AMERICAN ARCHIVES.-The National Intelligener of the 6th, says: Peter Force, Feq., has recently completed the seventh volume (or first of the fifth series) of his great work on the documentary history of the origin and progress of the North American Colonies, and of the Revolution and Constitution of the United States.

The period embraced by this series extends from the Declaration of Independence to the definitive treaty of peace with Great Britain in 1783. Some two hundred copies have aiready been delivered to the Secretary of State, and the entire complement, consisting of 1500 vol-umes, will be ready in the course of the present month. Of this whole number, betwee eleven and twelve hundred will be distribute to the Governors and Legislatures of all the States in the Union, and also to all the colleges, States in the Union, and amo to an the coneges, antenumms, and other prominent institutions of the land. The present volume, like all in predecessors, is handsomely printed on the best paper, and not only occupies about 900 folio pages, but is embellished with fac-aintiles of the Declaration of Independence, and other valua-ble documents. Mr. Force, as many of our Declaration of Independence, and other valuable documents. Mr. Force, as many of our readers are aware, is engaged upon this important national work by the authority of Congress, and his labor has been limited to preparing twenty volumes. The masgraids for thirteen volume remain to be collected and arranged; and it is the intention of the editor to publish, if possible, one volume per anoun until his task shall have been accomplished. If may be however, that he will complete the remaining volumes in ten years. Mr. Force has his antiquarian agents in all the older States of the Union, and the amount of money be has to expend for copying the State records is very considerable. We have seen, for example, one pile of manuscripts (which a strong man could carry in his arms) which cost the handsome little sum of \$1000, and, in Mr. Force's antique library, we doubt not there are manuscripts which would weigh one or two tons. The lebox upon which Mr. Force is engaged is very extensive, and eminently valuable, and, when completed, will undoubtedly stand unrivalled, in point of completeness, by any historical collection.
