LES IMMENSES CANONS DE PERSHING

SONT PLUS PUISSANTS QUE CEUX DES ALLEMANDS.

L'Autricho-Hongrois par l'entremise de son nouveau Ministre des Affaires Etrangères, le comte Andrássy, a envoyé une note au Secrétaire Lansing lui demandant d'intervenir auprès du Président Wilson pour un armistice sur tous les fronts et pour le commencement des négociations de paix.

Le gouvernement Autro-Hongrois a envoyé sa dernière note aux Français, aux Anglais, aux Italiens et aux Japonais suppliant ces nations de leur accorder leur appui.

La note était ainsi conçue : "Immédiatement après avoir pris charge du ministère des affaires étrangères et après l'avoir expédiée la réponse officielle à votre note du 18 octobre, 1918 par laquelle vous pouvez voir que nous adhérons en tout les principes énoncés par le Président Wilson dans ses diverses déclarations et et que nous sommes en accord avec le Président dans ses efforts pour empêcher les guerres à l'étranger et pour la création d'une Ligue des nations, nous avons pris les mesures nécessaires à fin que les Autrichiens et les Hongrois puissent selon leurs désirs, et sans être aucunement entraînés, décider de leur organisation future."

"Dès qu'il sera possible, il sera décidé que l'Empereur et le Roi Charles est monté sur le trône, il n'a en aucun cas de faire cesser la guerre. Plus que jamais c'est le devoir du peuple de l'Autriche-Hongrie, qui reconnaît que sa destinée future ne peut être accompagnée que dans la paix et quand le peuple sera délivré des dissensions, des privations et des chagrins occasionnés par la guerre."

"Voici pourquoi, je m'adresse à vous personnellement. Moi, le Secrétaire à l'Etat, vous priant d'intervenir auprès du Président des Etats-Unis afin que dans l'intérêt de l'humanité et d'apaiser l'hostilité de tous ceux qui habitent dans l'Autricho-Hongrois un armistice puisse être conclu sur tous les fronts pour que nous puissions immédiatement commencer les négociations de paix."

Si on parvient à percer cette ligne vers laquelle les Américains s'avancent constamment, cela voudrait dire l'événement de la ligne allemande sur la frontière de la Hollande. Même si on arrête le chemin de fer, momentanément, ce serait un grand gain car les Allemands envoient leurs troupes de secours contre les Américains par cette voie."

LES FABRICANTS DE JOUETS AMÉRICAINS.

No veulent pas qu'on permette aux jouets allemands d'entrer aux Etats-Unis.

Les fabricants de jouets Américains à une convention qui eut lieu à New York ont adopté une résolution demandant au Congrès de passer immédiatement une loi défendant de disposer dans aucun port des Etats-Unis des jouets allemands ou autre marchandise fabriquée en Allemagne jusqu'à ce que les Envoyés constants soient soumis aux exigences des Alliés."

Richard M. Hurd, président du comité de "boycott" du American Defense Society suggéra que la caisse de jouets allemands fut donnée à leur société, et que la société veillerait à ce qu'on en fasse un bon feu de joie dans les plaines de Jersey, et que l'on inviterait tous les enfants de la région à y assister.

Cette résolution rappela les familles américaines qui furent composées par ces imbéciles, mais sanguinaires qui ont fait ces jouets, et espèrent que tous les Américains loyaux resteront d'accord de ne distribuer ou de se servir de ces jouets fabriqués par cette nation de monstres.
