

A FORTUNE TO HUMANITY

Vast Bequest of Alfred Noble, an Inventor of Sweden.

Leaves a Big Fortune the Interest on Which is for Advancement of Science and Literature.

Some interesting details of the vast bequest made to the public by Noble, the inventor, have been made public by the state department.

Alfred Noble, who recently died in Sweden, provided in his will, dated at Paris, November 27, 1895, for the devotion of between 30,000,000 and 35,000,000 kroner for the advancement of science and literature, and it is thought that at five per cent. per annum the interest from the bequest will amount to \$240,000, or more.

Each individual piece will therefore be worth between \$48,000 and \$55,000. Some of the heirs at law are contesting the will, and this probably will delay the distribution of the prizes.

The following is an abstract from the will: "My total remaining fortune when capitalized shall be disposed of in the following work:

"When the capital has been converted into a good security by the trustee it shall form a fund, the interest of which shall be distributed annually as prizes to those persons who shall have rendered humanity the best service during the past year. The interest shall be divided into five equal portions which shall be distributed as follows:

He continues: "Obtain from healthy grain well cooked bread. Eat sparingly of chickens, lamb and beef, which are most nourishing to the body. Meat should be tender and without abundant sauces or root vegetables, which spoil it."

"Fresh eggs are excellent, rather raw or slightly cooked. Drink an abundant quantity of foaming milk; it nourishes infants and assists old age. Also honey, the celestial gift, but of this frugally."

"Add to these sweet herbs, fresh vegetables and garden supplies. Add ripe fruit according to season, especially tender apples, which, with their pink tints, brighten the banquet."

"Lastly comes drink, which in hard seeds of Mocha, renders you a softy sipping, black liquor that comforts the heart."

The pope adds that by following these precepts a man may live to a healthy, strong and good old age.
