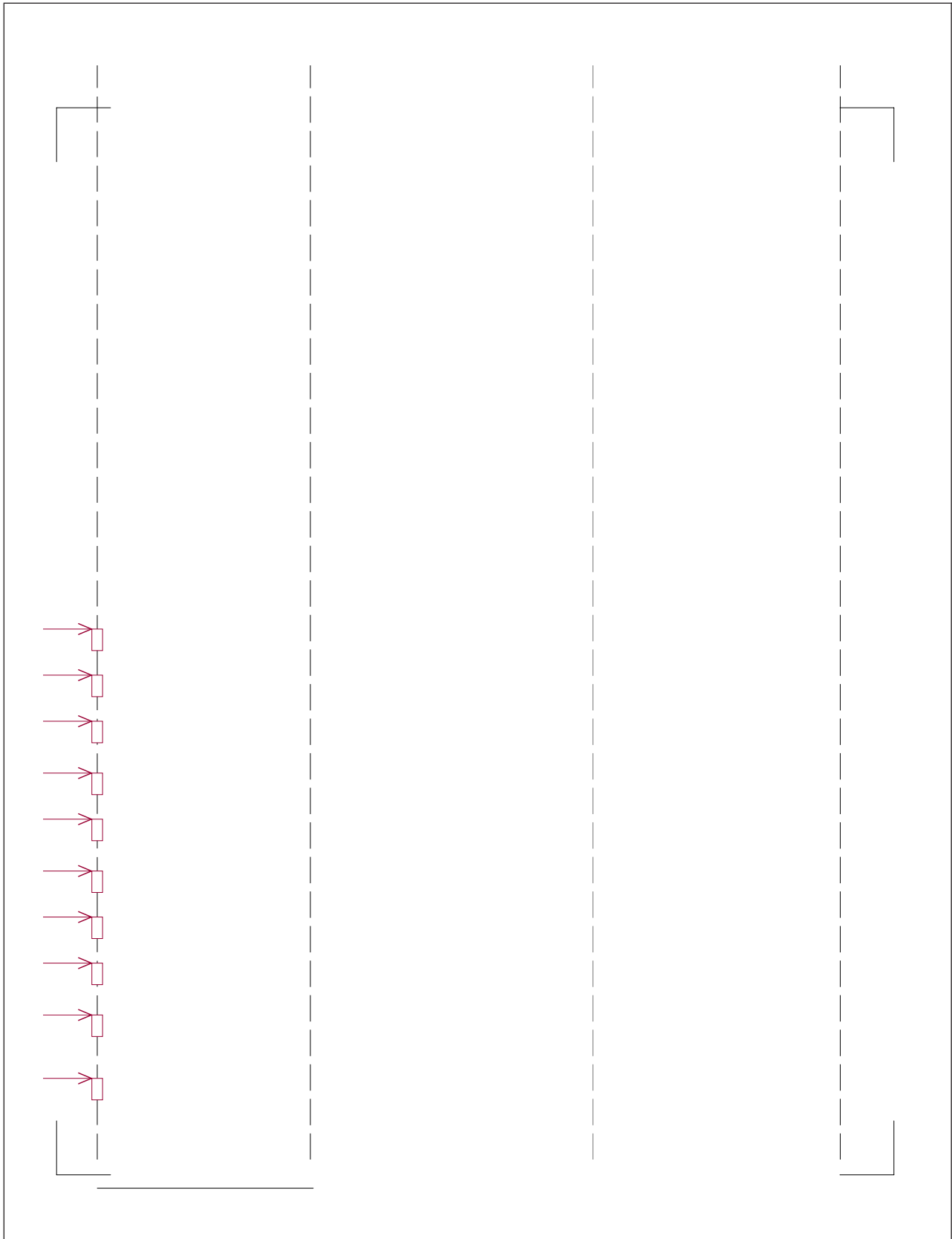


Figure 76. GetContractUnitPrice sequence diagram, 7 of 20 (2,3)

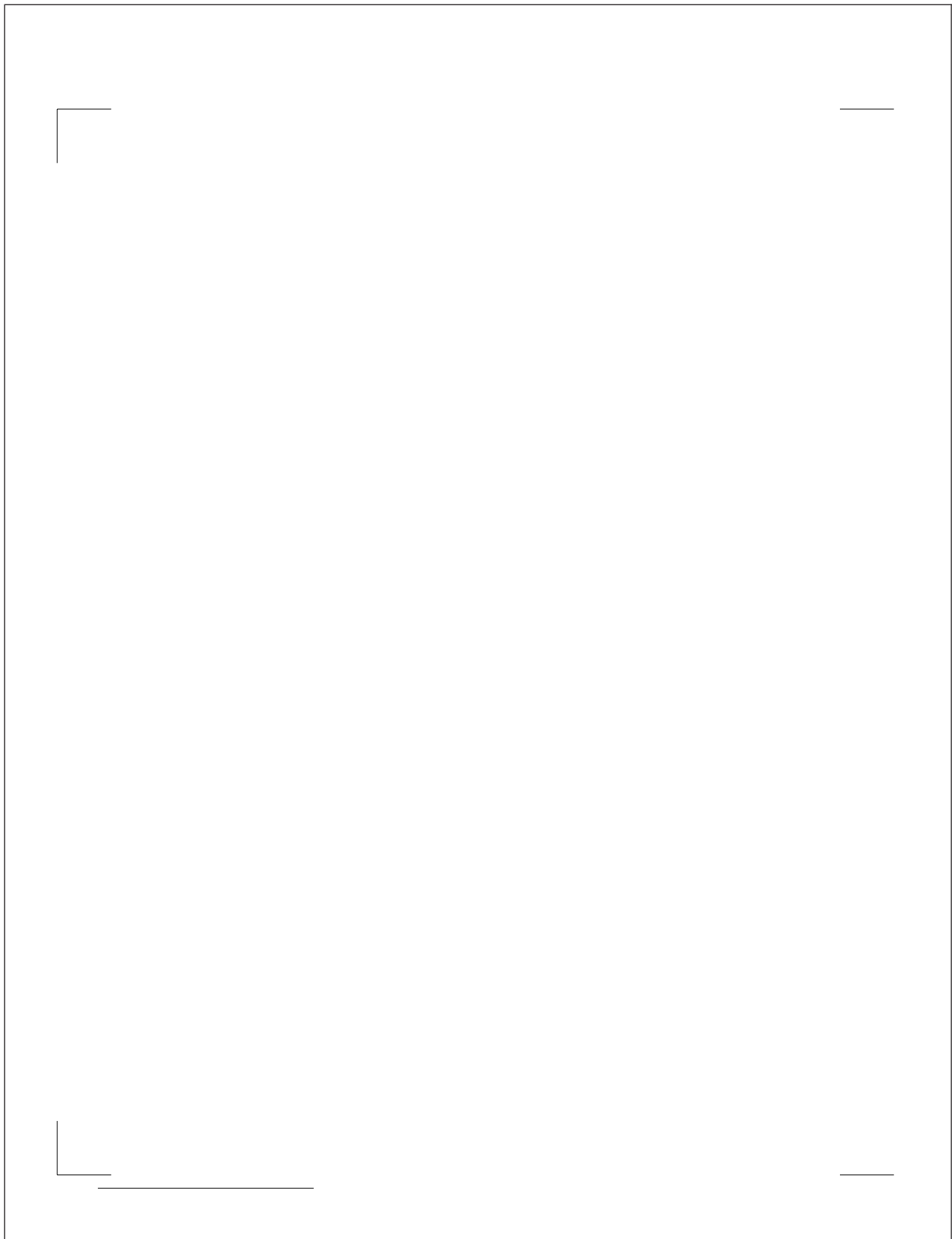


Figure 77. *GetContractUnitPrice* sequence diagram, 8 of 20 (2,4)

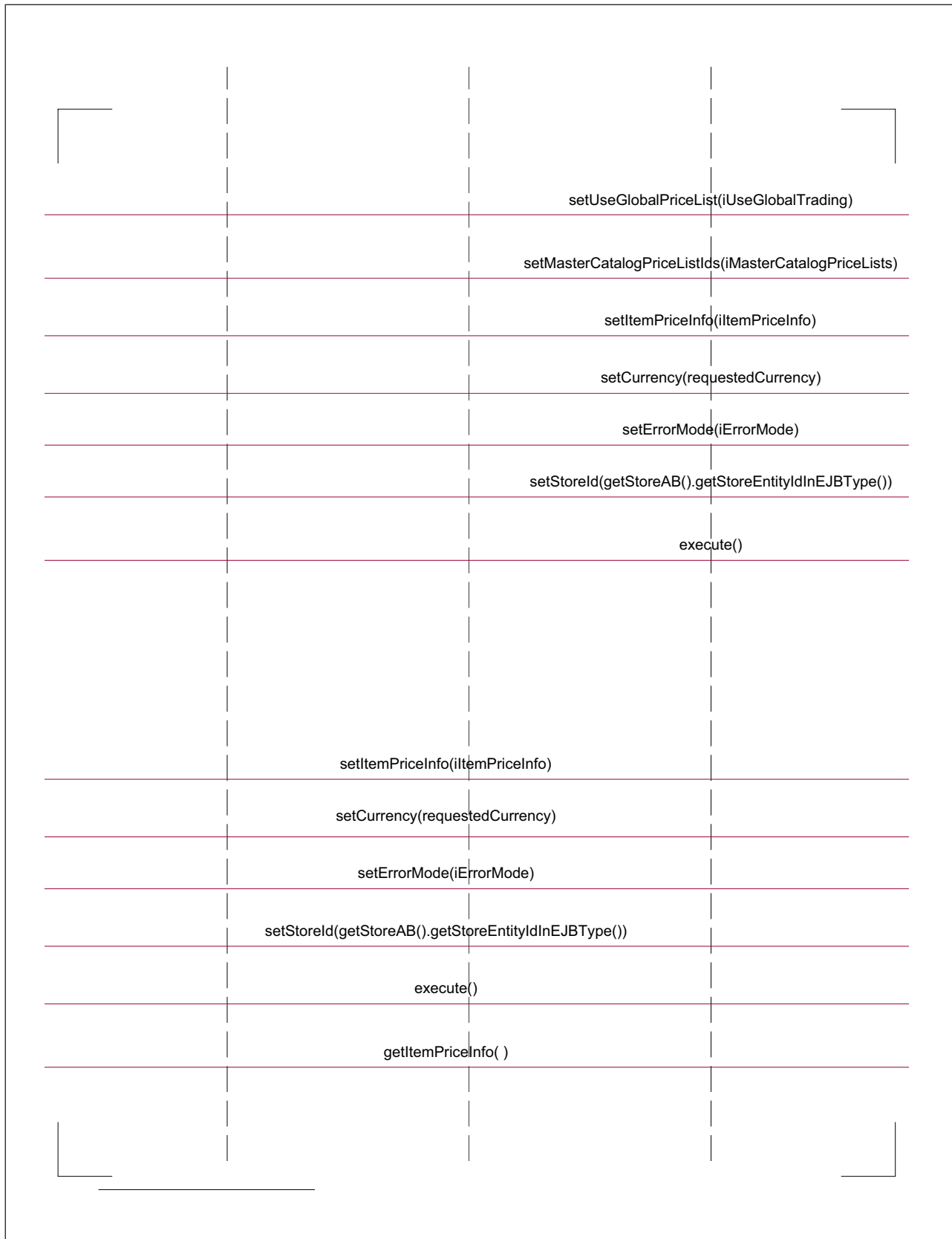


Figure 79. GetContractUnitPrice sequence diagram, 10 of 20 (3,2)

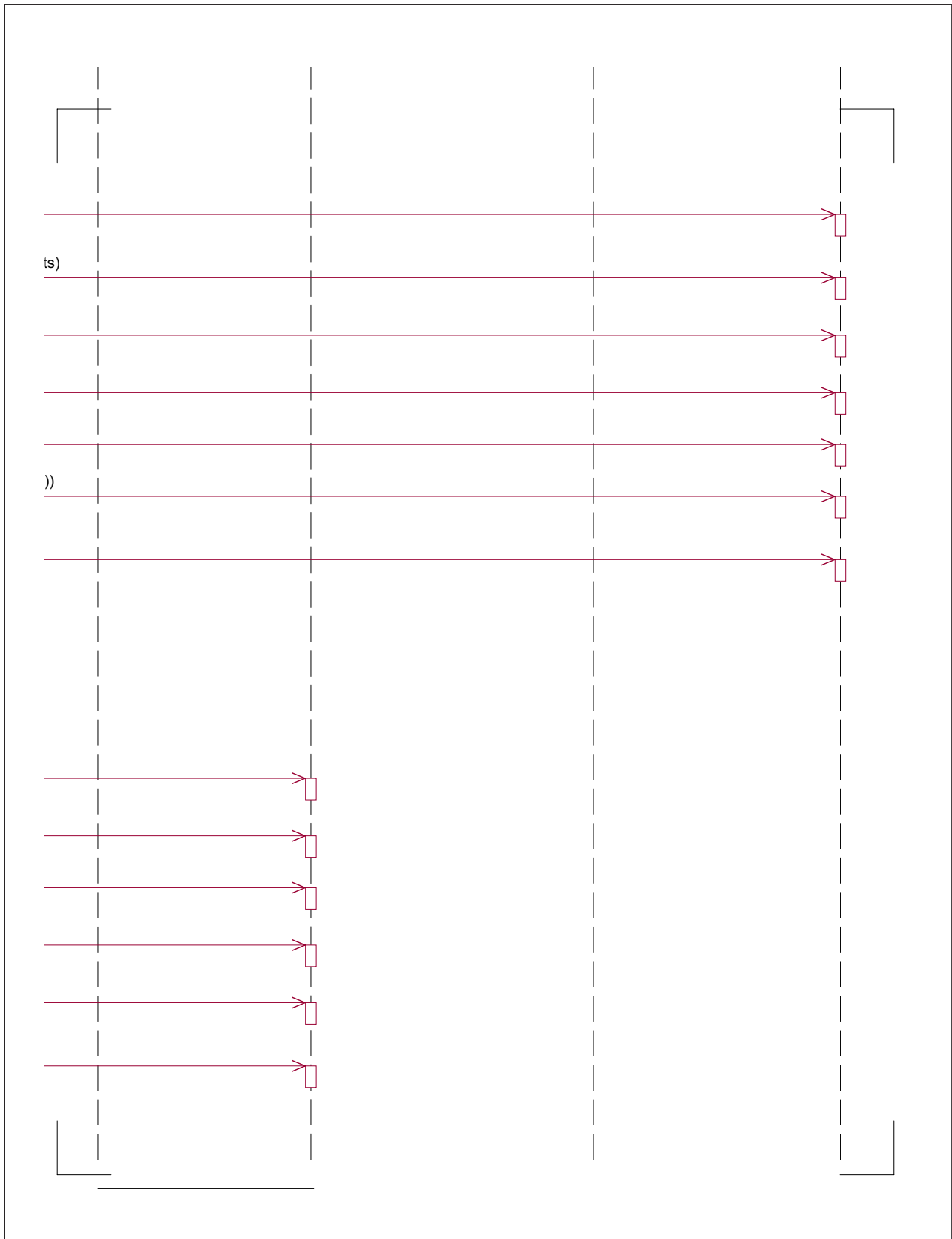


Figure 80. GetContractUnitPrice sequence diagram, 11 of 20 (3,3)

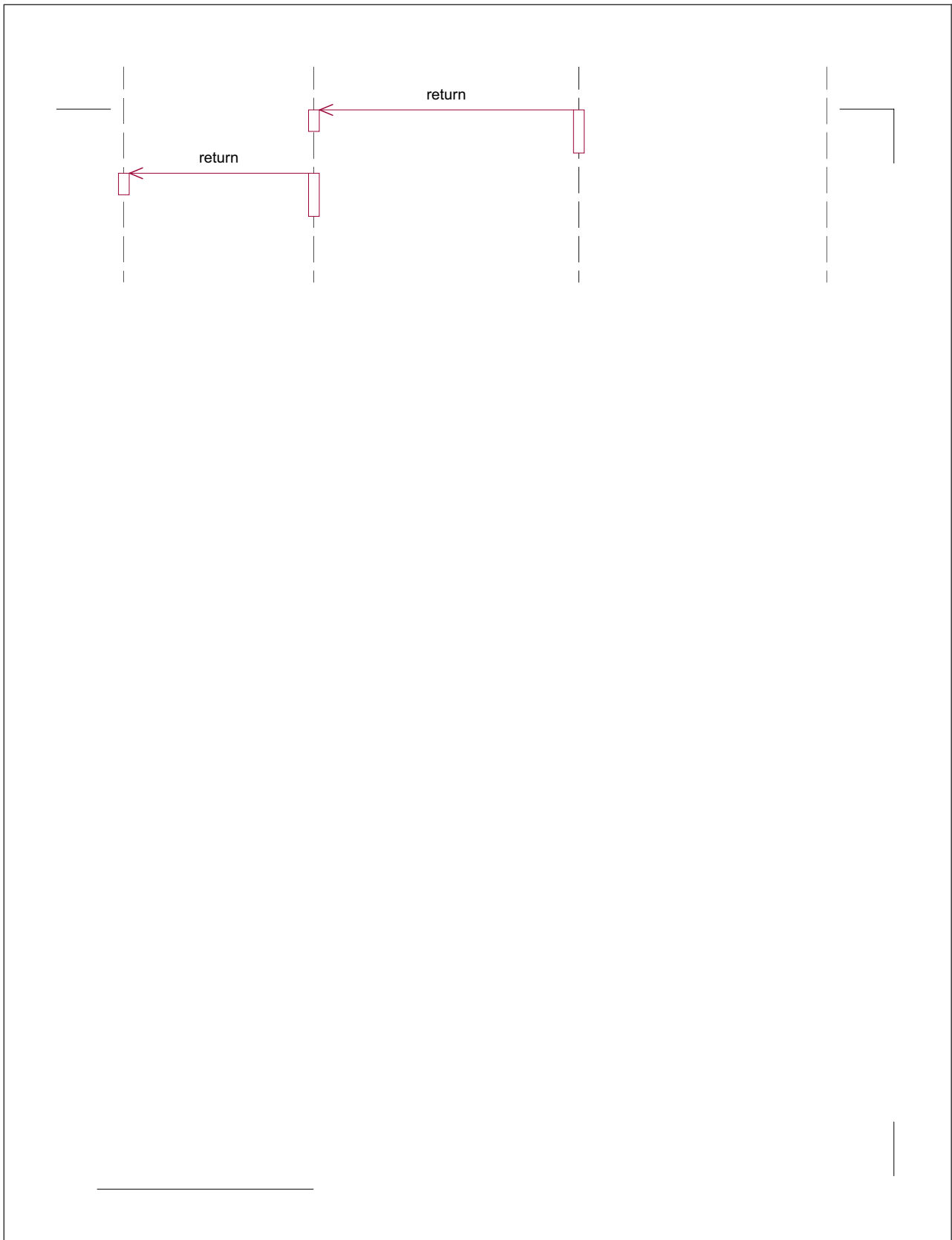


Figure 82. *GetContractUnitPrice* sequence diagram, 13 of 20 (4,1)

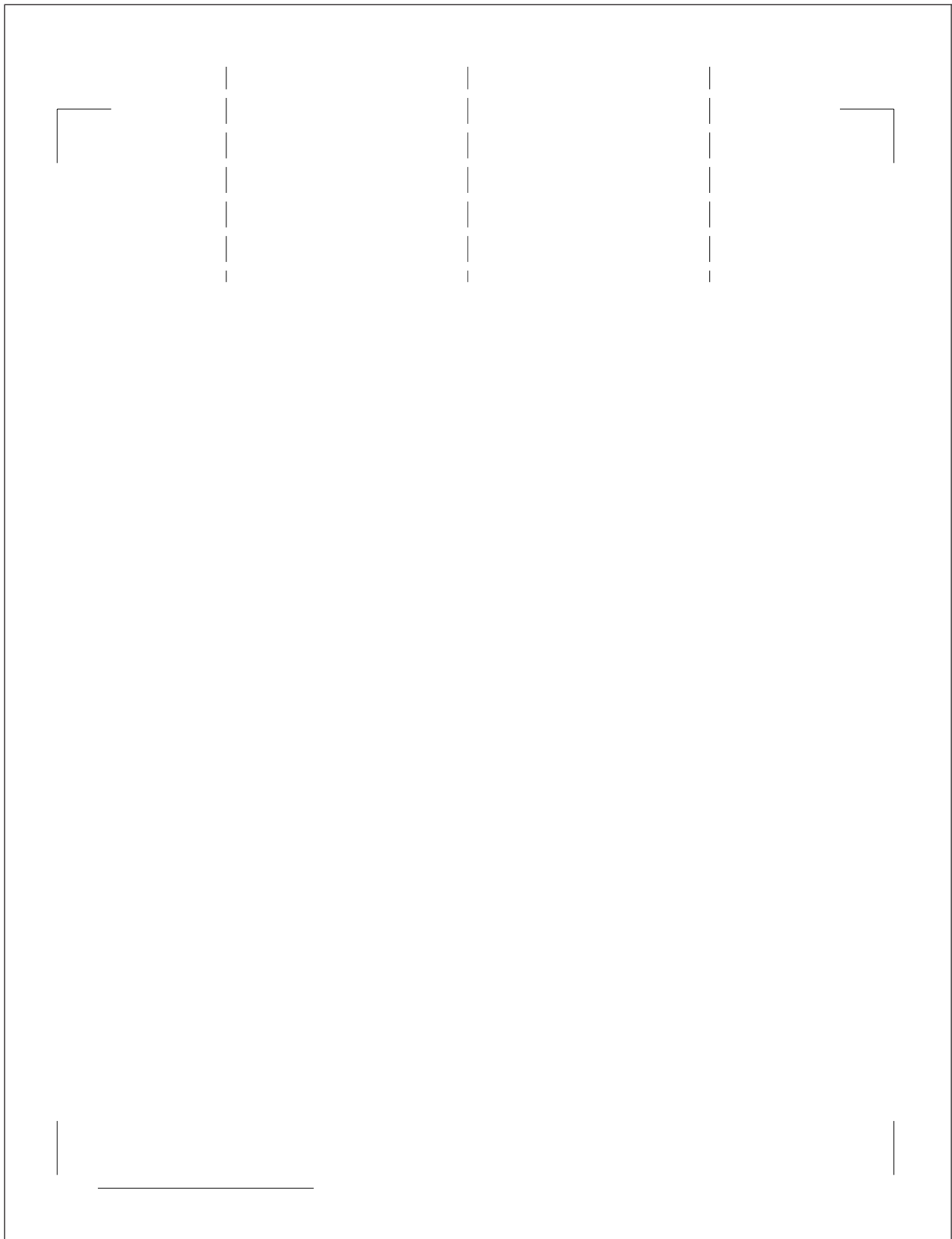


Figure 83. `GetContractUnitPrice` sequence diagram, 14 of 20 (4,2)

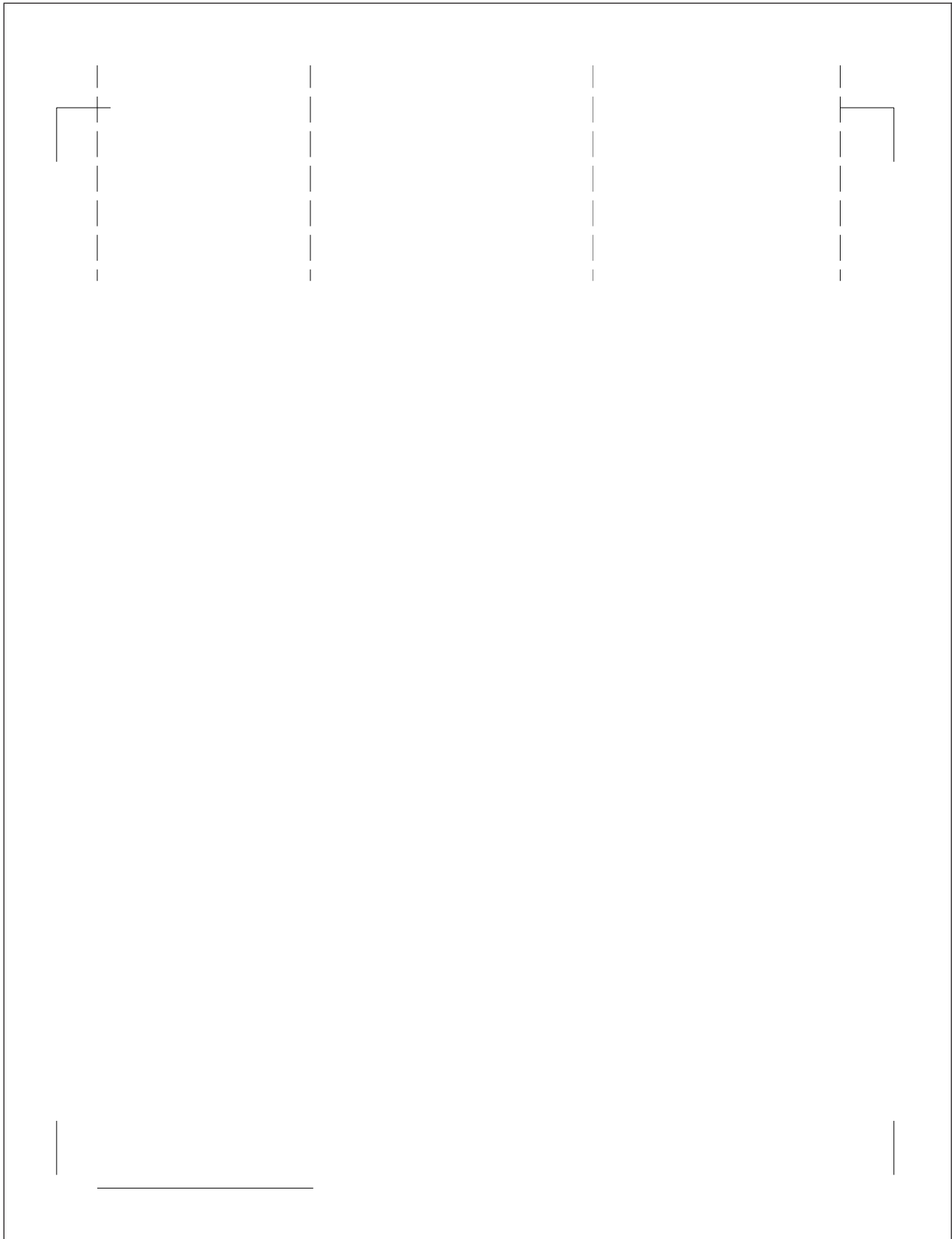


Figure 84. GetContractUnitPrice sequence diagram, 15 of 20 (4,3)

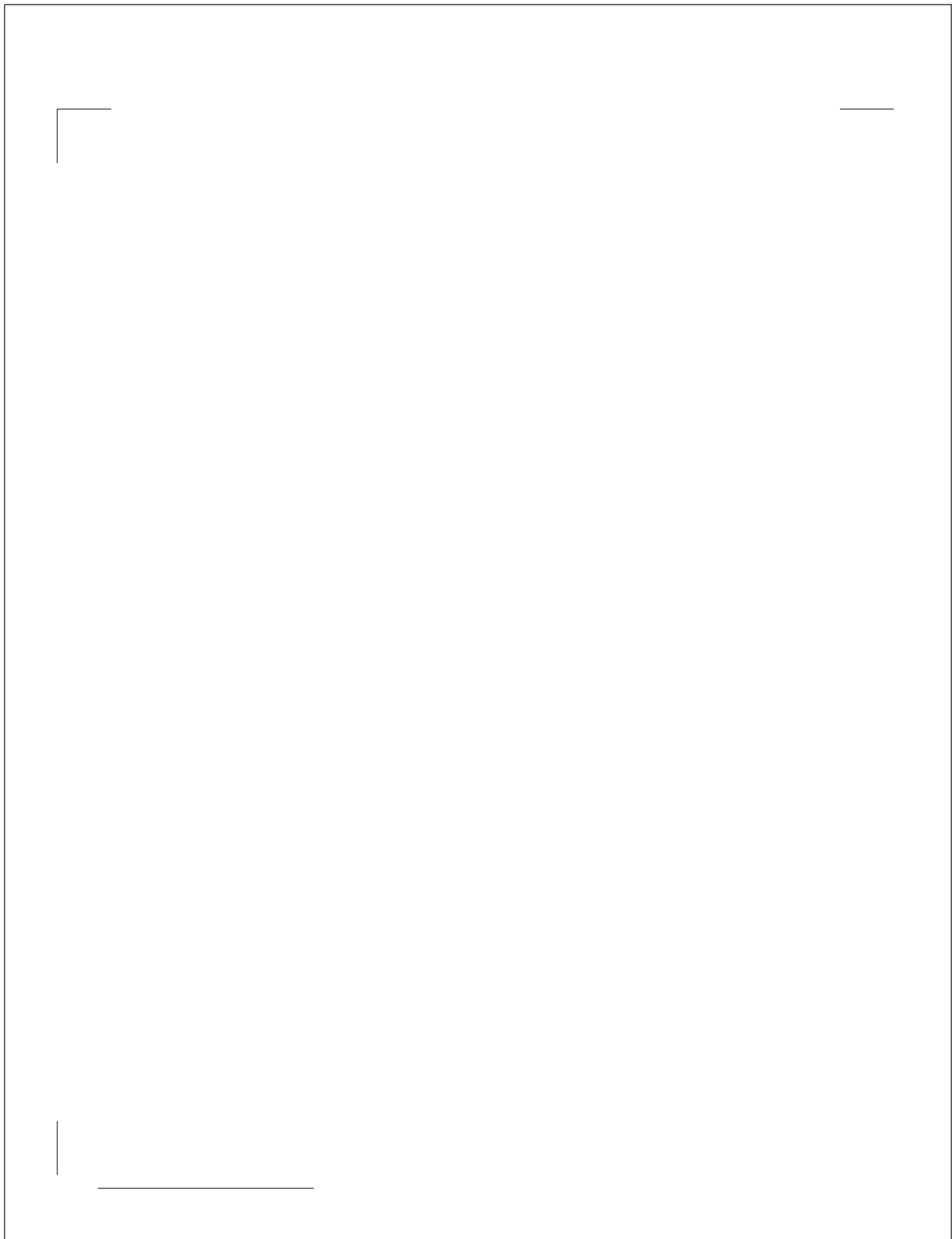


Figure 85. *GetContractUnitPrice* sequence diagram, 16 of 20 (4,4)

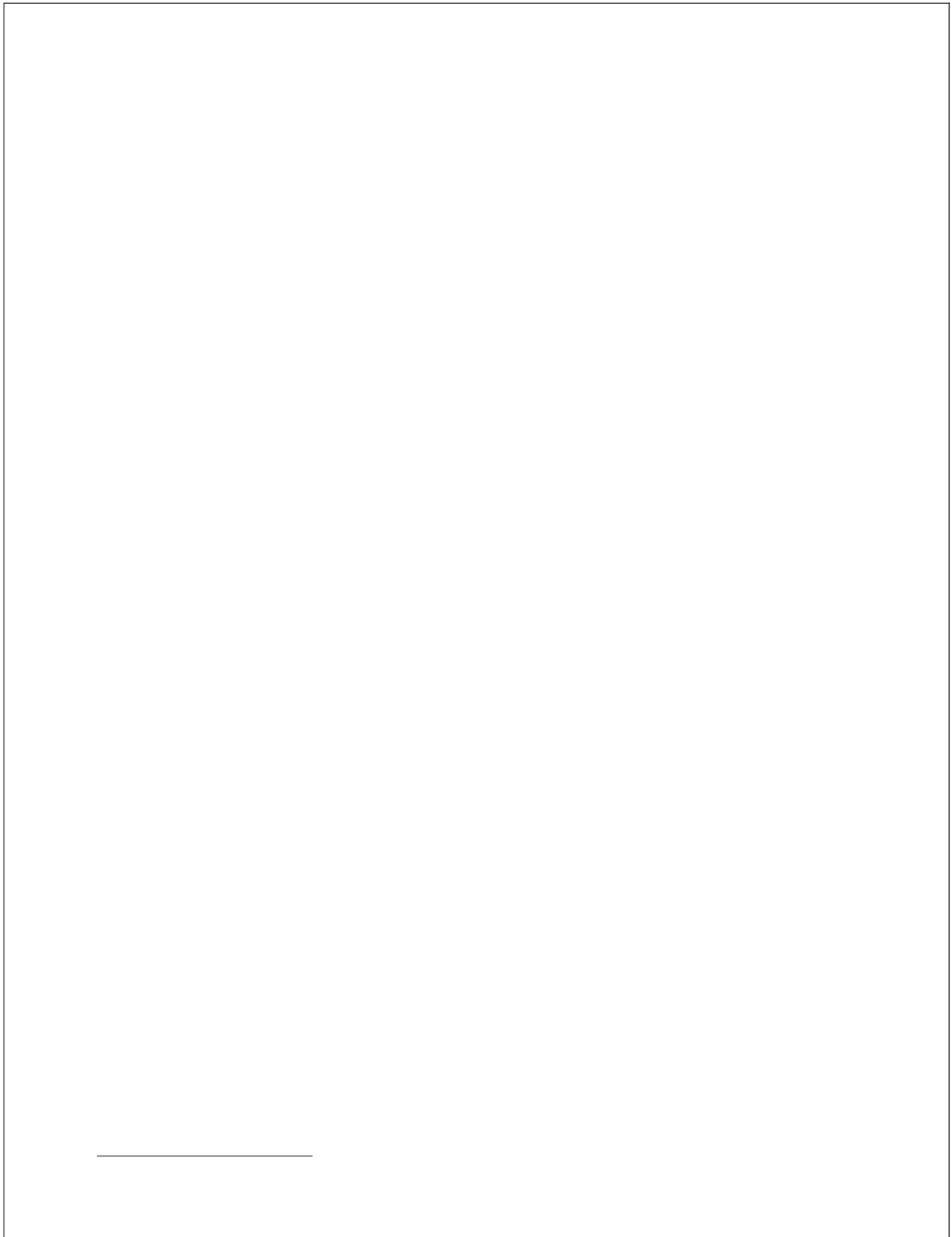


Figure 86. *GetContractUnitPrice* sequence diagram, 17 of 20 (5,1)

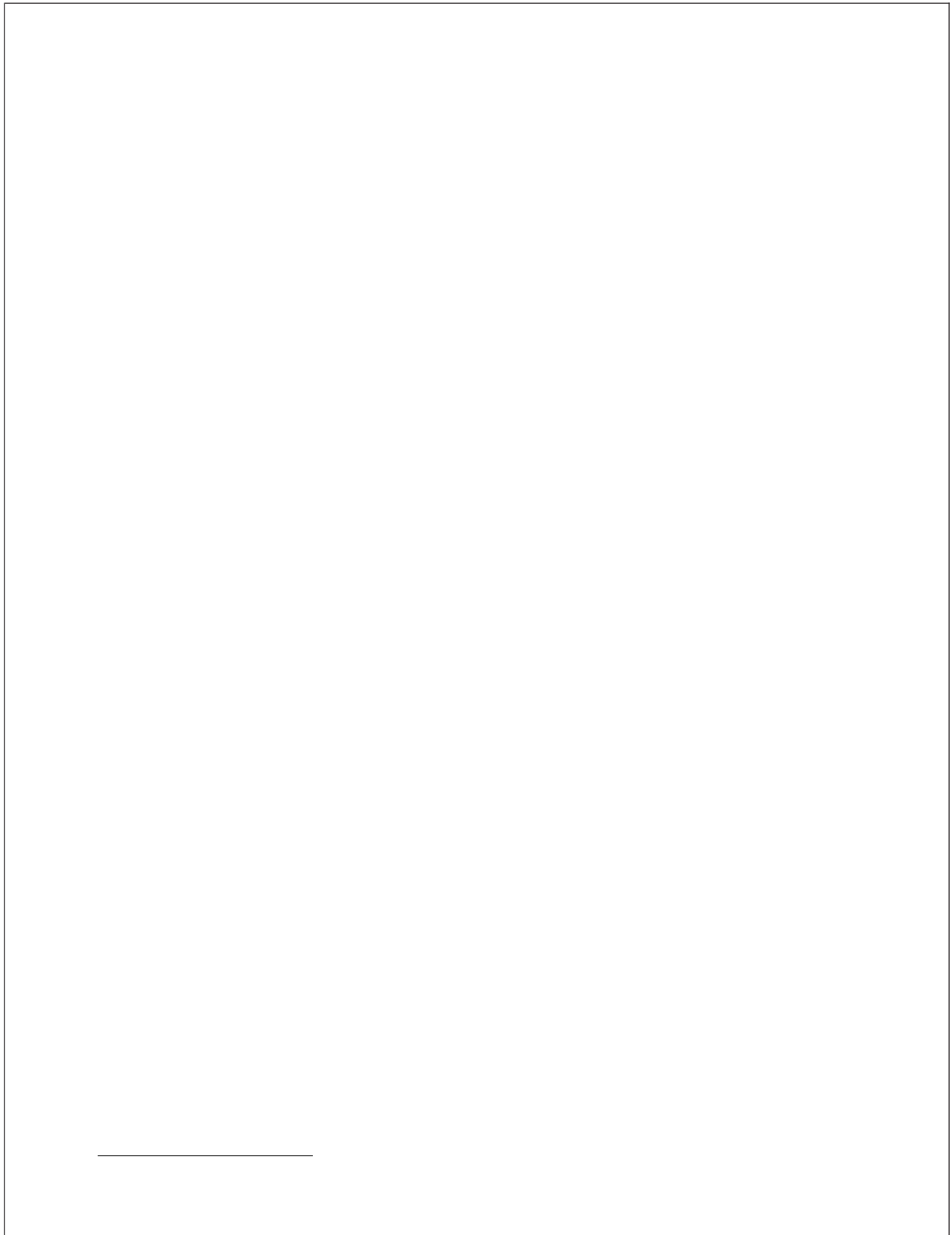


Figure 87. *GetContractUnitPrice* sequence diagram, 18 of 20 (5,2)

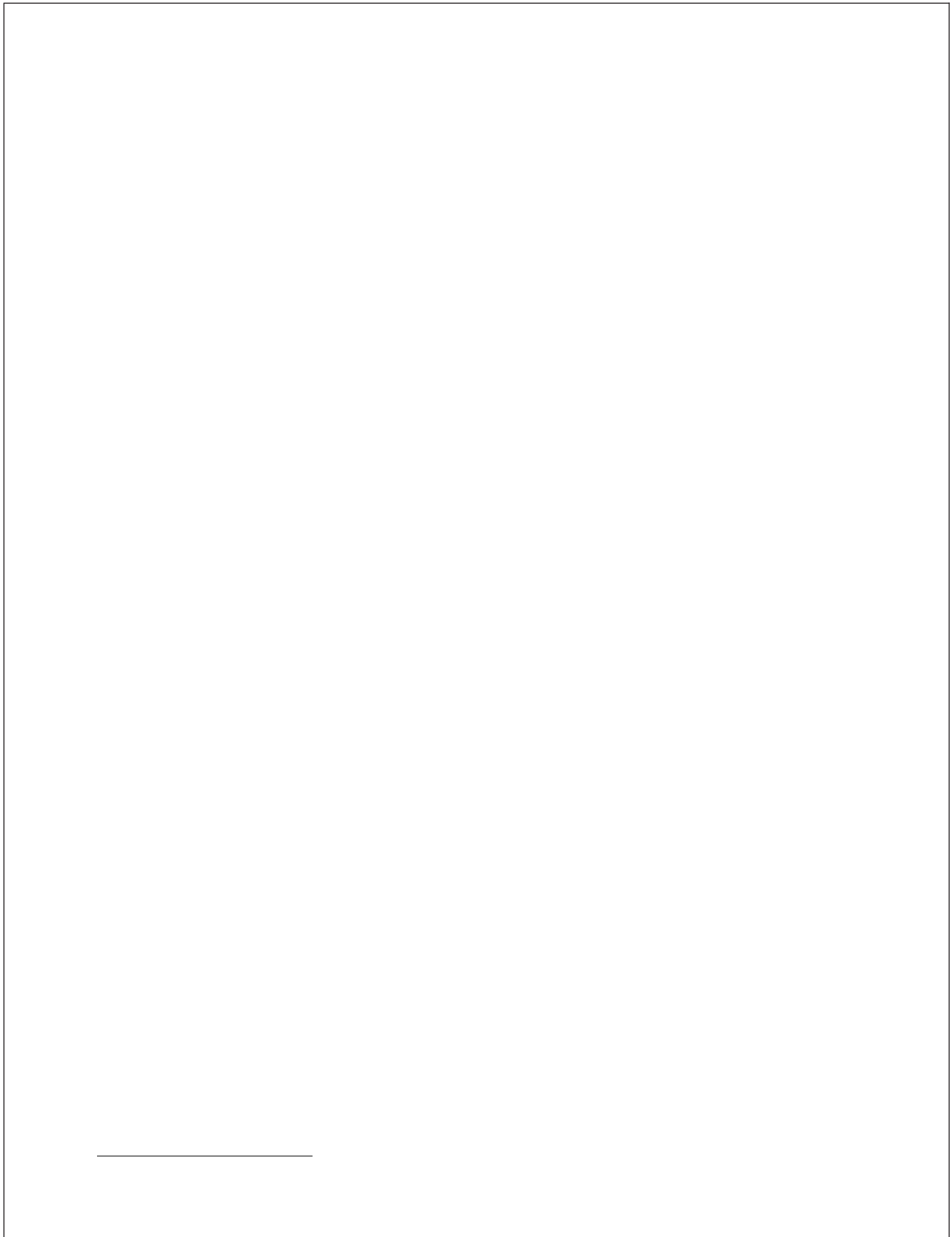


Figure 88. GetContractUnitPrice sequence diagram, 19 of 20 (5,3)

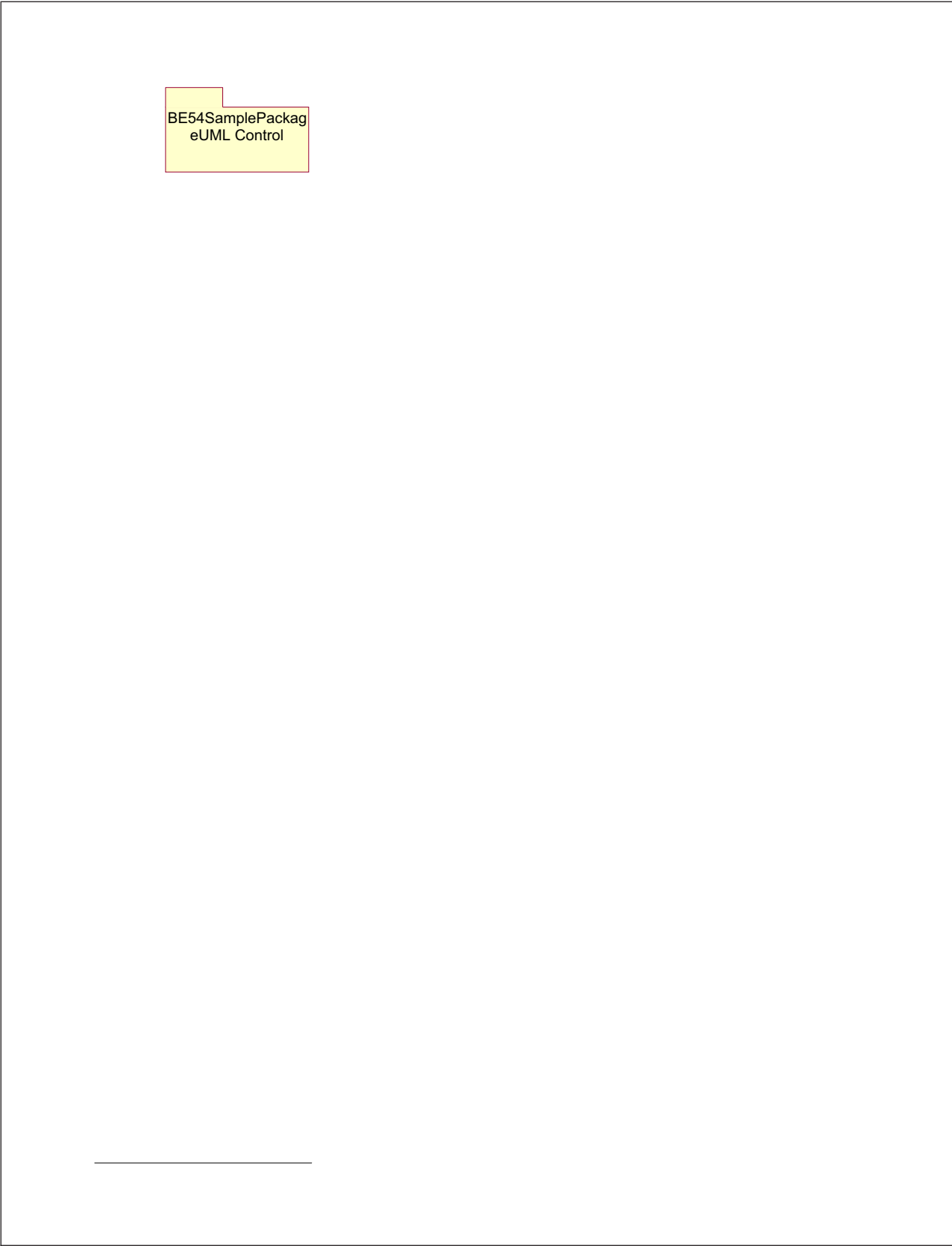


Figure 89. GetContractUnitPrice sequence diagram, 20 of 20 (5,4)

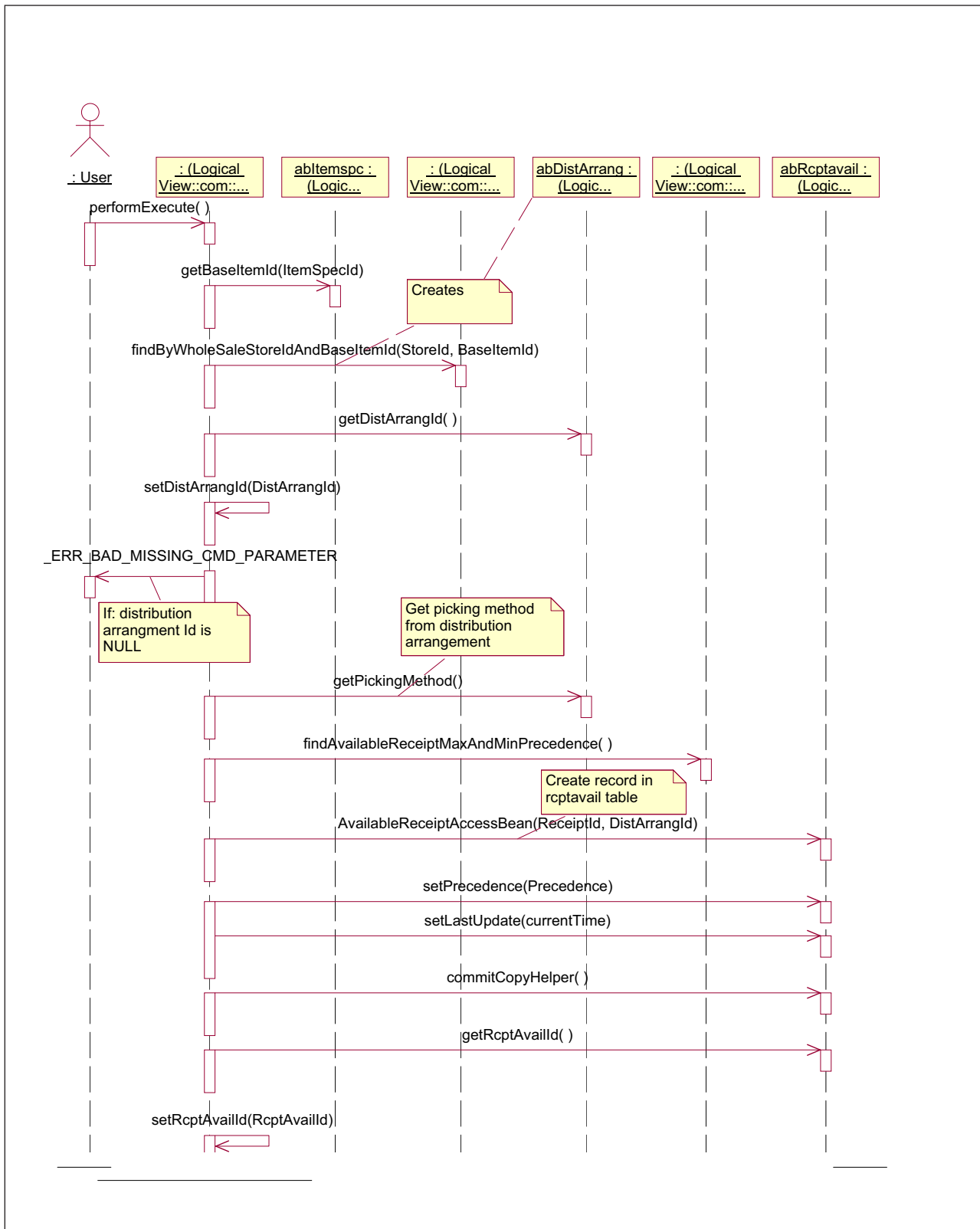


Figure 90. MakeReceiptAvailable sequence diagram, 1 of 2 (1,1)

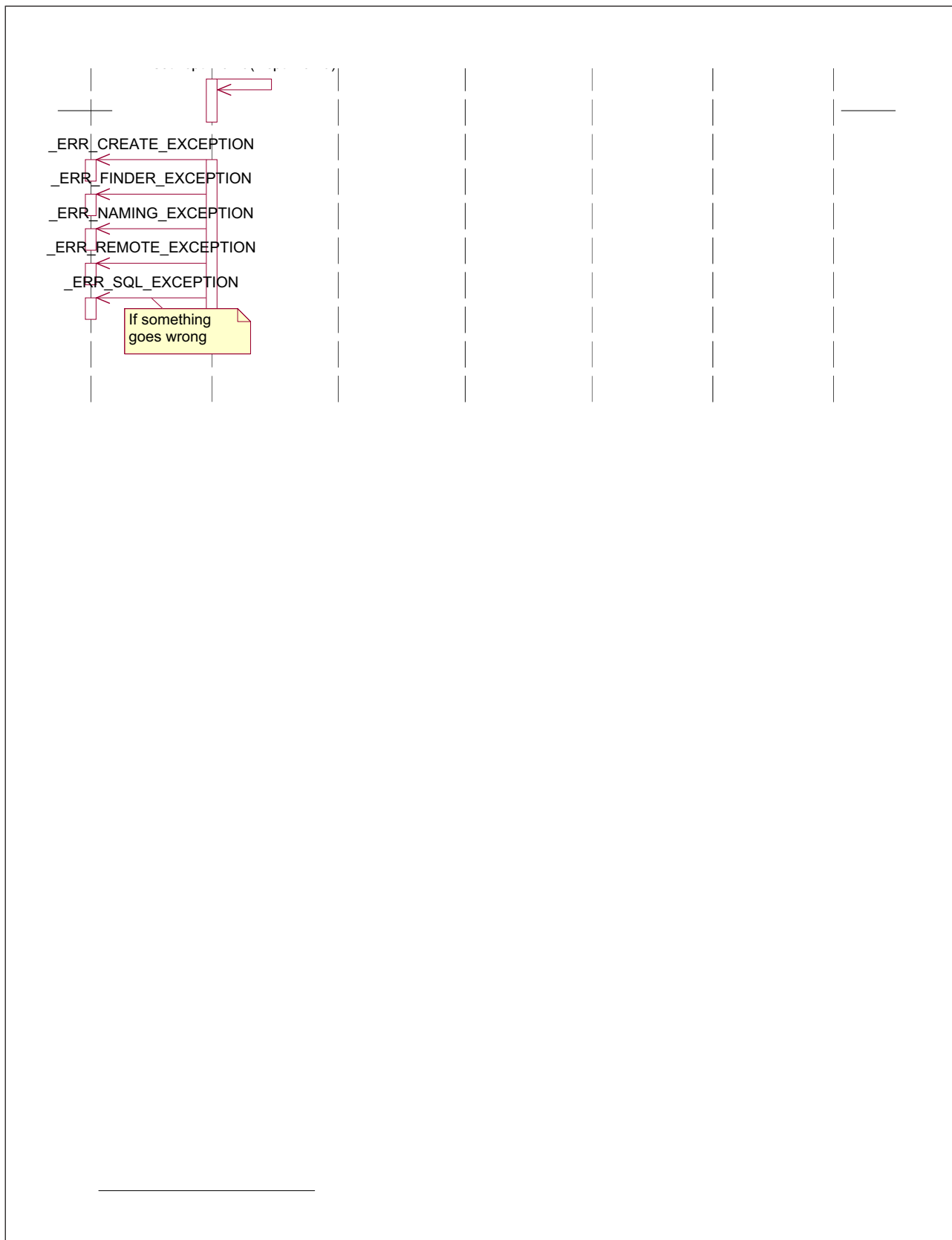


Figure 91. *MakeReceiptAvailable* sequence diagram, 2 of 2 (1,2)

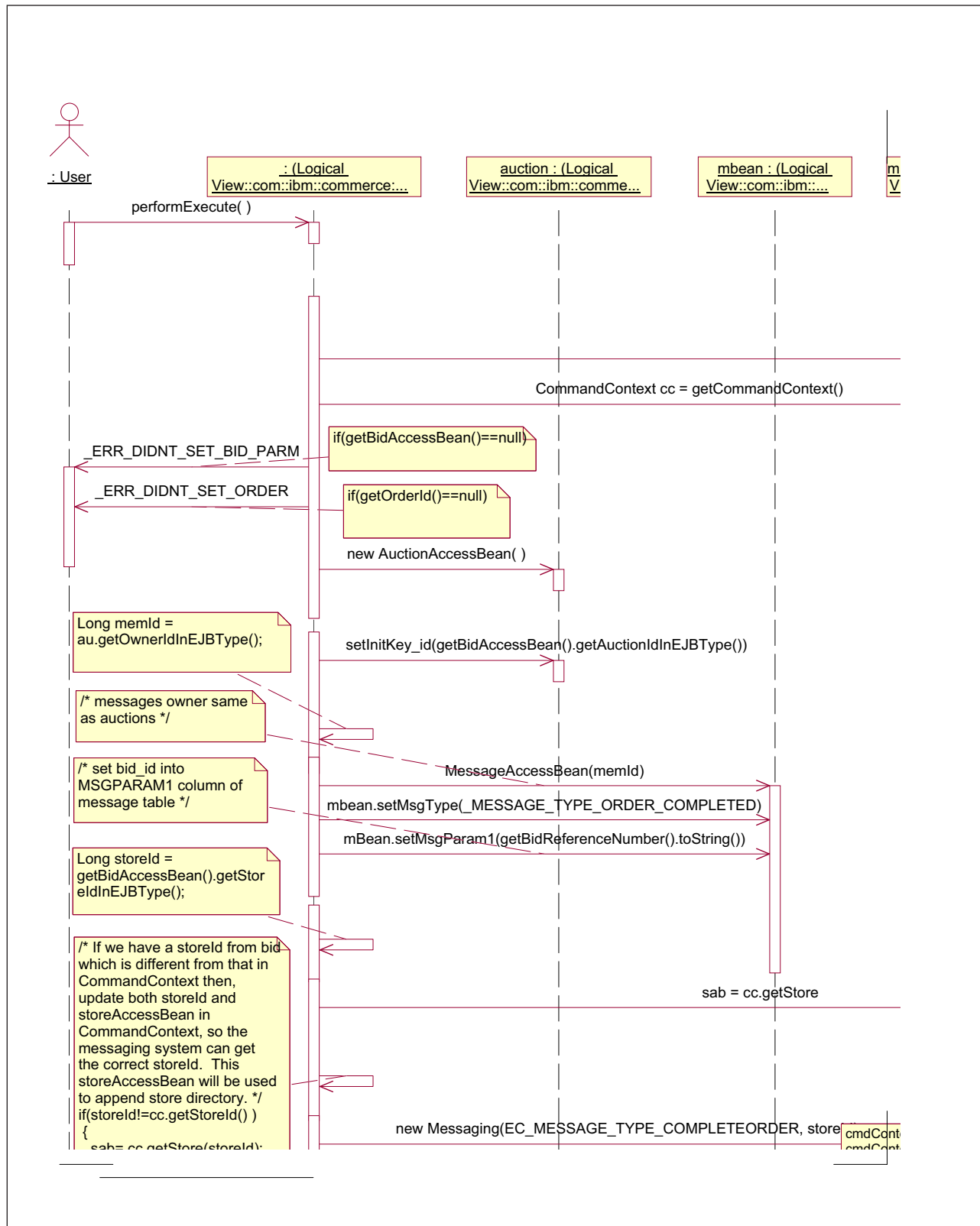


Figure 92. NotifyCompleteOrder sequence diagram, 1 of 4 (1,1)

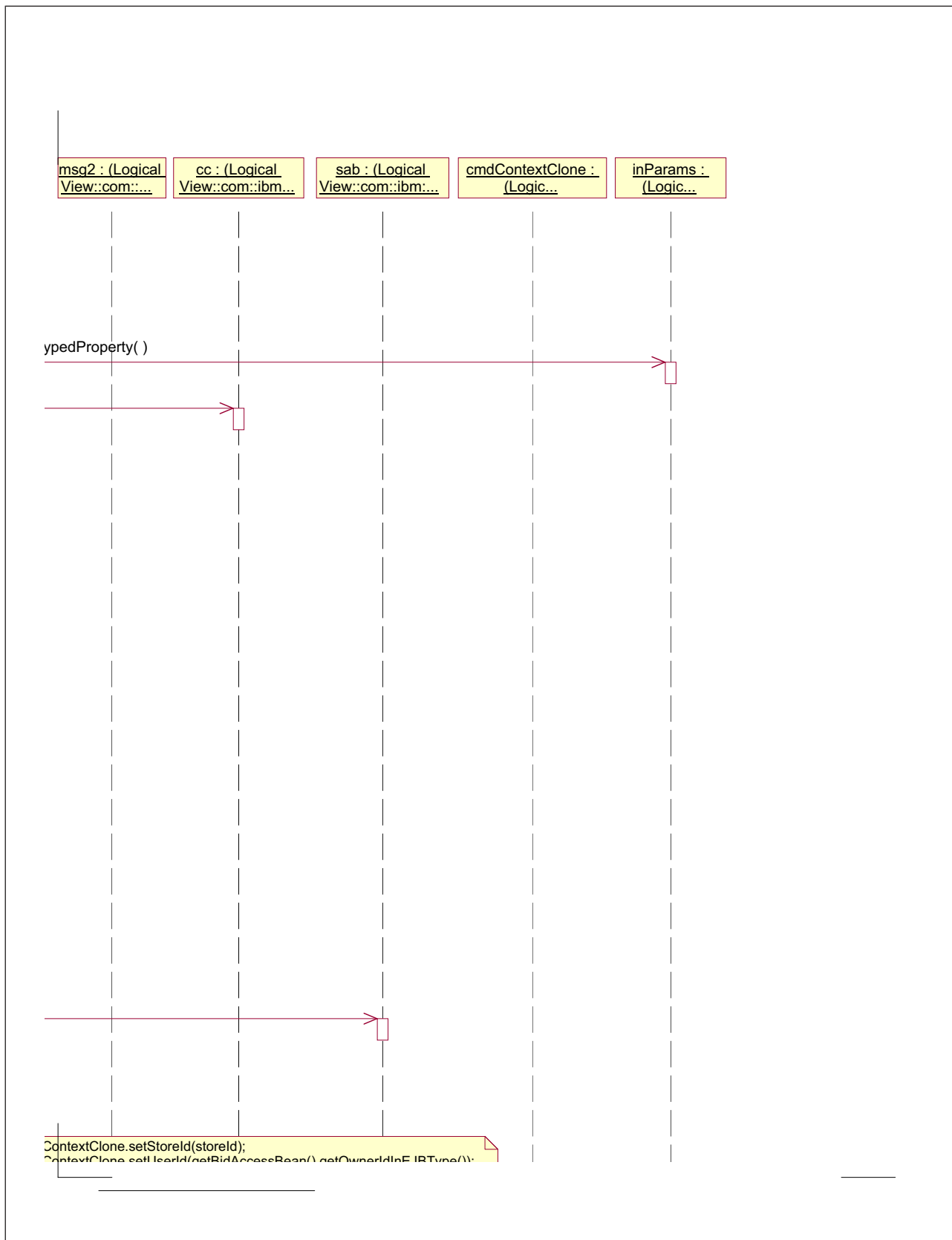


Figure 93. `NotifyCompleteOrder` sequence diagram, 2 of 4 (1,2)

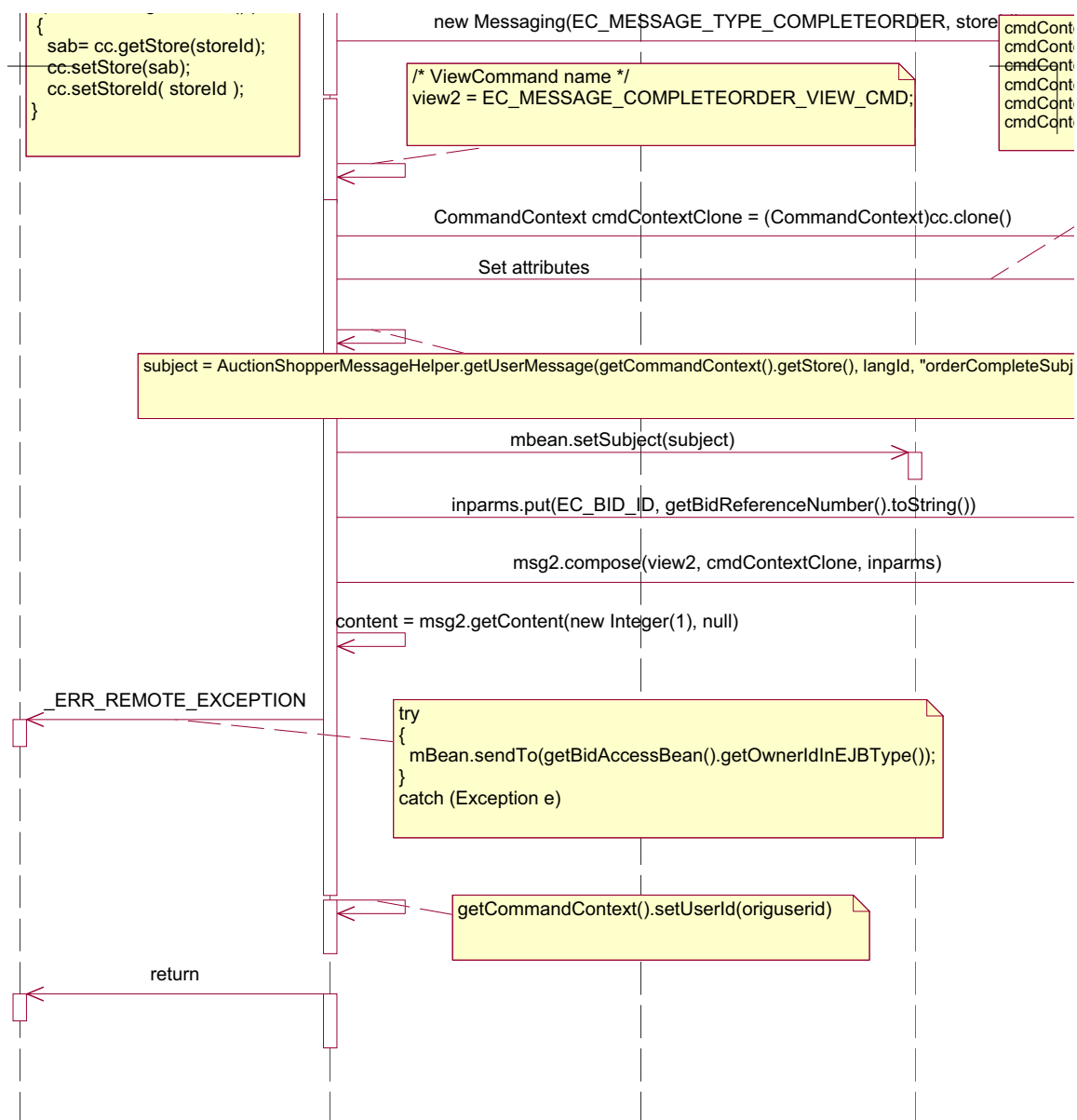


Figure 94. `NotifyCompleteOrder` sequence diagram, 3 of 4 (2,1)

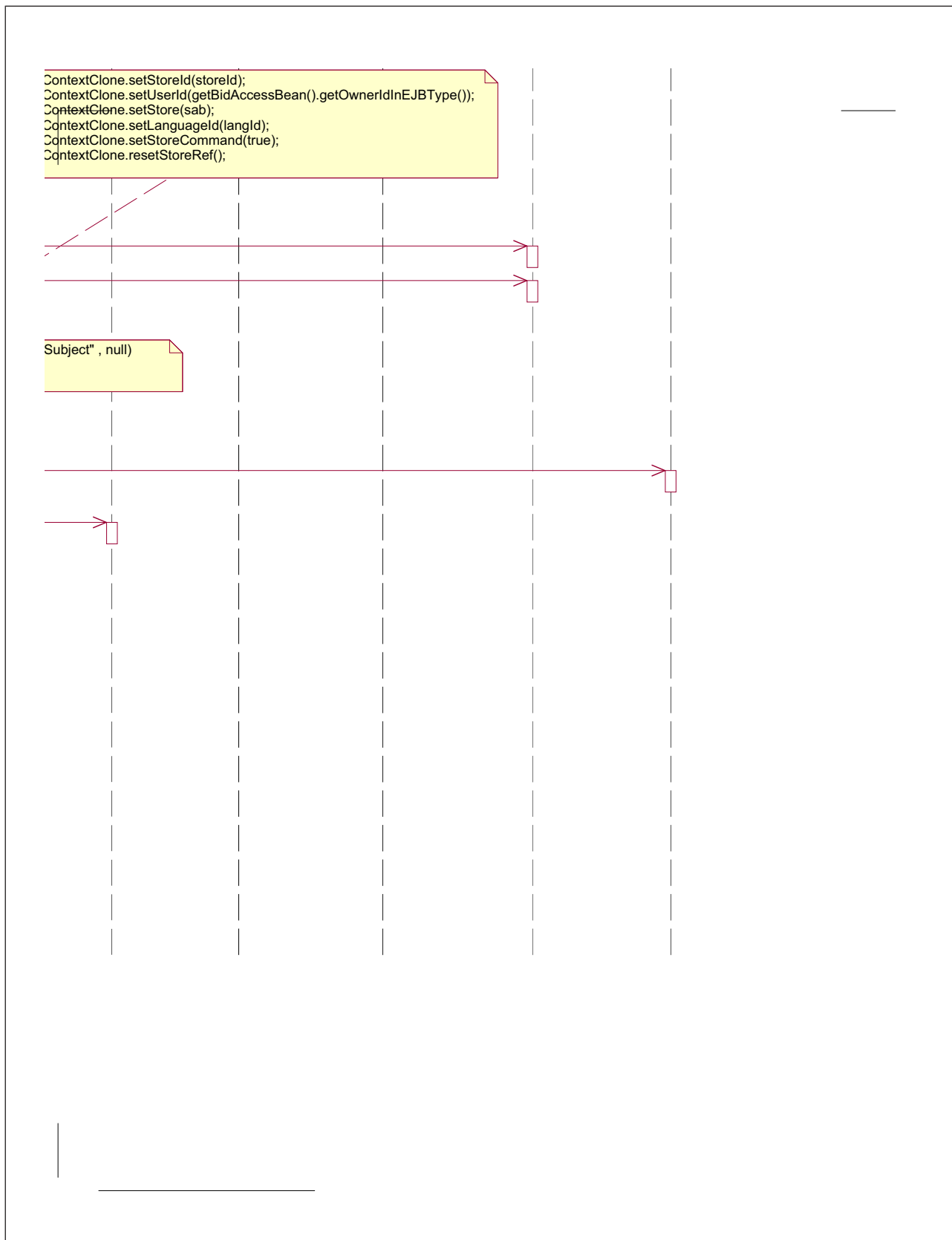


Figure 95. `NotifyCompleteOrder` sequence diagram, 4 of 4 (2,2)

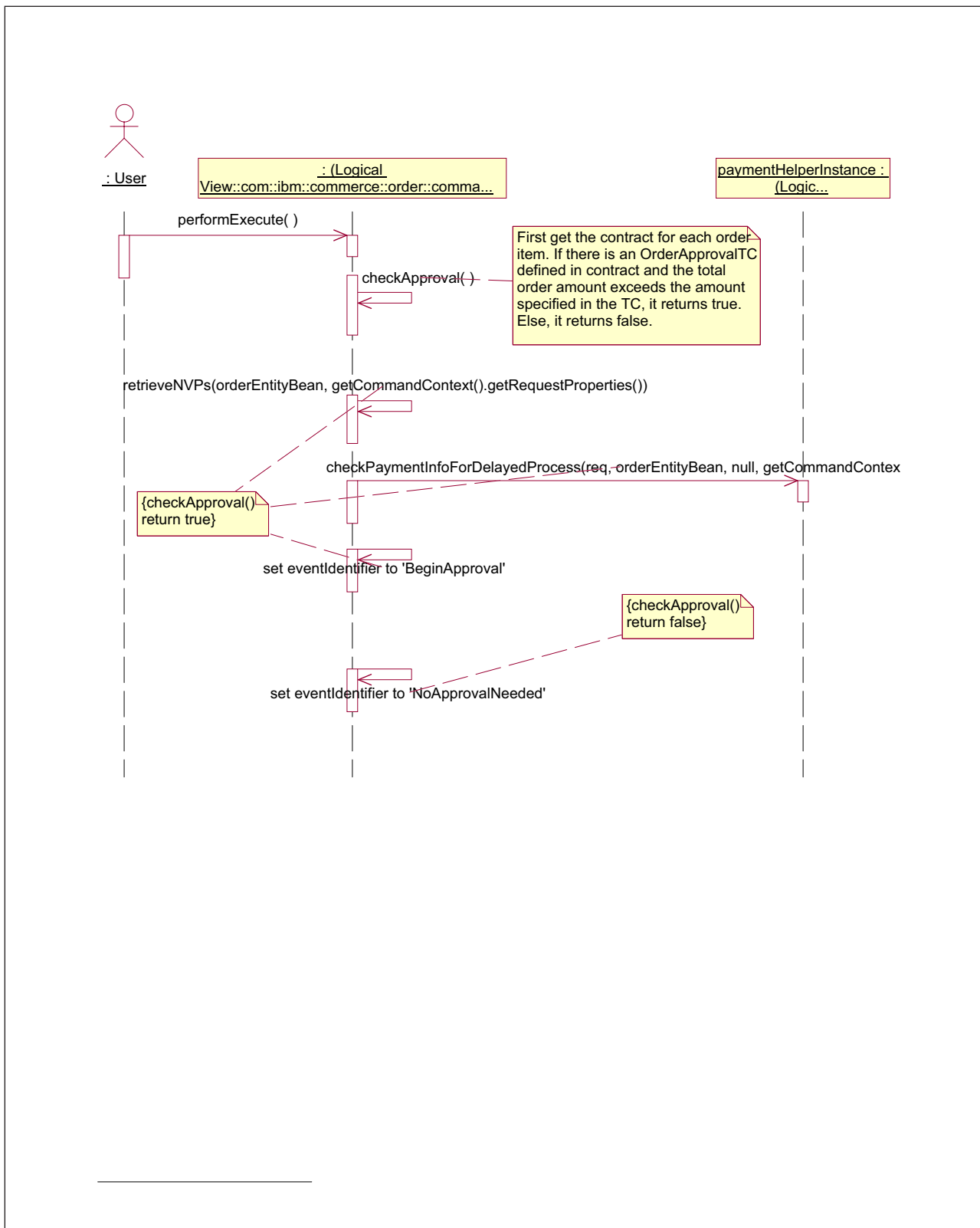


Figure 96. OrderProcessCheckApproval sequence diagram, 1 of 2 (1,1)

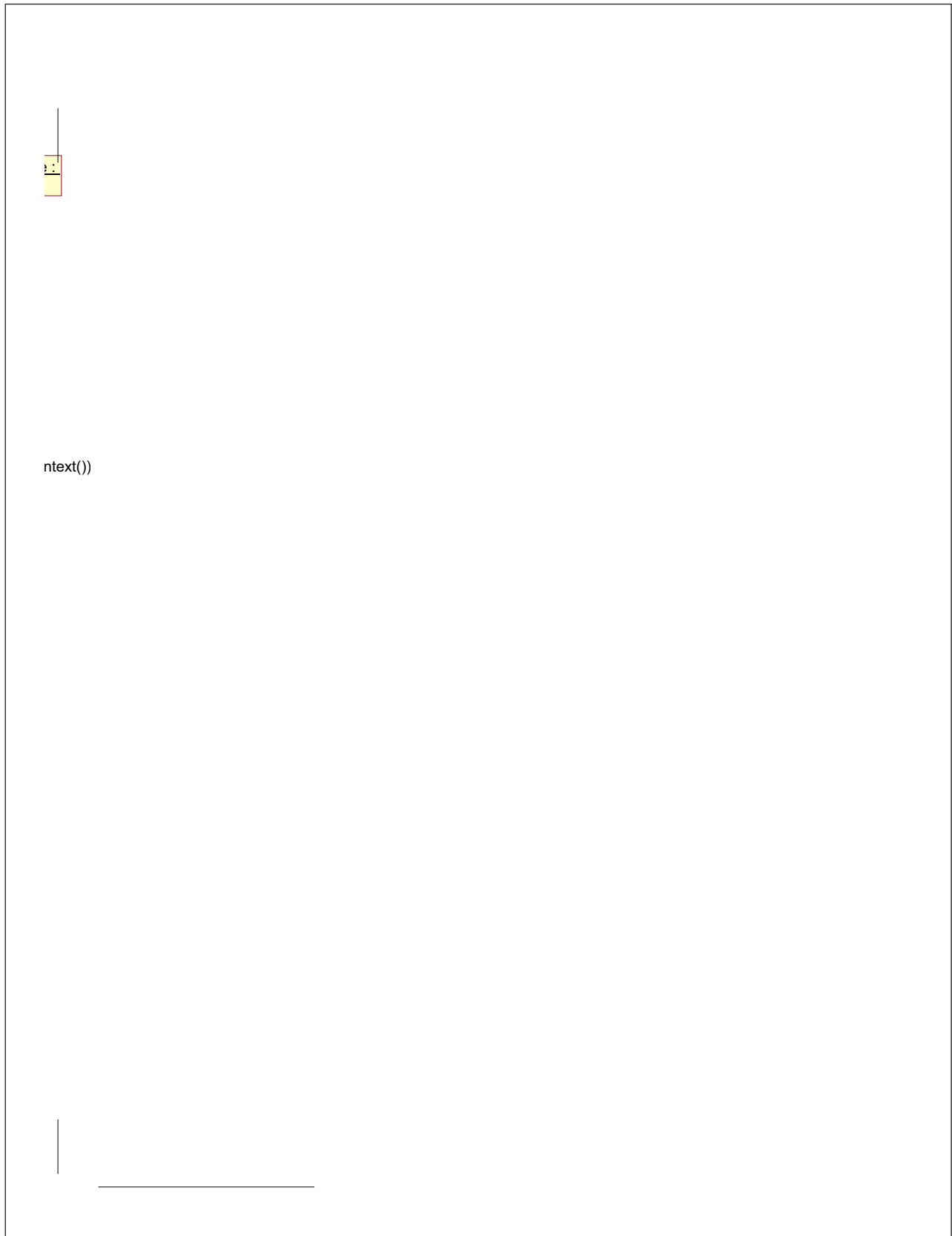


Figure 97. *OrderProcessCheckApproval* sequence diagram, 2 of 2 (1,2)

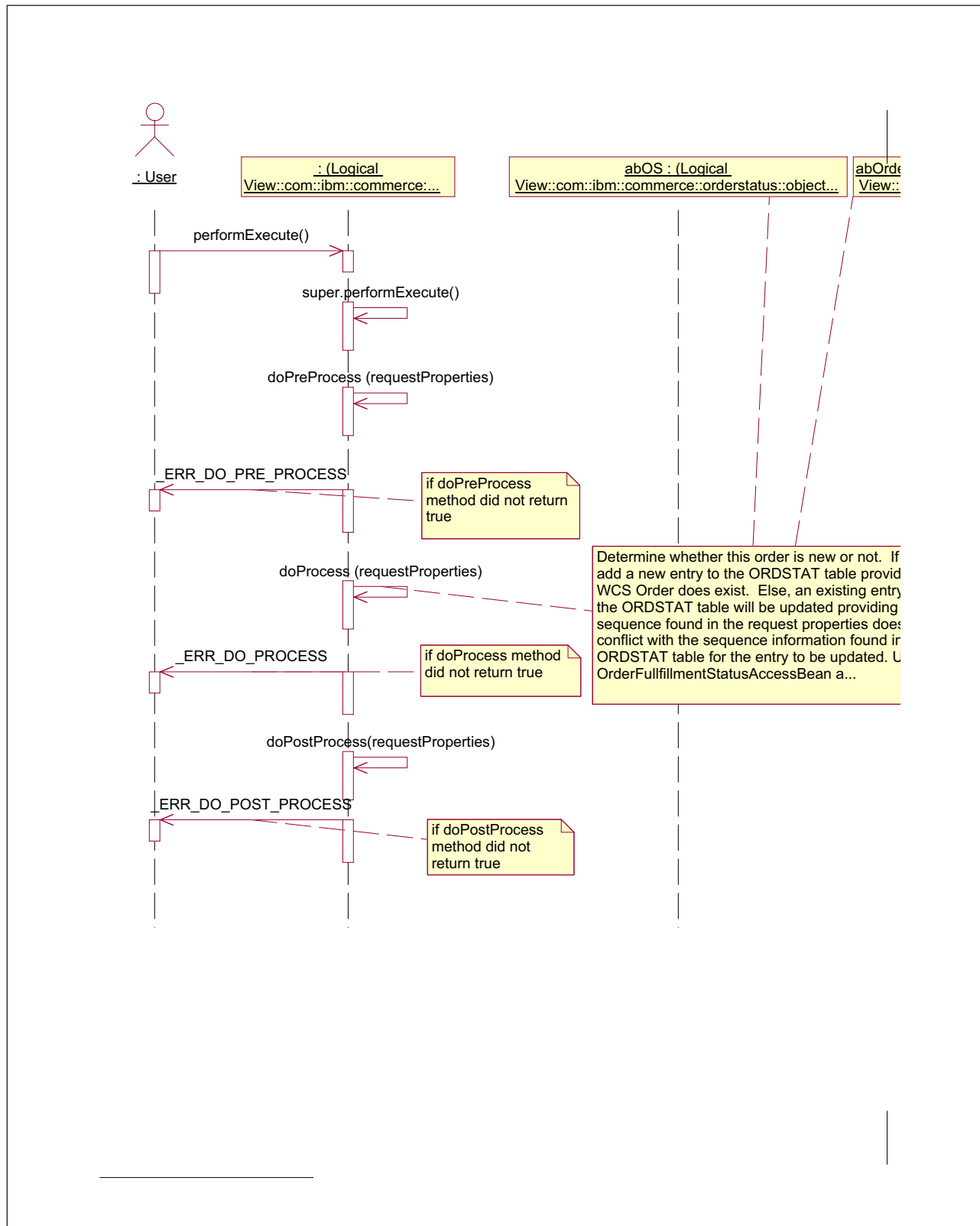


Figure 98. OrderStatus sequence diagram, 1 of 2 (1,1)

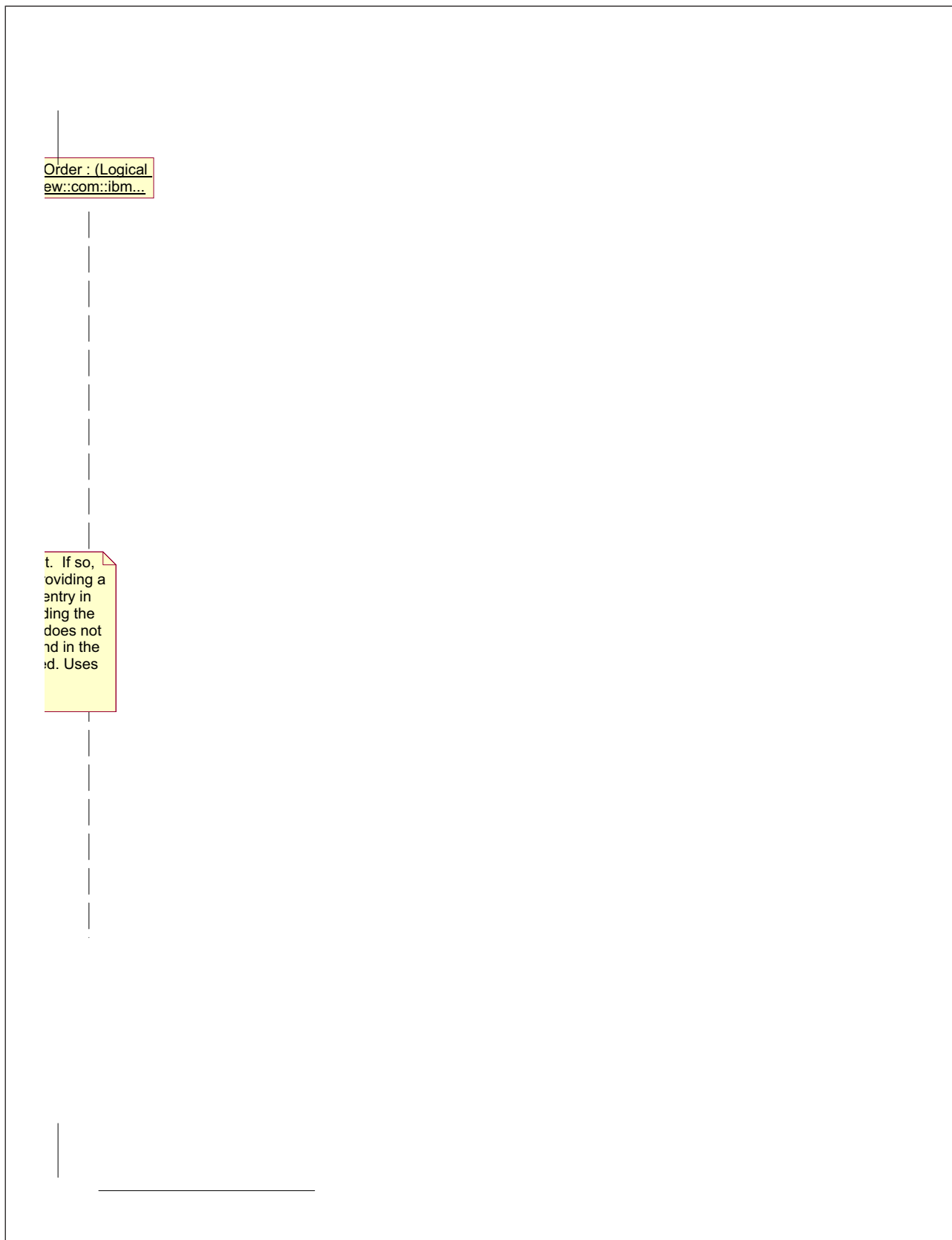


Figure 99. OrderStatus sequence diagram, 2 of 2 (1,2)

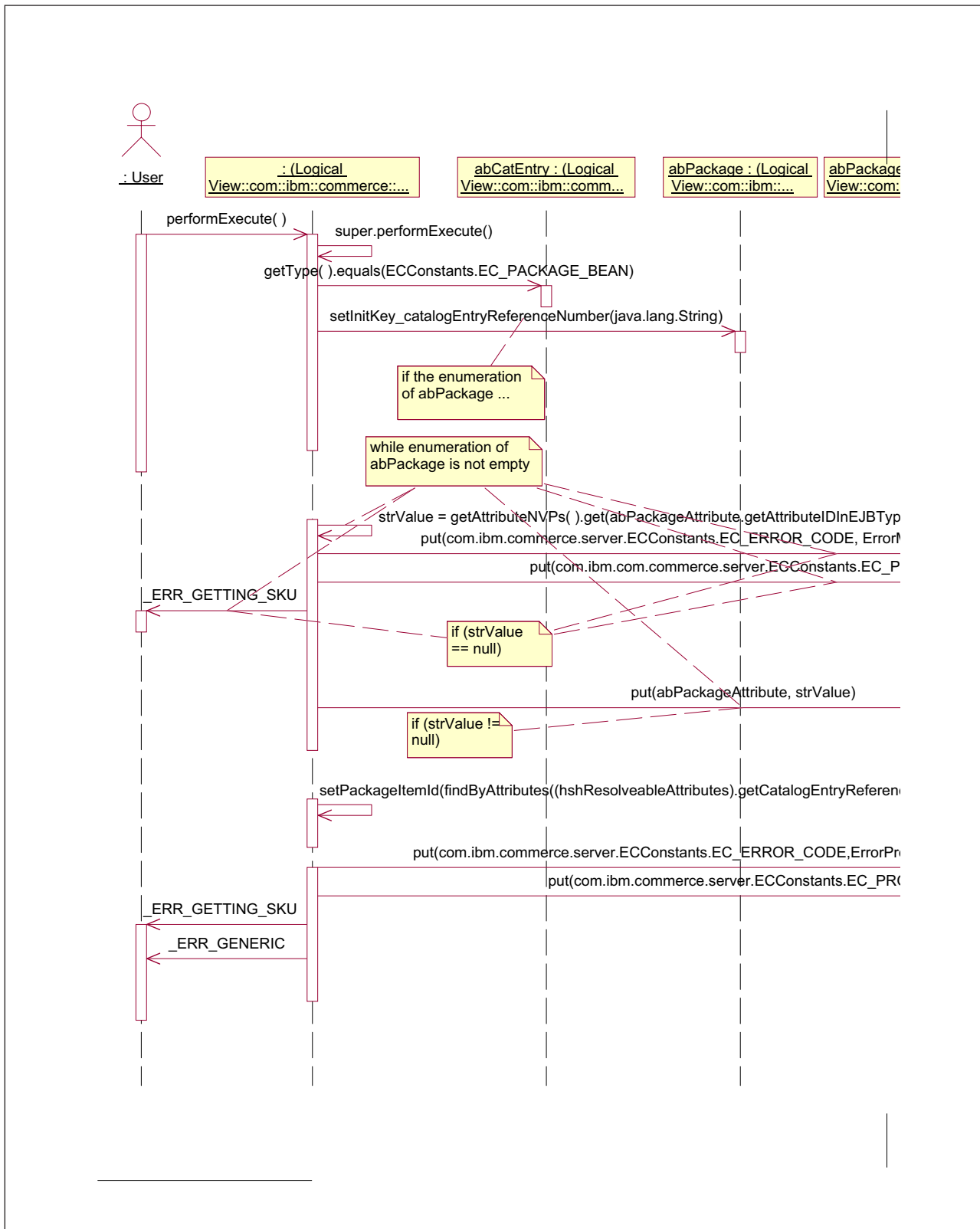


Figure 100. PackageResolveSKU sequence diagram, 1 of 2 (1,1)

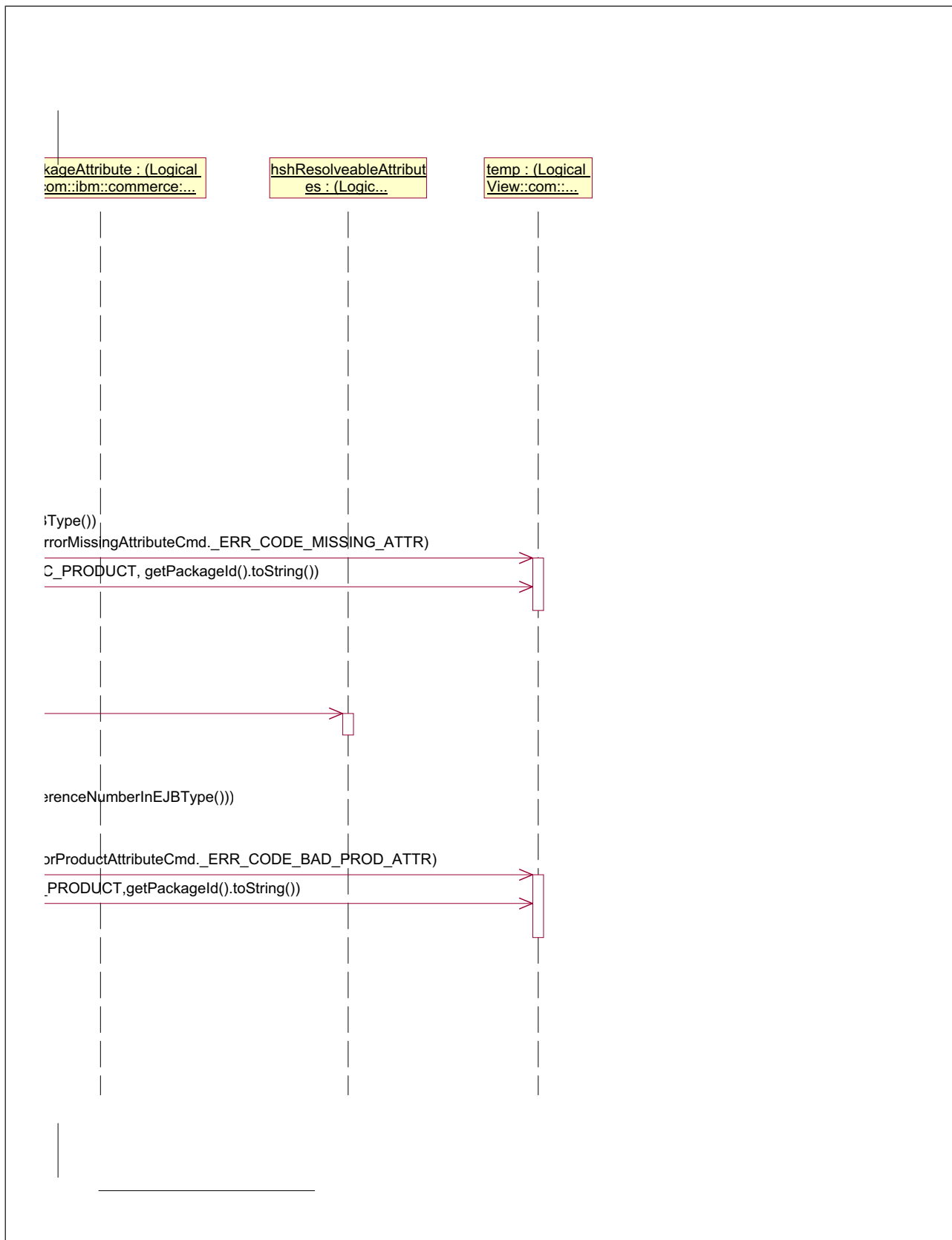


Figure 101. PackageResolveSKU sequence diagram, 2 of 2 (1,2)

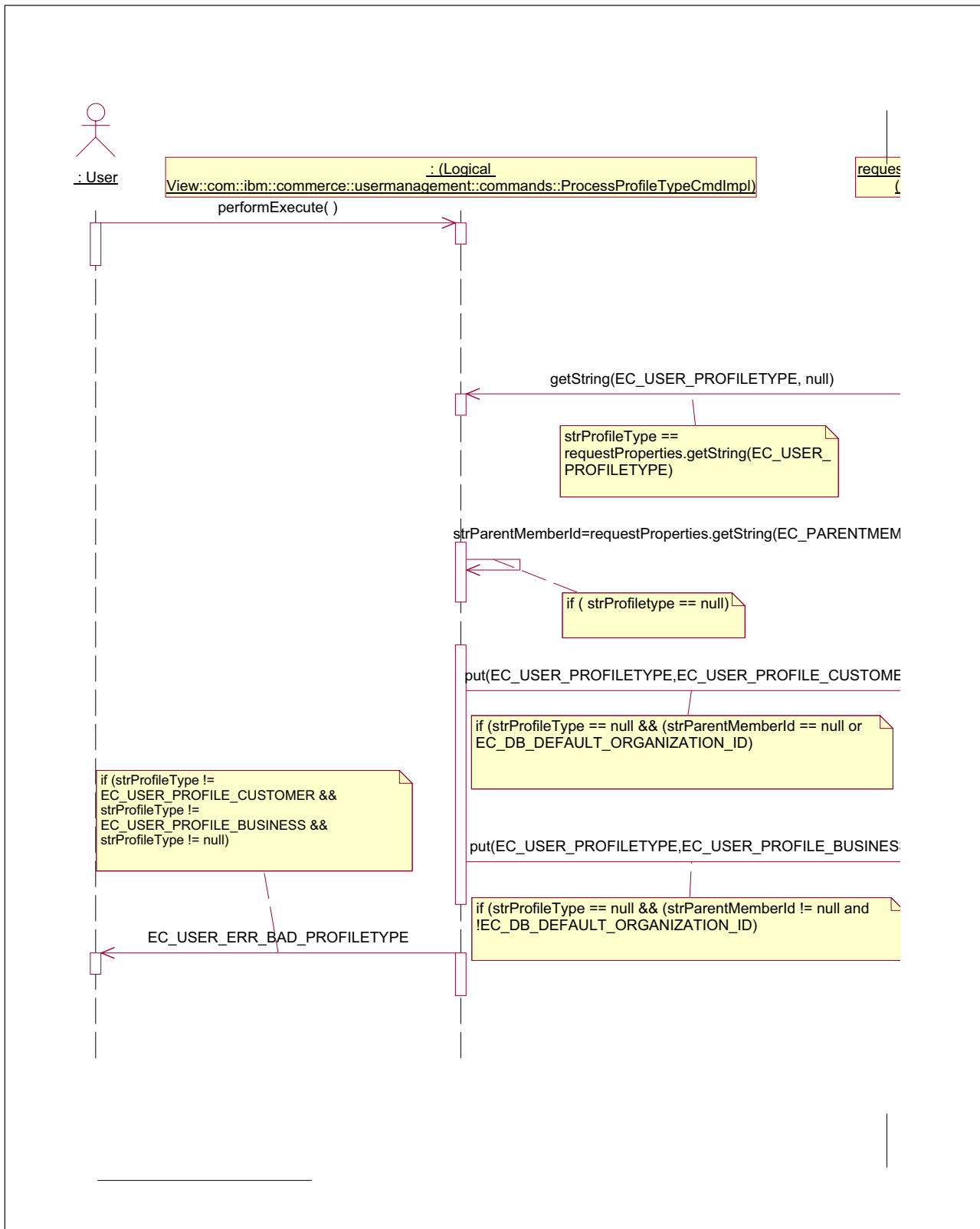


Figure 102. ProcessProfileType sequence diagram, 1 of 2 (1,1)

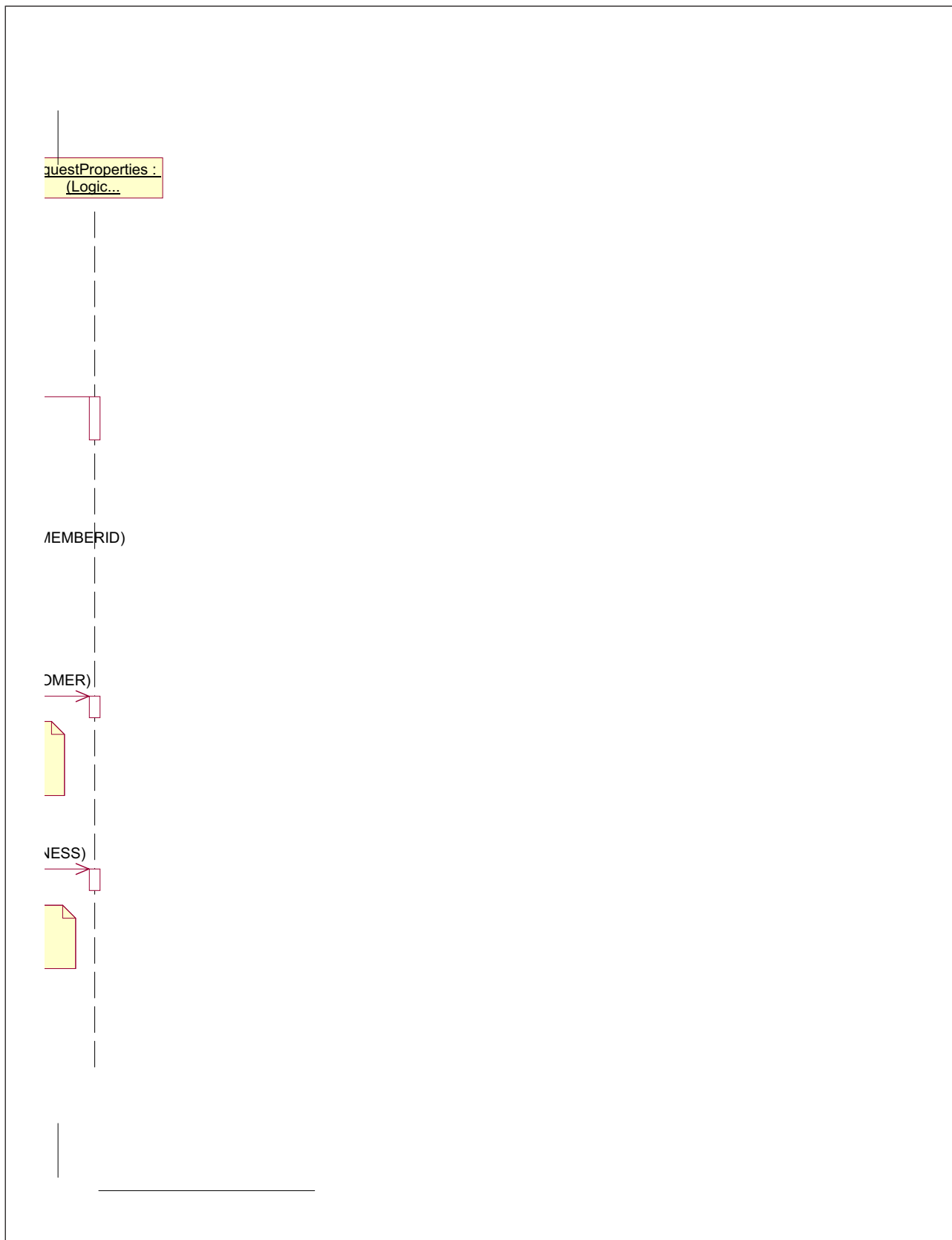


Figure 103. *ProcessProfileType* sequence diagram, 2 of 2 (1,2)

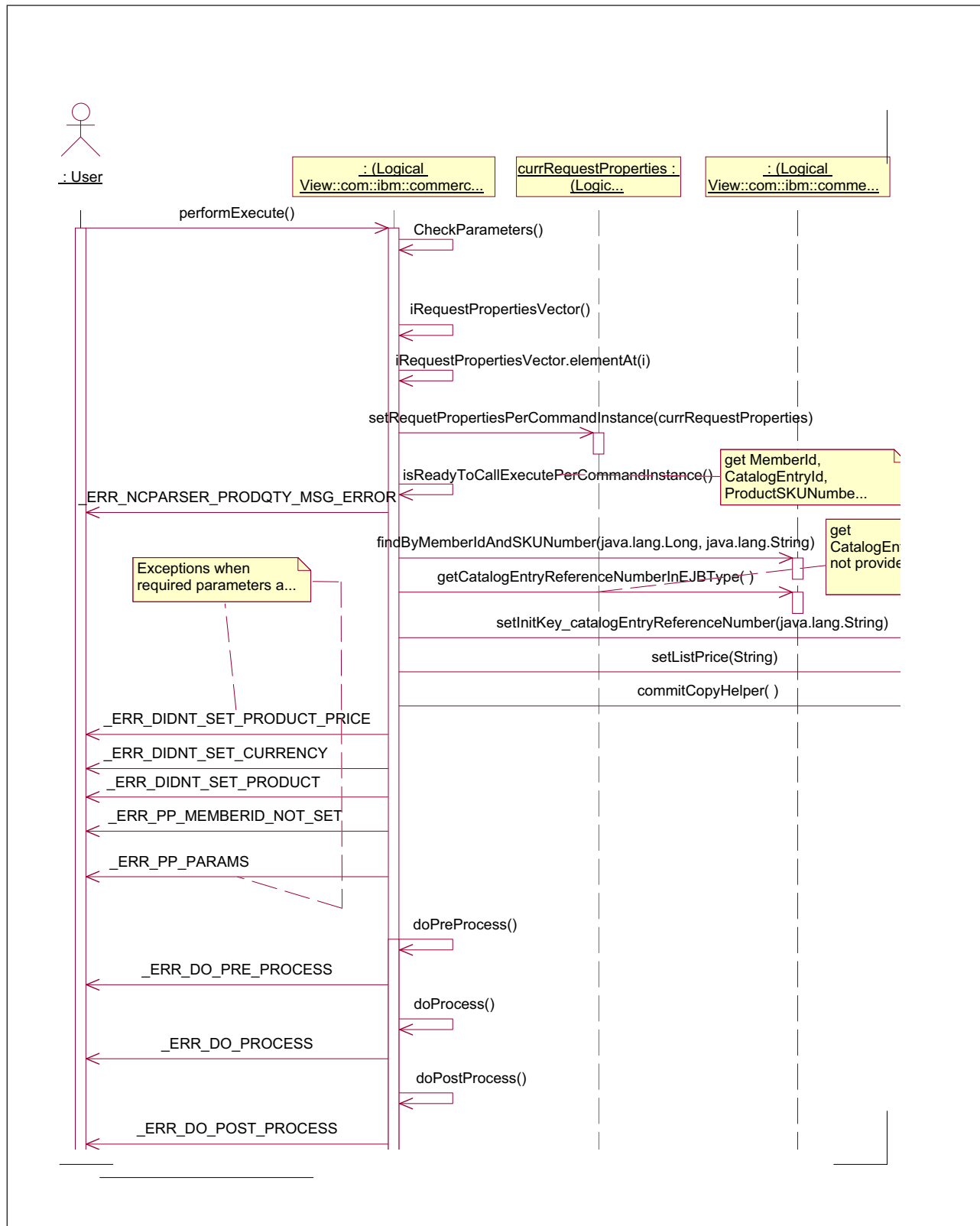


Figure 104. ProductListPriceUpdate sequence diagram, 1 of 26 (1,1)

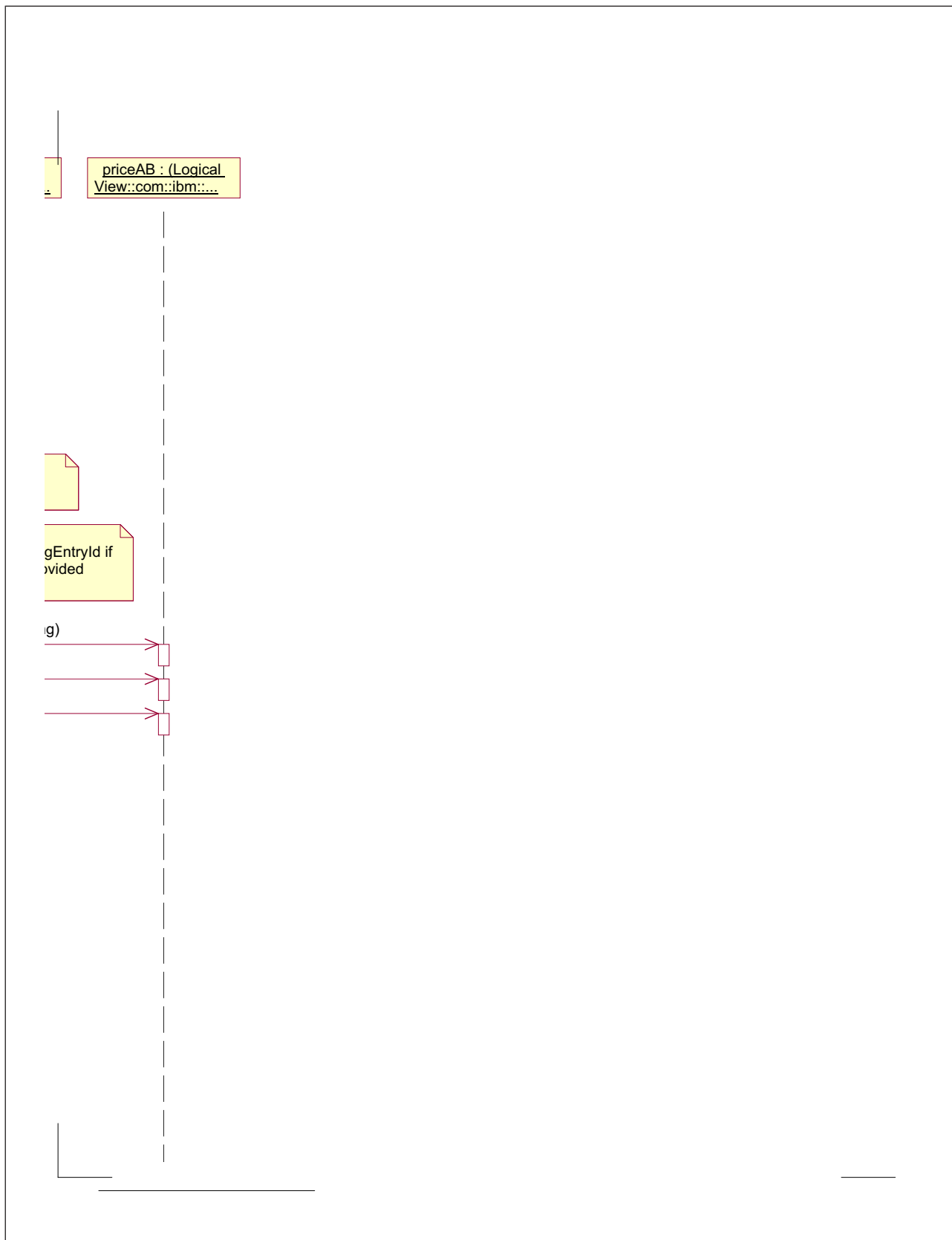
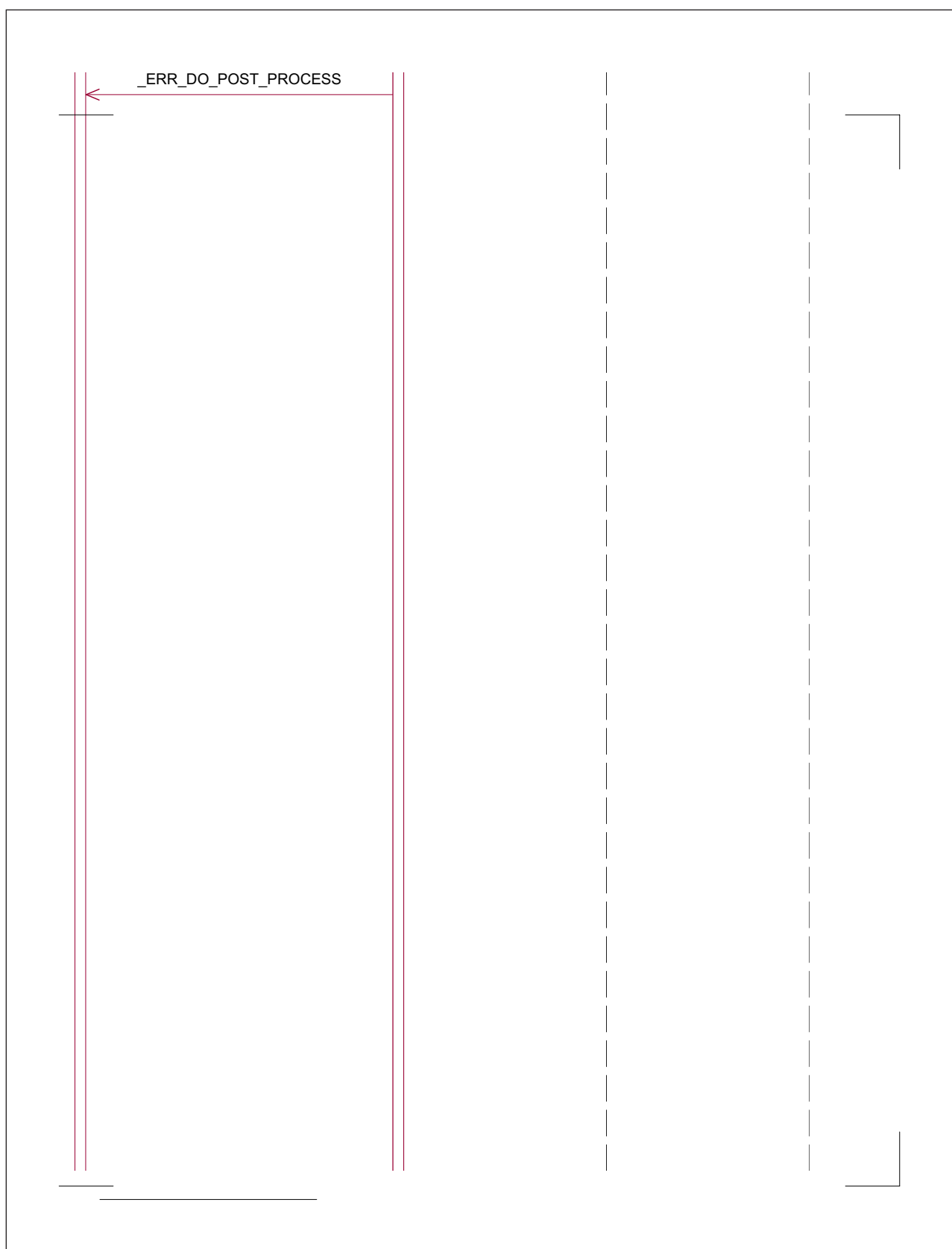


Figure 105. *ProductListPriceUpdate* sequence diagram, 2 of 26 (1,2)



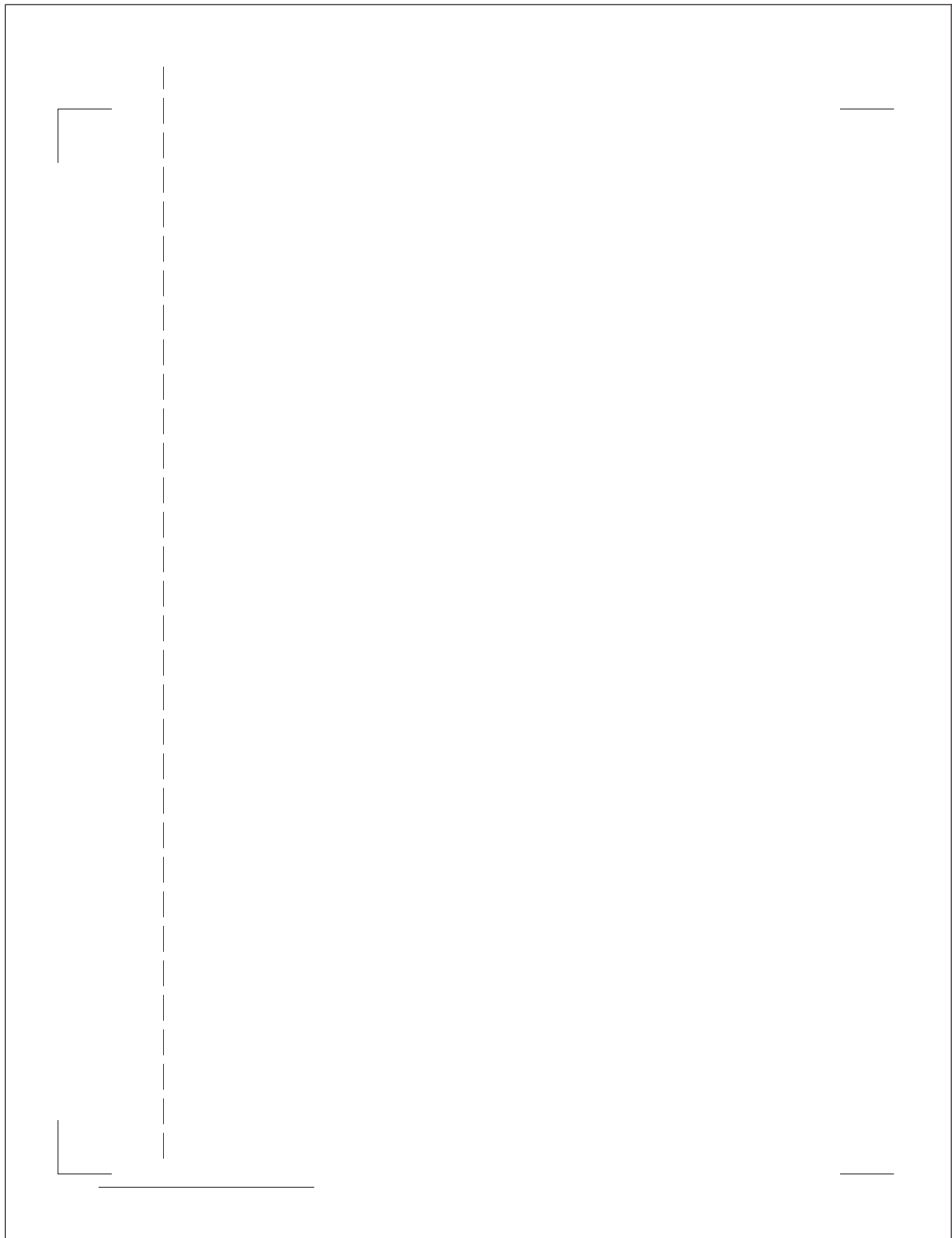


Figure 107. *ProductListPriceUpdate* sequence diagram, 4 of 26 (2,2)

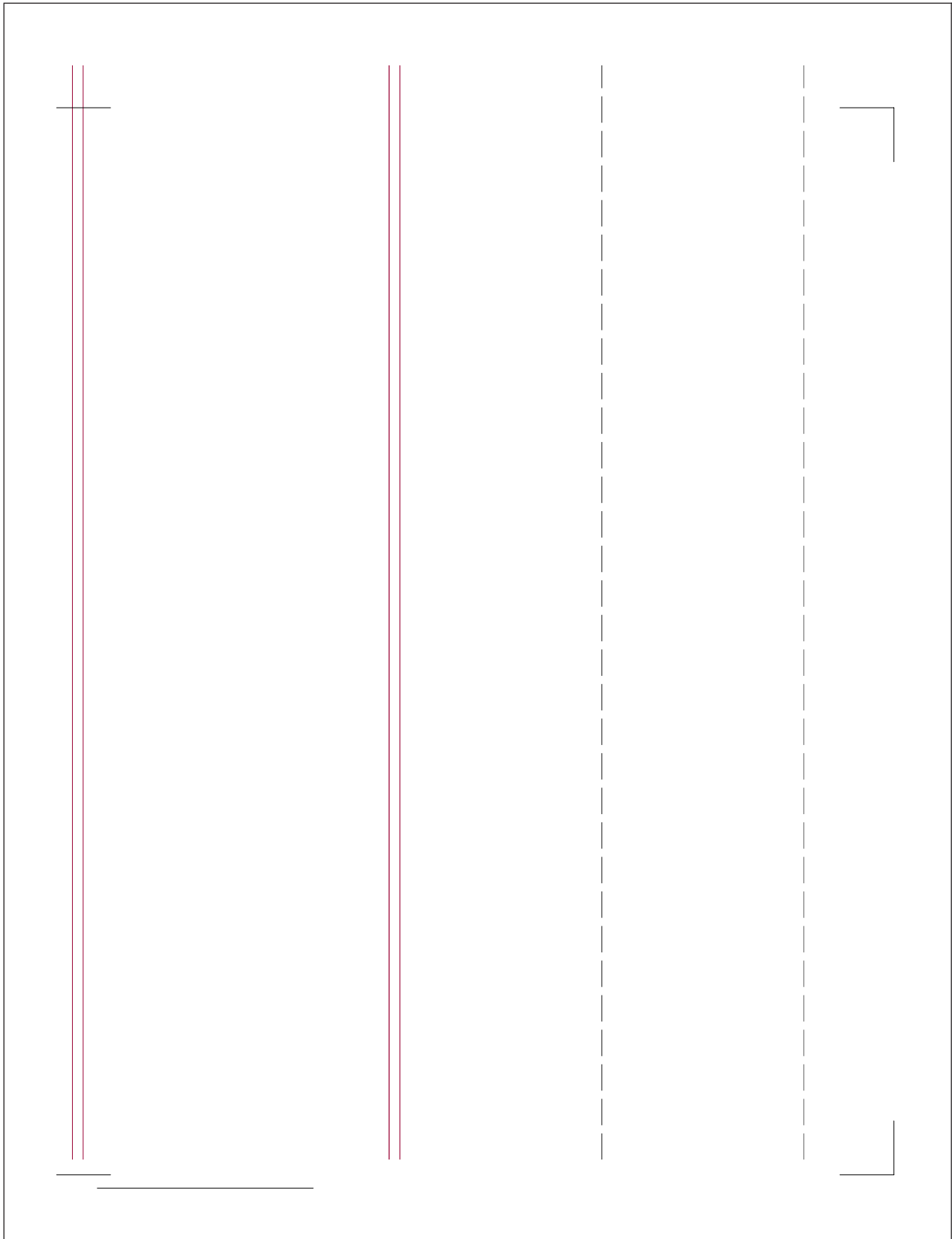


Figure 108. ProductListPriceUpdate sequence diagram, 5 of 26 (3,1)

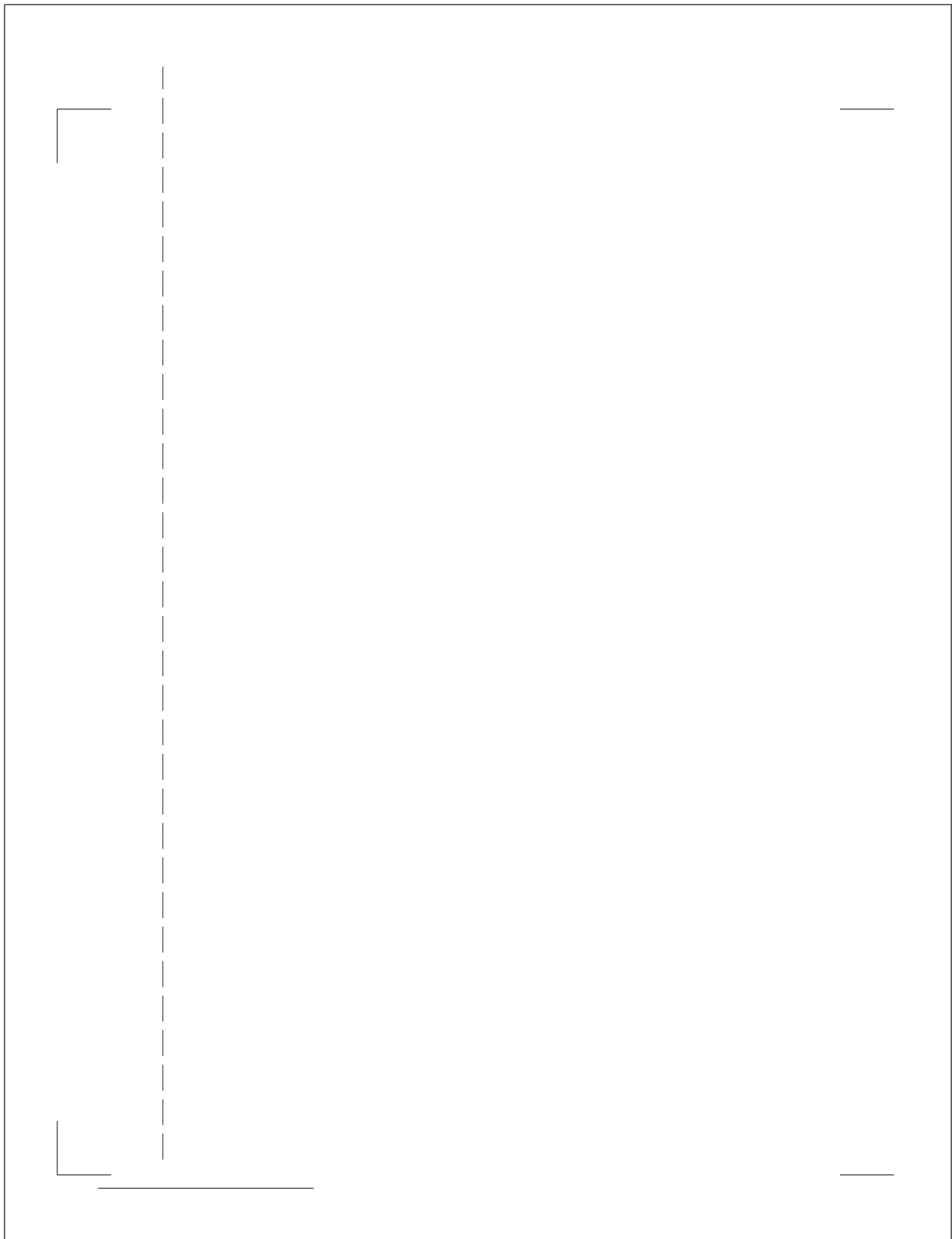


Figure 109. *ProductListPriceUpdate* sequence diagram, 6 of 26 (3,2)

Figure 110. ProductListPriceUpdate sequence diagram, 7 of 26 (4,1)

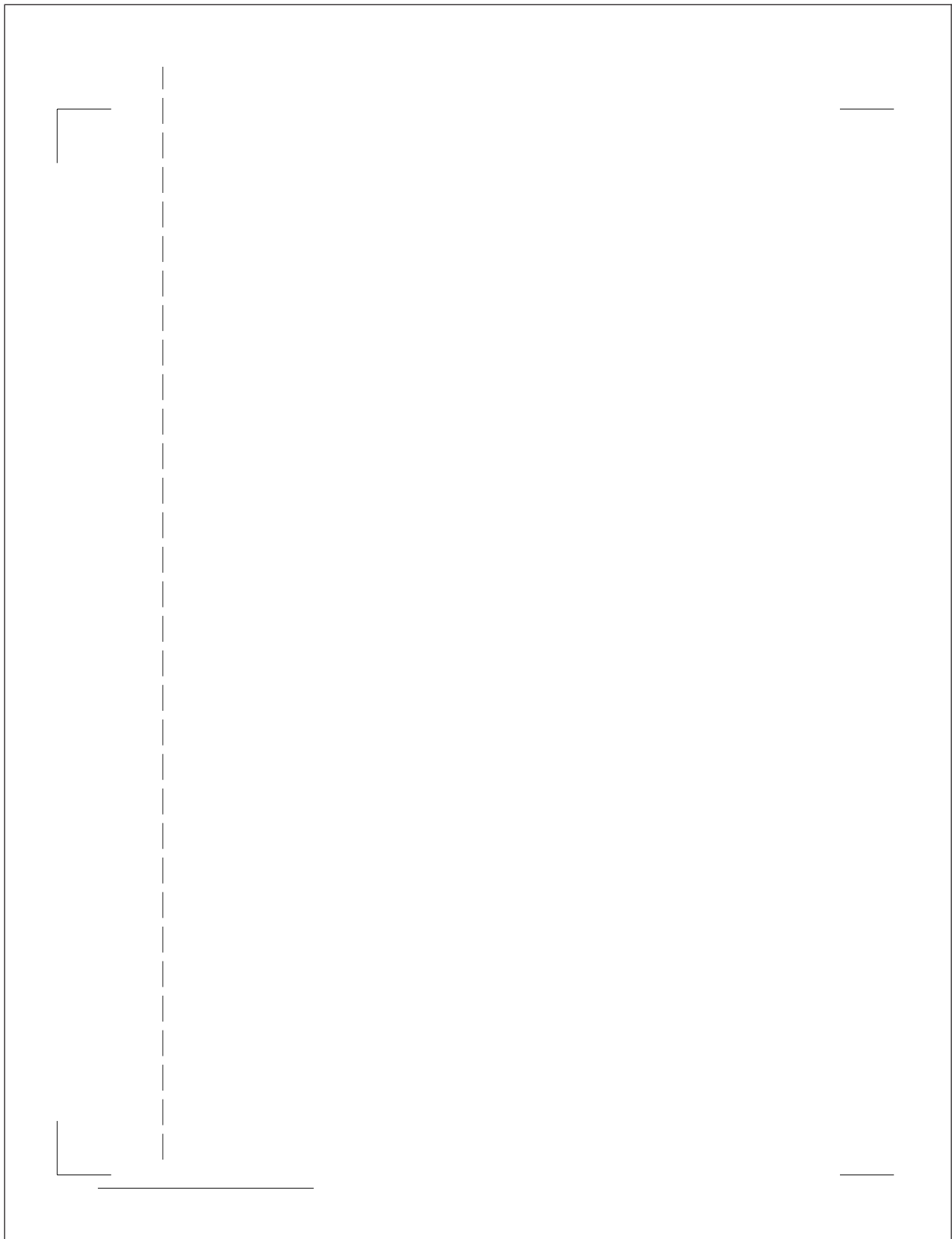


Figure 111. ProductListPriceUpdate sequence diagram, 8 of 26 (4,2)

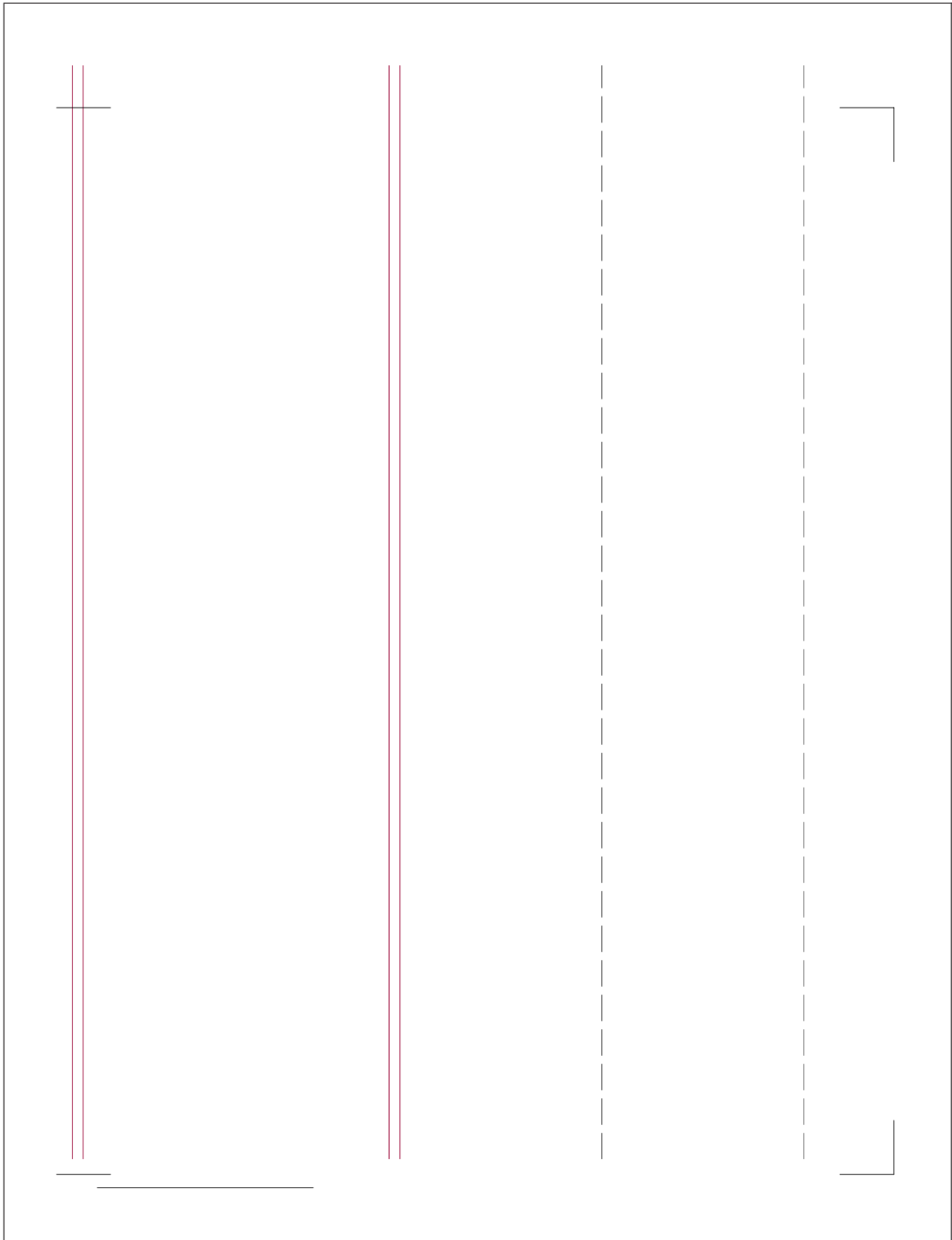


Figure 112. ProductListPriceUpdate sequence diagram, 9 of 26 (5,1)

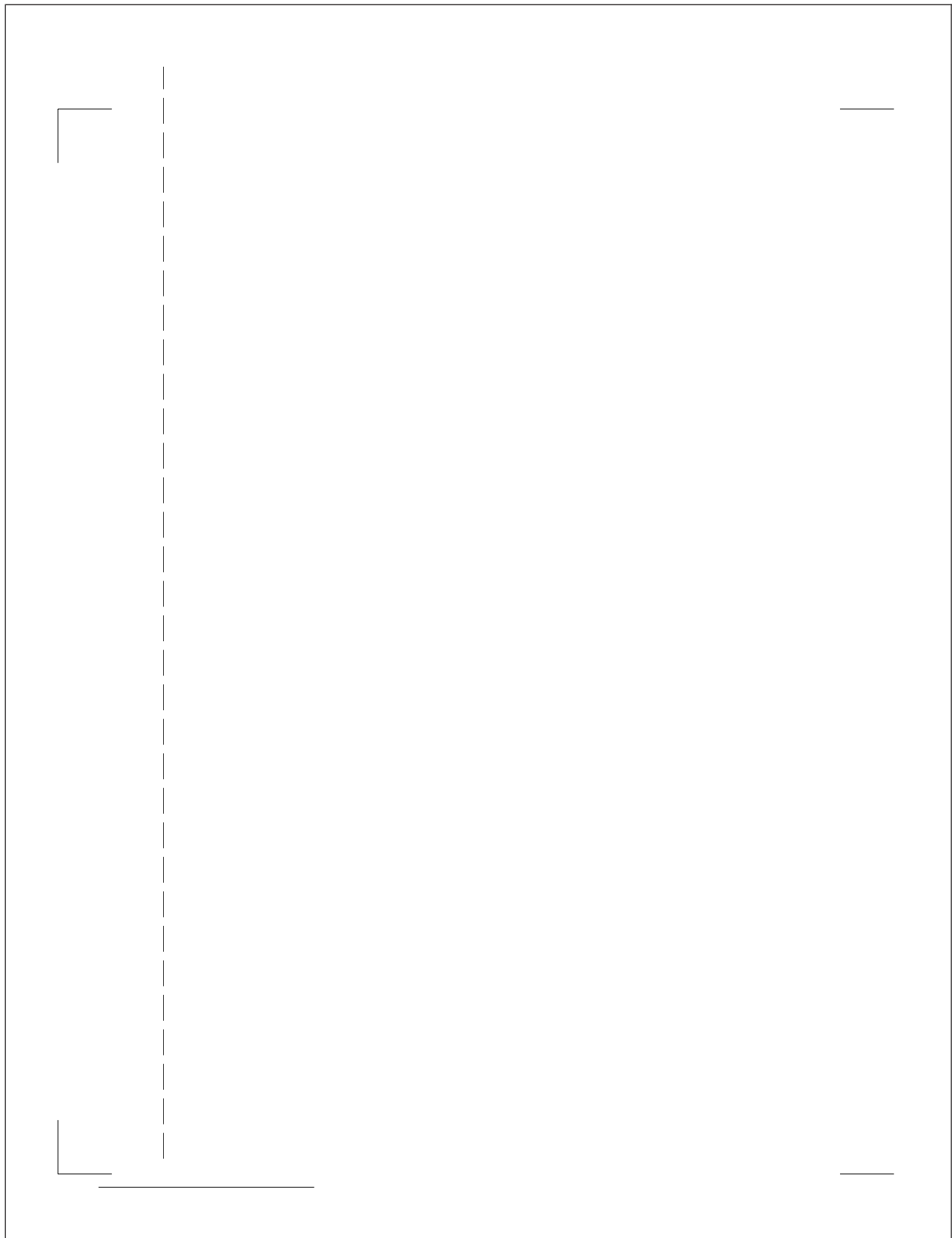


Figure 113. *ProductListPriceUpdate* sequence diagram, 10 of 26 (5,2)

Figure 114. ProductListPriceUpdate sequence diagram, 11 of 26 (6,1)

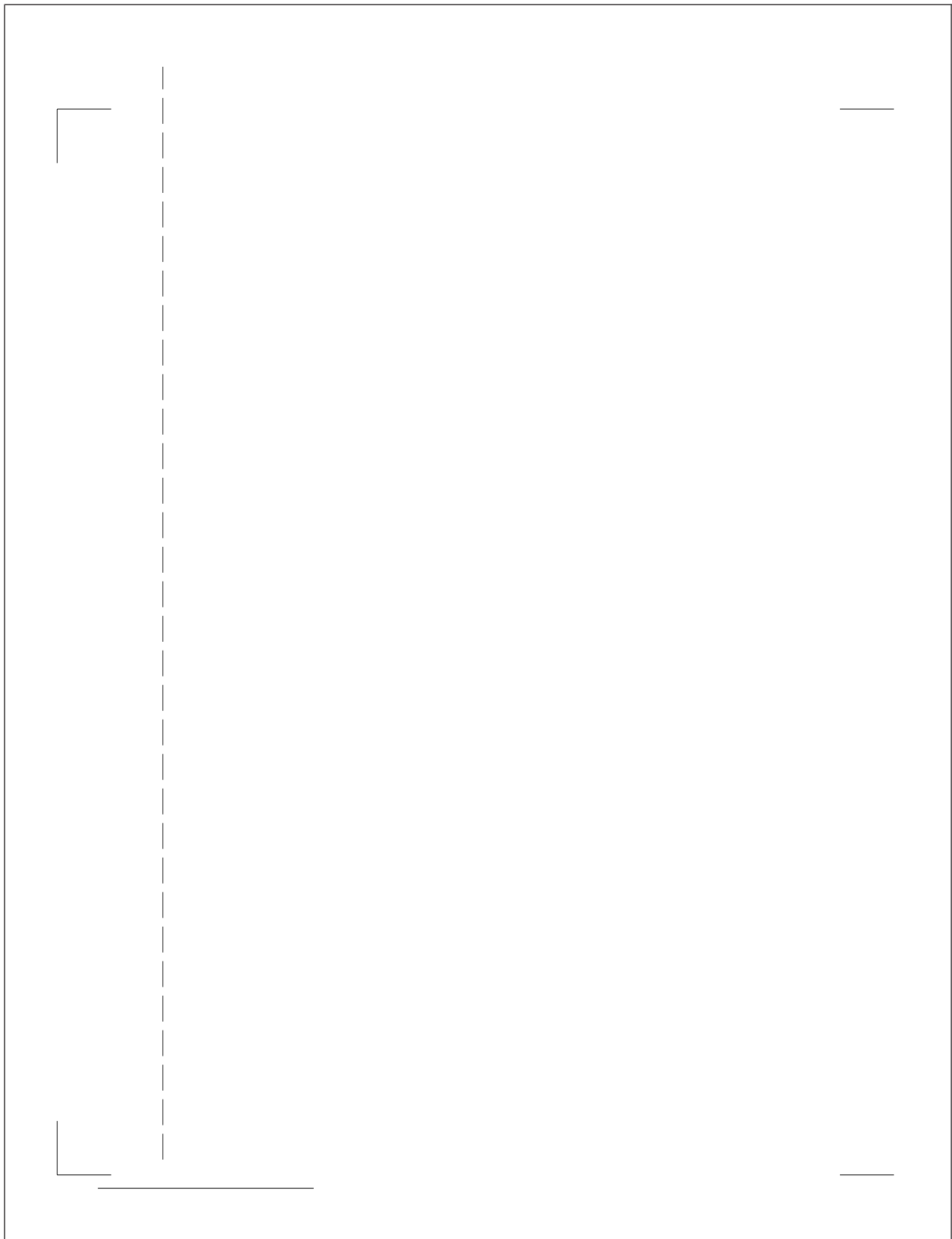


Figure 115. *ProductListPriceUpdate* sequence diagram, 12 of 26 (6,2)

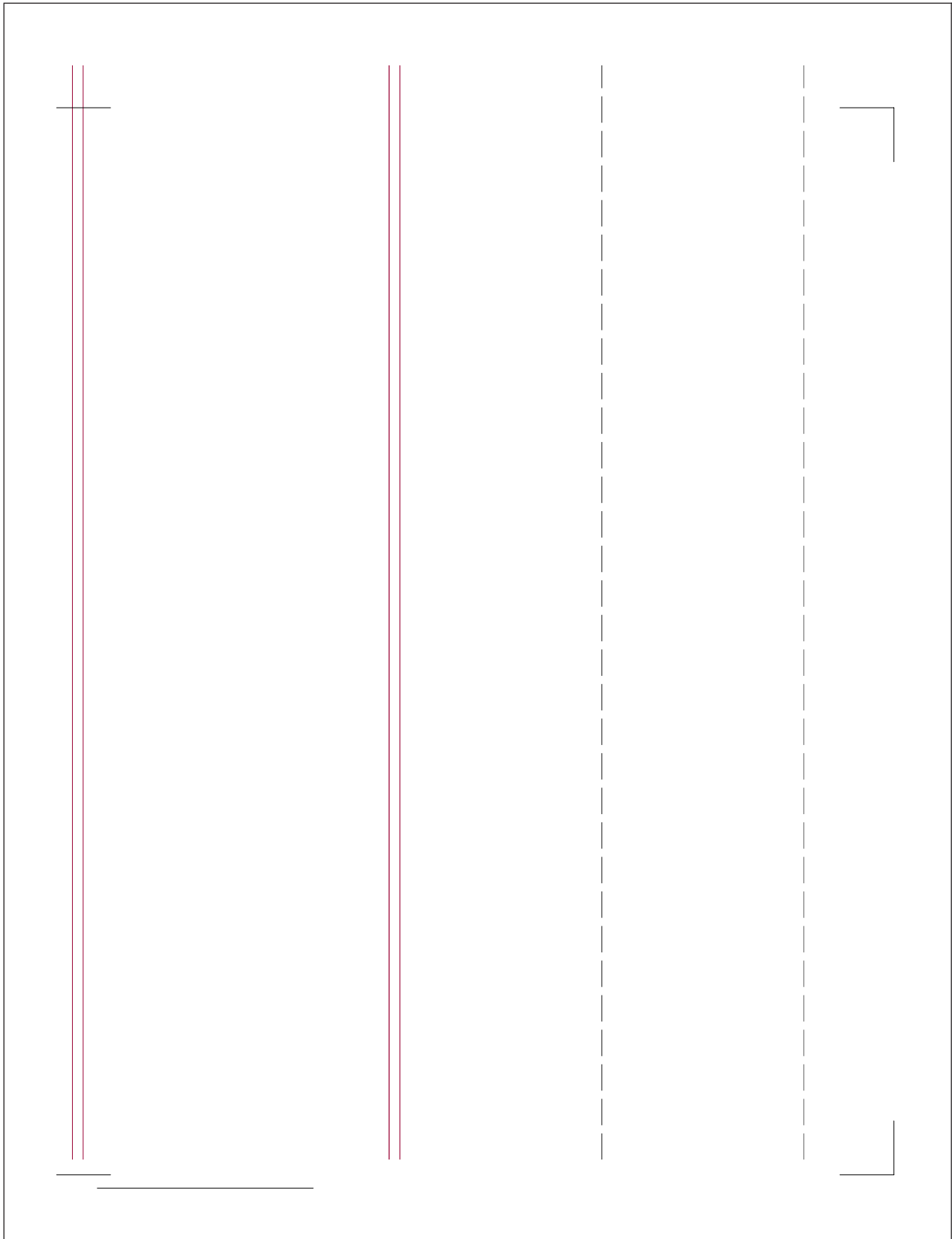


Figure 116. *ProductListPriceUpdate* sequence diagram, 13 of 26 (7,1)

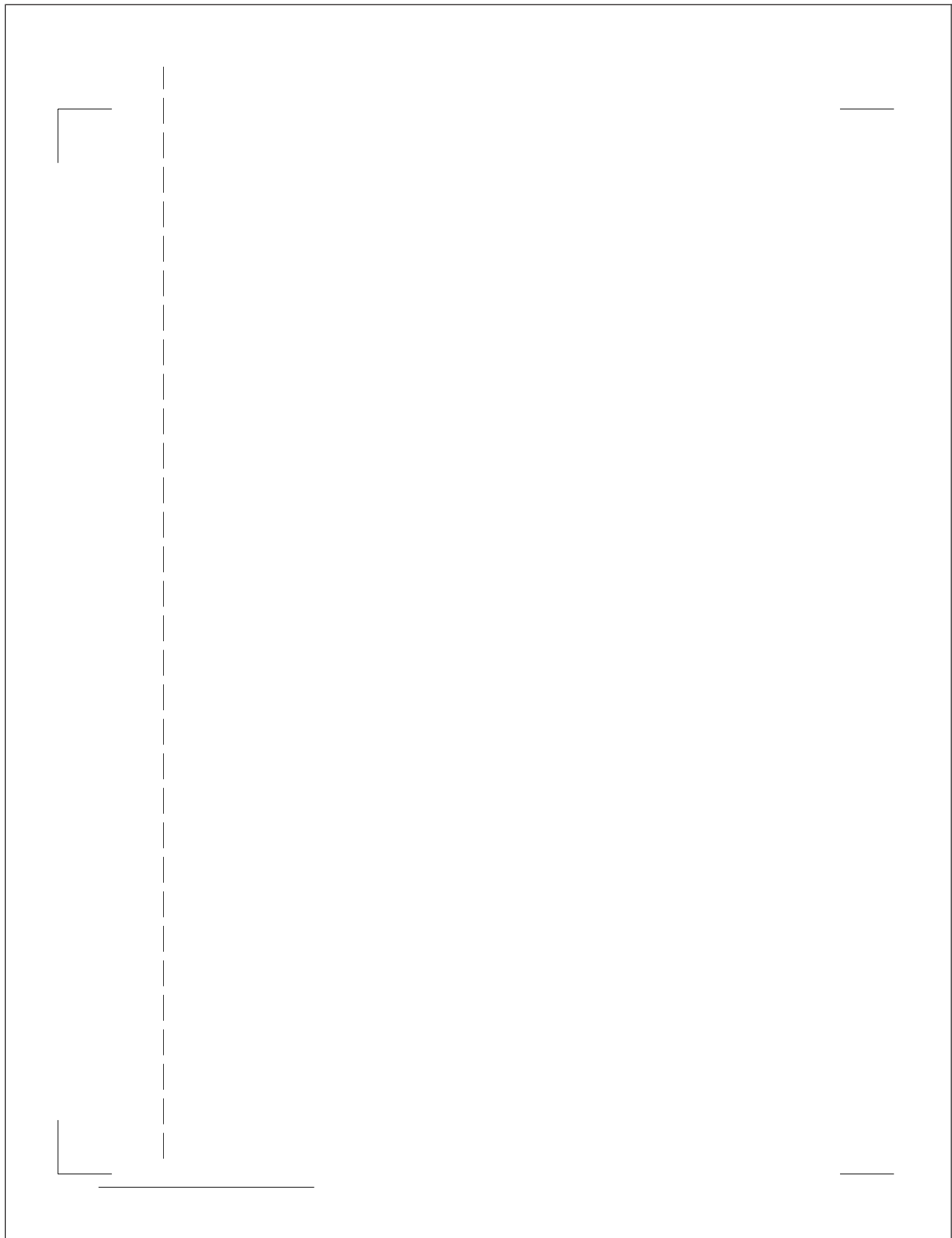


Figure 117. ProductListPriceUpdate sequence diagram, 14 of 26 (7,2)

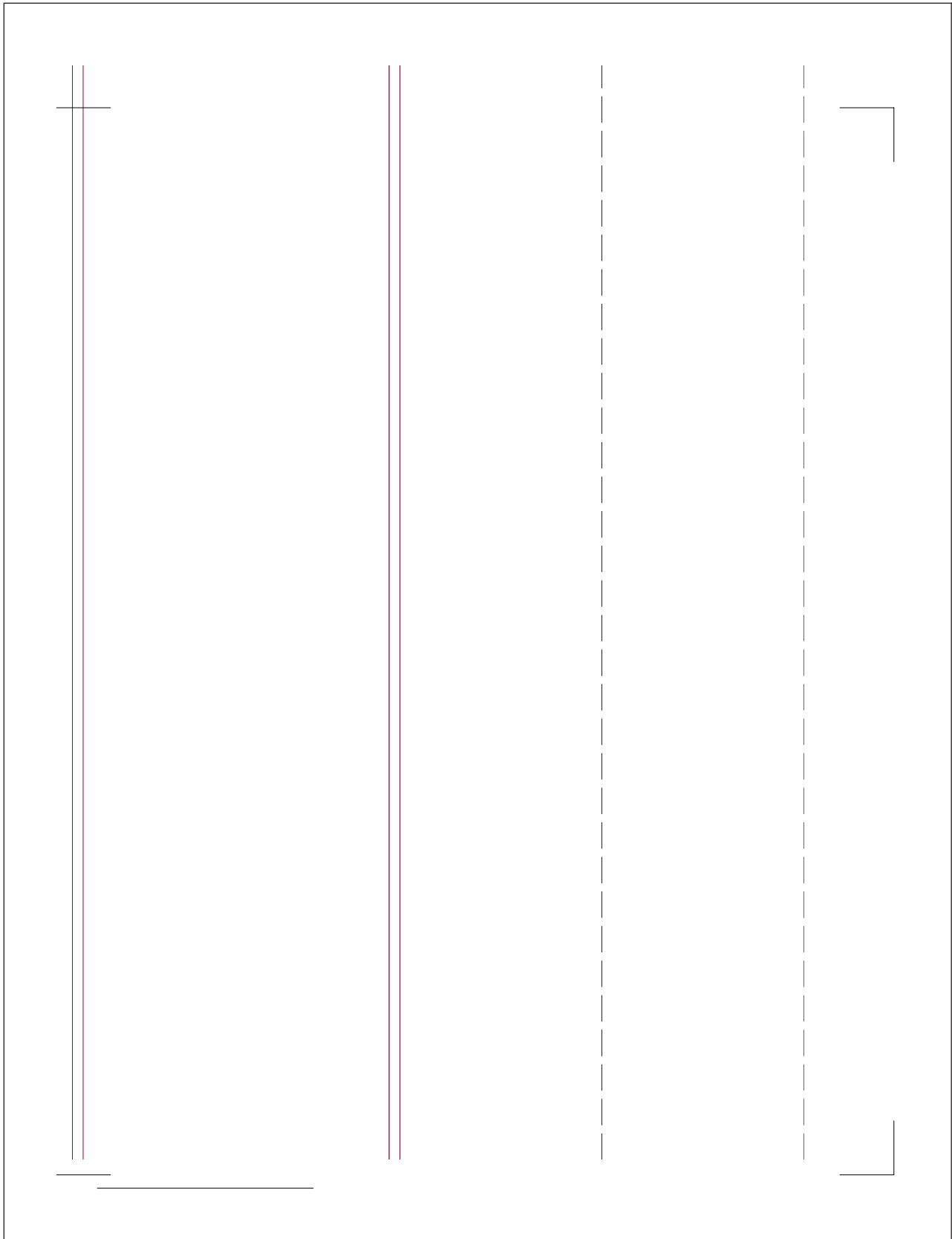


Figure 118. ProductListPriceUpdate sequence diagram, 15 of 26 (8,1)

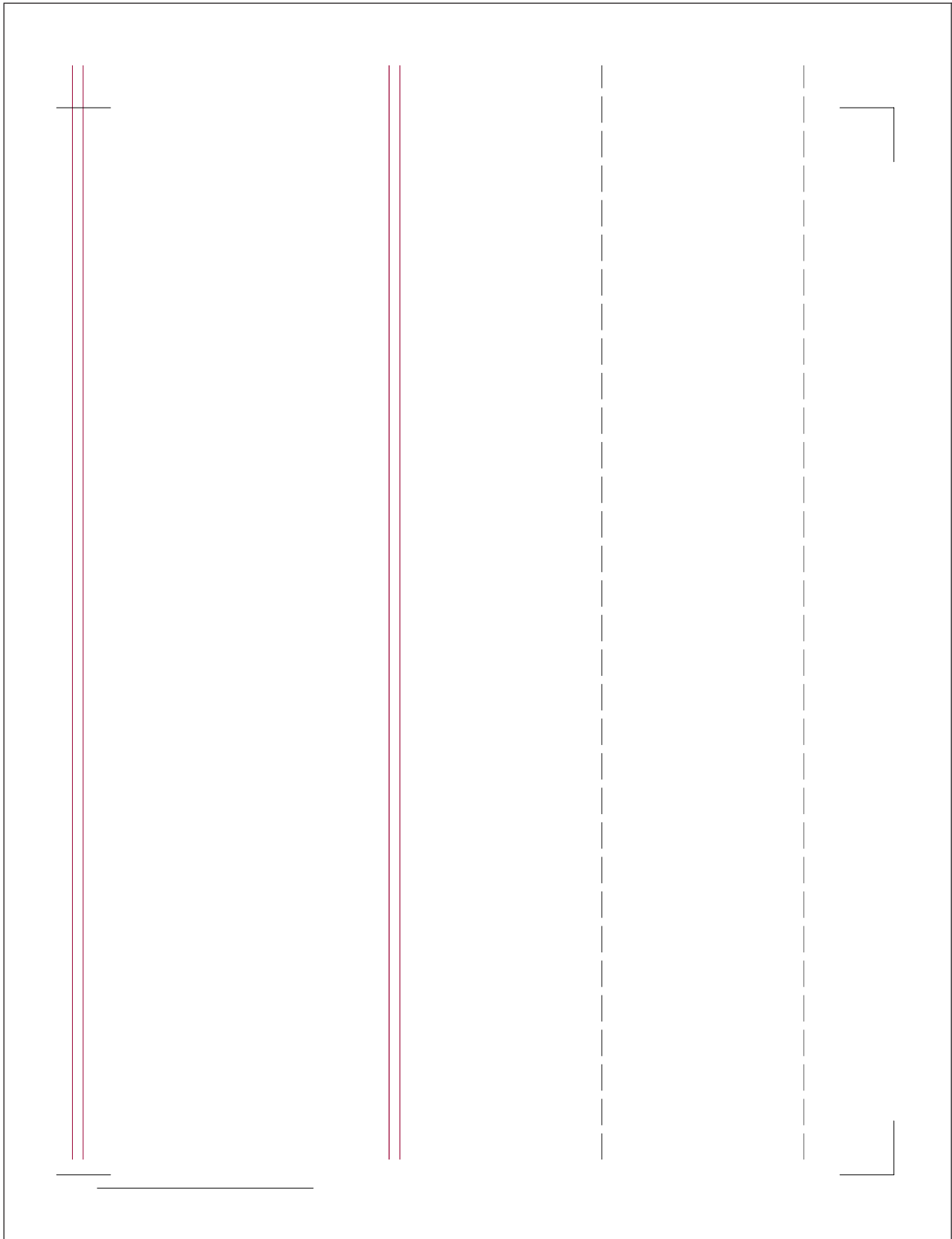


Figure 120. ProductListPriceUpdate sequence diagram, 17 of 26 (9,1)

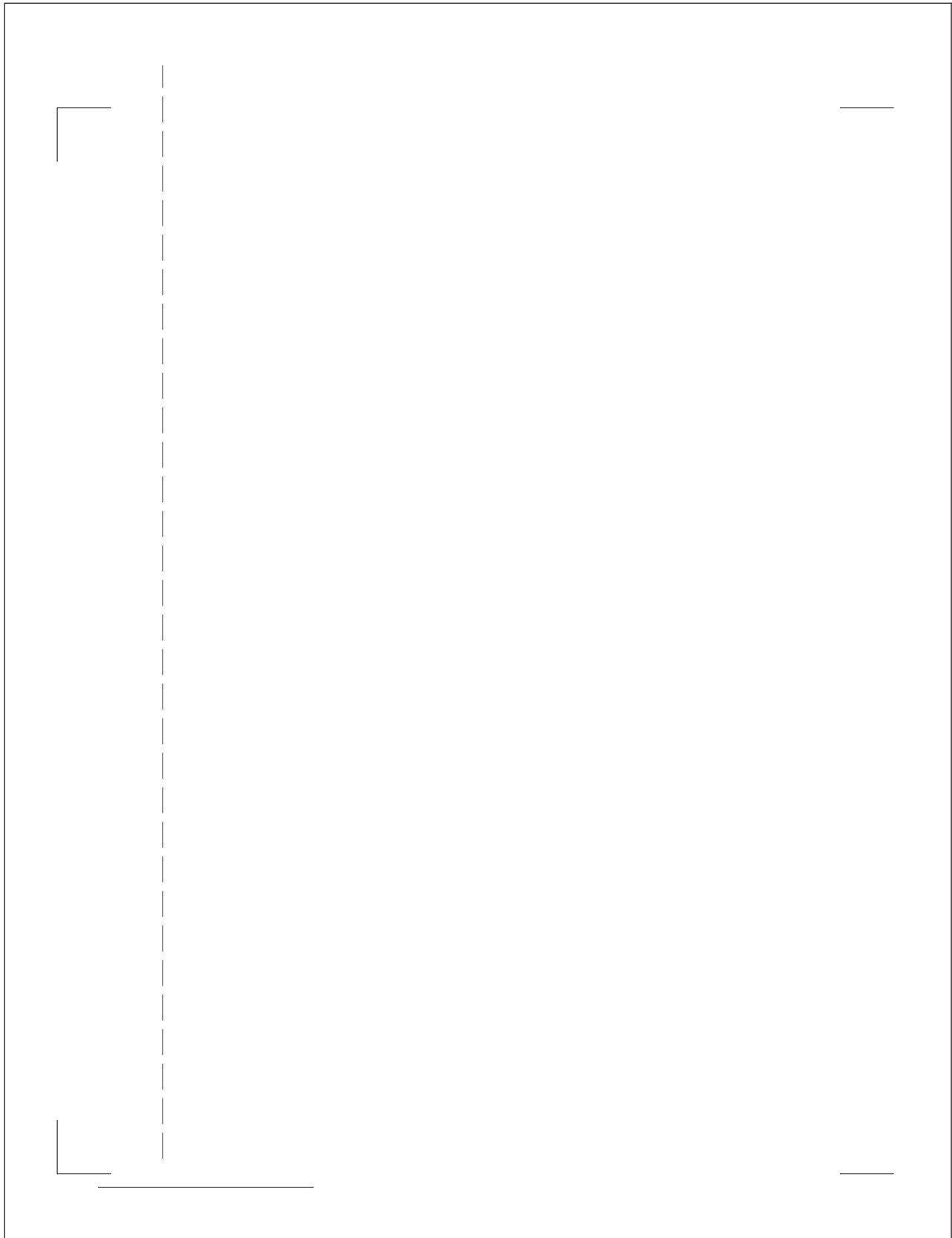


Figure 121. *ProductListPriceUpdate* sequence diagram, 18 of 26 (9,2)

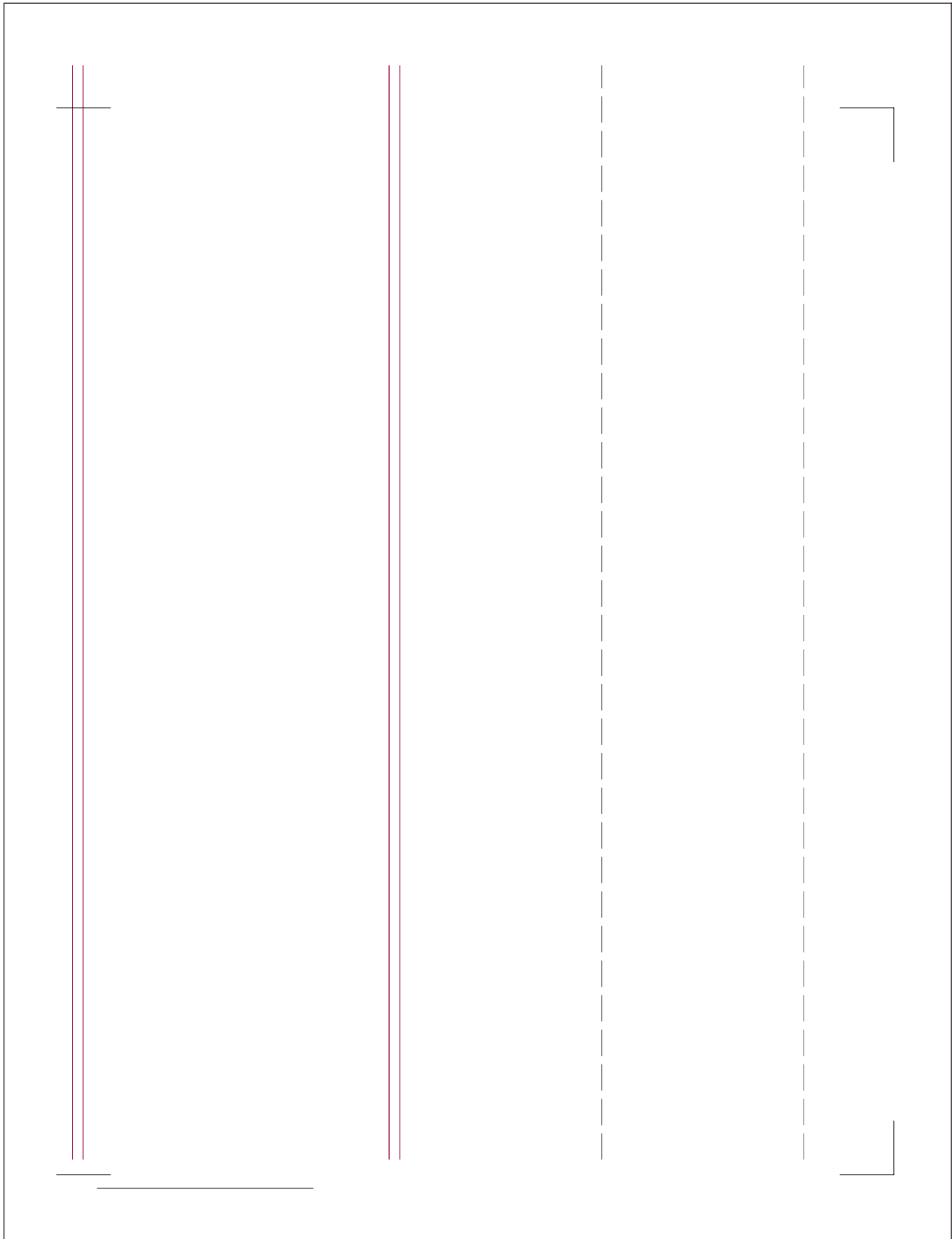


Figure 122. *ProductListPriceUpdate* sequence diagram, 17 of 26 (9,1)

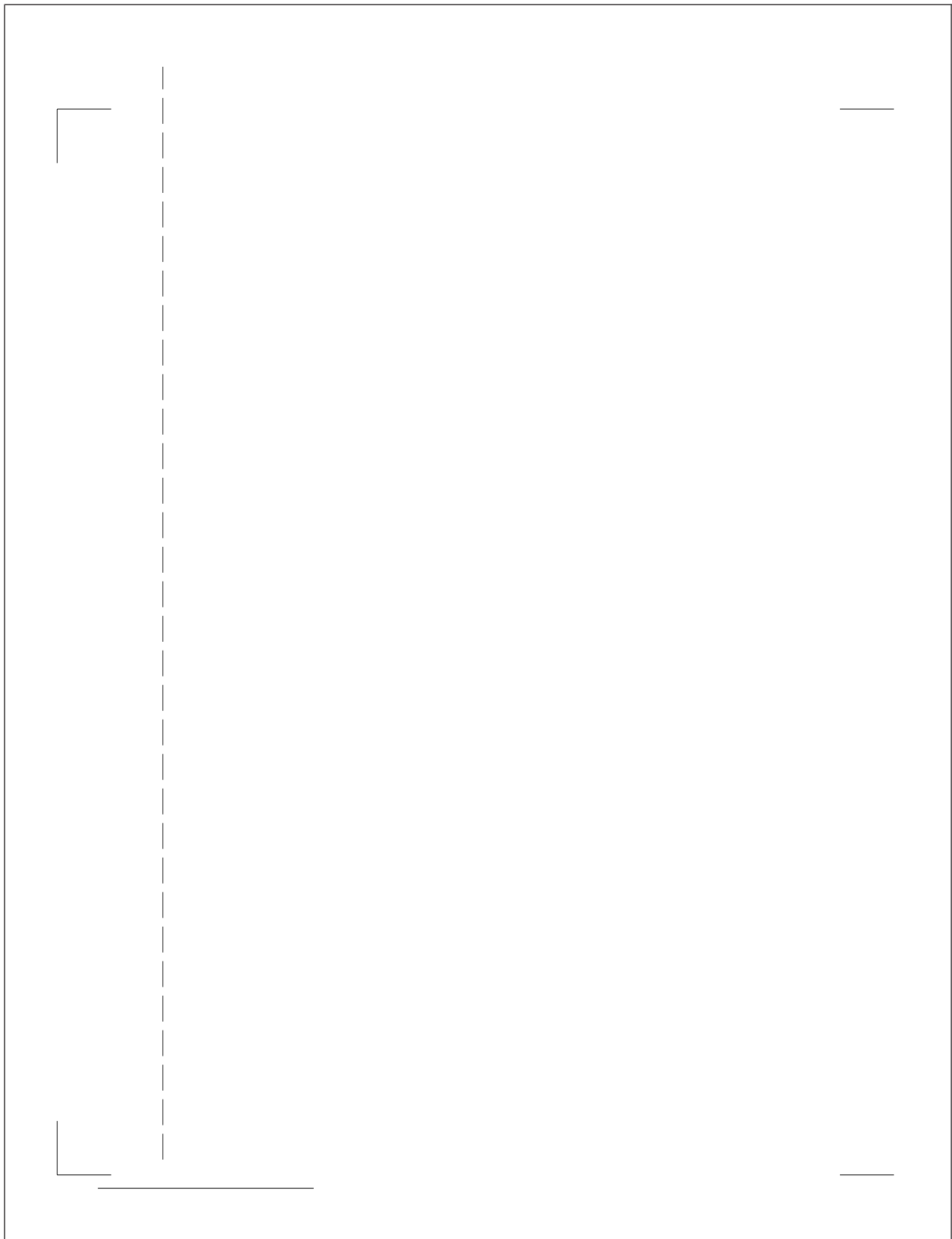


Figure 123. *ProductListPriceUpdate* sequence diagram, 18 of 26 (9,2)

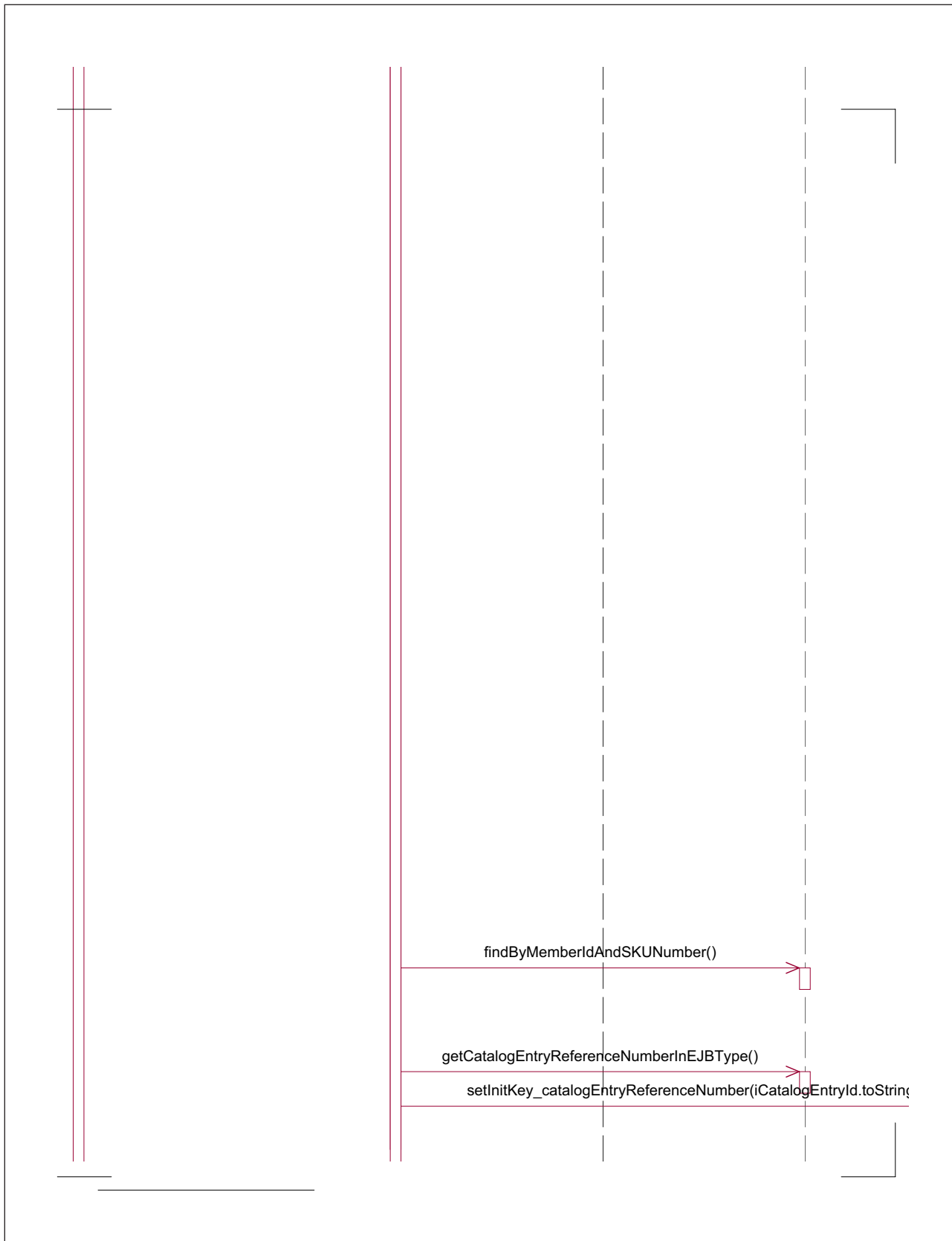


Figure 124. *ProductListPriceUpdate* sequence diagram, 19 of 26 (10,1)

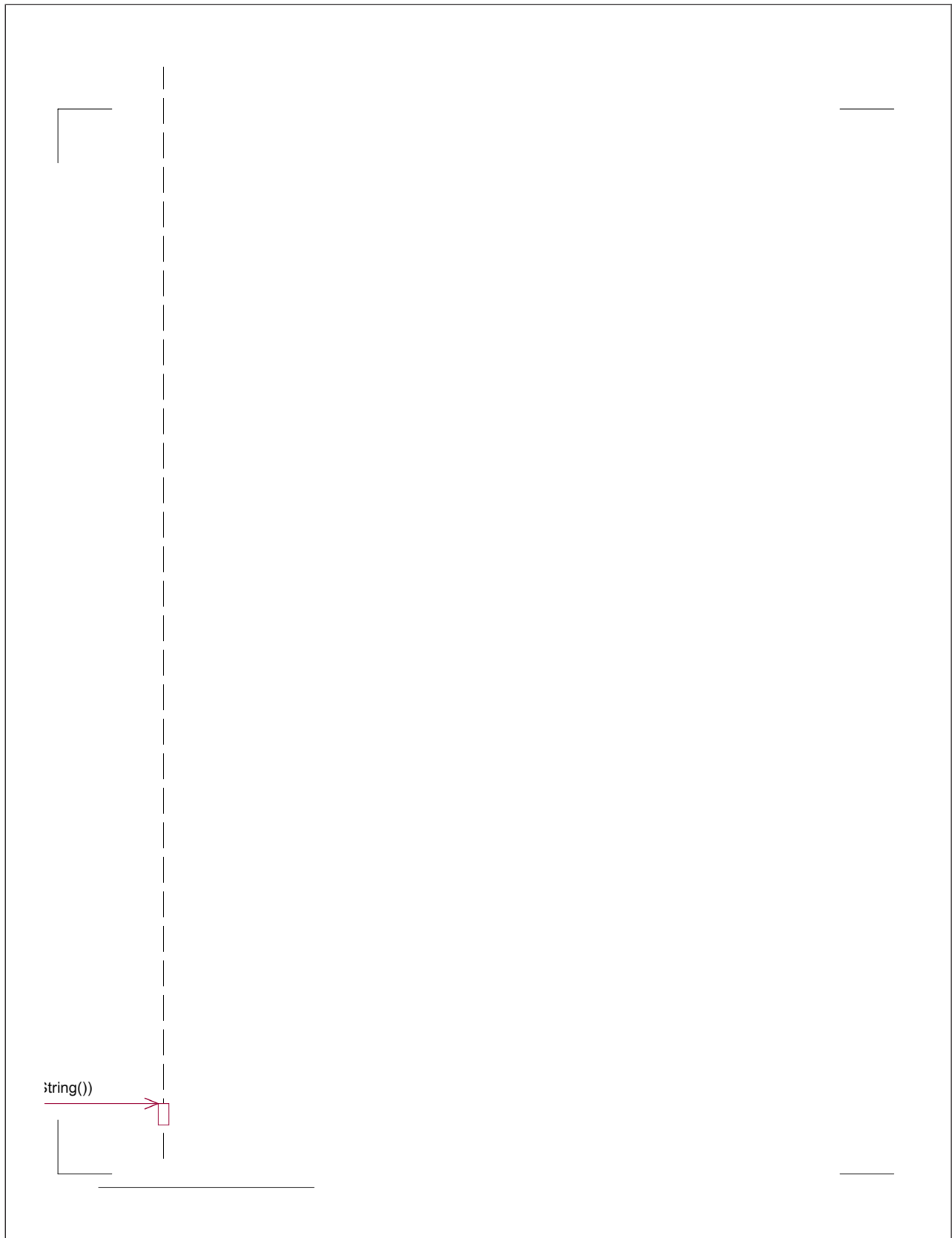


Figure 125. *ProductListPriceUpdate* sequence diagram, 20 of 26 (10,2)

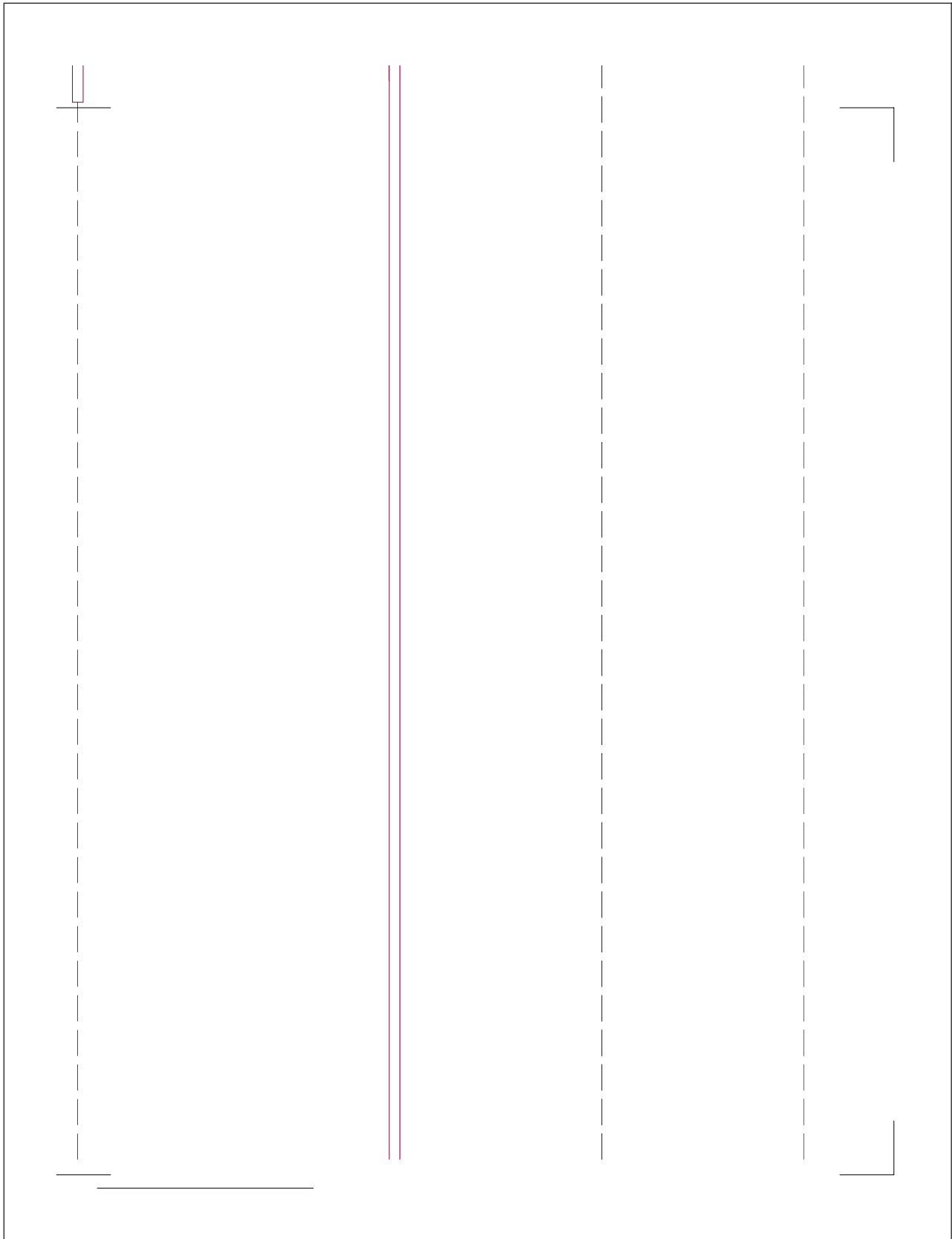


Figure 126. ProductListPriceUpdate sequence diagram, 21 of 26 (11,1)

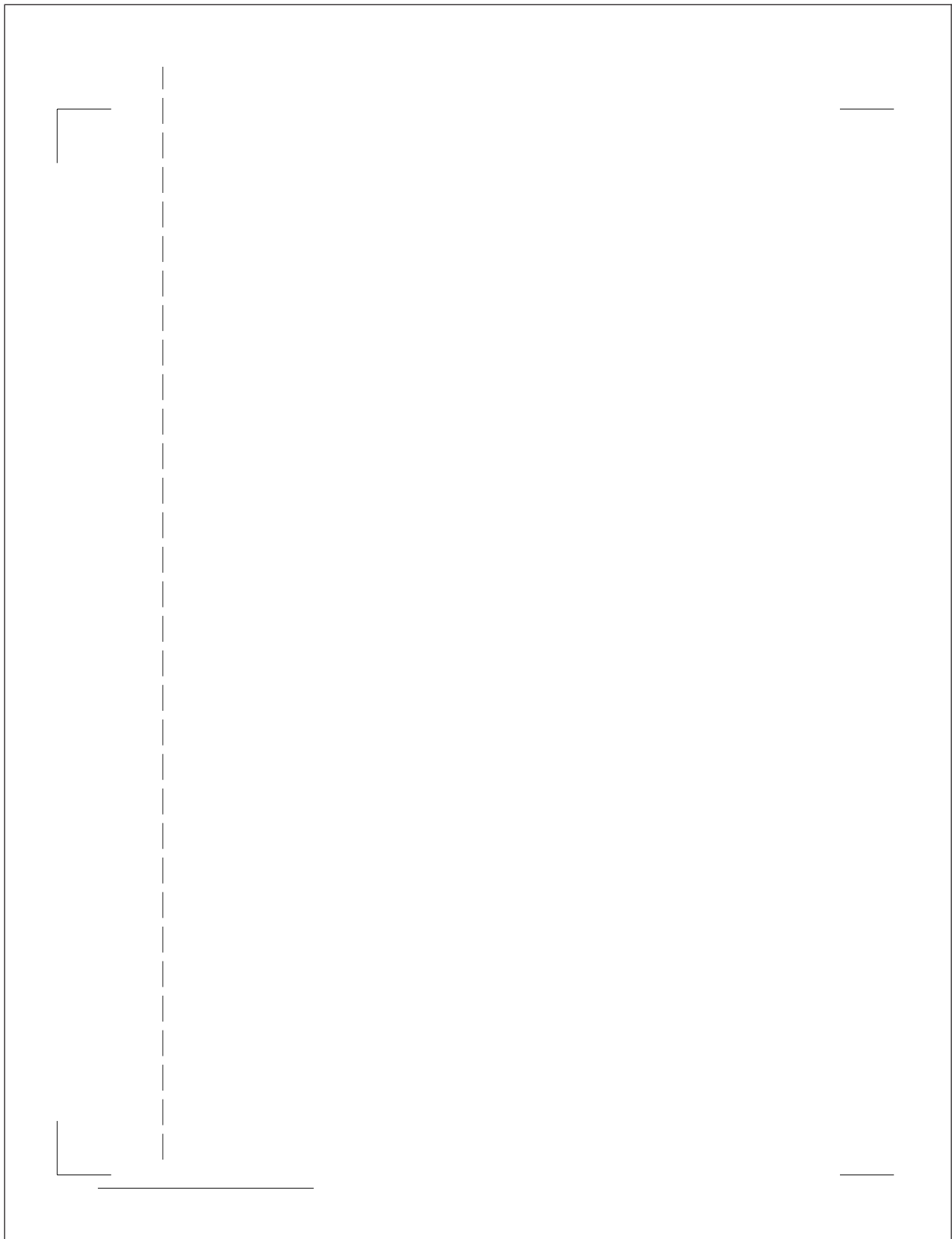


Figure 127. *ProductListPriceUpdate* sequence diagram, 22 of 26 (11,2)

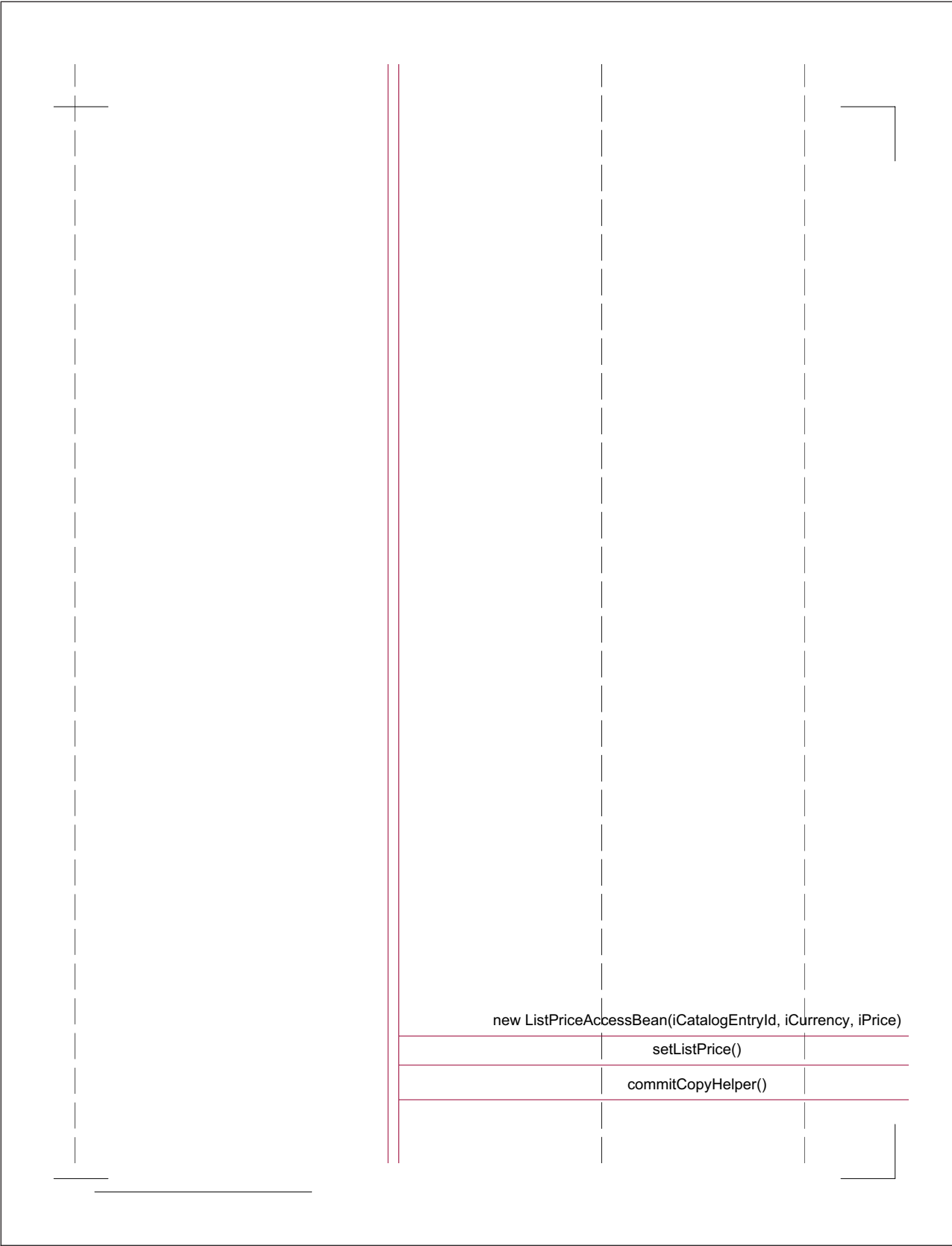


Figure 128. ProductListPriceUpdate sequence diagram, 23 of 26 (12,1)

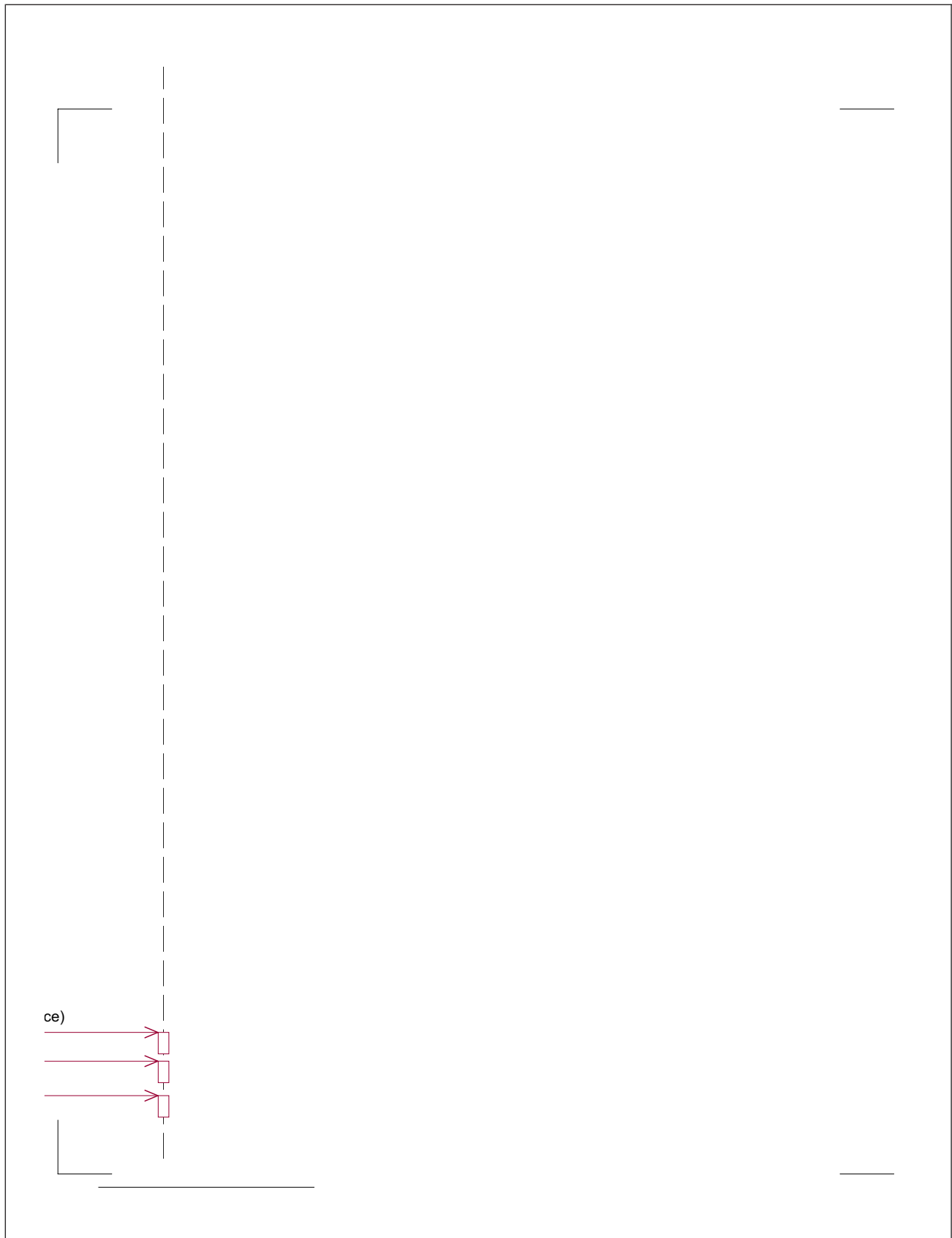


Figure 129. *ProductListPriceUpdate* sequence diagram, 24 of 26 (12,2)

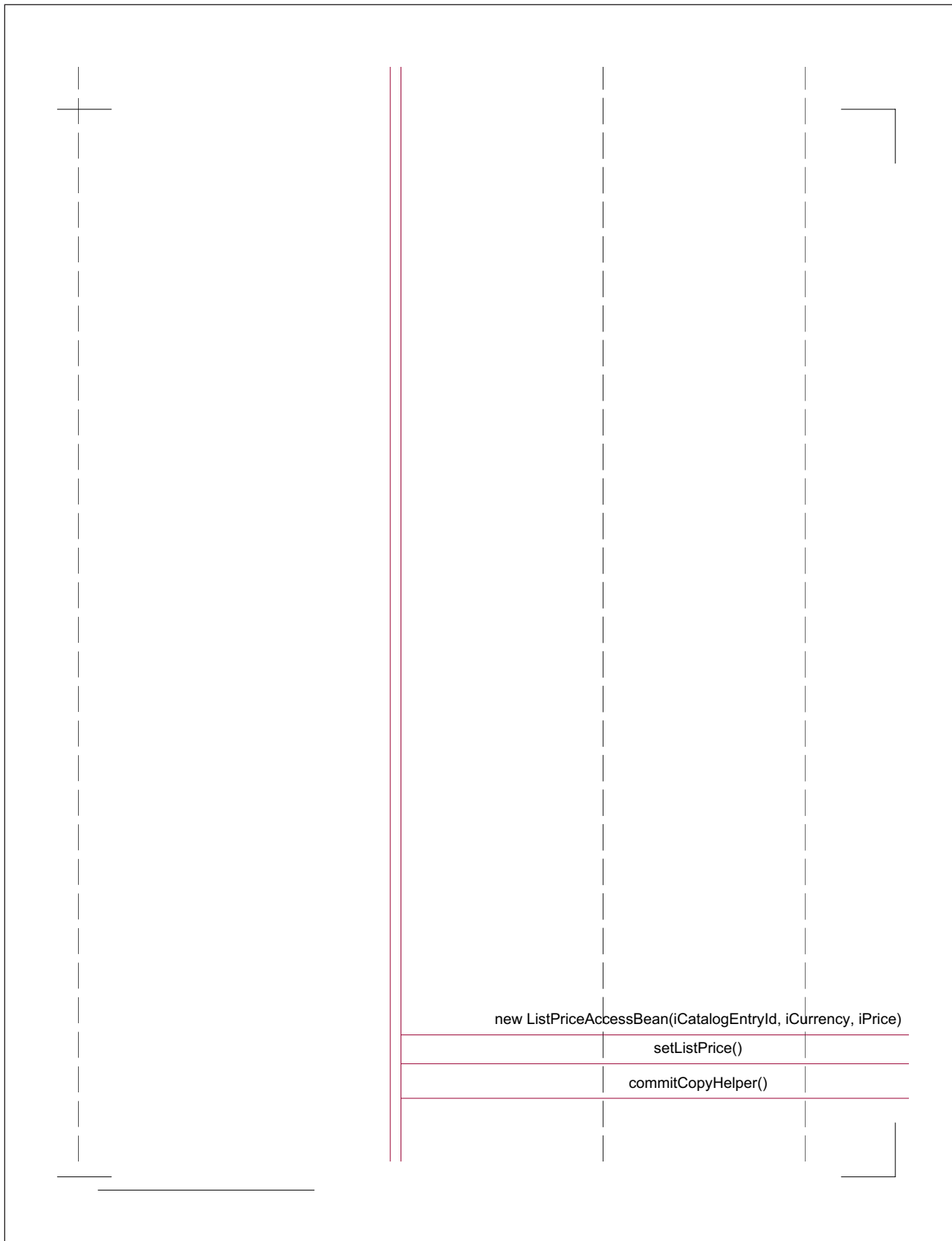


Figure 130. ProductListPriceUpdate sequence diagram, 23 of 26 (12,1)

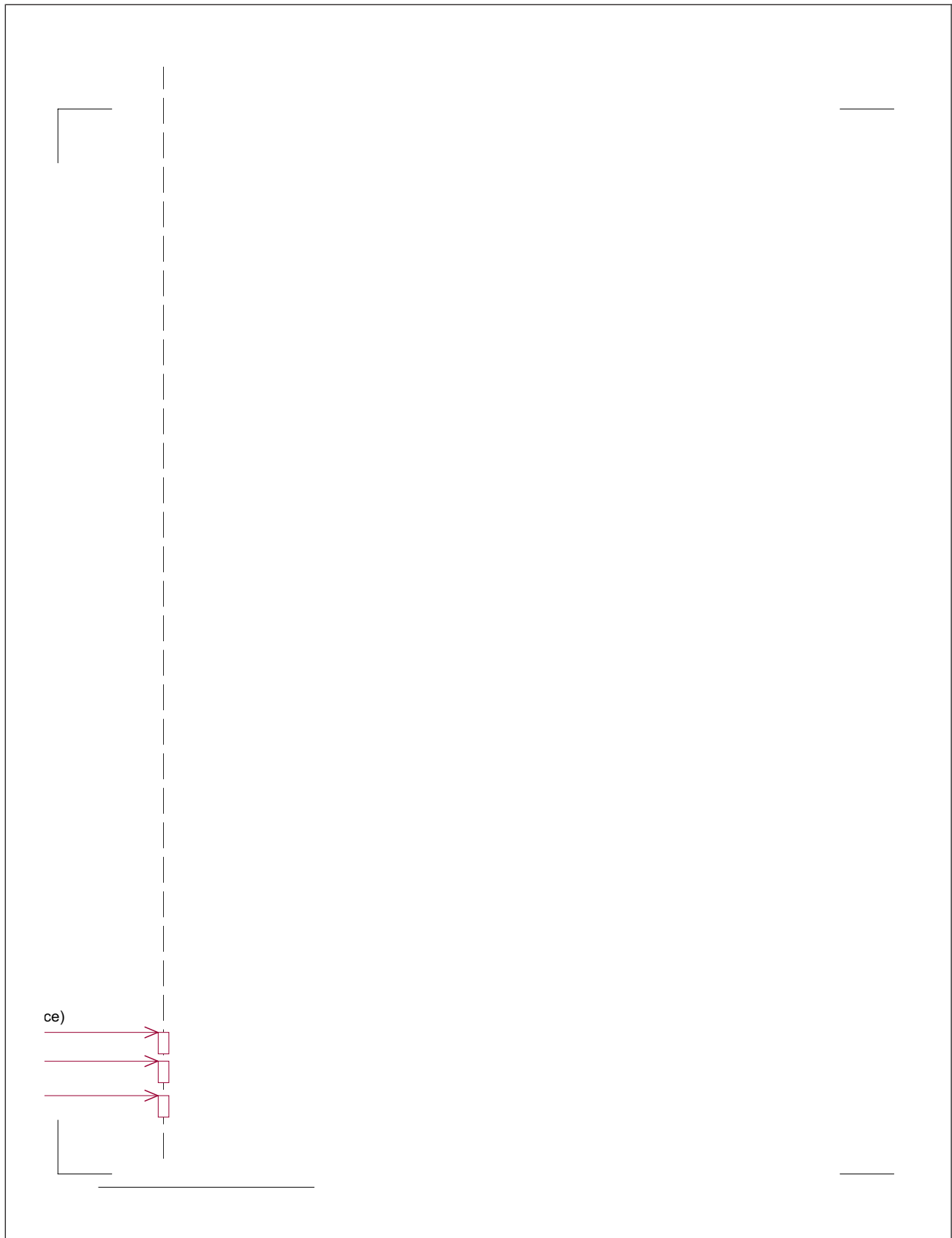


Figure 131. *ProductListPriceUpdate* sequence diagram, 24 of 26 (12,2)

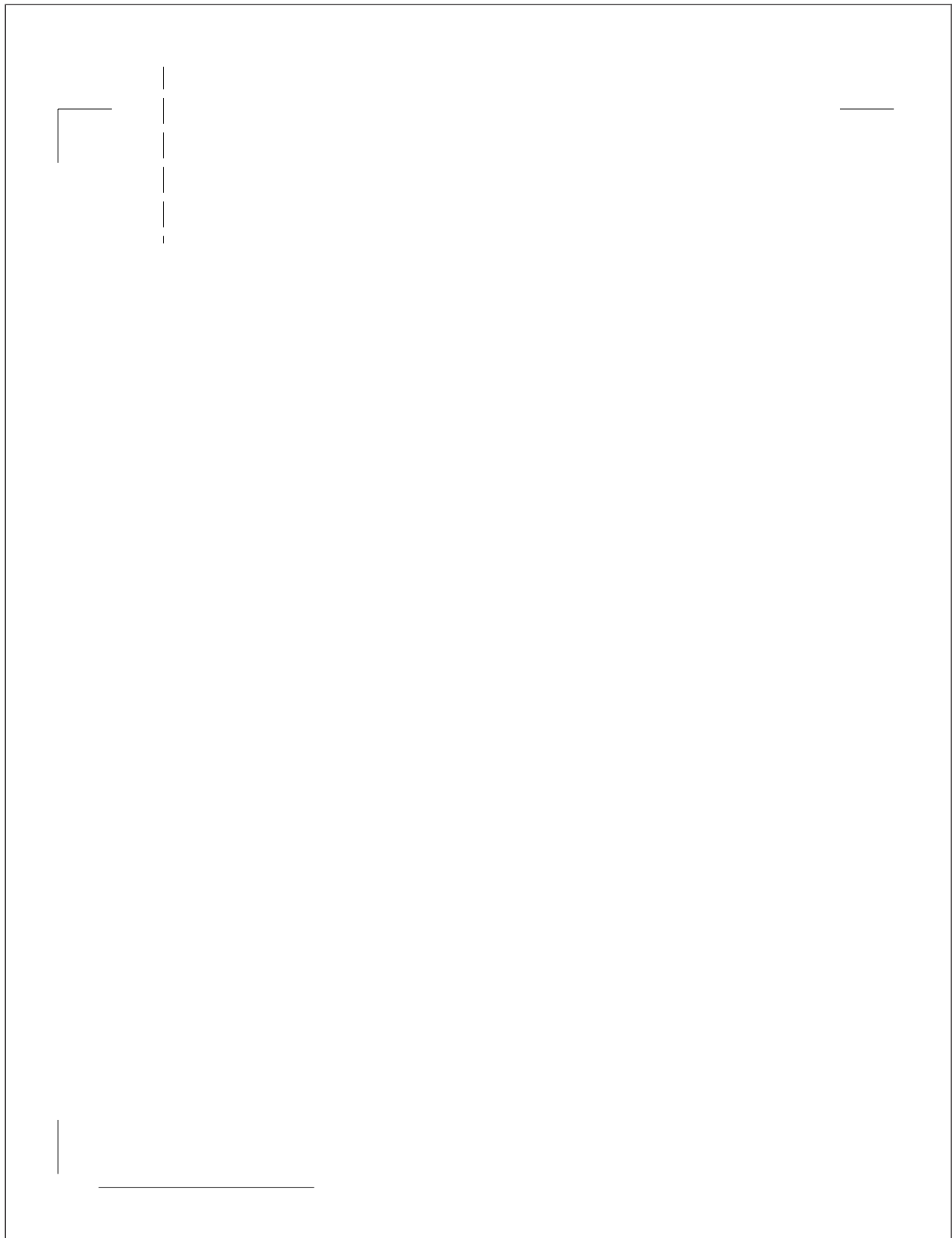


Figure 133. *ProductListPriceUpdate* sequence diagram, 26 of 26 (13,2)

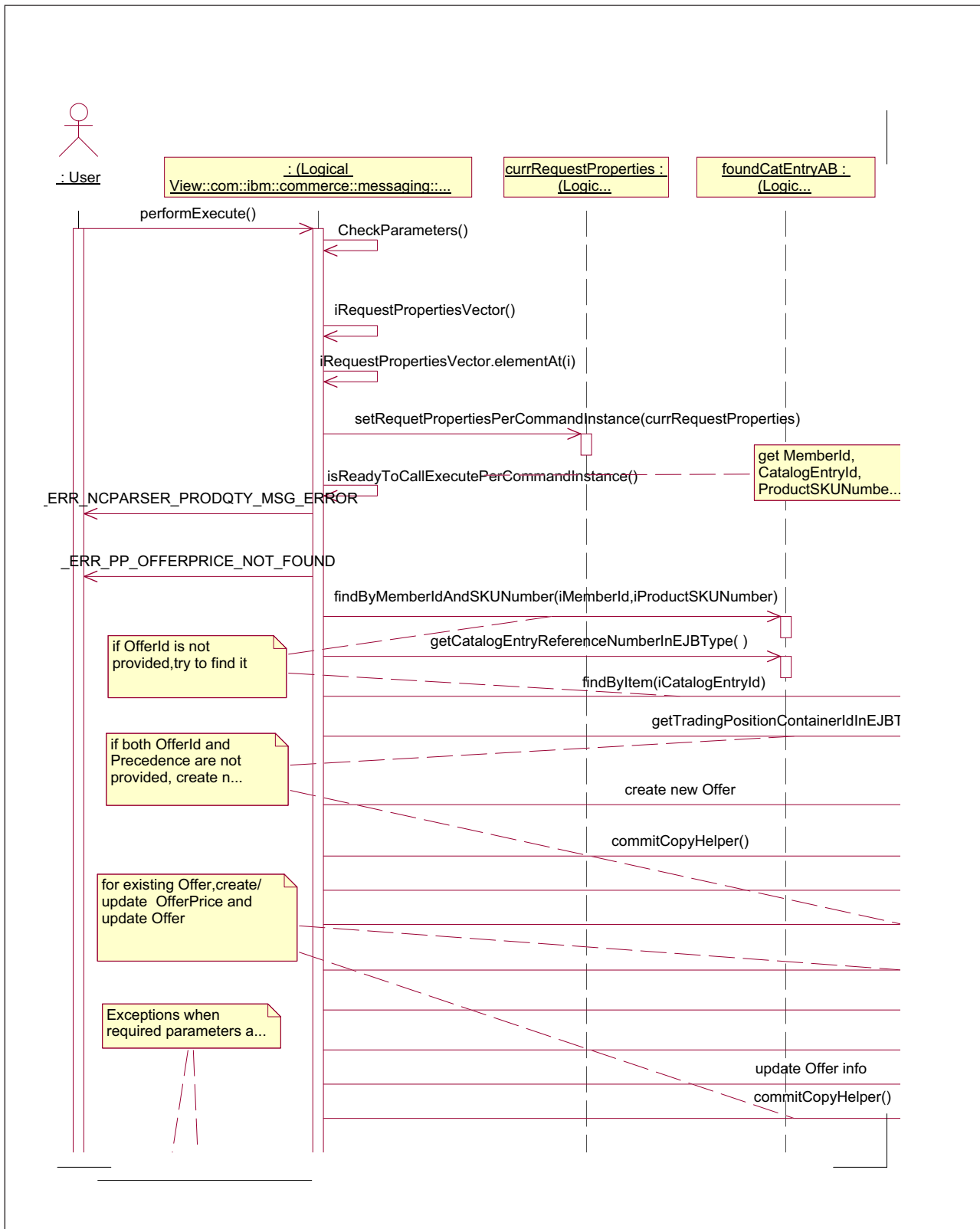


Figure 134. ProductOfferPriceUpdate sequence diagram, 1 of 26 (1,1)

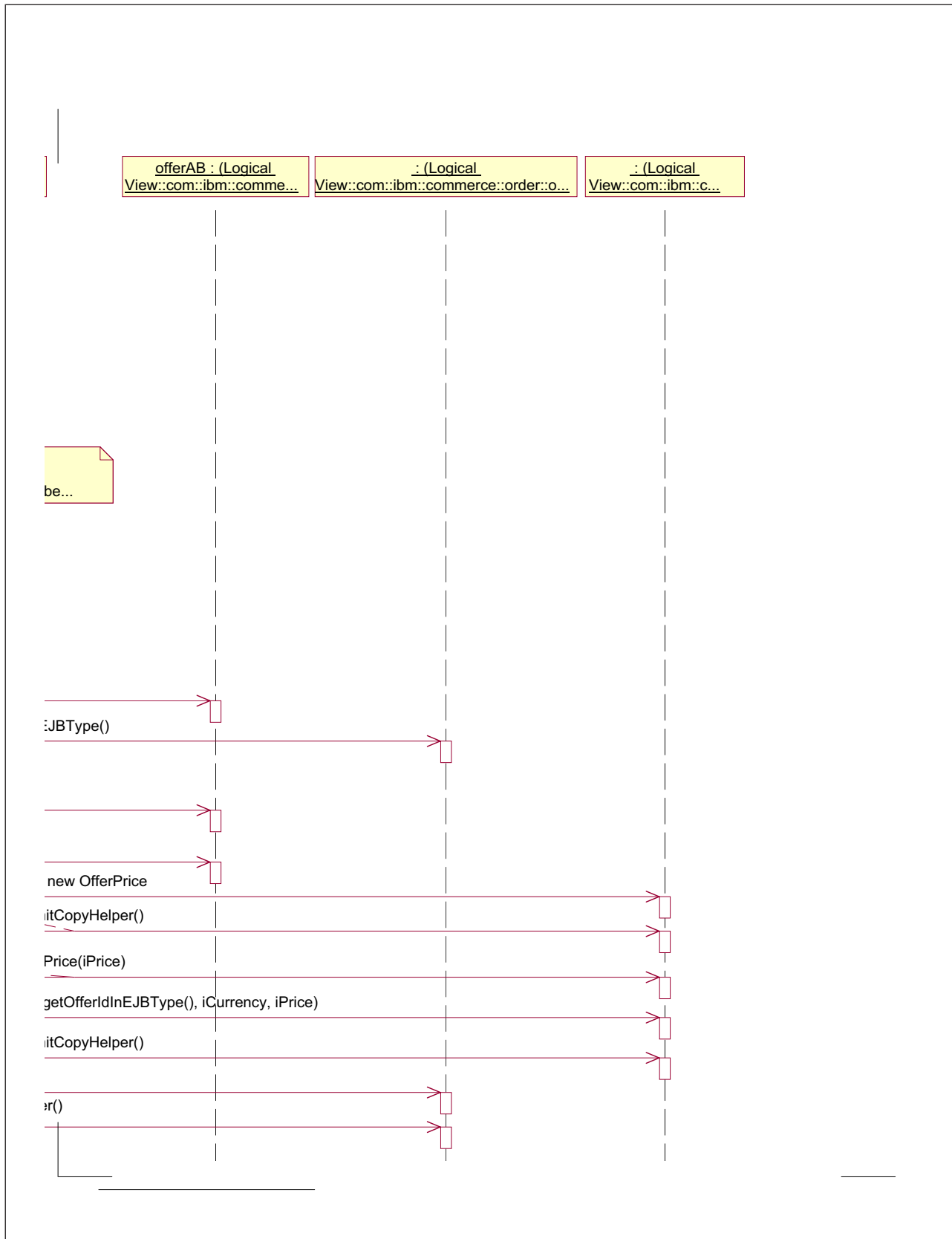


Figure 135. ProductOfferPriceUpdate sequence diagram, 2 of 26 (1,2)

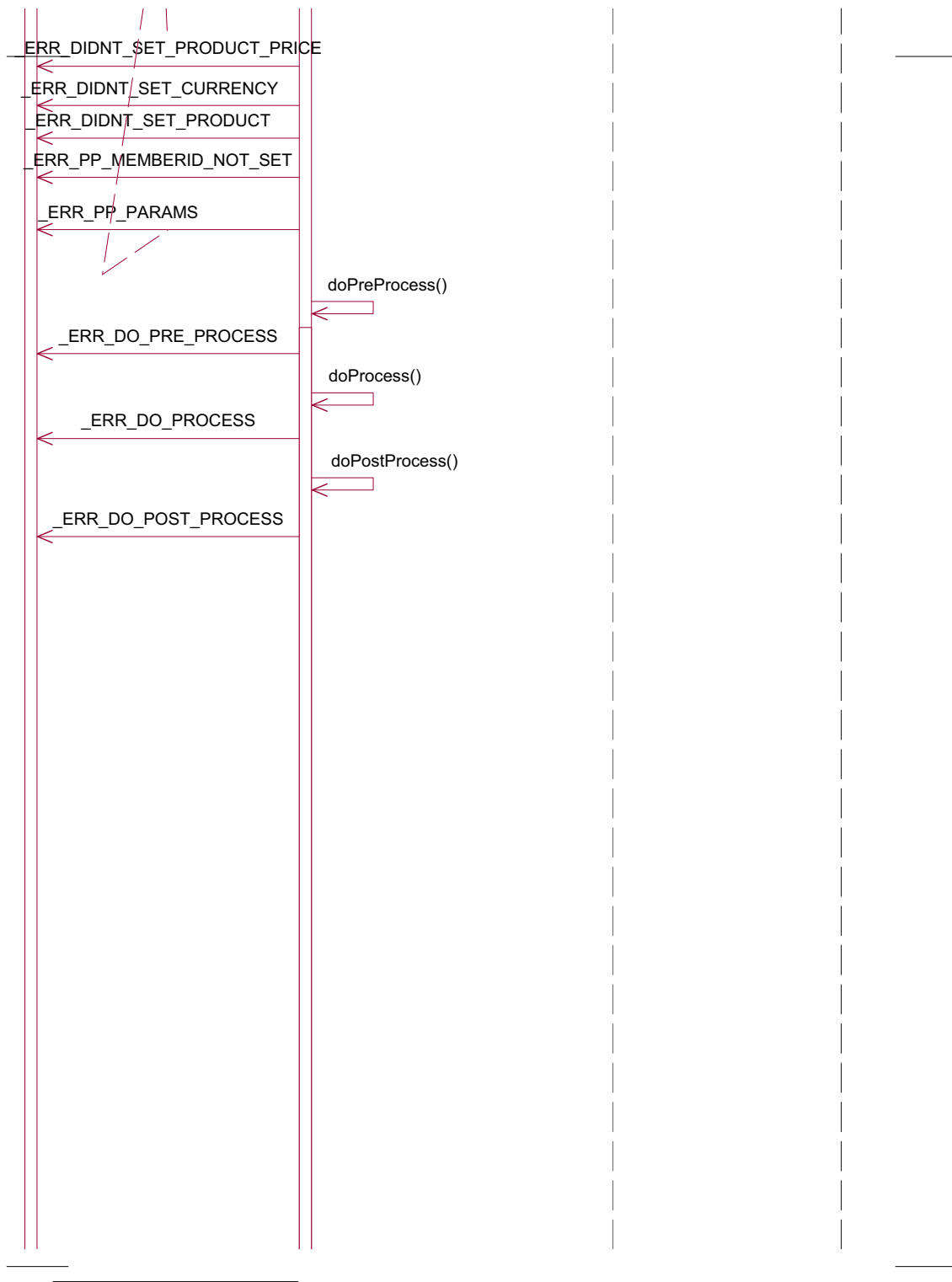


Figure 136. *ProductOfferPriceUpdate* sequence diagram, 3 of 26 (2,1)

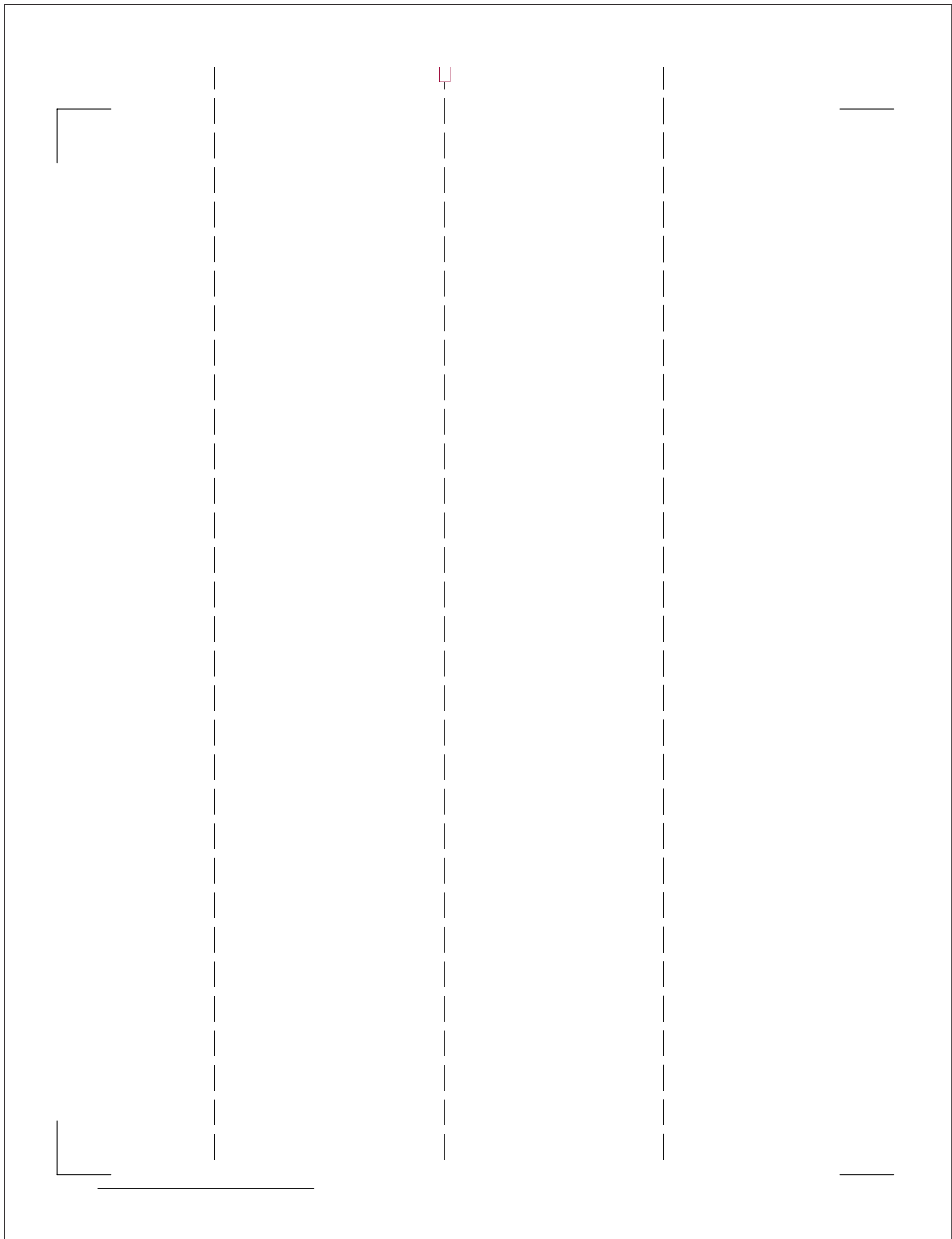


Figure 137. ProductOfferPriceUpdate sequence diagram, 4 of 26 (2,2)

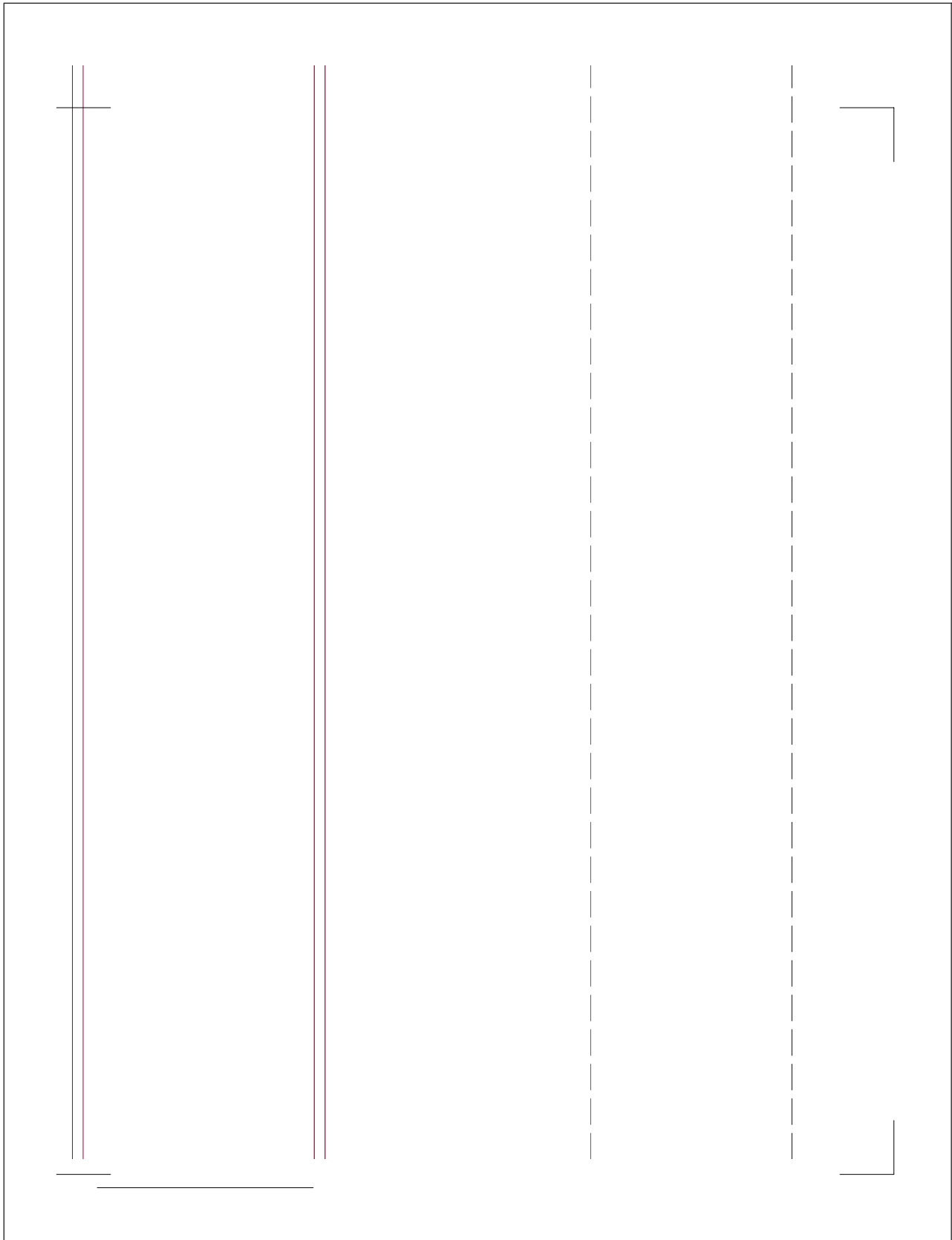


Figure 138. ProductOfferPriceUpdate sequence diagram, 5 of 26 (3,1)

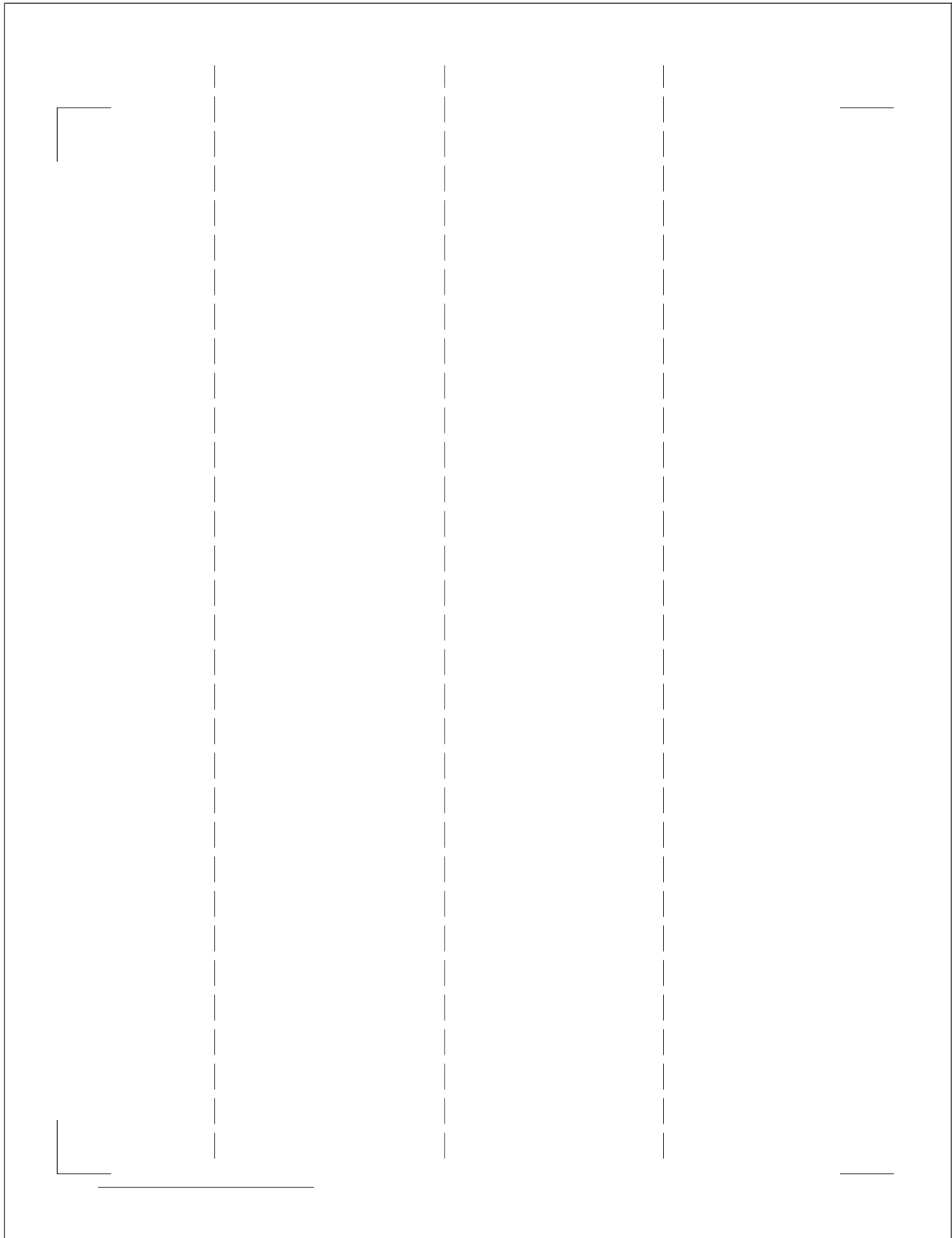


Figure 139. ProductOfferPriceUpdate sequence diagram, 6 of 26 (3,2)

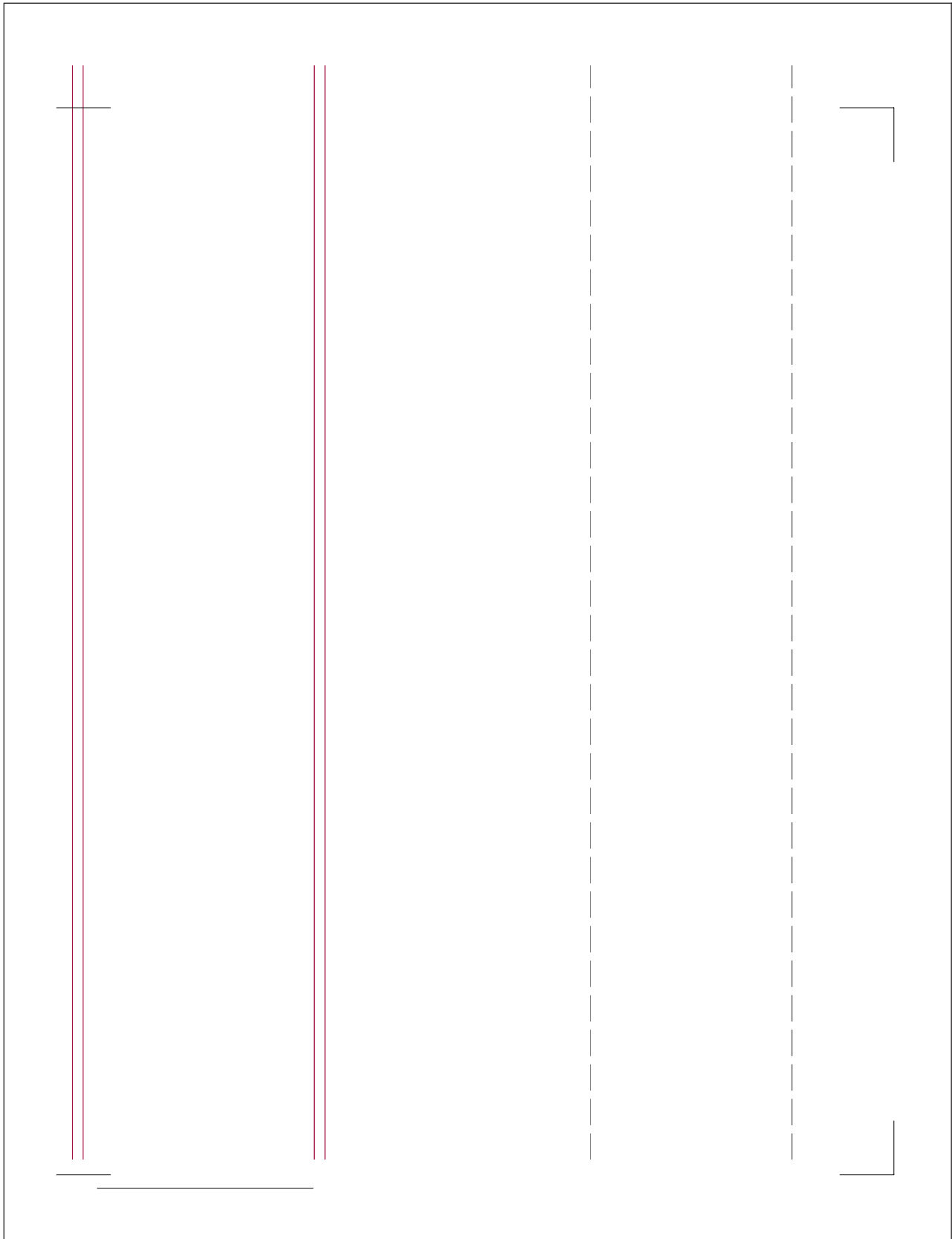


Figure 140. ProductOfferPriceUpdate sequence diagram, 7 of 26 (4,1)

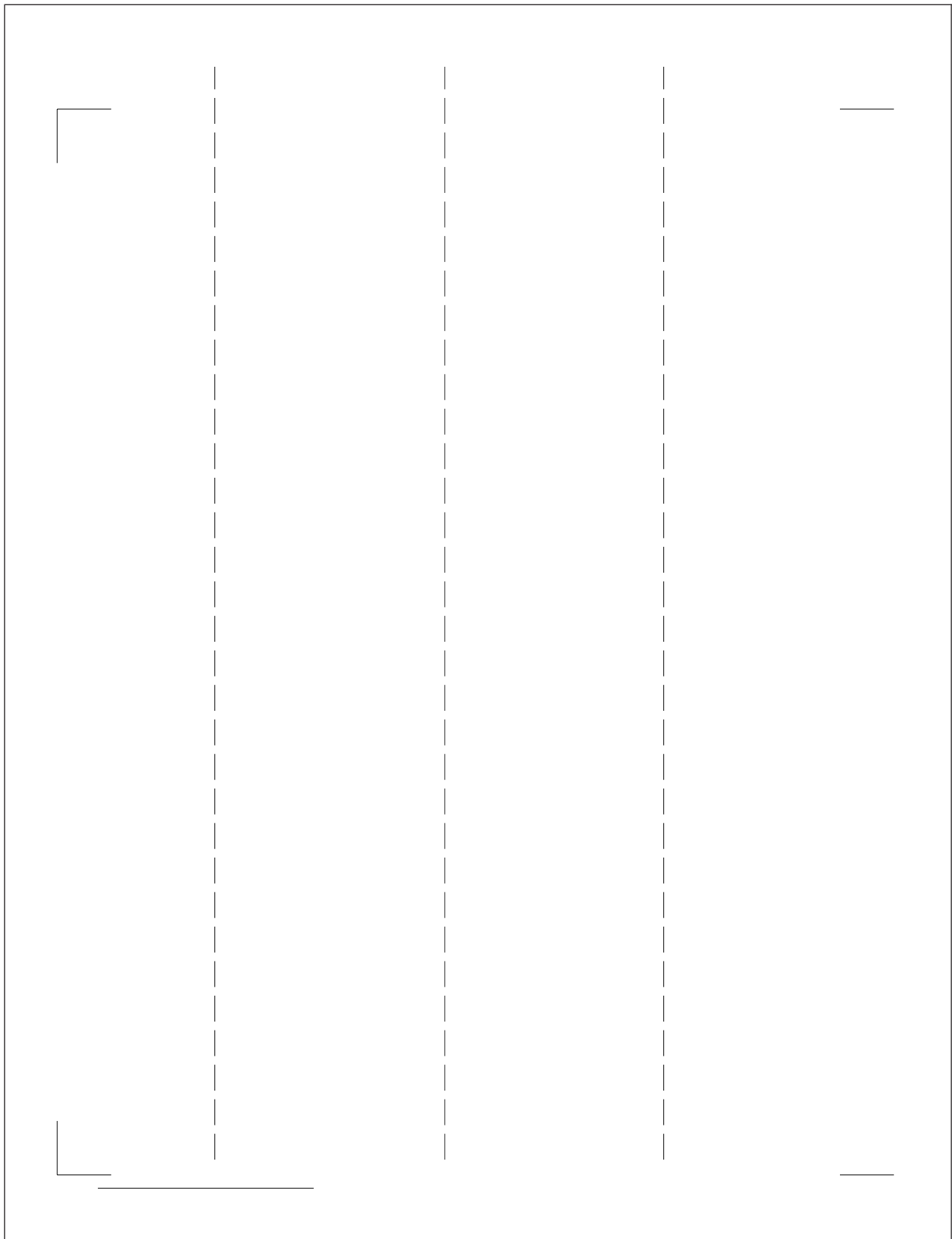


Figure 141. ProductOfferPriceUpdate sequence diagram, 8 of 26 (4,2)

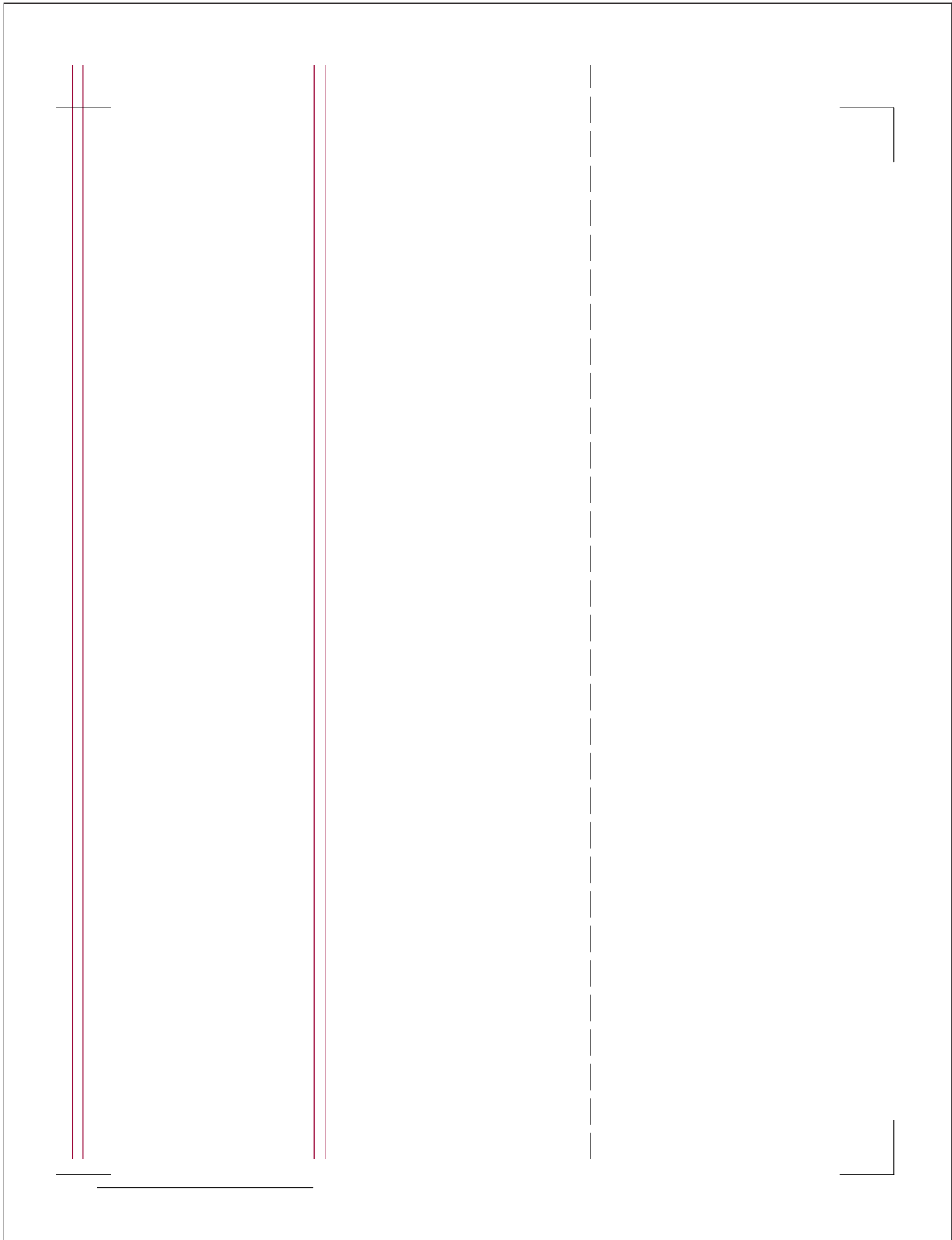


Figure 142. ProductOfferPriceUpdate sequence diagram, 9 of 26 (5,1)

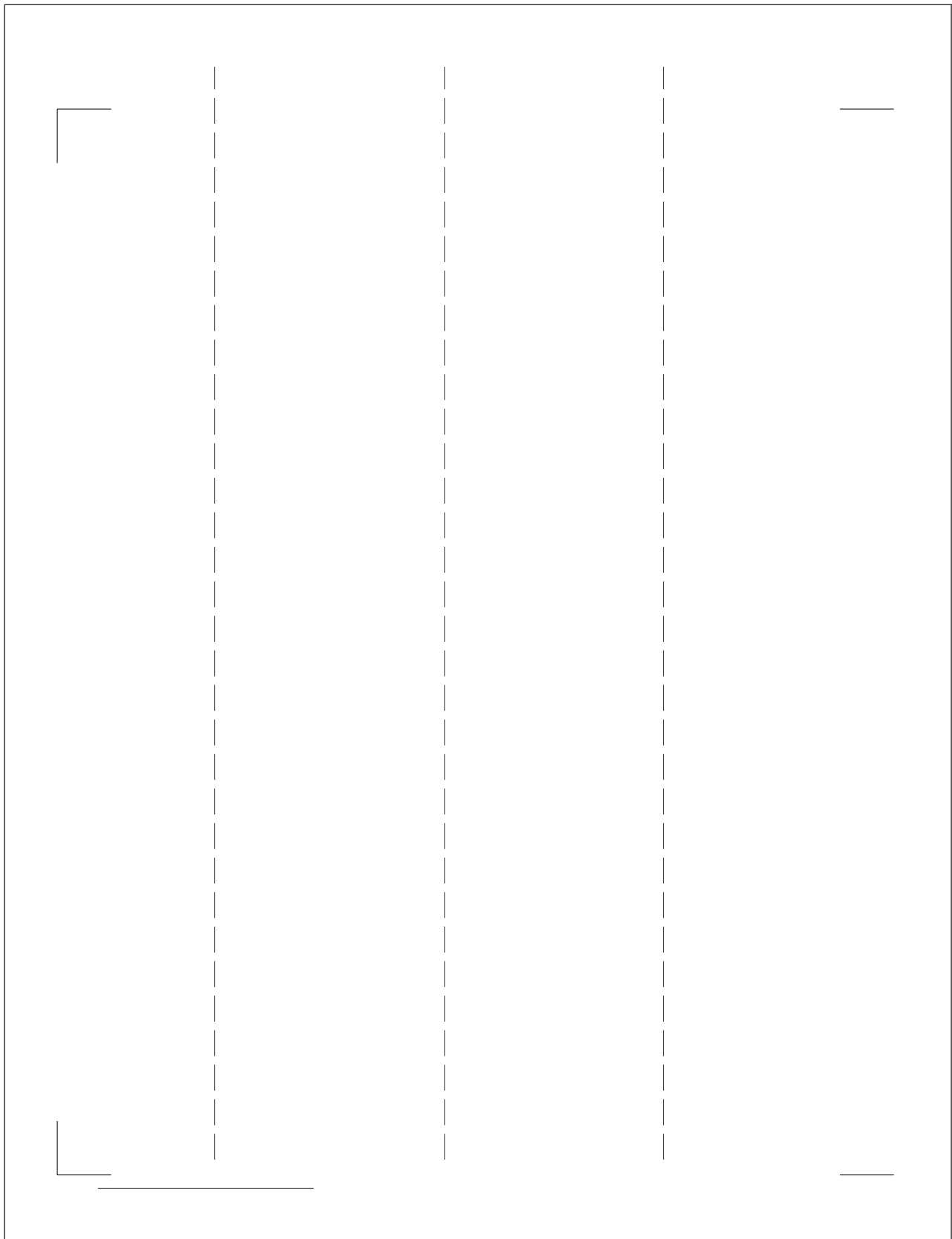


Figure 143. ProductOfferPriceUpdate sequence diagram, 10 of 26 (5,2)

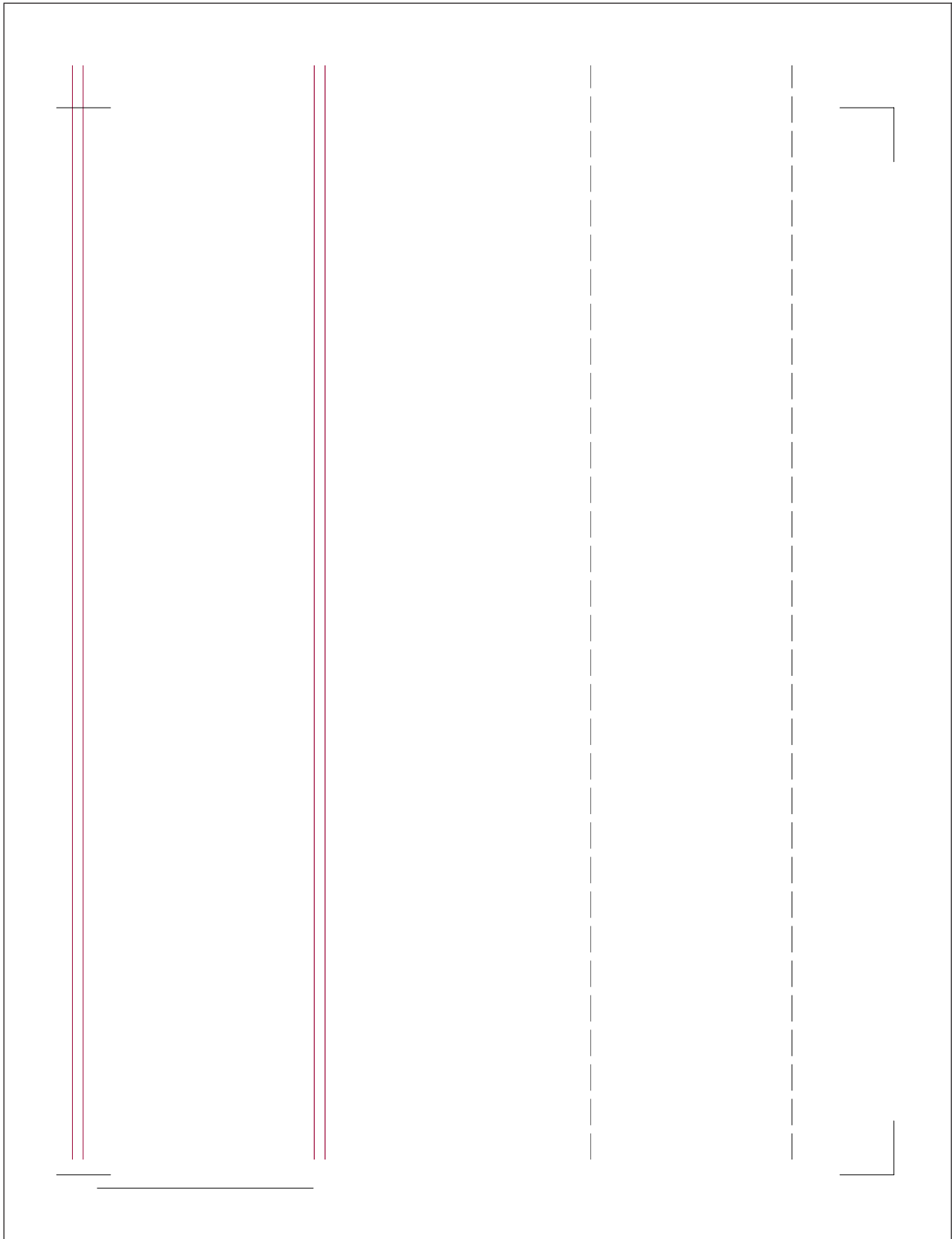


Figure 144. ProductOfferPriceUpdate sequence diagram, 11 of 26 (6,1)

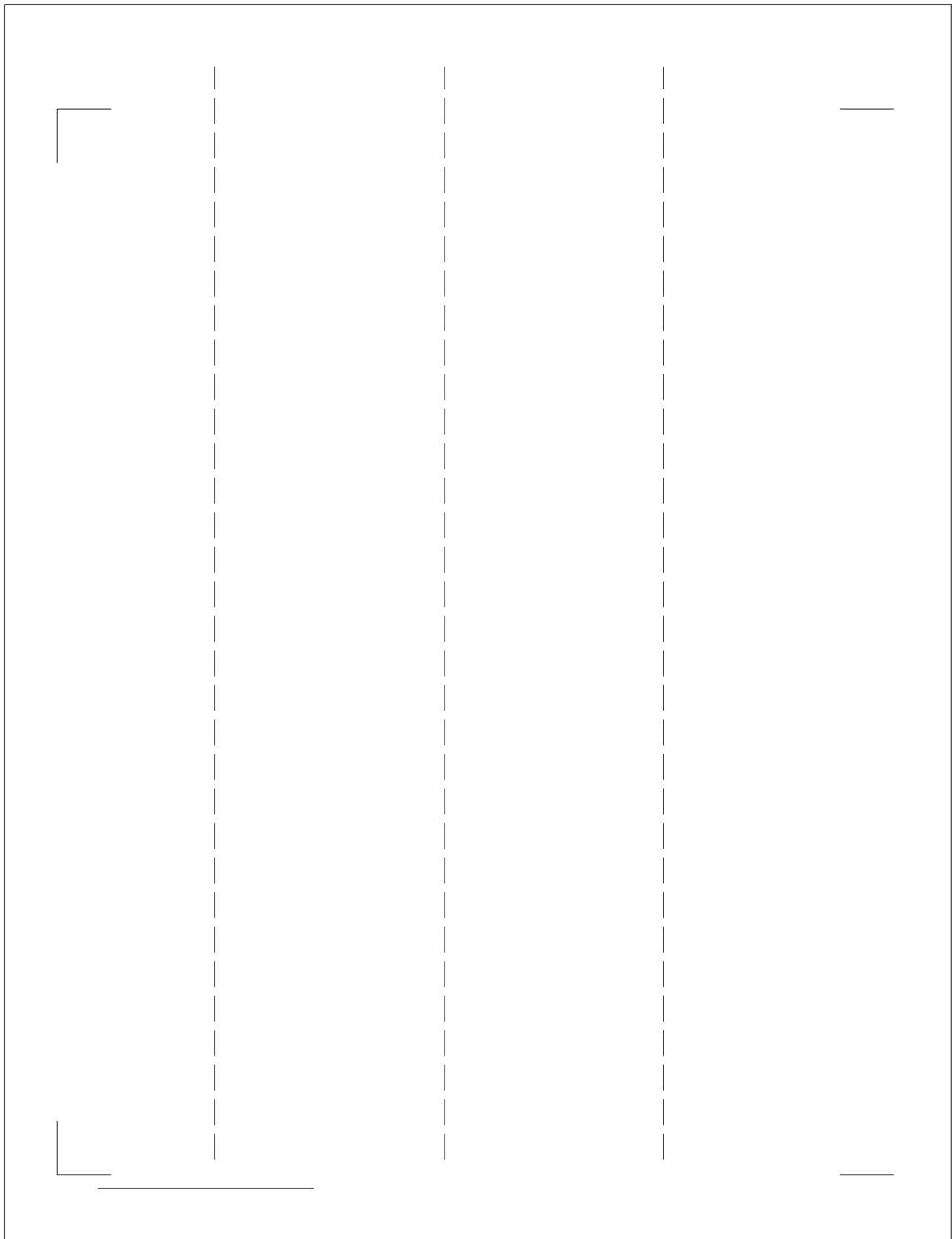


Figure 145. ProductOfferPriceUpdate sequence diagram, 12 of 26 (6,2)

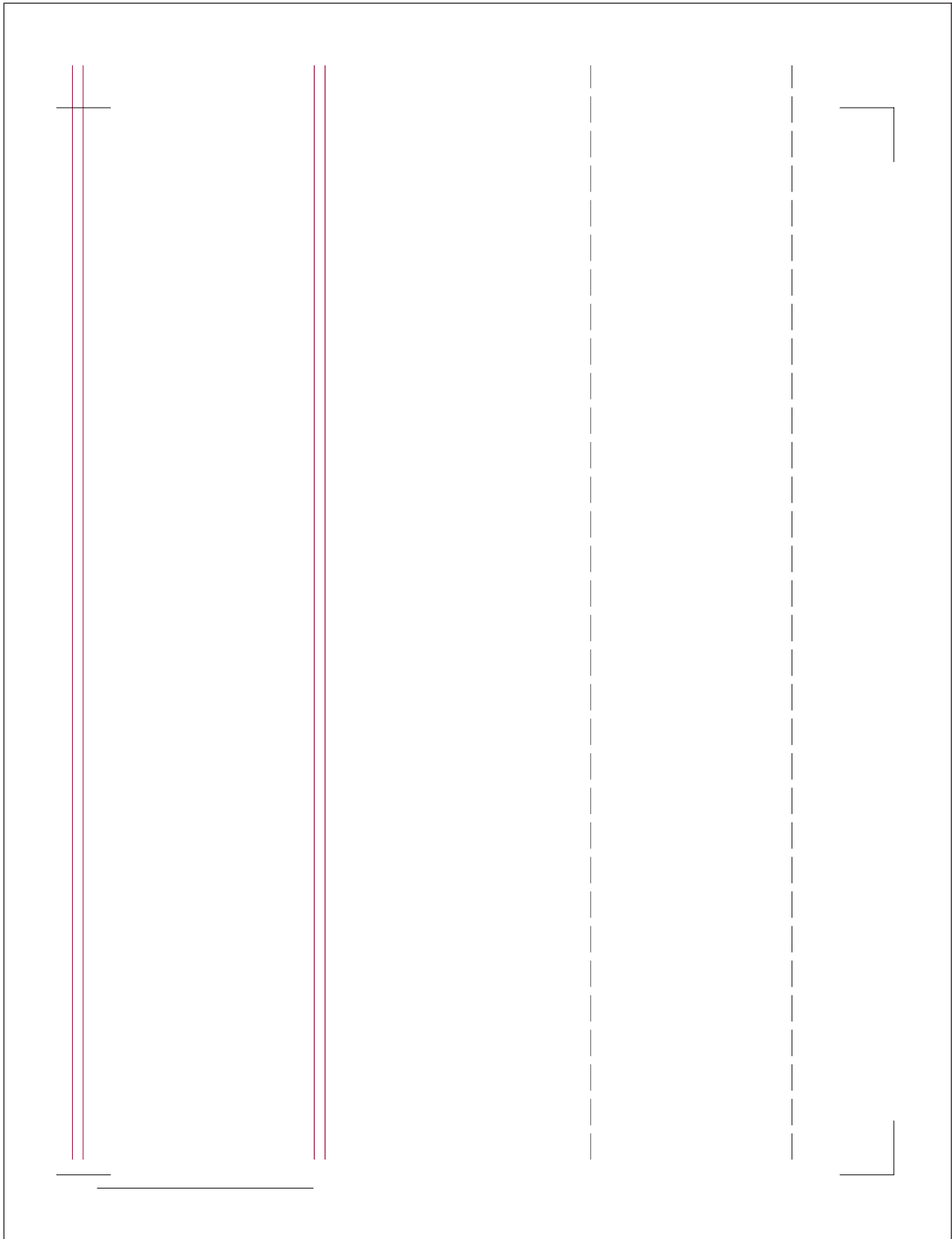


Figure 146. ProductOfferPriceUpdate sequence diagram, 13 of 26 (7,1)

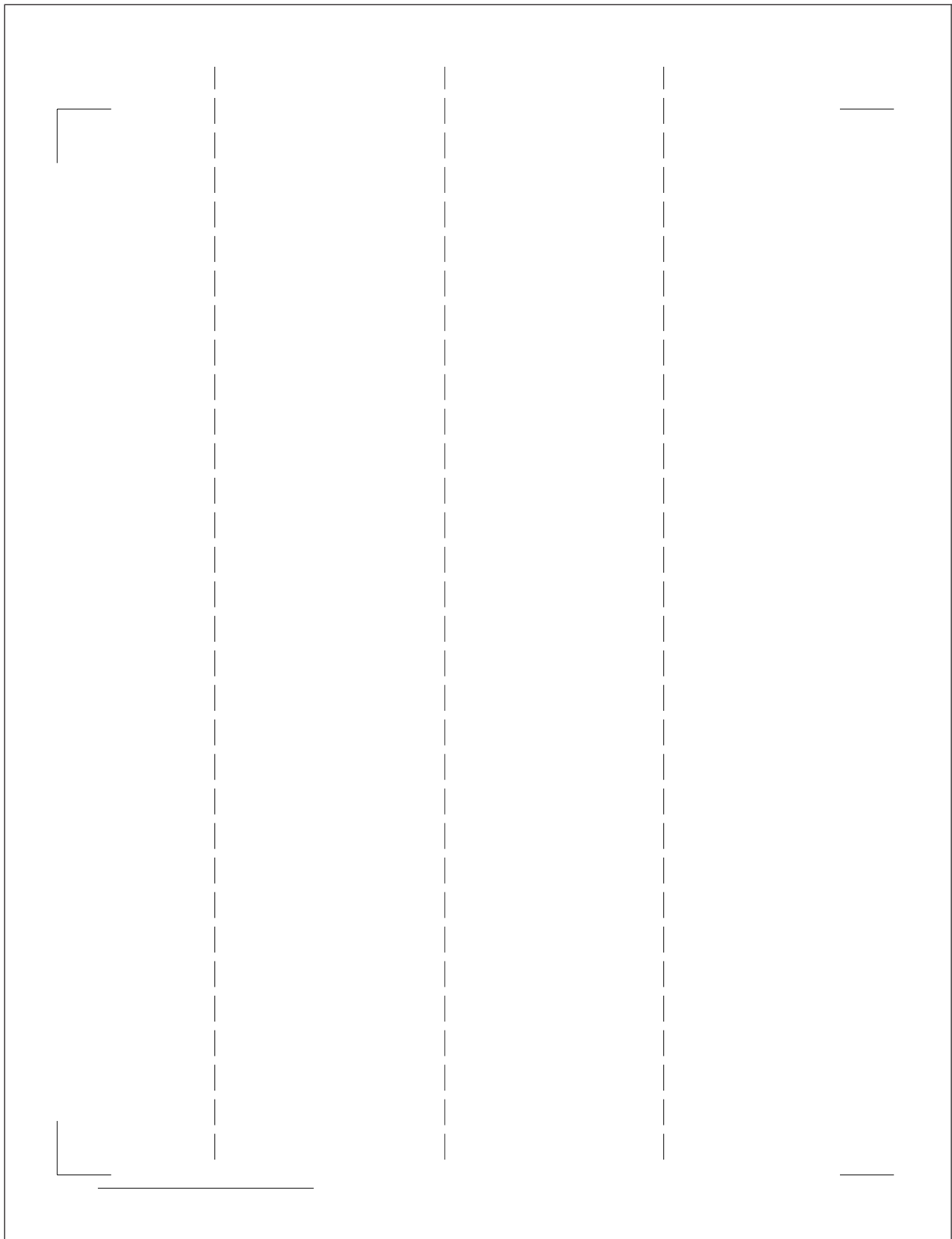


Figure 147. ProductOfferPriceUpdate sequence diagram, 14 of 26 (7,2)

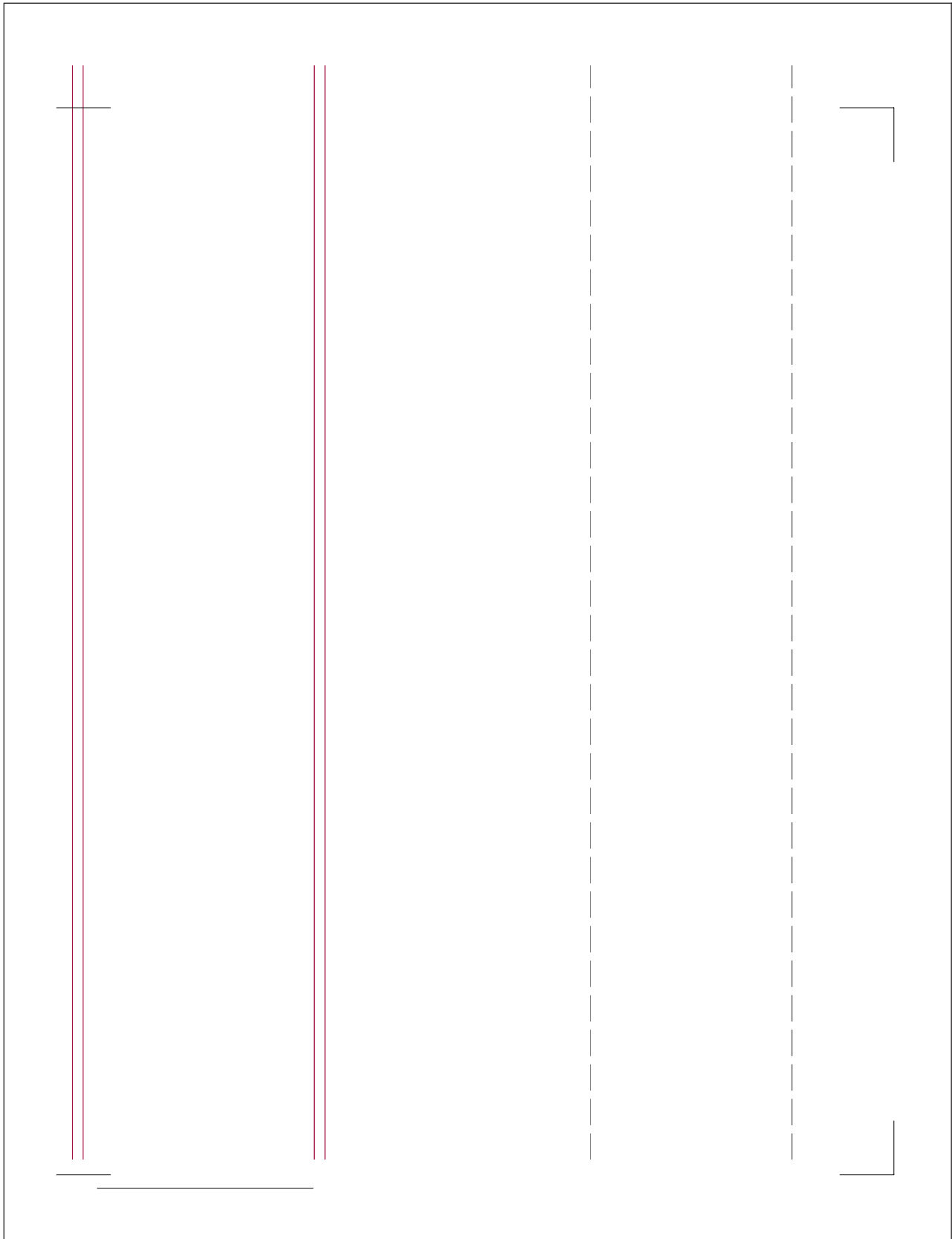


Figure 148. ProductOfferPriceUpdate sequence diagram, 15 of 26 (8,1)

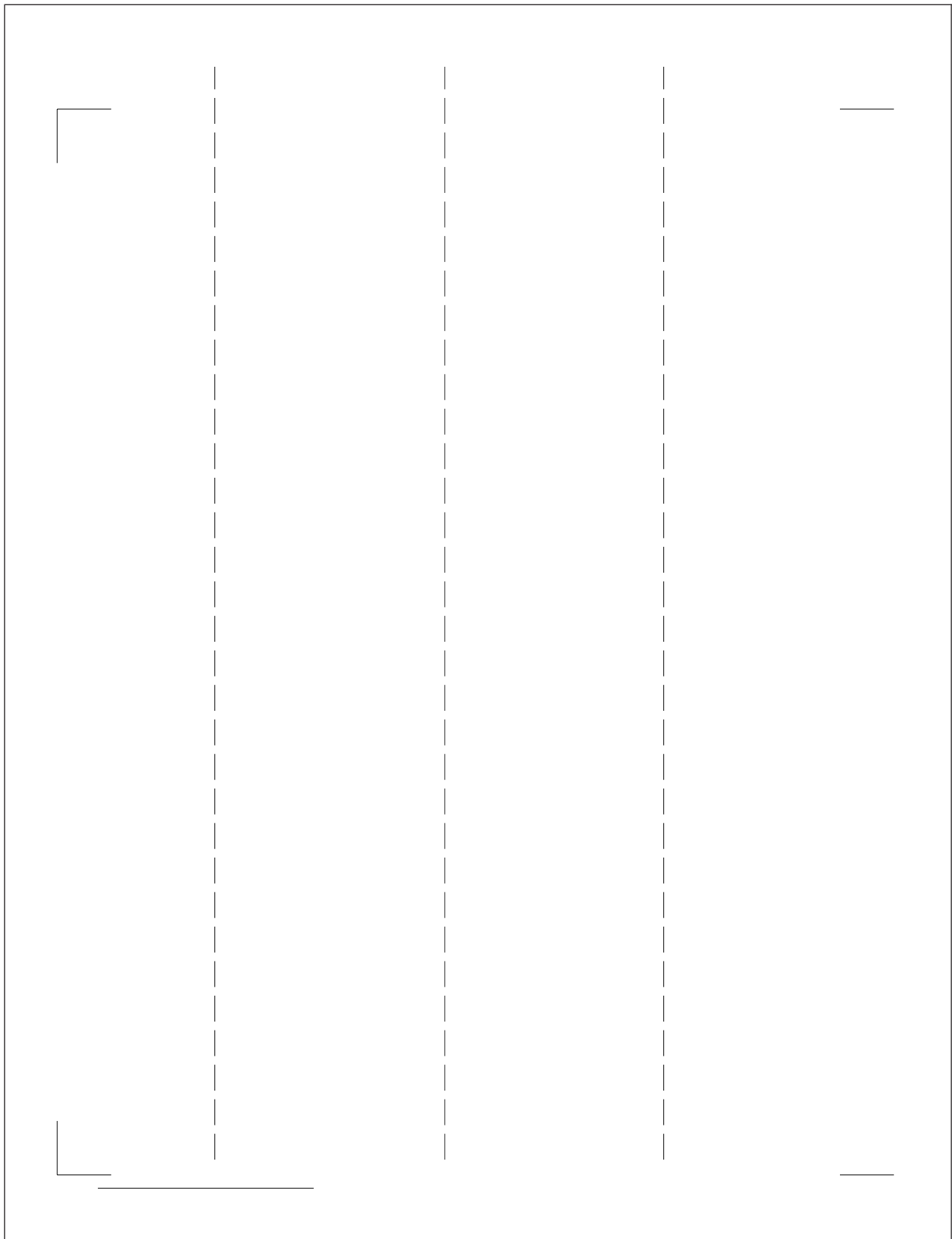


Figure 149. ProductOfferPriceUpdate sequence diagram, 16 of 26 (8,2)

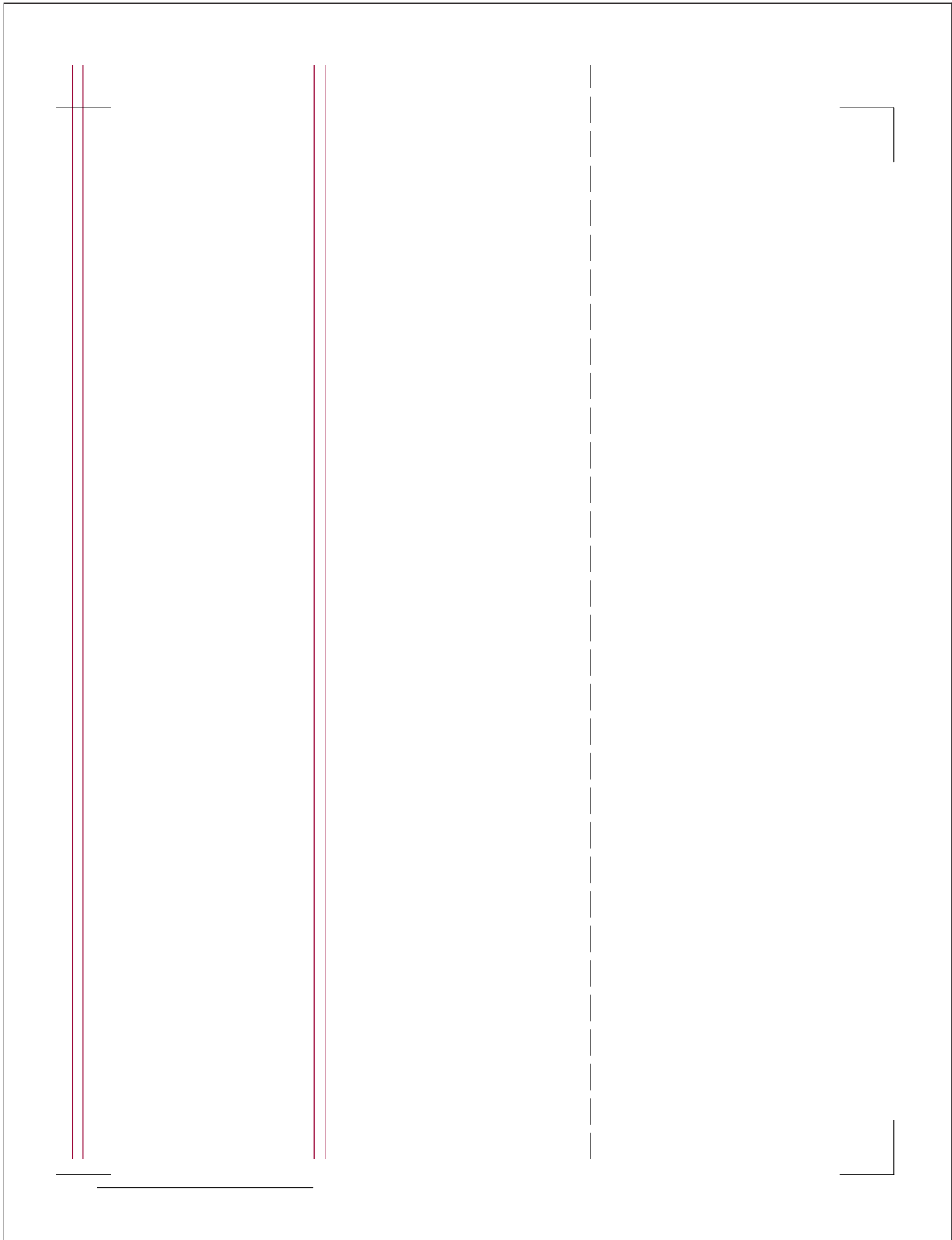


Figure 150. ProductOfferPriceUpdate sequence diagram, 17 of 26 (9,1)

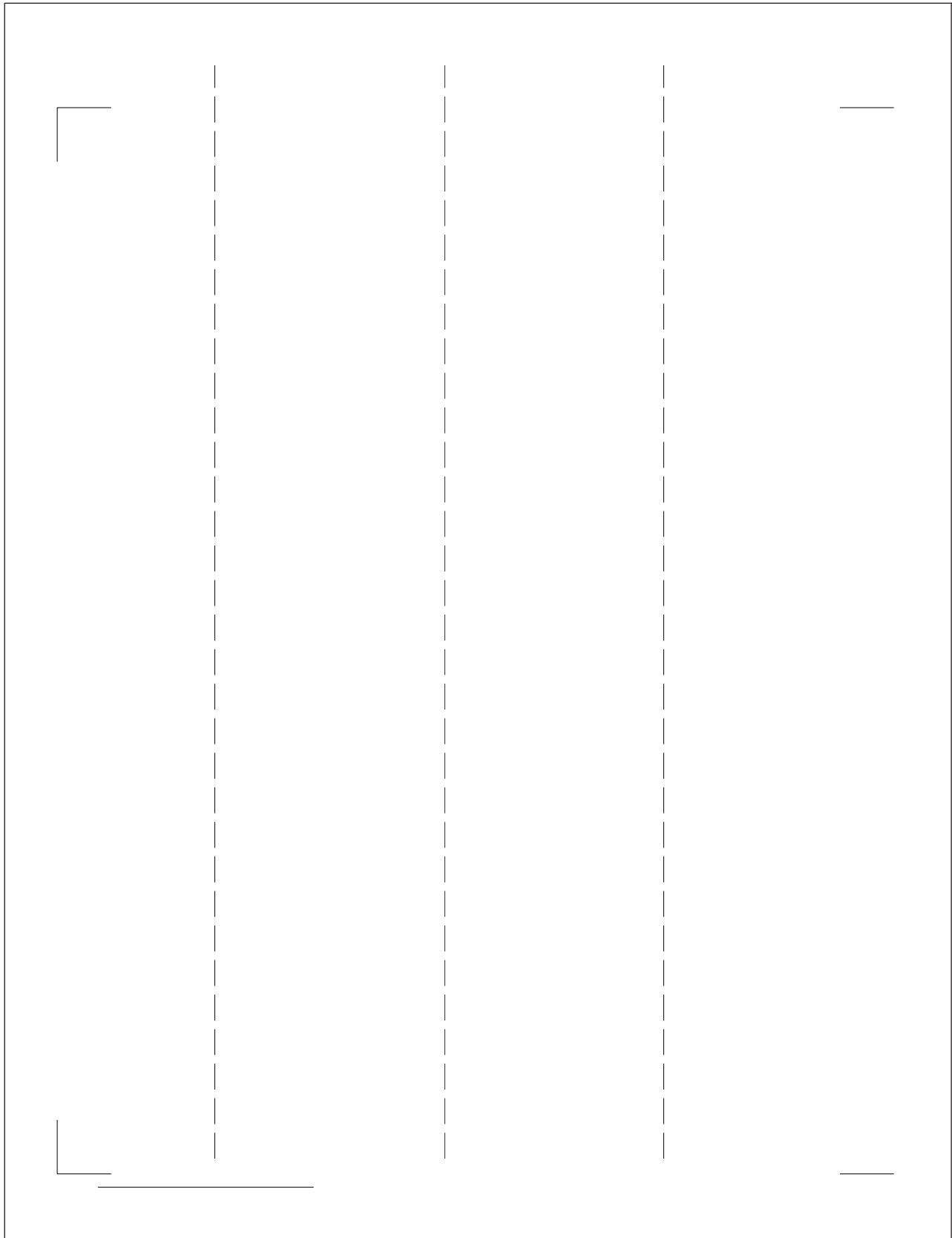


Figure 151. *ProductOfferPriceUpdate* sequence diagram, 18 of 26 (9,2)

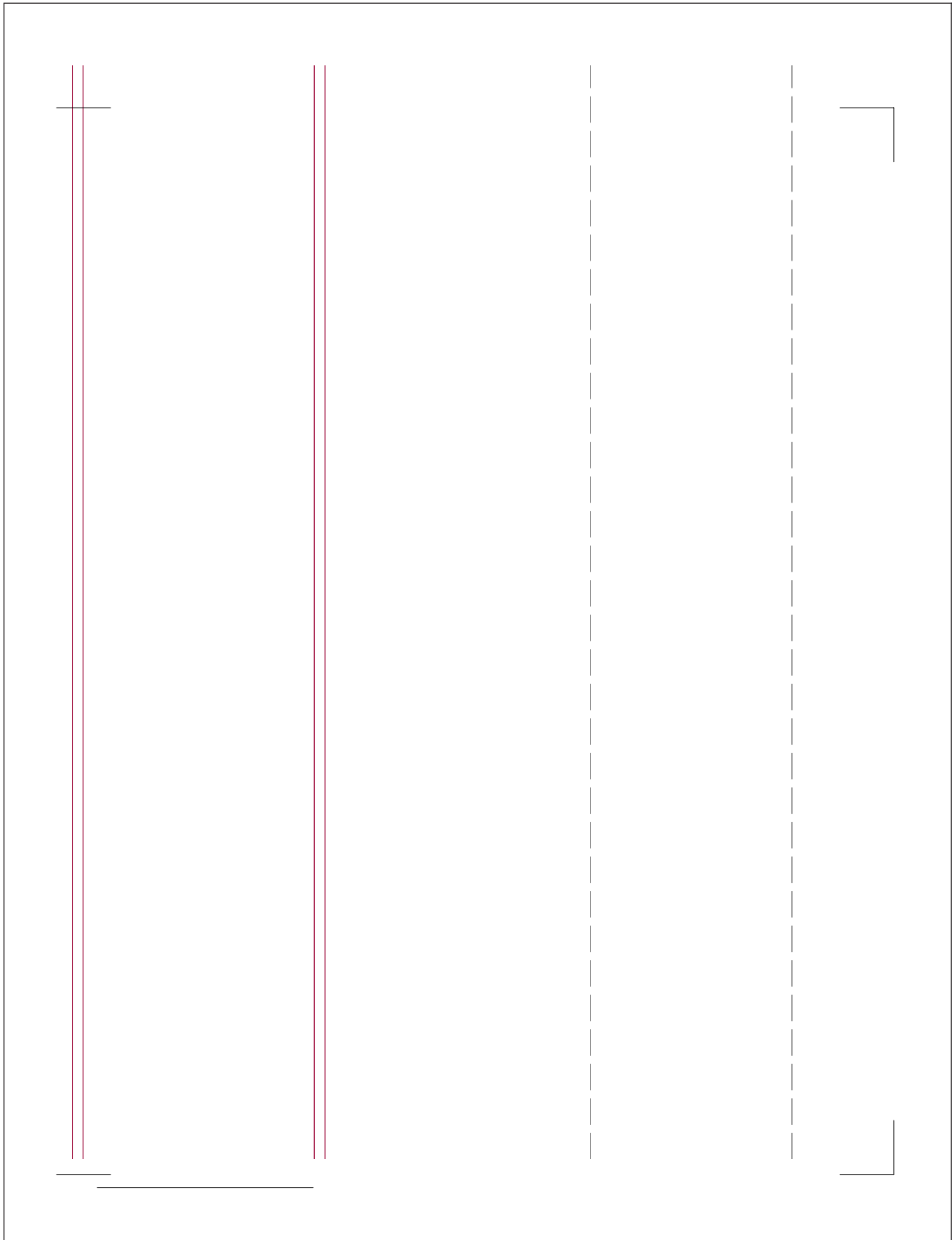


Figure 152. ProductOfferPriceUpdate sequence diagram, 17 of 26 (9,1)

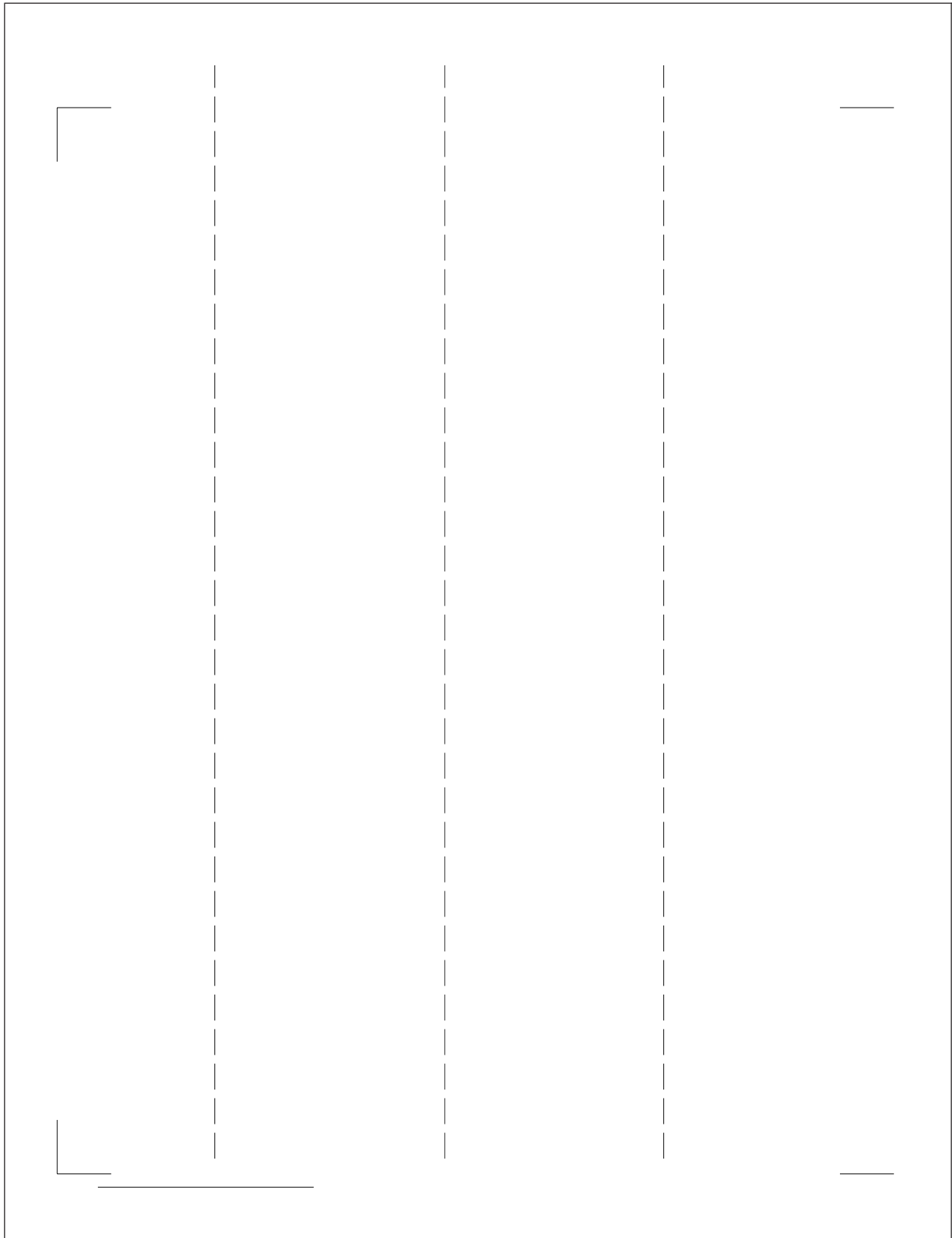


Figure 153. *ProductOfferPriceUpdate* sequence diagram, 18 of 26 (9,2)

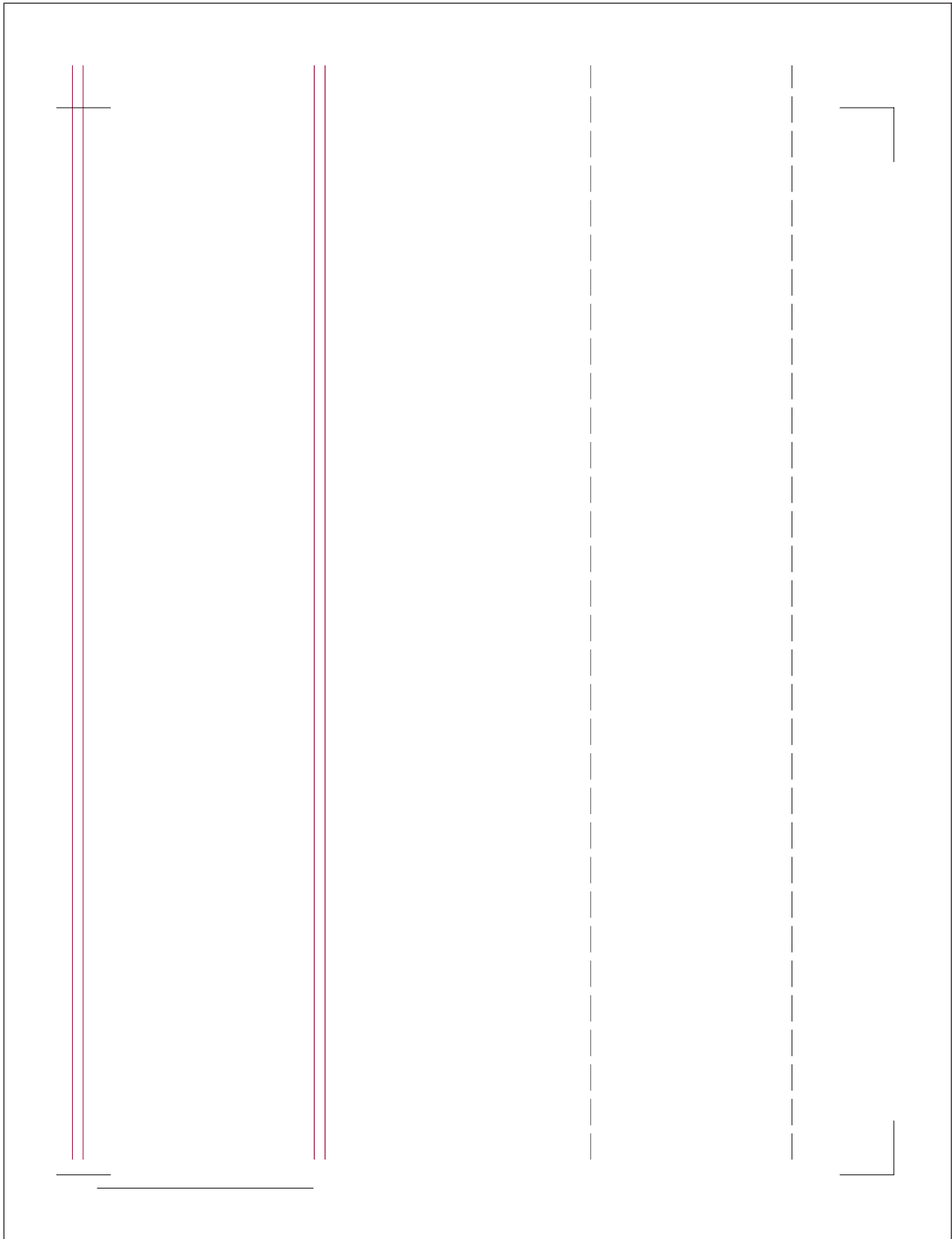


Figure 154. ProductOfferPriceUpdate sequence diagram, 19 of 26 (10,1)

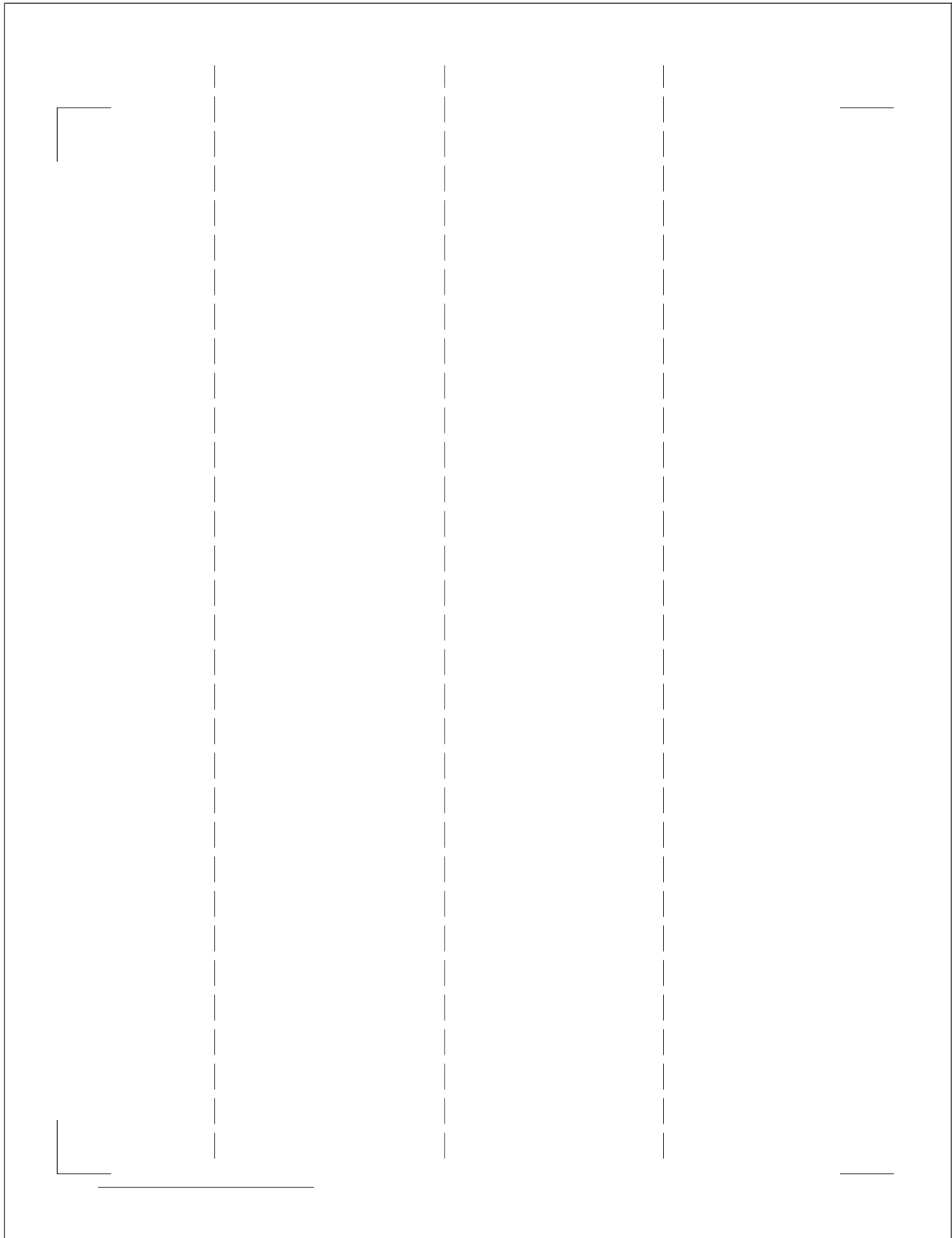


Figure 155. ProductOfferPriceUpdate sequence diagram, 20 of 26 (10,2)

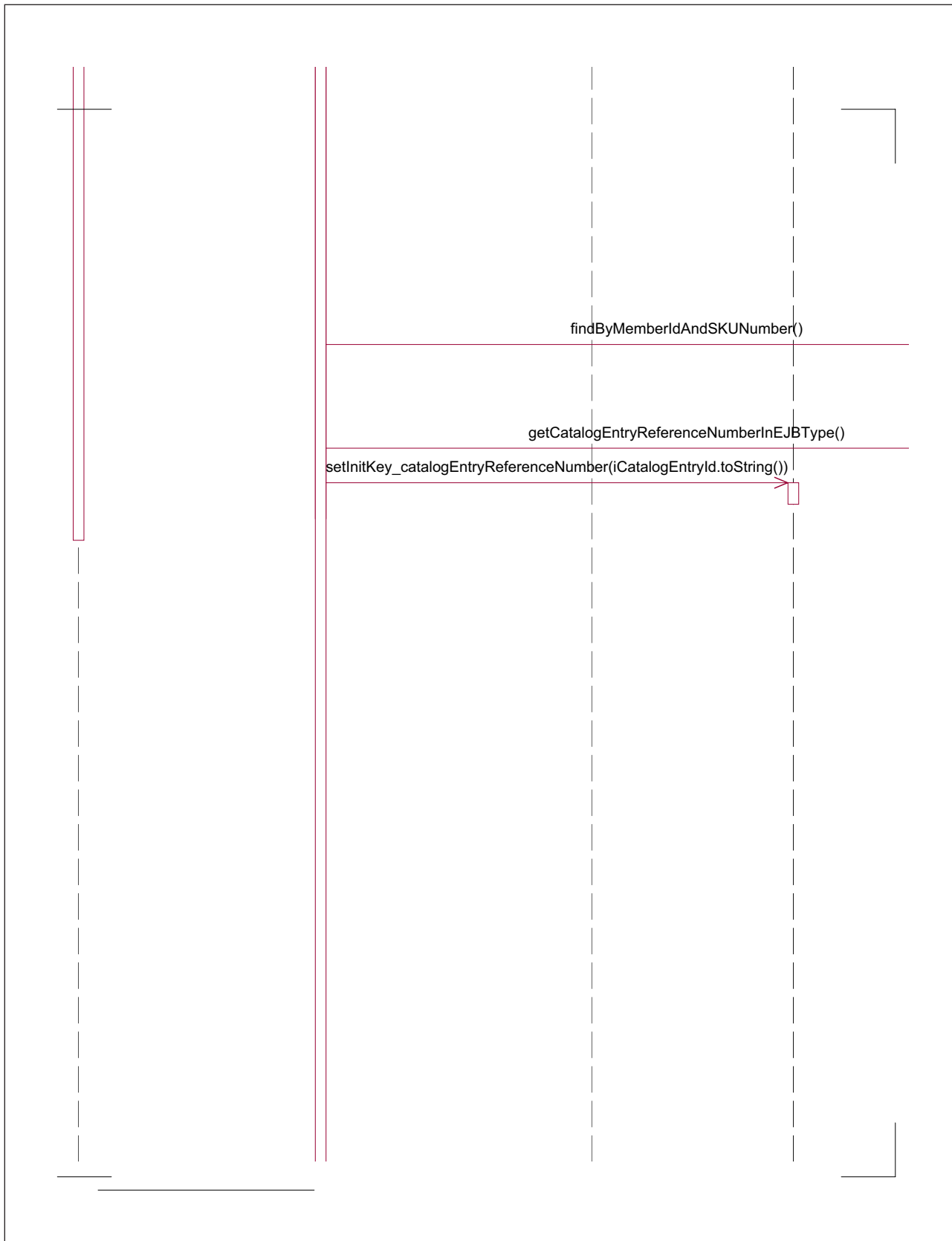


Figure 156. *ProductOfferPriceUpdate* sequence diagram, 21 of 26 (11,1)

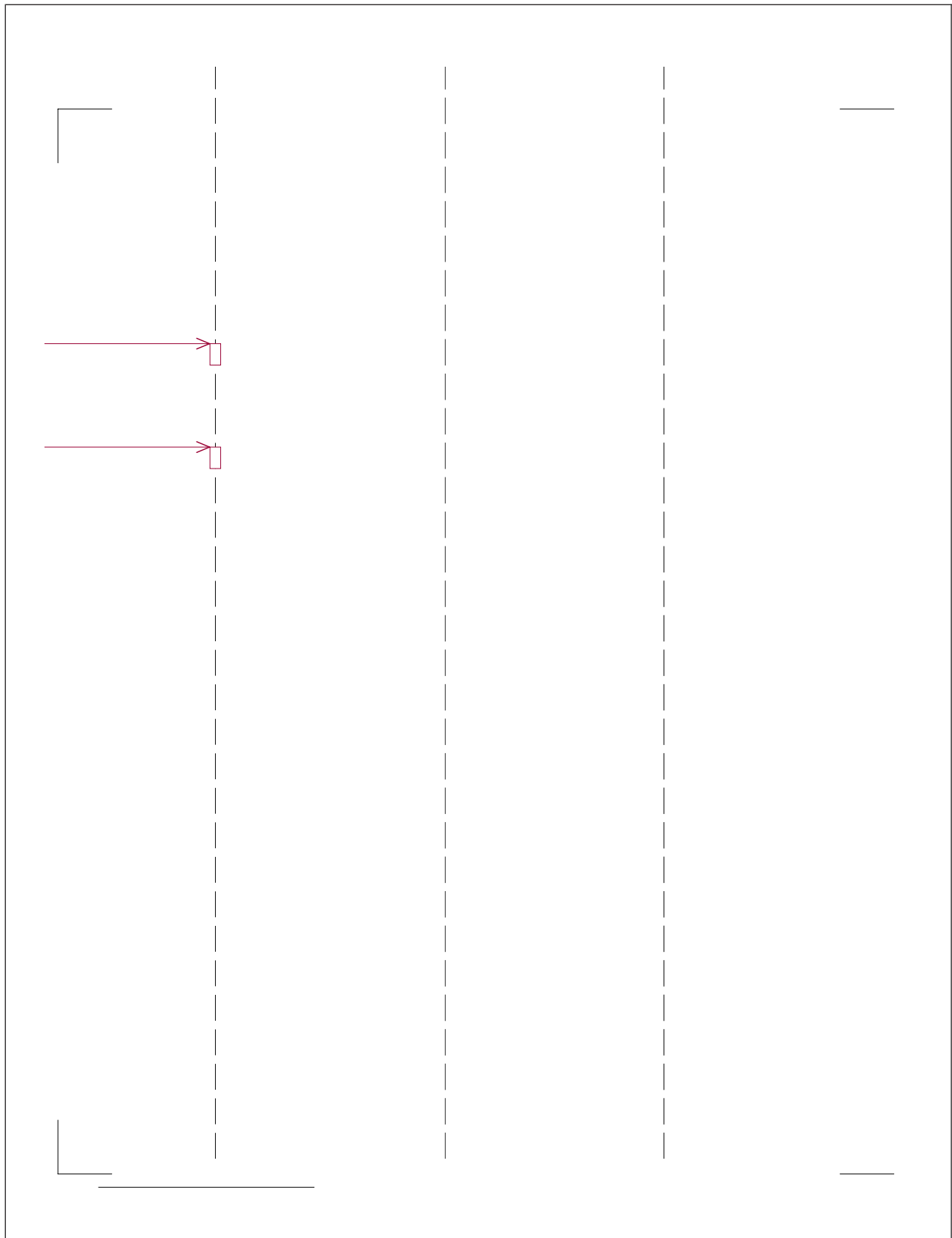


Figure 157. ProductOfferPriceUpdate sequence diagram, 22 of 26 (11,2)

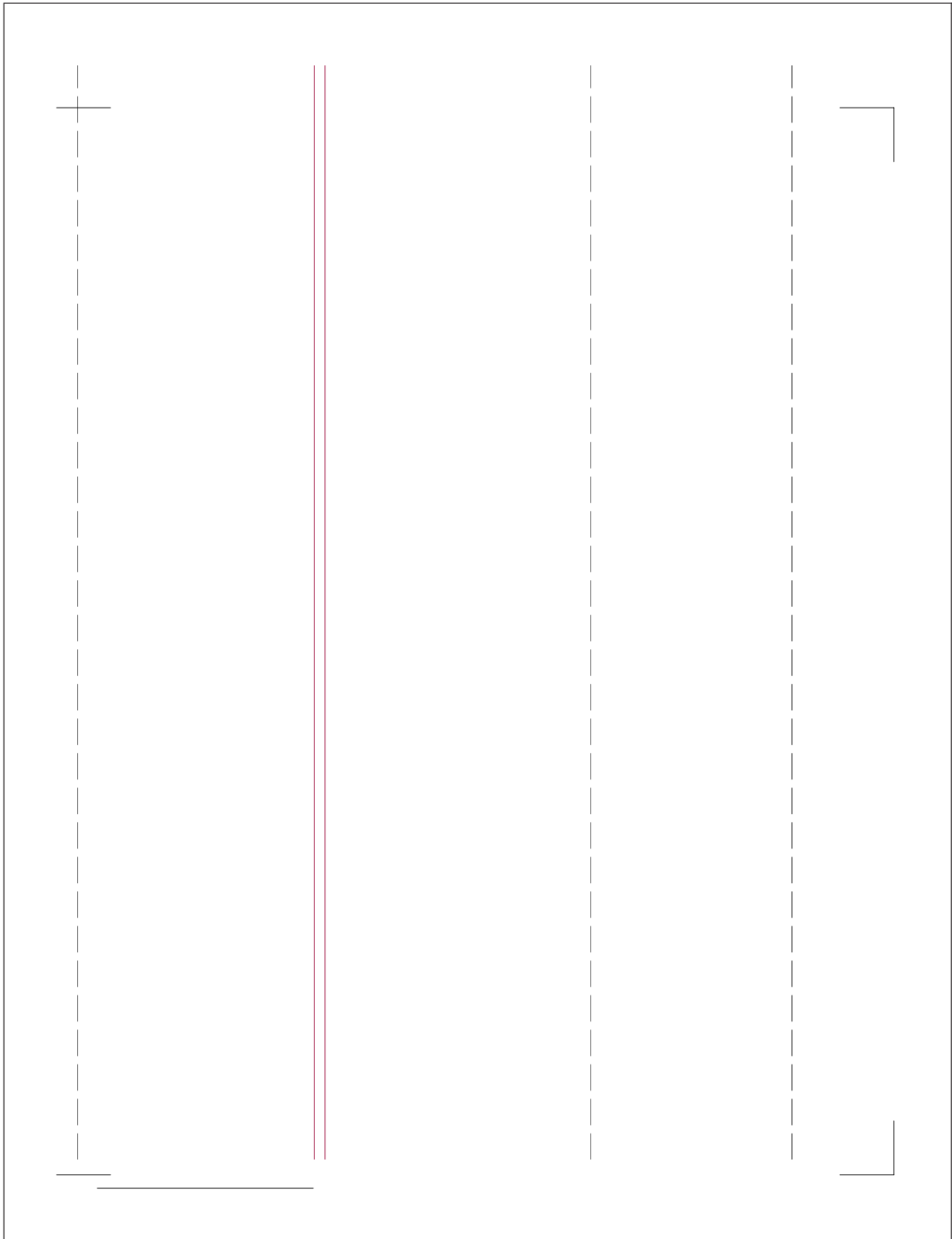


Figure 158. *ProductOfferPriceUpdate* sequence diagram, 23 of 26 (12,1)

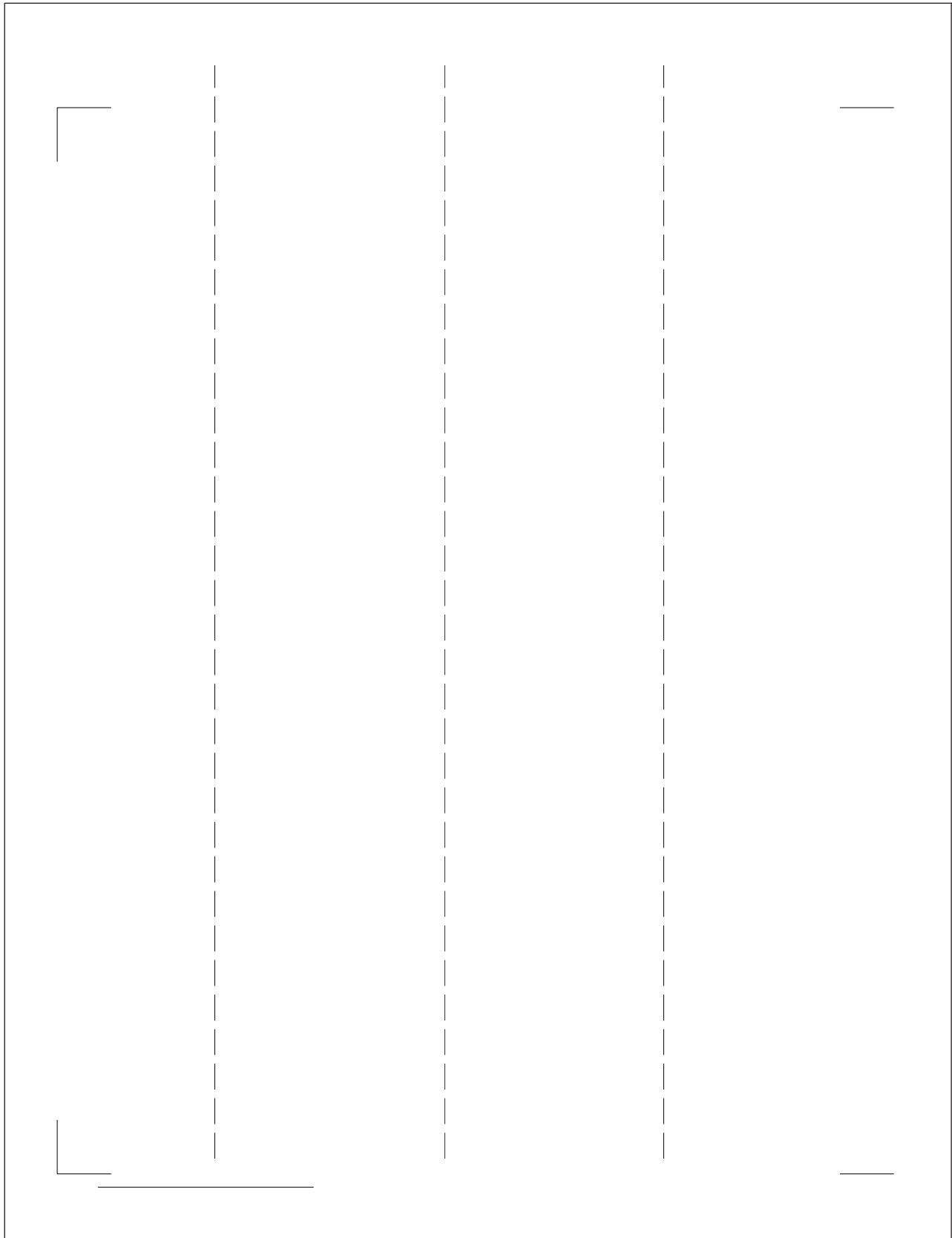


Figure 159. ProductOfferPriceUpdate sequence diagram, 24 of 26 (12,2)

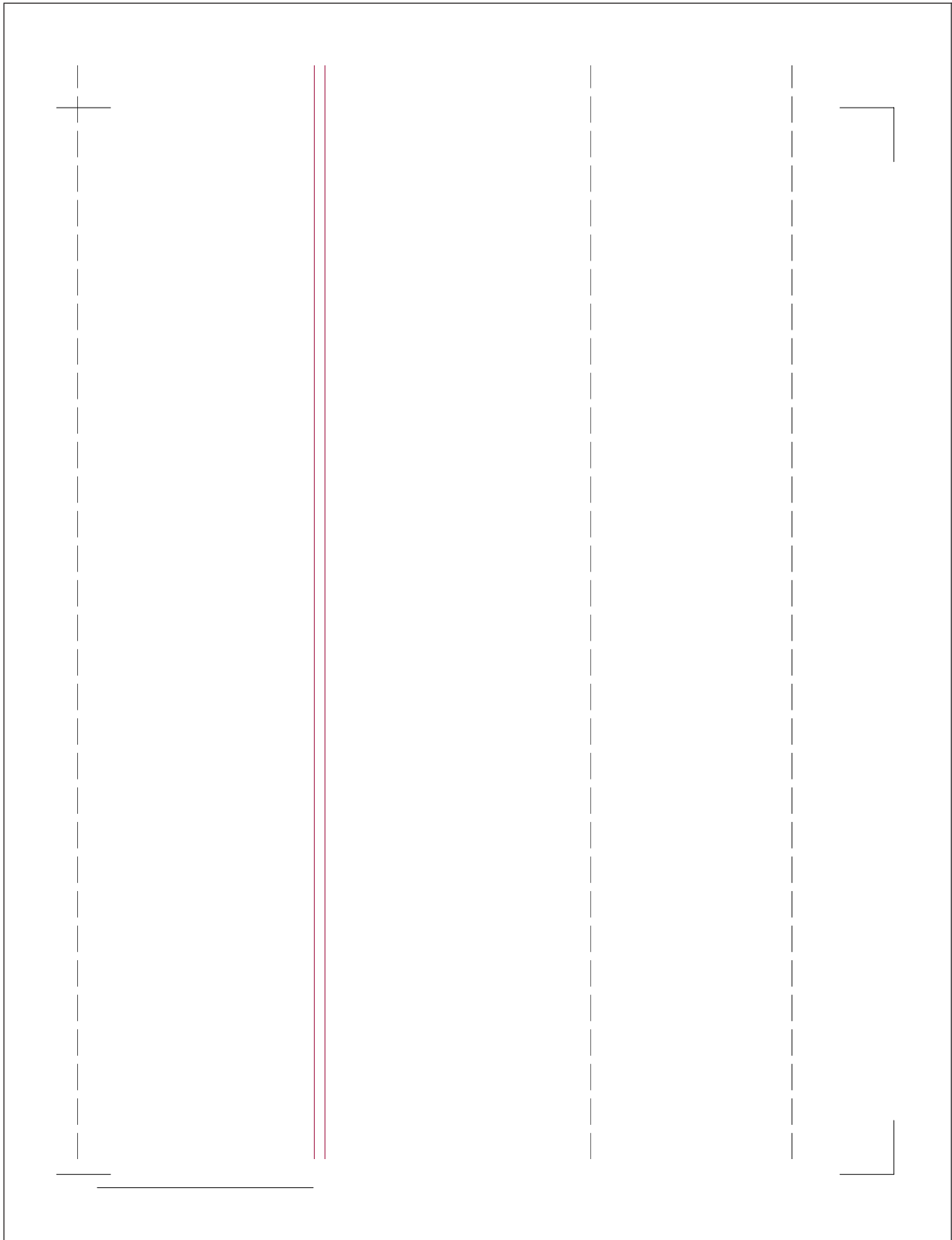


Figure 160. ProductOfferPriceUpdate sequence diagram, 23 of 26 (12,1)

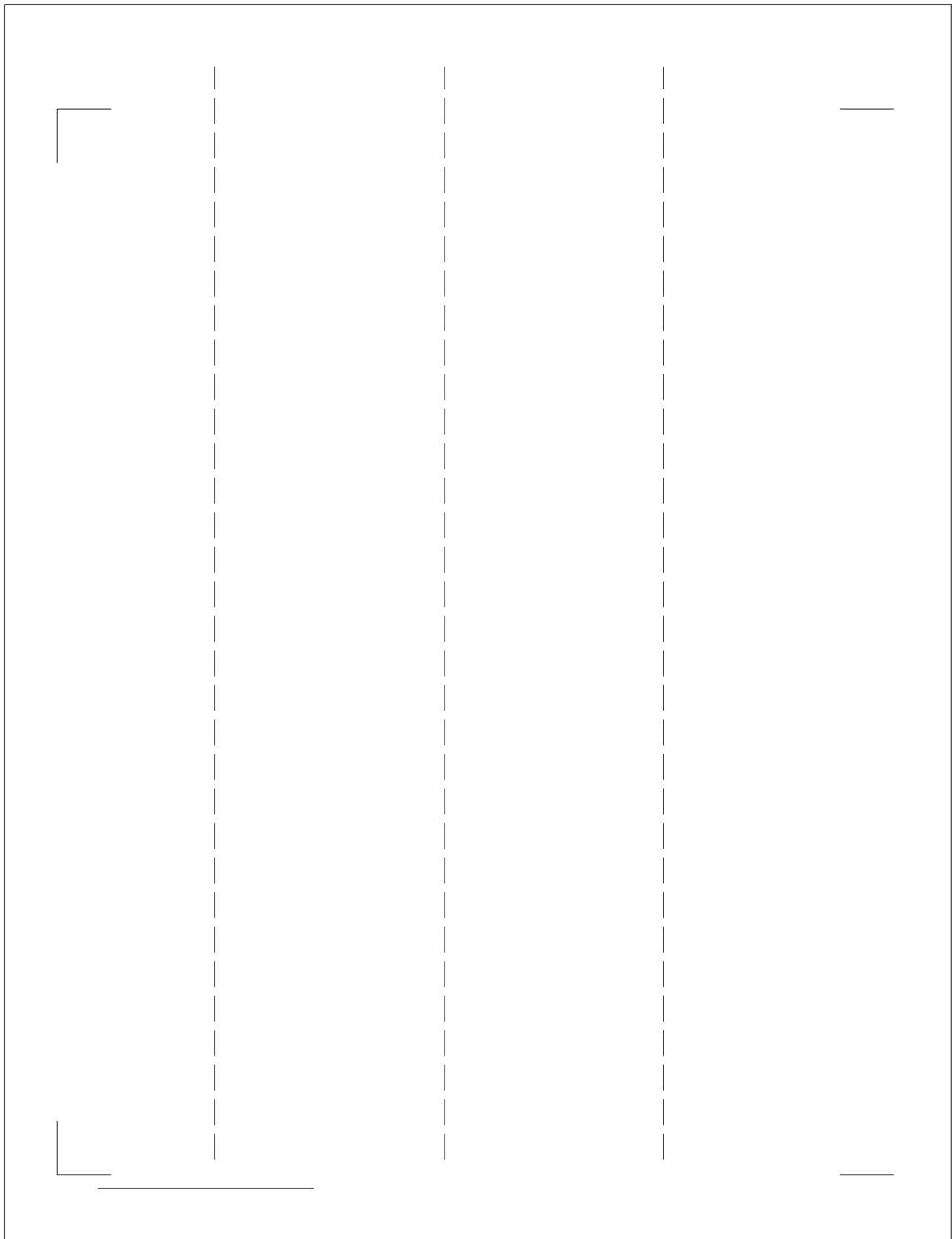


Figure 161. *ProductOfferPriceUpdate* sequence diagram, 24 of 26 (12,2)

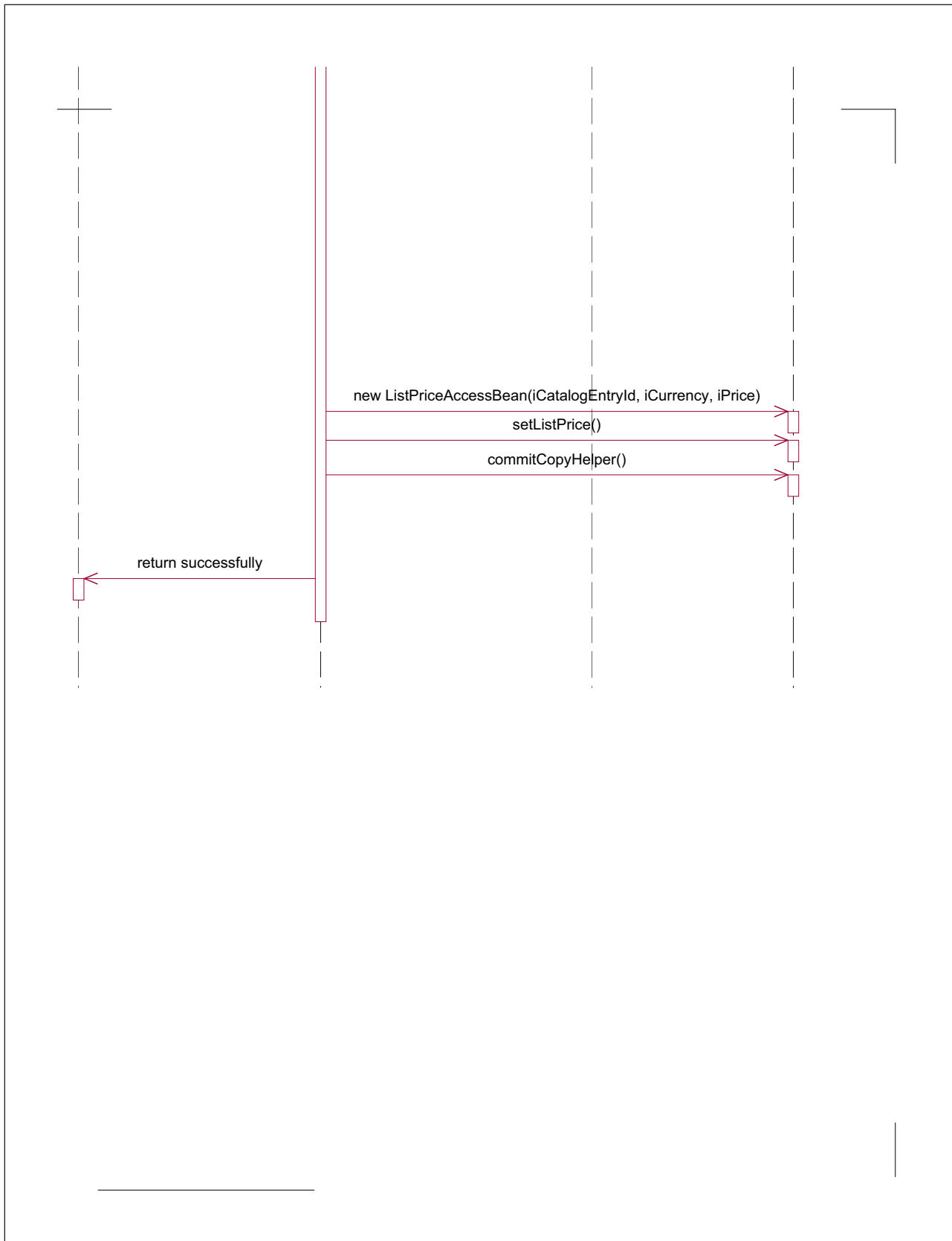


Figure 162. *ProductOfferPriceUpdate* sequence diagram, 25 of 26 (13,1)

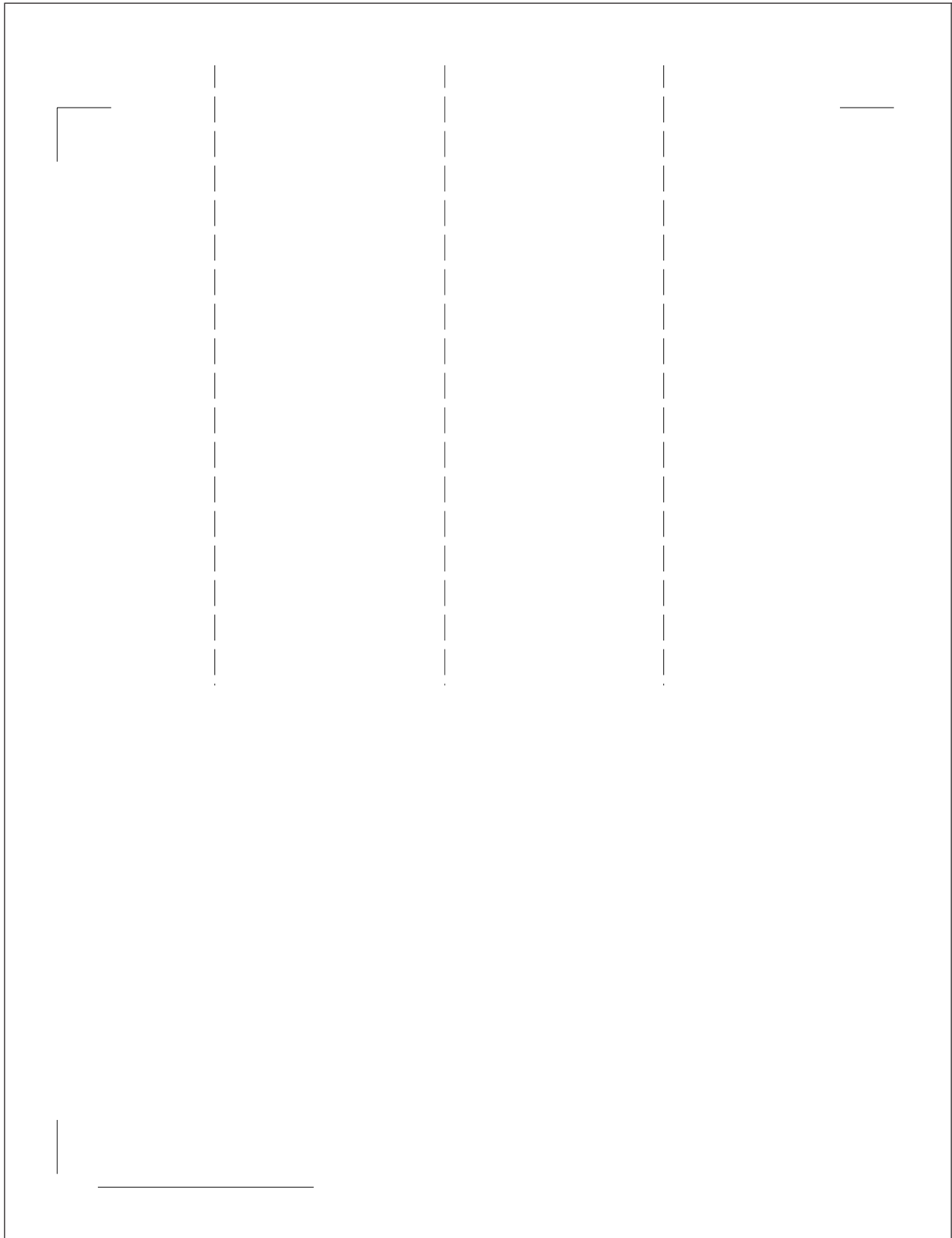


Figure 163. ProductOfferPriceUpdate sequence diagram, 26 of 26 (13,2)

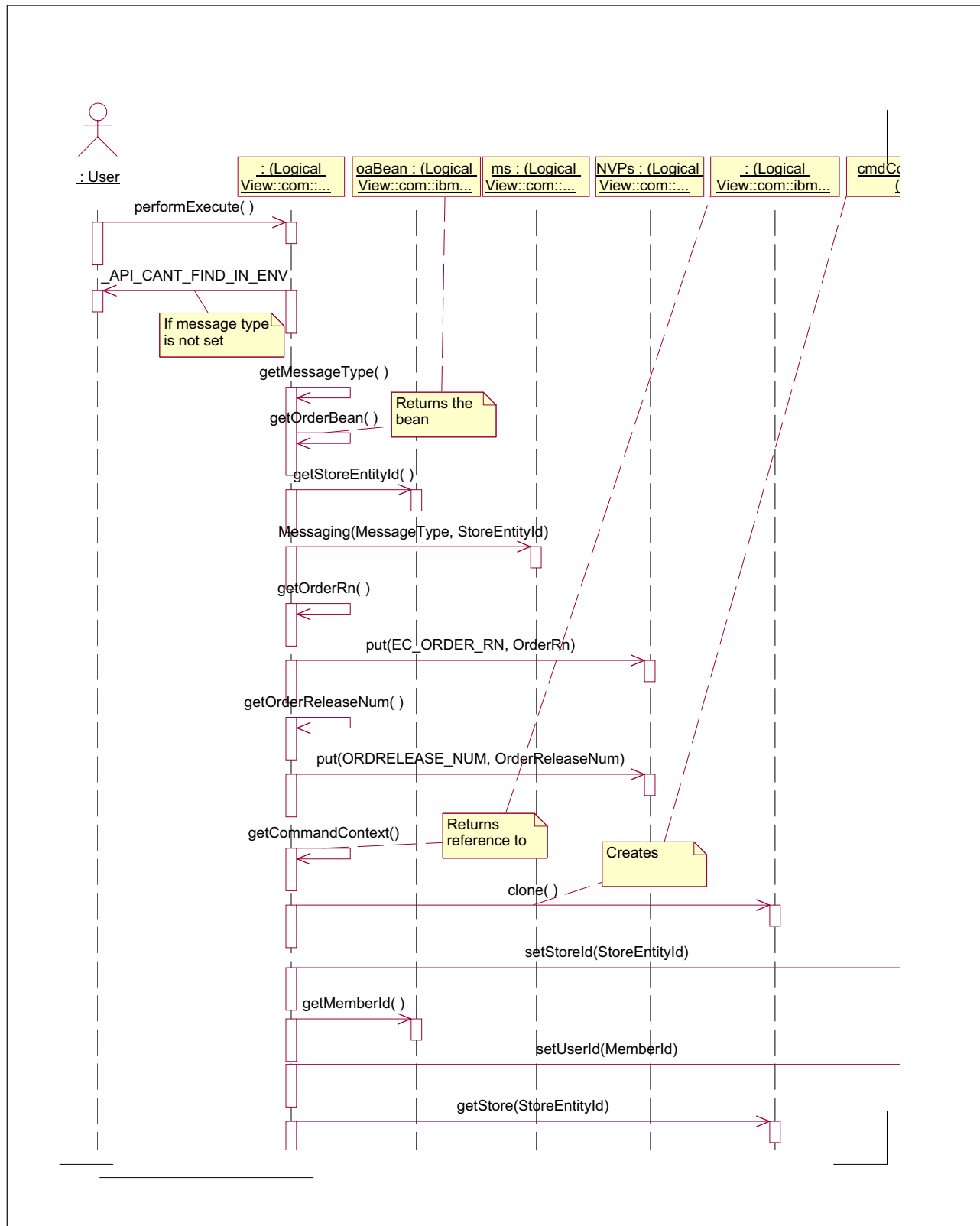


Figure 164. ReleaseShipNotify sequence diagram, 1 of 6 (1,1)

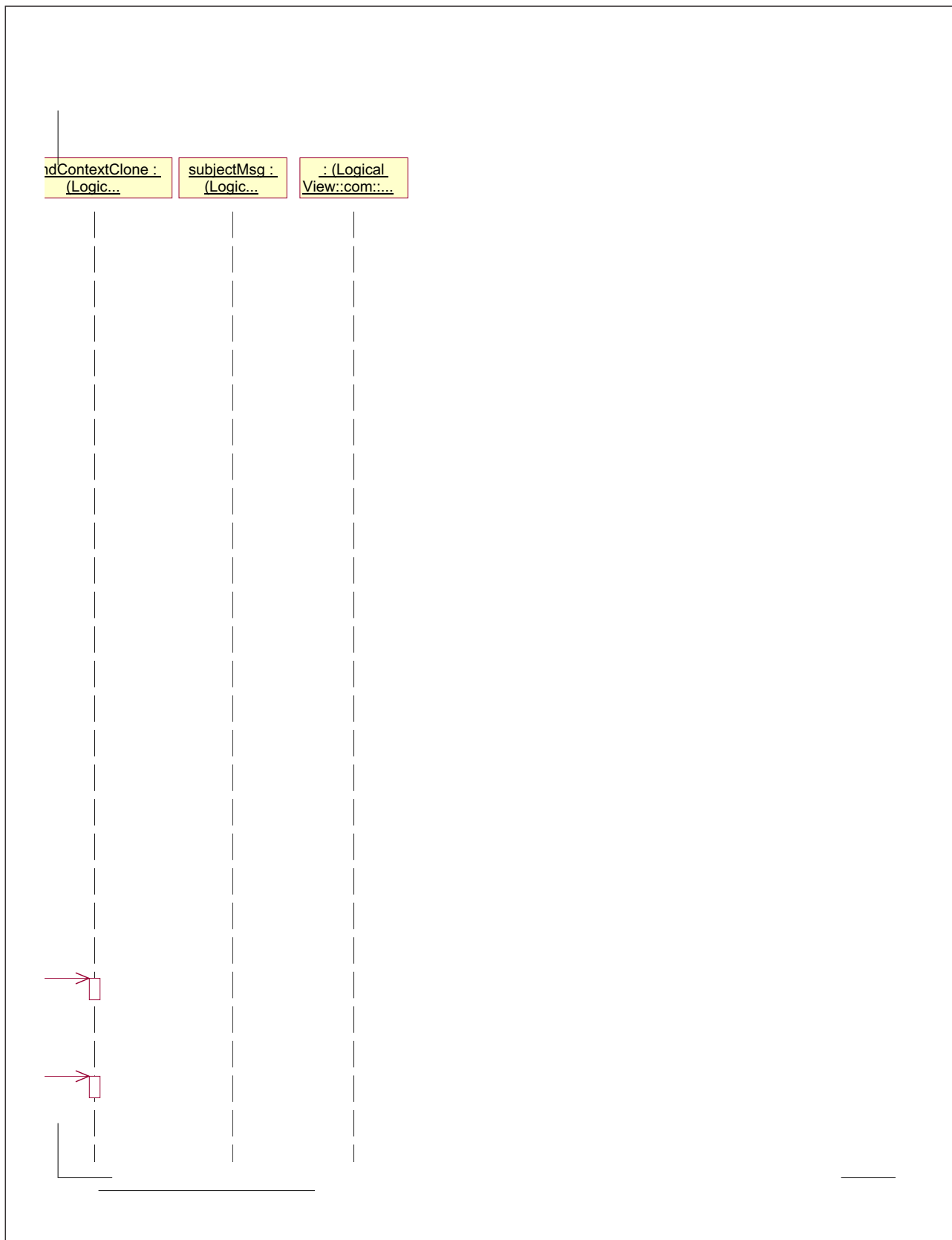


Figure 165. ReleaseShipNotify sequence diagram, 2 of 6 (1,2)

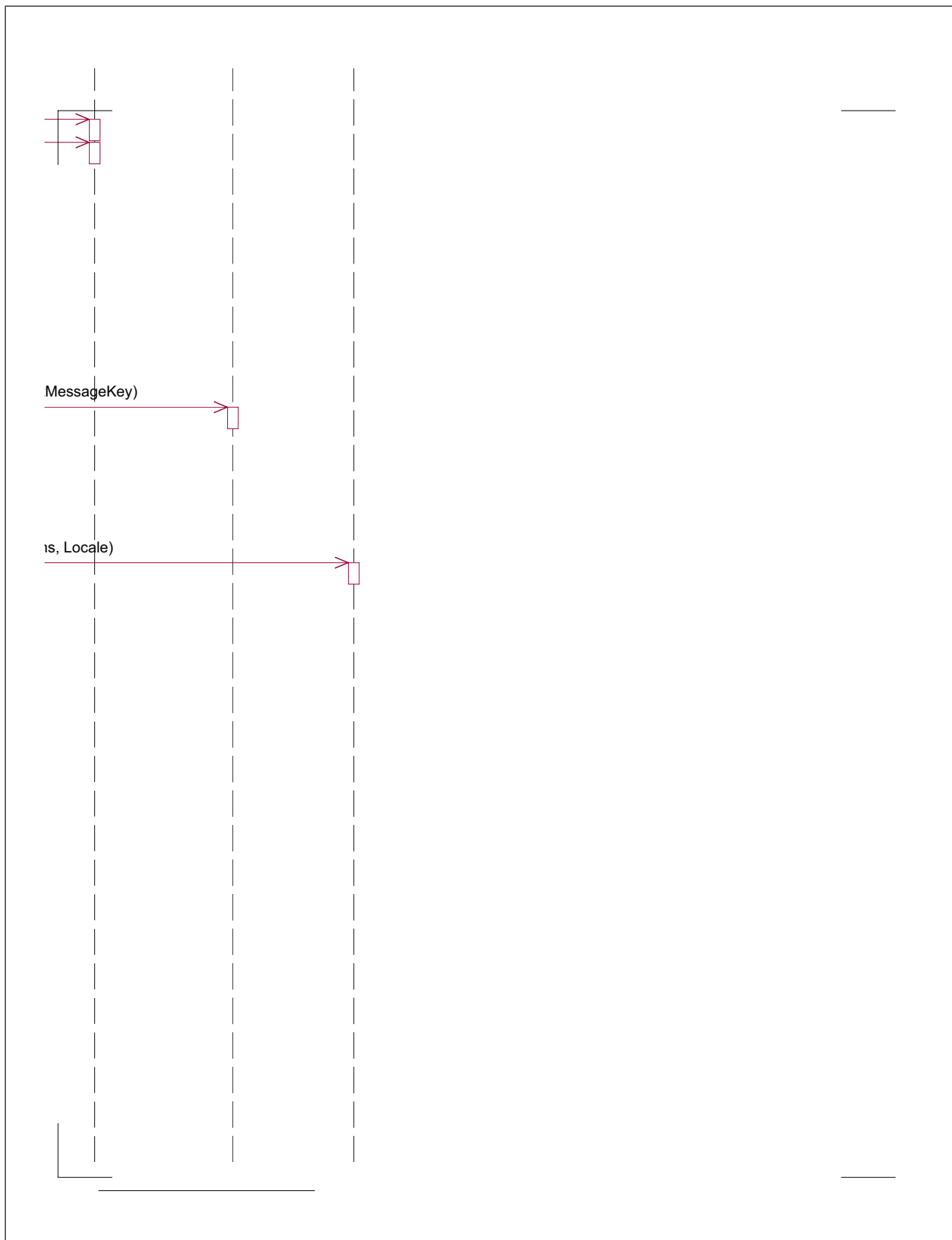


Figure 167. ReleaseShipNotify sequence diagram, 4 of 6 (2,2)

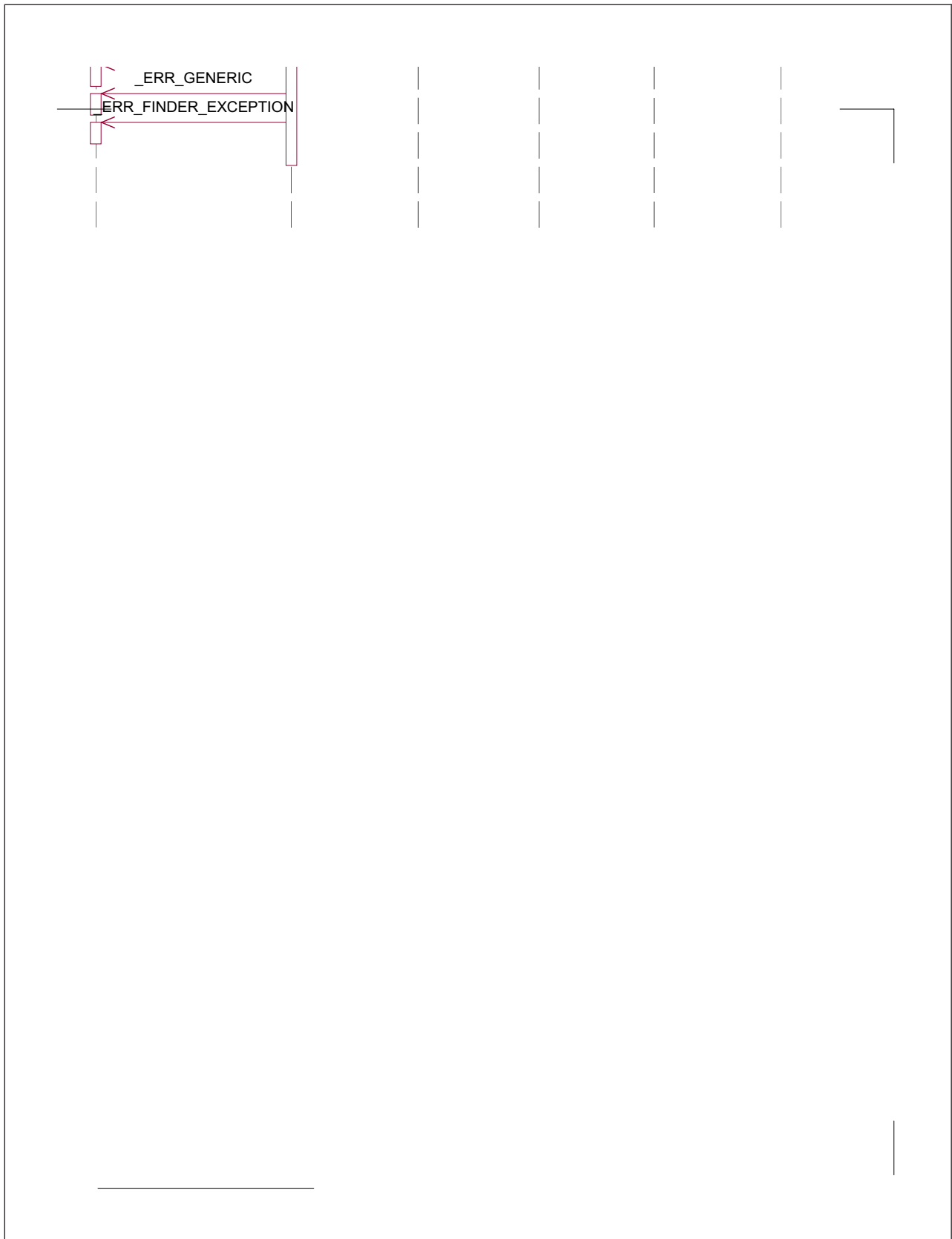


Figure 168. *ReleaseShipNotify* sequence diagram, 5 of 6 (3,1)

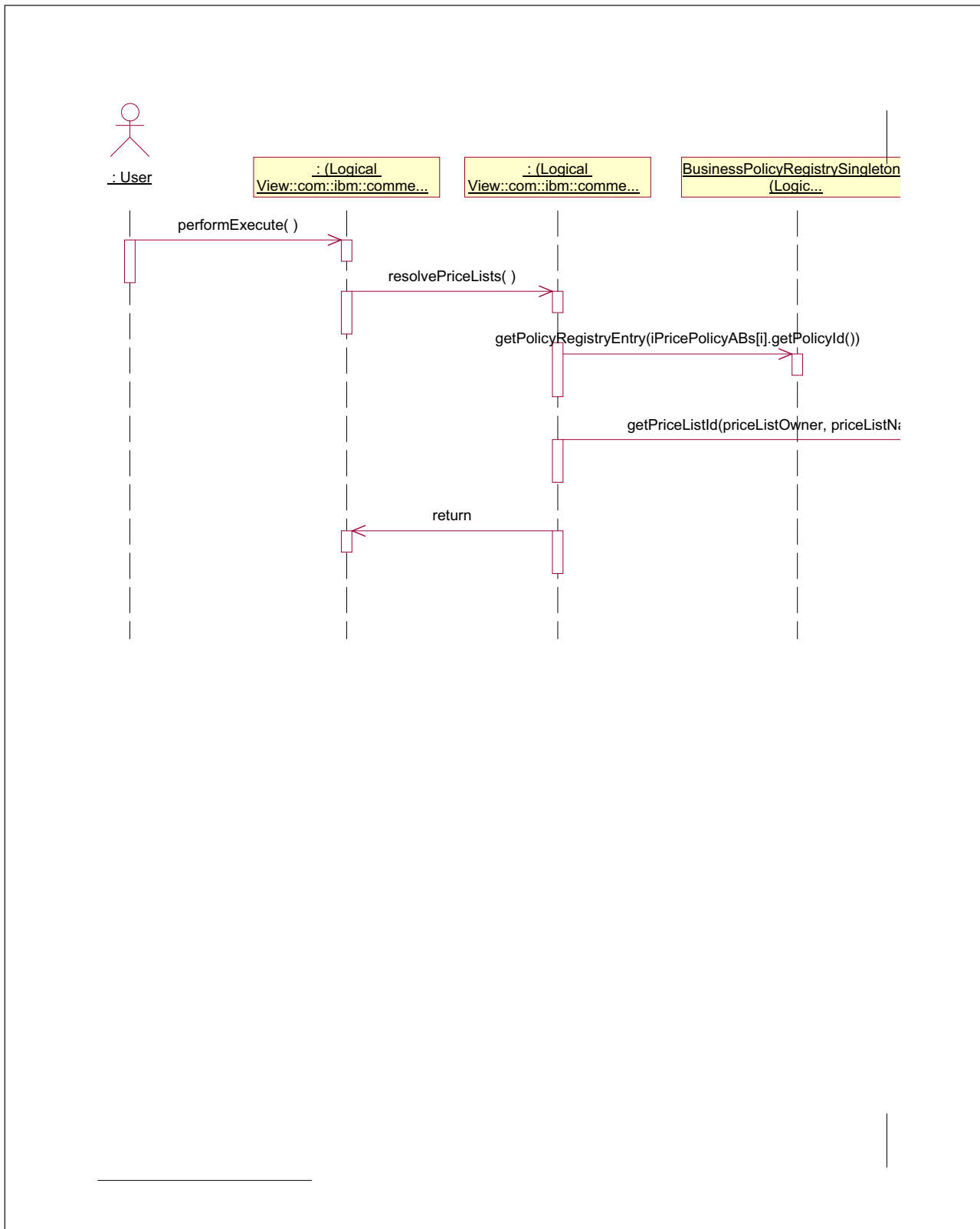


Figure 170. ResolvePriceLists sequence diagram, 1 of 2 (1,1)

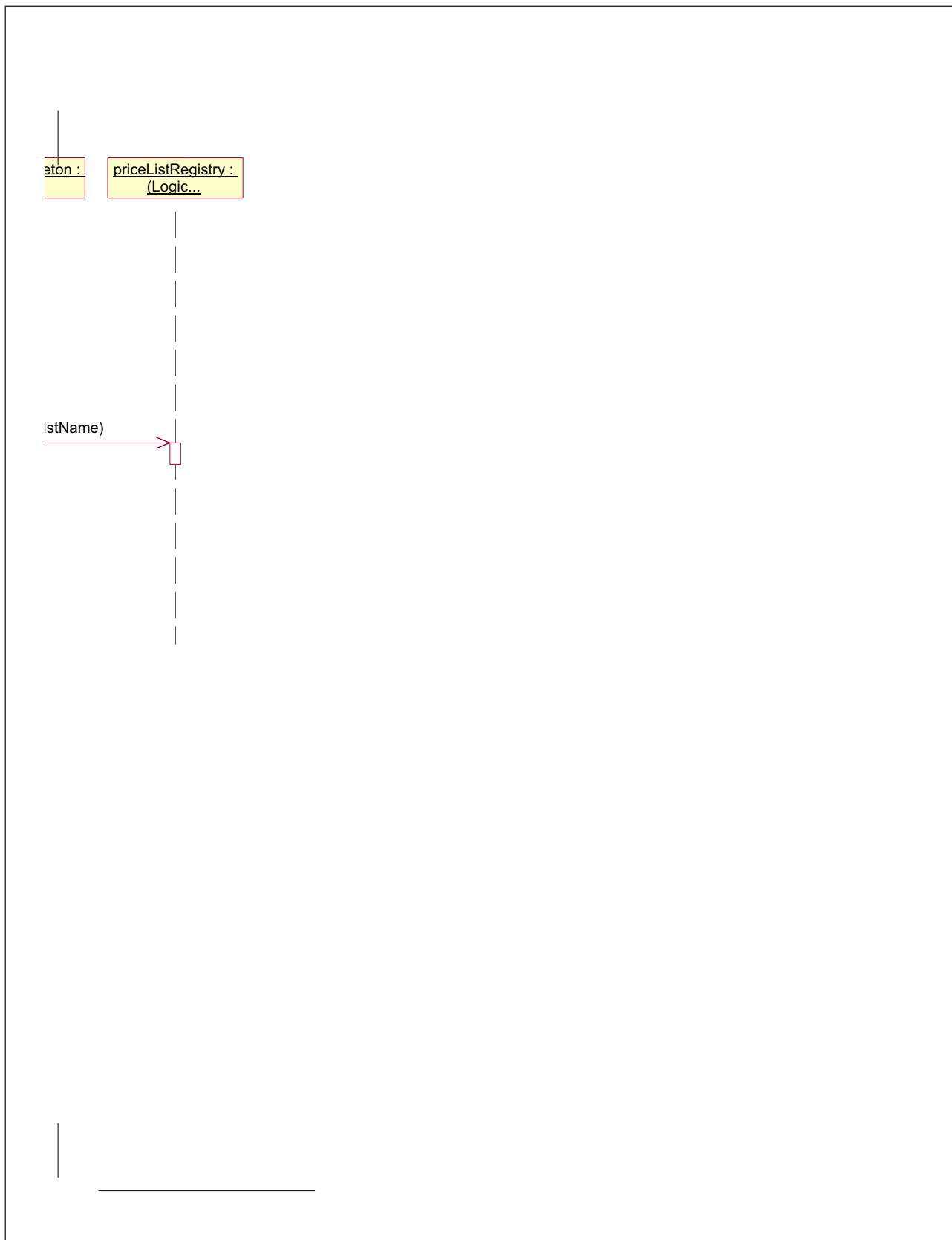


Figure 171. ResolvePriceLists sequence diagram, 2 of 2 (1,2)

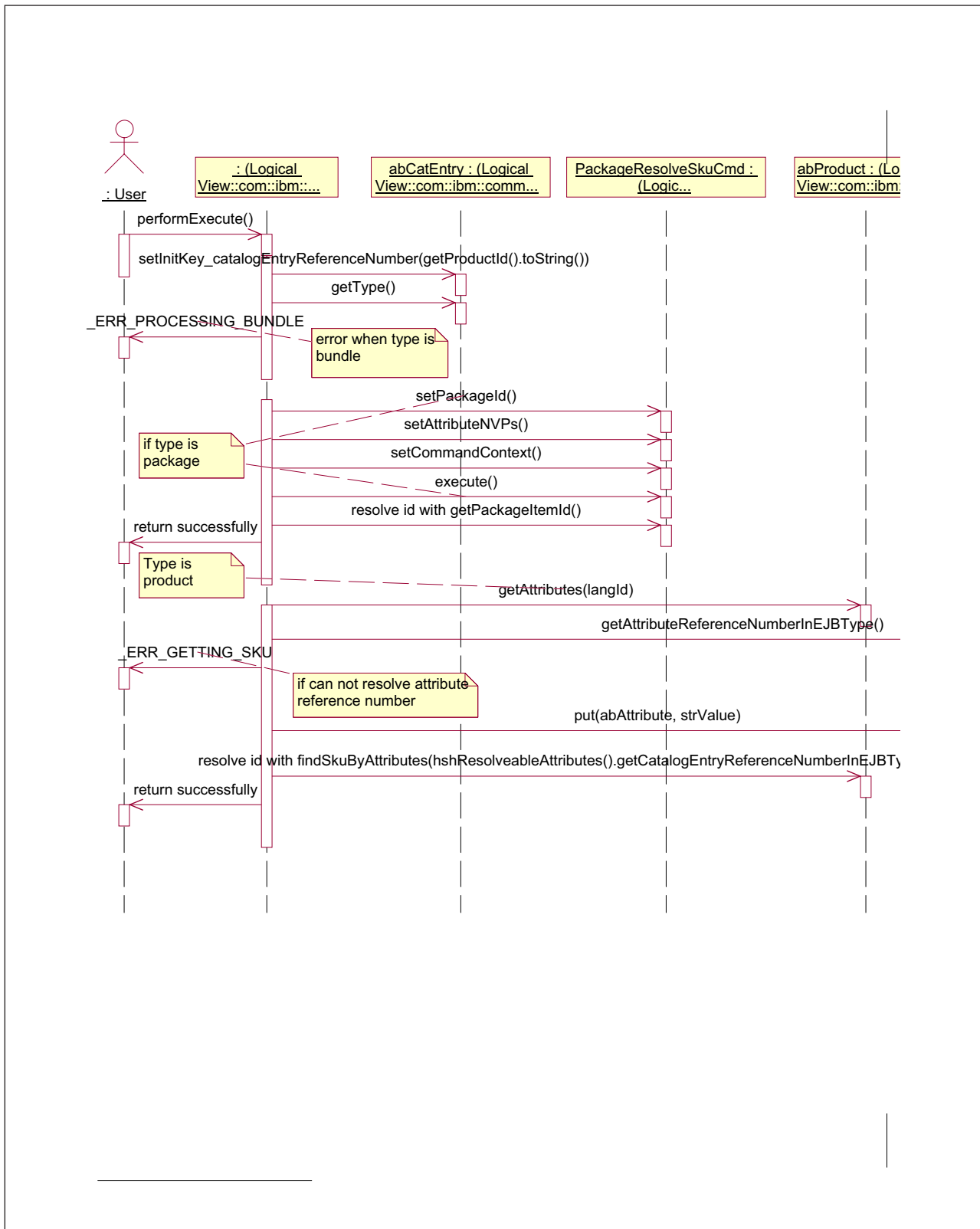


Figure 172. ResolveSKU sequence diagram, 1 of 2 (1,1)

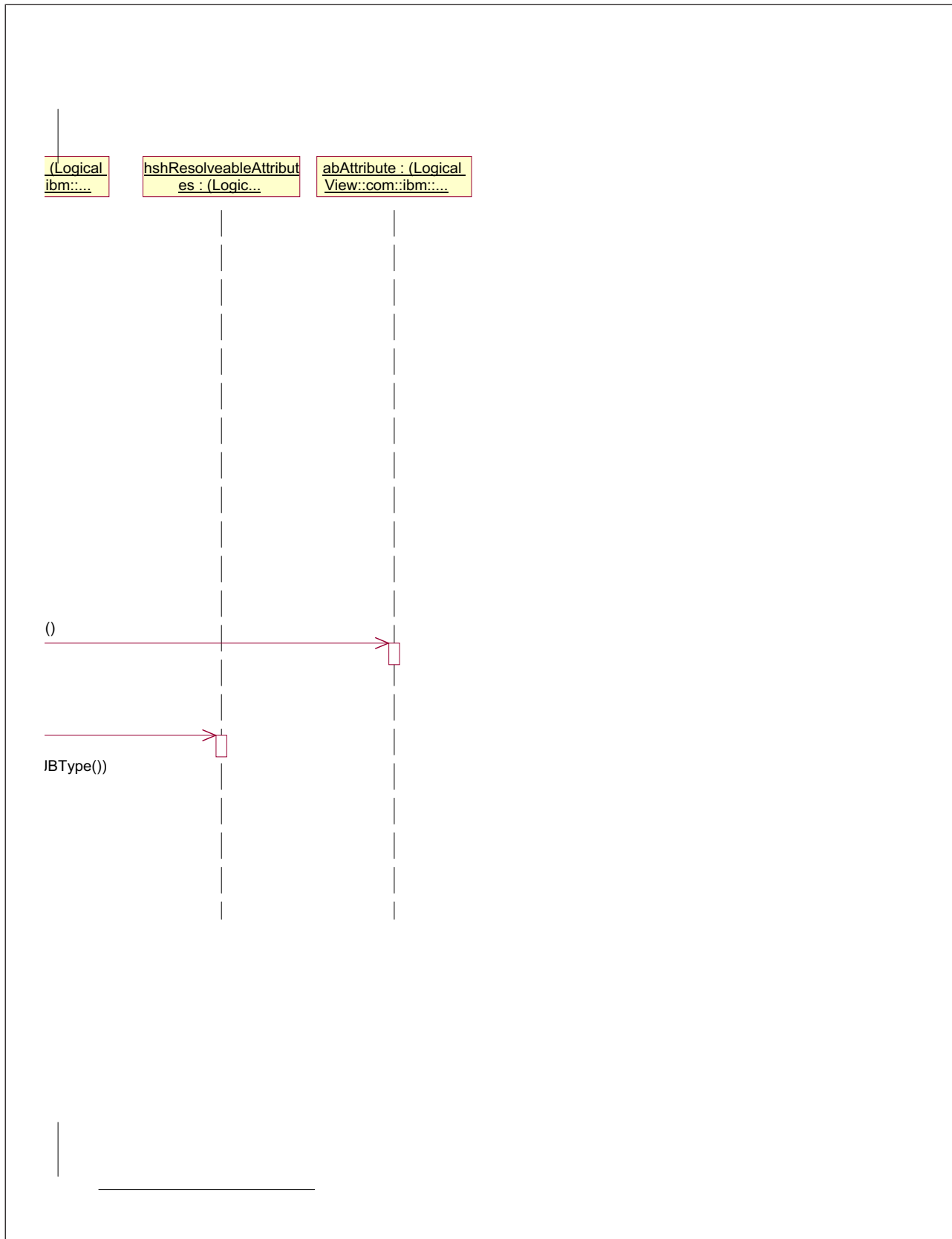


Figure 173. ResolveSKU sequence diagram, 2 of 2 (1,2)

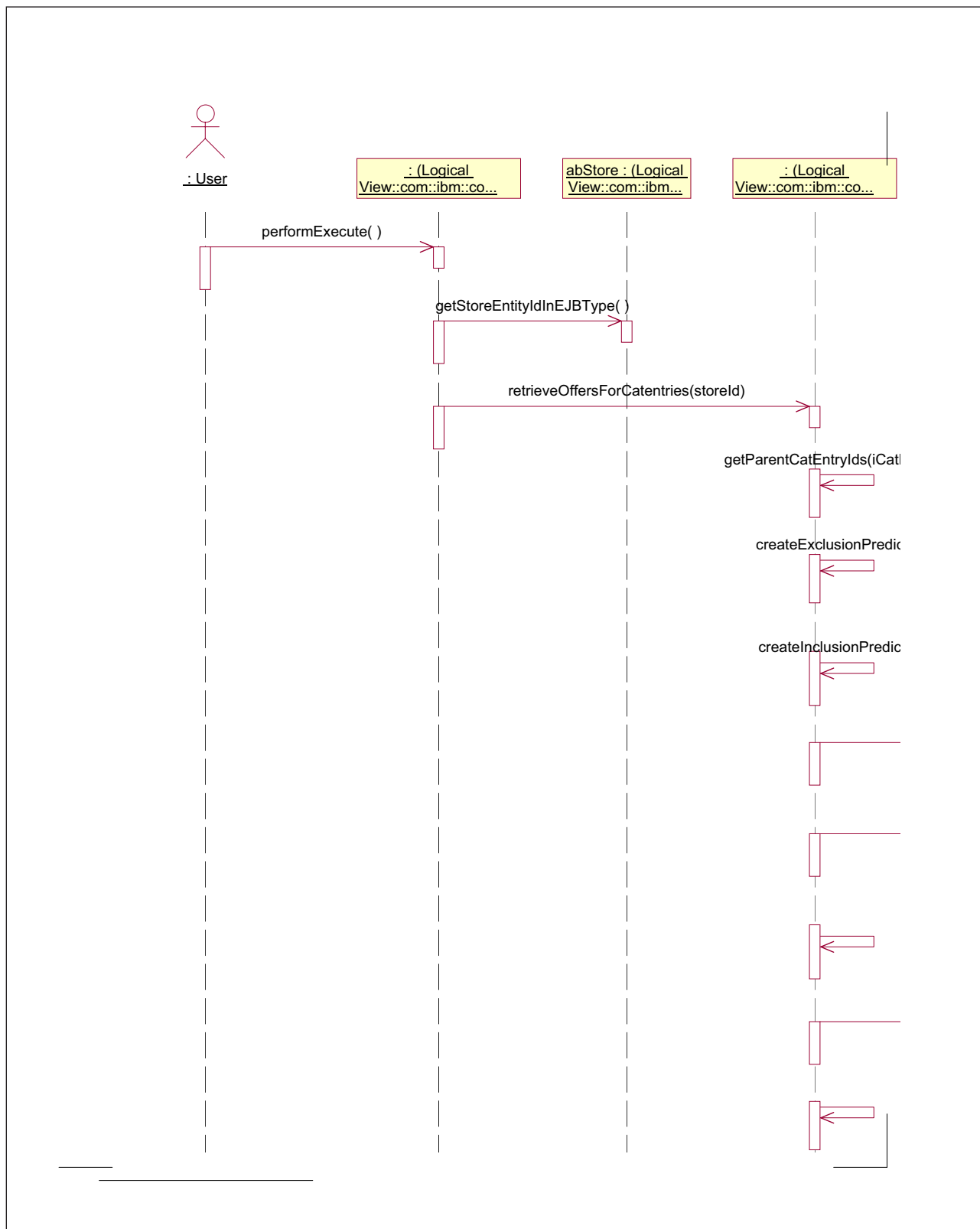


Figure 174. RetrievePrices sequence diagram, 1 of 4 (1,1)

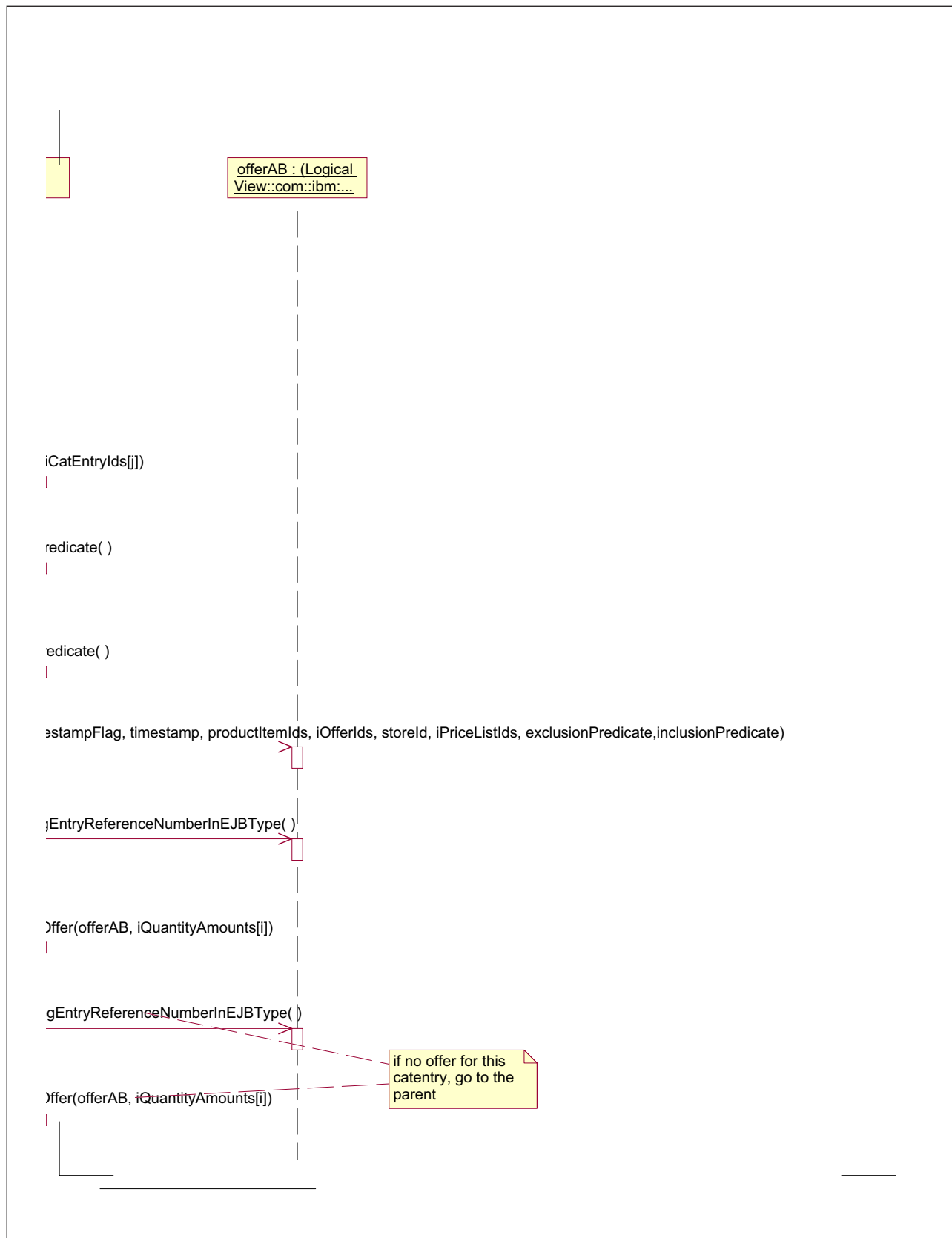


Figure 175. RetrievePrices sequence diagram, 2 of 4 (1,2)

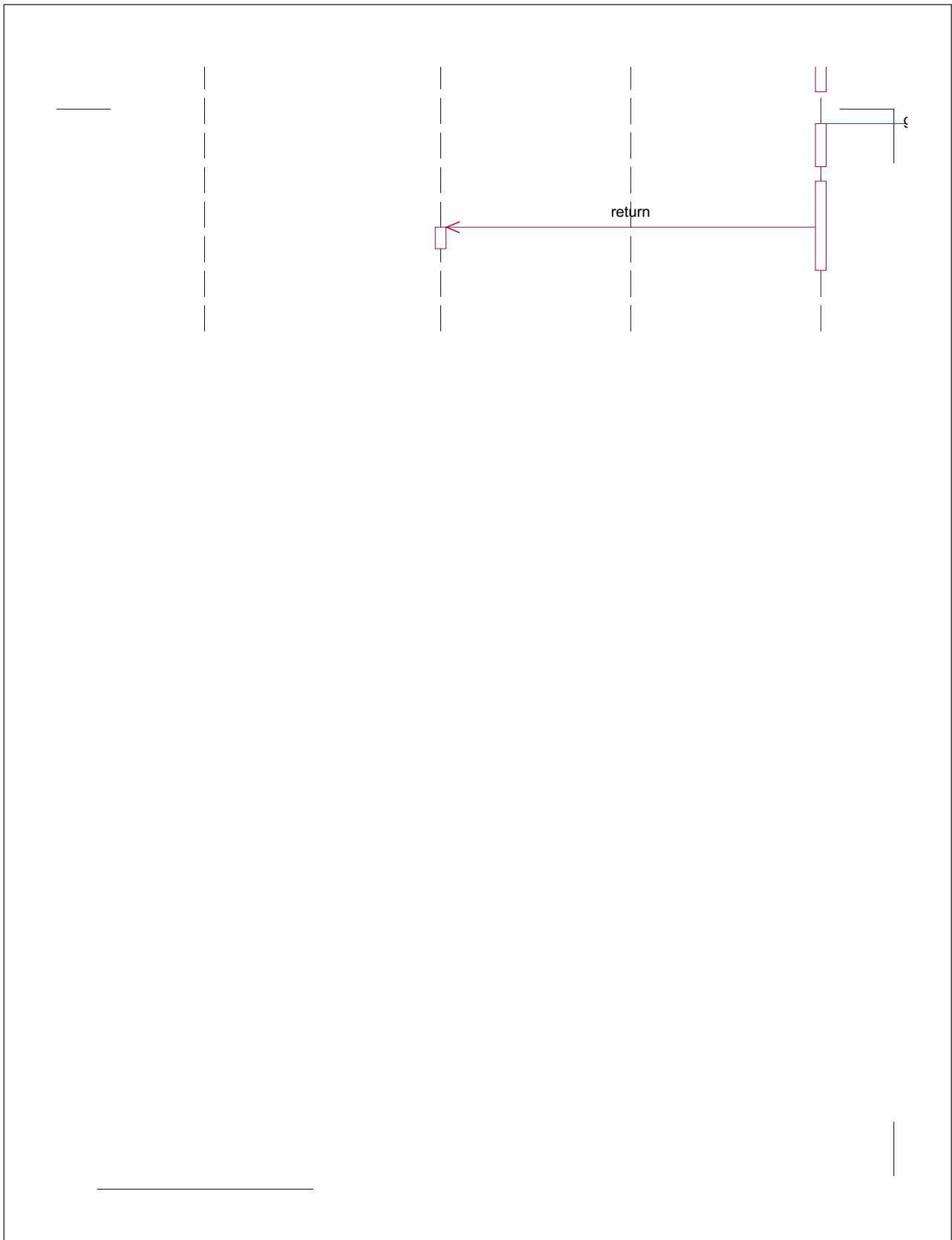


Figure 176. RetrievePrices sequence diagram, 3 of 4 (2,1)

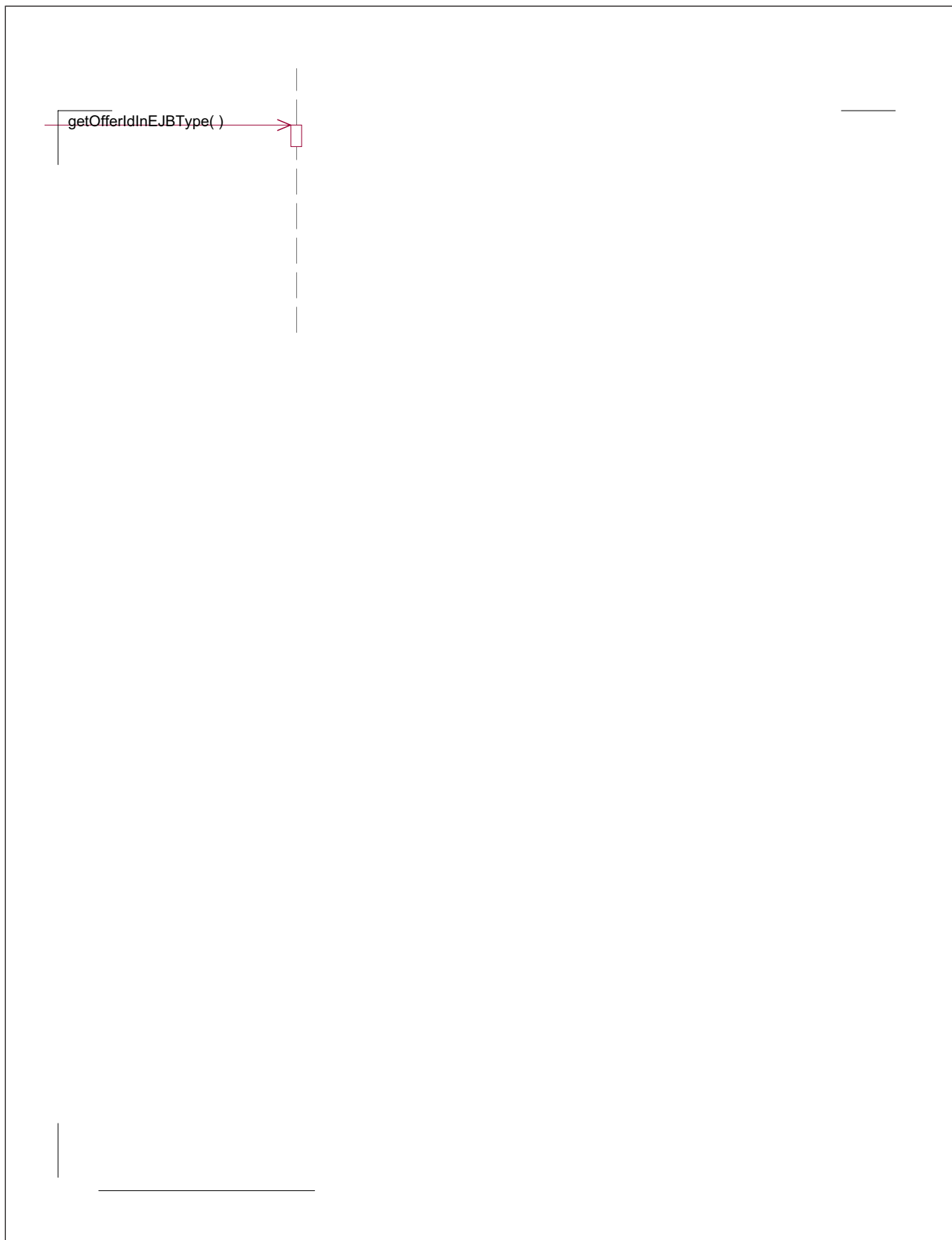


Figure 177. RetrievePrices sequence diagram, 4 of 4 (2,2)

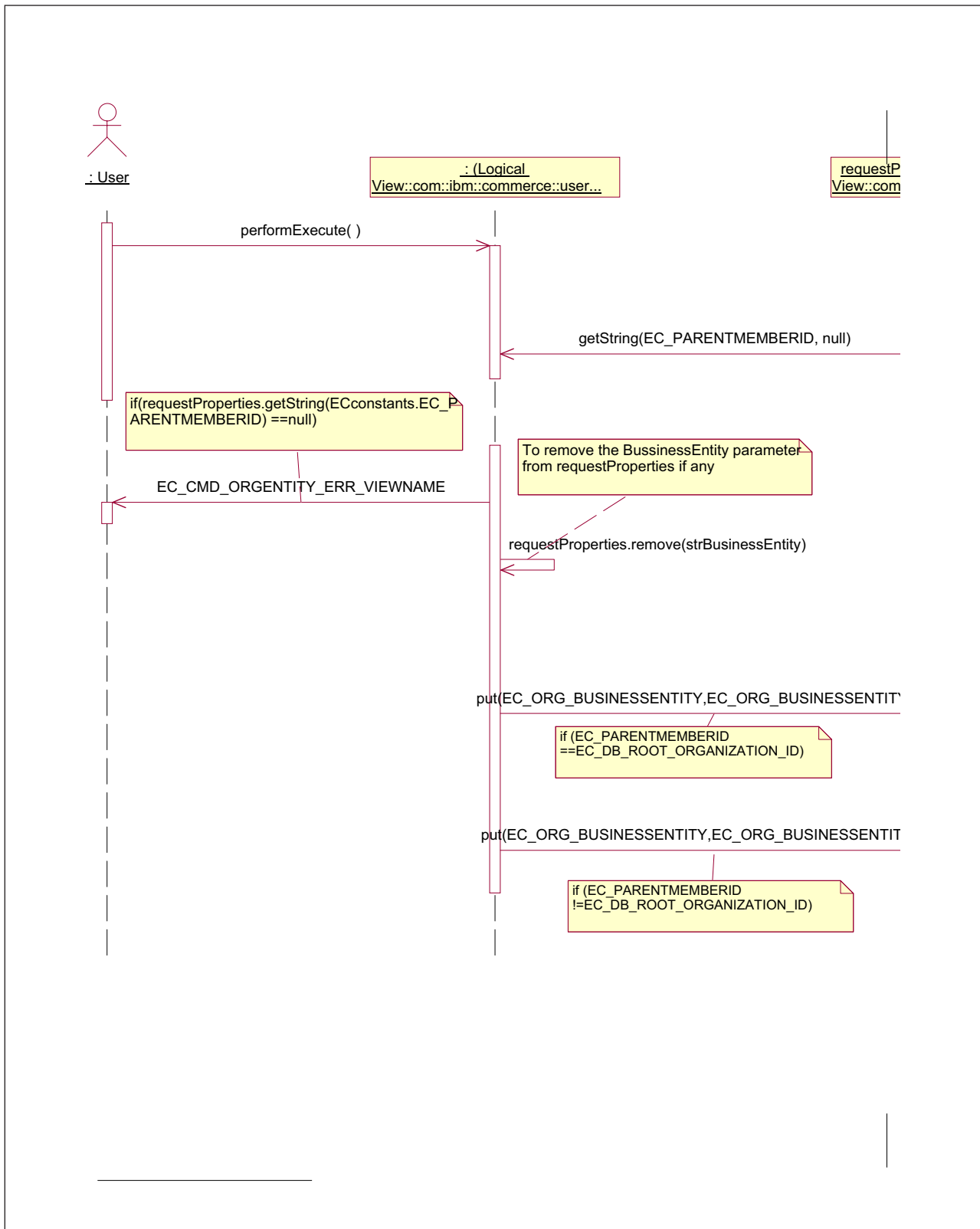


Figure 178. SendWCSOrder sequence diagram

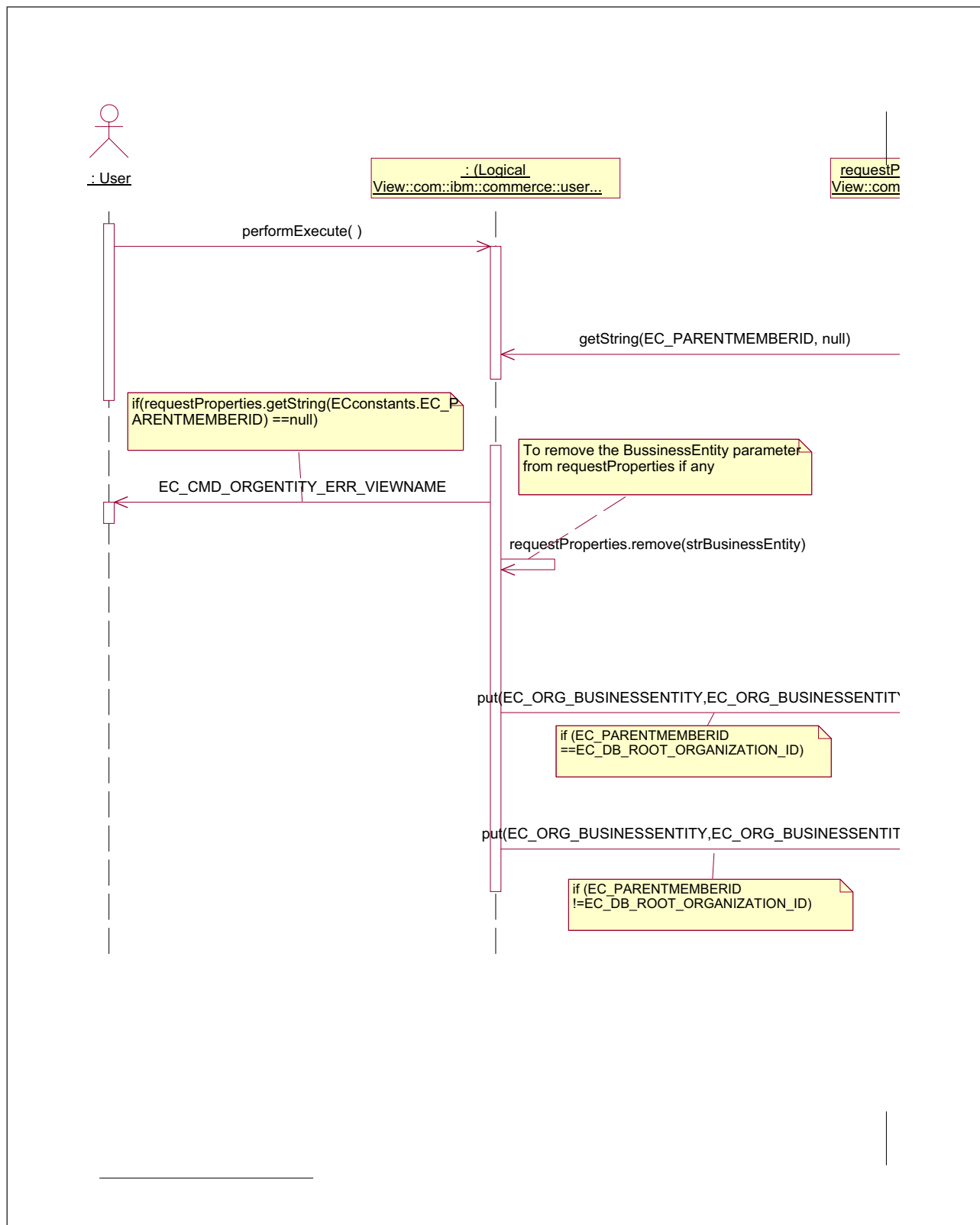


Figure 179. SetBusinessEntity sequence diagram, 1 of 2 (1,1)

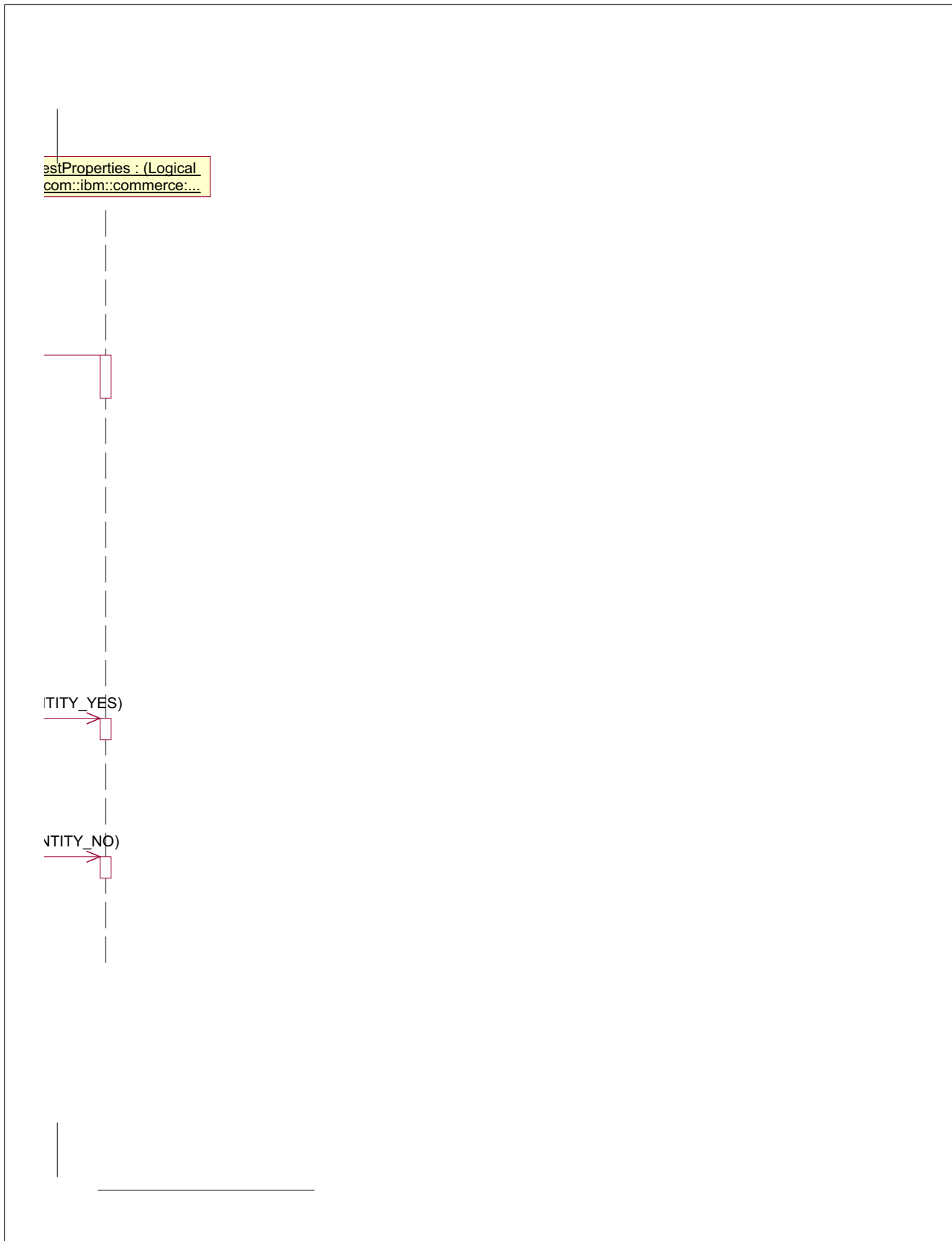


Figure 180. SetBusinessEntity sequence diagram, 2 of 2 (1,2)

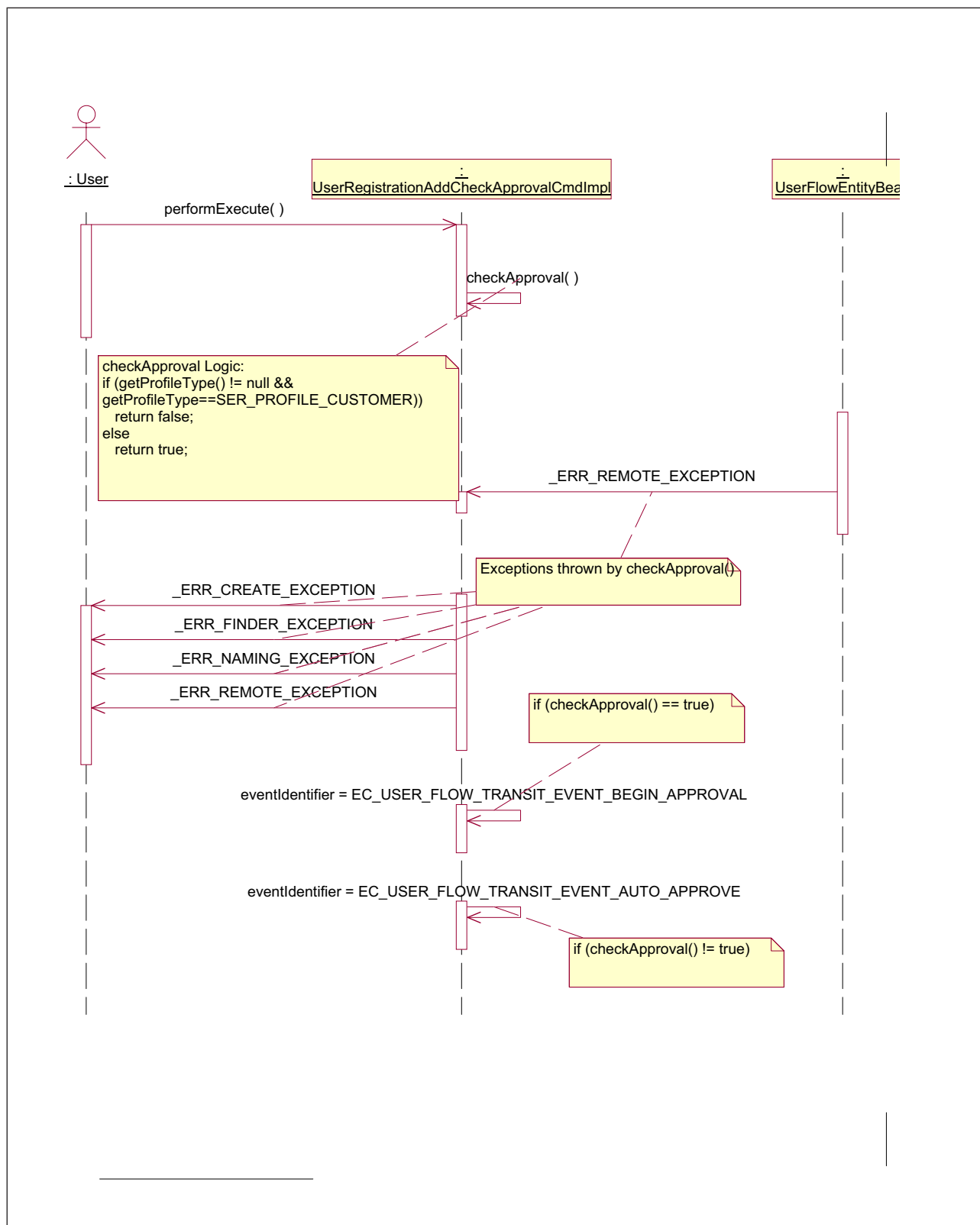


Figure 181. UserRegistrationAddCheckApproval sequence diagram
