# Deletion process

**Speedy:** Admin deletes on sight, or another user tags for an admin to delete

**Proposed:** Anyone can add the tag. If anyone disagrees, they can remove the tag. If no one removes the tag in 5 days, it gets deleted.

### Normal:

- •[[Wikipedia:Articles for deletion/Article name]]
- 5 days discussion
- Admin closes according to consensus

# Deletion review (undeletion)

•First, try resolving with deleting administrator

### Use when:

- Inappropriate speedy
- Inappropriate close (against consensus)
- New information has come to light
- •You just really want it back :)
