Access

- Stores your basic contact information
- Includes preferences such as email notification
- Product and component lists are saved here
- Profile information automatically populates new Service Requests to let you get right to problem definition

Open, edit Service Requests

- Edit existing Service Requests from the Support Portal module
- Open new Service Requests using the link in the Support Portal module
- Choose product and component to submit directly to the right support queue
- Define the problem in your own words and describe the business impact
- Assign severity and attach one or more troubleshooting files
- Include names of others to be notified, as needed
- Receive email notification when updates are made

Search or create reports

- Search to quickly find existing Service Requests
- View all open Service Requests and those closed within a year
- Choose from 10 fields to display Service Request information
- Print reports or download in spreadsheet format
