MEMORANDUM OF CONVERSATION

PARTICIPANTS: Dr. ~~Secretary~~ Kissinger, Asst to P for NSA  
Amb. Huang Chen, PRC

DATE AND TIME: Friday, July 6, 1973  
10:15 am

PLACE: San Clemente, Calif.

Huang: Said Sihanouk hadn't gotten our messages.

Kissinger: We can't control Lon Nol group says. They know nothing about our conversations so on their part it is just speculation.

As I said, we propose ceasefire, if necessary, for only 90 days. This would take care of realities of the situation. We have no interest in Cambodia - we agree with the Prime Minister's statement to Bruce. We would welcome government friendly and Peking and one which would refuse to participate in great power negotiations. But it is a delicate problem for us - how to encourage the situation. If we are pushed into an undignified position it will make it difficult for us to do other things over the next 2 or 3 years which may be necessary. It (be ended?) is important that Cambodia \_\_\_\_\_ in a way not unnecessarily \_\_\_\_\_ for the United States. We take care not to embarrass you publicly. 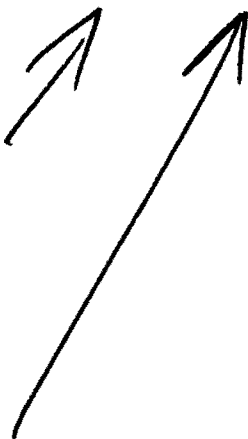

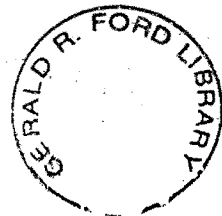

If I would call Bob Hope <sup>with HAK w/ Pres</sup>. HAK in w/ Pres. If Hope could say a few words tonight it would be very nice - would help w/ his visit to China at a few Chinese jokes but jokes about China. HAK w/ Pres.

We will stop all speculation about a Cham visit in the interim (hope my visit to Peking)

- A- Said Sihanouk hadn't gotten any message.
- K- We can't contact Lon Nol group sup. They know nothing about an evacuation as on their part just speculation.

As said, we propose ~~to~~ confer, if we. for only 9 days. This would turn conf resolution of it. We have no interest in Cambodia - we agree w/ P.M. statement to Borne. We would welcome govt power to Peking & one which would open to part in govt power beginning. That is a delicate problem for us - how to manage & structure. If we are pushed into an undisputed position it will worsen it big. For us to do other things over next 2-3 yrs which may be useful. It is important that Cambodia be included in a way not unnecessarily wounding for US. We take care not to embarrass you publicly. It is not in our interest to create conditions which are unnecessarily diff. for both sides.
