



Le conformateur Peyry A LA NOUVELLE-ORLEANS.

Le "Conformateur Peyry" est le système du vingtième siècle; c'est ce qui fait aux tailleurs pour hommes et pour femmes, aux modistes en robes et aux dames qui désirent confectionner elles-mêmes leurs vêtements.

Cette invention rivalise avec la machine à coudre quant à son utilité; et toutes les personnes qui s'intéressent à la coupe, à la confection et à l'élégance des vêtements des deux sexes, trouveront ce système scientifique d'une grande valeur pour le coupeur de peu d'expérience, et d'une grande utilité pour une personne expérimentée qui, ayant obtenu succès et renommée, désire pousser son savoir jusqu'à la perfection.

Le "Conformateur Peyry" est un système d'une grande précision appliqué à la coupe des vêtements, avec ou sans coutures. Il fonctionne de deux manières: s'ajuste aux mesures prises sur la personne et se conforme à toutes les courbes et lignes du corps; s'ajuste aussi en plaçant sur la personne même et prend les contours du corps horizontalement et verticalement. Breveté en 1899, et médaille à l'Exposition Universelle de Paris en 1900, il est donc universellement recommandé. Le système est expliqué par un livre finement renfermant 1013 différents diagrammes et dessins. Les dames et les messieurs pourront à première vue en comprendre les secrets, et quelques explications et un peu de pratique les rendront maîtres de cet art de la coupe. Des diplômes seront donnés aux élèves qui suivront un cours complet.
