SUBJECT: Update Recommendation to a Transfer to the Control of Another Country for Continued Detention (TRCD) for Guantanamo Detainee, ISN: US9AF-000897DP (S)

1. (FOUO) Personal Information:

2. (FOUO) Health: He is in good health.

3. (S) Detainee Summary:

a. (S) Detention Information: Same as previously stated in JTF-GTMO CG memo, dated 11 November 2003.

b. (S) Prior Assessment: MG Geoffrey D. Miller, Commander JTF Guantanamo, recommended that detainee be retained for continued detention. This recommendation was based on the assessment that detainee was assessed as being a member of Hezib-e-Islami (HIG), and possibly being involved in a rocket attack on U.S. Fire Base Salerno.

c. (S) New Information:

- The detainee joined HIG for a brief 4 month period in the mid 1990s, after which he broke off his association.
- The detainee spent most of the 1990s involved with various Northern Alliance combat units, fighting the Taliban.
- The detainee is assessed as having no current ties to HIG.
- Further investigation revealed no links between the detainee and the rocket attack on U.S. Fire Base Salerno, which he was suspected of being involved in.

SUBJECT: (S) Recommendation for Guantanamo Detainee, ISN: US9AF-000897DP

- The other people arrested out of the same taxi have also been assessed as having no links to the rocket attacks.

d. (S) Intelligence Value: Detainee is assessed as having a minimal intelligence value.

4. (S) Detainee's Conduct: Detainee has shown minimal signs of non-compliance and minimal signs of aggressiveness.


5. (S) EC Status: Detainee's enemy combatant status is currently under review.

6. (S) JTF-GTMO New Assessment:

a. (S) Summary. Based on information collected and available to Joint Task Force Guantanamo as of 26 February 2004, detainee ISN: US9AF-000897DP is no longer assessed as being an HIG member. There is nothing linking the detainee to the rocket attack. It has been determined that the detainee poses a low risk as he is unlikely to pose a threat to the U.S., its interests or its allies.

b. (S) Recommendation: JTF-GTMO recommends this detainee be considered for transfer or release to the control of another government.

7. (S) Coordination: JTF-GTMO notified the Criminal Investigative Task Force (CITF) of the prior recommendation on 20 October 2003. CITF assessed the detainee as a low risk on 15 September 2003. Both JTF-GTMO and CITF agree on the threat assessment of this detainee as a low risk.
