Re: Your Agreement with ILOG – Transfer of Business Processes from ILOG to IBM, effective July 1, 2009

Dear Partner of ILOG,

On December 29, 2008, IBM completed the acquisition of ILOG.

We are pleased to report that the integration of ILOG continues to progress on schedule and would like to inform you that on **July 1, 2009**, we will finalize an important milestone in the integration known as "transfer of business." On that date, among other things, we will consolidate all transaction fulfillment activity into an IBM company that does business in your country. Your contracts with ILOG will be managed by IBM.

This means that we will be transitioning from ILOG processes and systems to IBM processes and systems, which include IBM software ordering; billing; course search and registration; and support renewals. Accordingly, from July 1, 2009, all documentation will be issued by IBM. Payment of any invoices after July 1, 2009, should be made to IBM, and complete payment details will be specified in the IBM invoices. Please note that as we move to IBM processes and systems, new orders for software and services and all renewals will be under IBM terms and conditions.
