CHARTER

STATE OF LOUISIANA - PARISH OF ORLEANS, CITY OF NEW ORLEANS

BE IT KNOWN, That on this 15th day of October, in the year of our Lord, One thousand nine hundred and six, and of the Independence of the United States of America, the one hundred and thirty first.

ARTICLE I. The name of this corporation shall be the OUBREUX LUMBER MANUFACTURING AND EXPORT COMPANY.

ARTICLE II. The objects and purposes for which this corporation is organized and established are hereby declared to be to buy, build, maintain and operate a saw mill and other facilities for the manufacture of all kinds of lumber, shingles, laths, and other kindred products.

ARTICLE III. The capital stock of this corporation is hereby fixed at ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00) divided into and represented by (500) shares of stock of the sum of One Hundred Dollars each.

ARTICLE IV. The name and title of the corporation hereby formed is declared to be the H. W. SLOAN COMPANY, LIMITED, under which name it shall carry on its corporate business.

ARTICLE V. All the corporate powers of said corporation shall be vested in and exercised by Board of Directors composed of not less than five nor more than ten members.

ARTICLE VI. All elections shall be by ballot, and held at the office of said corporation, under the supervision of the Secretary.

ARTICLE VII. Whenever this corporation may be dissolved, either by limitation or from any other cause, the Board of Directors shall have the right to sell or to exchange its stock in some other corporation, at such price and on such terms as to the Board may seem best.
