To meet varied deployment environments, courses are available for specific operation platforms, including Windows, Linux and AIX.

WebSphere Application Server Community Edition

WebSphere Application Server Community Edition (CE) is a free, lightweight Java EE 5 application server that provides a readily accessible and flexible foundation for building Java applications. This course teaches you how to install and configure the server component and deploy business applications to it by covering server administration, security, clustering, messaging, Web services, the new Java Persistence Architecture, and Enterprise Java Beans (EJB) V3.0 specifications. You will also learn about the new features of Java EE 5 that are supported in WebSphere Application Server CE.

Application development for WebSphere Application Server and SOA
