


Cooperation with OpenStreetMap



- Wikipedia wants to have maps inside articles
- These maps should be optimized for wikipedia content and contain special informations
- We want to geocode more than point objects
- So Wikimedia Deutschland e.V. sponsored last year a server in toolserver-cluster to experiment with OSM-data.

- Wikipedia get the data and maps and can use the whole software stack




