1. I reviewed the findings and recommendations of the DRB that convened on 14 January 2010 concerning the internment of Detainee ISN 4252 and find them to be legally sufficient.
2. The DRB found that ISN 4252 meets the criteria for continued internment for the reasons outlined in the DRB President's Memorandum found at Enclosure 1.
3. After taking into account the detainee's potential for rehabilitation, reconciliation, and eventual reintegration into society, the Board recommends continued internment at the Detention Facility in Parwan.
4. The DRB determined that internment is necessary to mitigate the threat ISN 4252 poses.
5. The Board further found that the detainee appears to be a good candidate for some of the reintegration programs offered here at the DFIP.
6. The DRB did not assess ISN 4252 to be an Enduring Security Threat.
