^{24 j}“A disciple is not above *his* teacher, nor a servant above his master. ²⁵ It is enough for a disciple that he be like his teacher, and a servant like his master. If ^kthey have called the master of the house ⁷Beelzebub, how much more *will they call* those of his household! ²⁶ Therefore do not fear them. **For there is nothing covered that will not be revealed, and ^lhidden that will not be known.**

^{2 c}**For there is nothing covered that will not be revealed, nor hidden that will not be known. ³**

Therefore whatever you have spoken **in the dark** will be heard **in the light**, and what you have spoken **in the ear** in inner rooms will be **proclaimed on the housetops.**
