HAVE MOUTHS OF GOLD. Thousands of Dollars of the Metal in Teeth of Lendon.

"From a variety of causes teeth appear to decay much earlier and much nore rapidly than they used to do. In consequence the study of dentistry has now it is really astonishing what can be done in the way of arresting decay and in surmounting the affliction when it has run its course.

"In one sense there are people whose mouths are veritable gold mines. Speaking broadly, the people of London carry no less than £40,000 or £50,000 worth of gold about with them in their mouths, representing something between two and three hundredweight.
