EDITORIAL CORRESPONDENCE

JACKSON, August 26, 1844.

On the assembling of the Convention this morning.

My friends estimated a report on the preliminary

Committee, of which the following is a summary:

1st. The judicial power to be vested in a Supreme

Court and District Courts, in Justice of the Peace, and

each other in the City of New Orleans as the

Legislature may deem necessary.

2d. The Supreme Court to have appellate jurisdiction

in all cases for some amount exceeding \$500—except

in certain cases hereinafter provided.

3d. The Supreme Court to be composed of a President

Judge and two Associate Judges, of whom the

majority will constitute a quorum, and a salary of

\$8,000. The Judges to be appointed by the Governor

and to hold office for seven years.

4th. The Supreme Court to be organized on November

1st, to be held in New Orleans from November

1st to June 1st. The Legislature to have power
