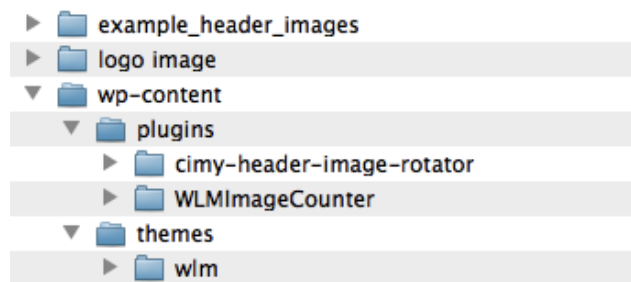


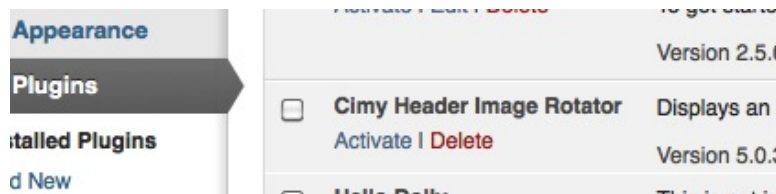


How to install a Wordpress instance with the Wiki Loves Monuments theme

- Download and install a fresh Wordpress instance from <http://wordpress.org> on your web server. (from 3.4.1) Follow the installation instructions on the Wordpress.org website.
- Download the WLM theme package from
 - http://www.visueya.de/wlmeu/?page_id=12.
 It contains the design, a plugin for soft rotation of header images, and a counter plugin that can be activated during the contest:



- Copy the files from wp-content to your server into the respective folders under wp-content.
- Log in to your Wordpress Backend and click „Plugins“:



- Click „Activate“ for the Cimy Header Image Rotator
- Click „Appearance“ and „Themes“ and activate the WLM Wordpress theme:

The new Wiki Loves Monuments theme is based on the TwentyEleven theme but redesigned to be used by local WLM teams. It needs the Cimy image rotator plugin, suggested plugin: WLMImageCounter

- Goto the „Header“ section of the theme. The header is (mis-)used for the logo in our theme:

Select Image You can upload a custom header image to be shown at the top of your site instead of the default one. On the next screen you will be able to crop the image. Images of exactly **170 x 150 pixels** will be used as-is.

Or choose an image from your media library:

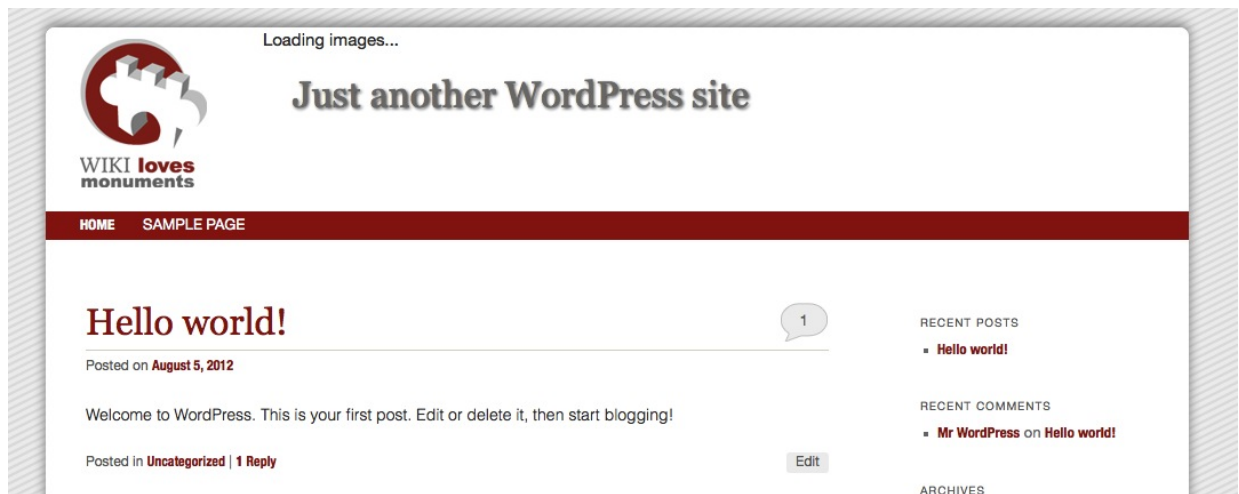
Default Images If you don't want to upload your own image, you can use one of these cool headers, or show a random one.

Random: Show a different image on each page.

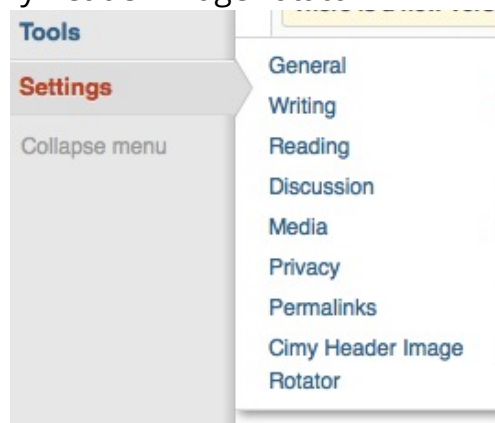

- Choose the wlm logo from the theme package (wlm.png) or your own localized version in 170 x 150 pixels. Upload the image.

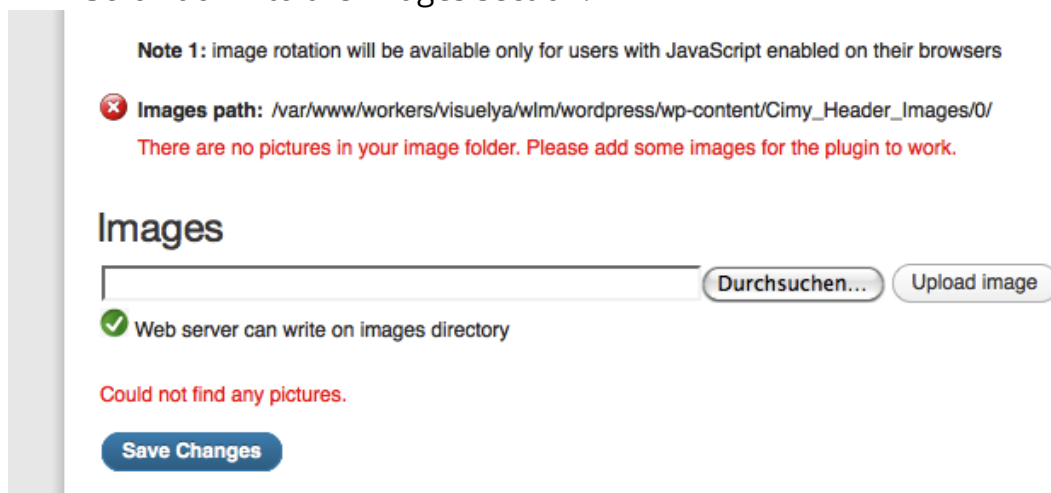
- Check „Show header text with your image“ and choose #fff as text color.
- Check your site:



- Now create some real header images, or choose the sample images in the package.
- Click Settings → Cimy header image rotator



- Scroll down to the images section:



- Choose and upload some header images in the size 810px x 150px or take the sample images in the package. If you create your own or take images from Commons, use header images with some clean space (sky, water etc.) on the left hand side for the slogan to fit in nicely. Crop existing images to the correct

size with Gimp or Photoshop.

- Add Link and Caption to the header images – important to conform to the CC licenses!

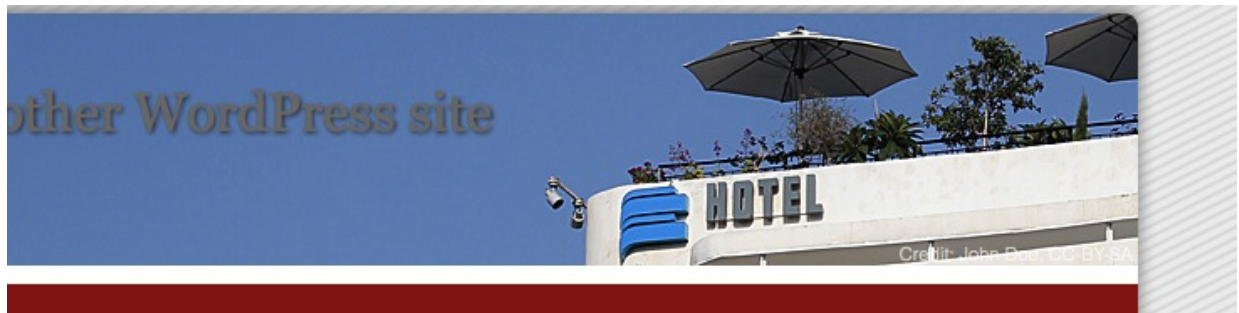

- Check the result:



- Now we check the slogan of the header, that's easy: Click Settings → General and change the tagline:

 **General Settings**

- **Clean up your sidebar:** Choose „Appearance“ → „Widgets“ and remove some of the sidebar widgets you don't need.
- **Put some partner logos in the footer:**

- Upload logo images (80px height)
- copy the URL of this image to your clipboard.
- Create a link category, name it „Partners“ or „Sponsors“ (which may fit better for you)

Link Categories

Add New Link Category

Name

The name is how it appears on your site.

Slug

The "slug" is the URL-friendly version of the name. It is usually all lowercase and contains only letters, numbers, and hyphens.

Description

The description is not prominent by default; however, some themes may show it.

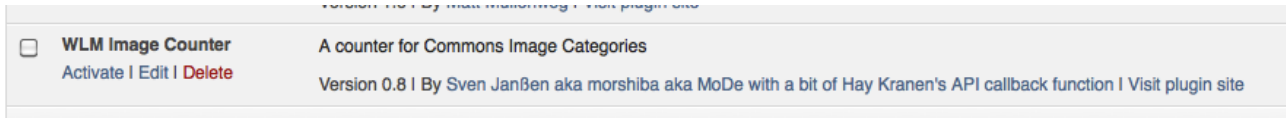


The counter plugin

During the contest in September, you can put a counter widget to your sidebar.

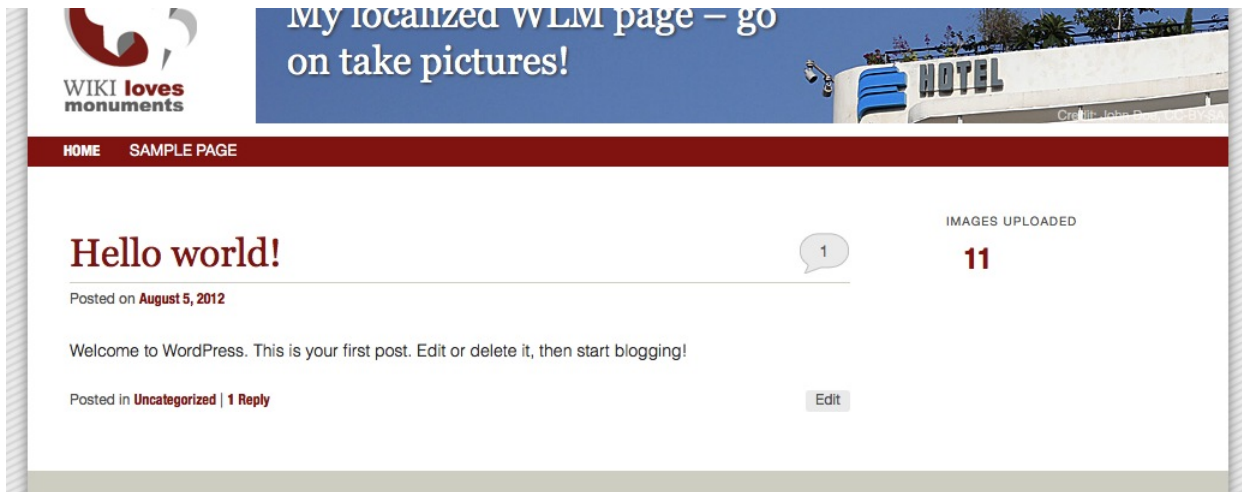
- Click „Plugins“ and activate the WLM image counter:



- Click „Appearance“ → Widgets to put the counter to your sidebar.
