Dear Mr. Ong,

Having received information on the Second Delphic games in Malaysia on the web site www.2nddelphicgames.com, which are to take place on September 1 -7, 2005 in Kuching, and being aware of the facts of misrepresentation of history of the Delphic games, closely related to Greece, by Christian Kirsch, as well as for the reason that he lacks experience in implementation of such projects we consider necessary to show our deep concern to you and inform on the real state of affairs in the international Delphic movement.

Delphic Games are the higher forum of arts, complex competitions which combine classical and contemporary nominations (piano, violin, folk instruments, wind instruments, pop singing, folk singing, academical singing, pop dance, folk dance, theatre, dramatic reading, circus, DJ, photography, poster, graffiti, web design, journalism, television, cooking, hairdressing, landscape design, etc.).

The official date and place of birth of the Games is the 582 B. C., Greece. Together with the Olympic the Delphic (earlier called the Pythian) games were prohibited more than 1600 years ago and reappeared only at the beginning of the 20th century: from 1927 till 1936 regularly, once in three years, in Greece the Delphic Festival was held, which became the complete analog of the ancient Pythian games. However, the Second World War suspended the Higher forum of arts.

Unfortunately, Mr. Kirsch thoroughly suppresses the fact of reappearance of the Delphic games in Greece ascribing this achievement to himself. Moreover, he conceals and does not admit the history of development of the Delphic games of the present.

Actually the international organization which really holds the Delphic games and develops the Higher forum of arts of ancient Greece is the International Delphic committee (the IDC, the headquarters is located in Moscow), which activity is supported by the European Cultural Center of Delphi (Greece), heads of a number of states, the Council of Europe and UNESCO.

In regards to the First World Delphic games of the present, they were held by the National Delphic council of Russia (the NDC of Russia) in 2000 in Moscow with the participation of 27 countries. In 18 nominations took part 938 people and the jury consisted of representatives of 13 countries. In connection with the fact that Mr. C. Kirsch did not fulfill the taken upon himself obligations in regards to these Games, the NDC of Russia was bound to solve all technical and financial questions on its own.

To the present moment the Games organized by the International Delphic committee became a significant event in the field of higher arts, they take place regularly on national, international and regional levels. Now the preparation of the Third youth Delphic games of the CIS member states is being held, which will take place according to the Decision of the Council of heads of governments of 12 countries of the Commonwealth of Independent States dated September 18, 2003.

We also consider necessary to inform you that the International Delphic committee and its bodies were obliged to stop all business relations with Christian Kirsch starting from November 25, 2004 for the following reasons:

- recommendations, received from Greece, on the necessity to stop contacts with Mr. Kirsch because of his incorrect attitude to the state history and the culture of the country;
- repeated decision of Mr. C. Kirsch to hold the Delphic games and his irresponsible cancellation of the Games on the last preparation stage;
- intentional incorrect recordkeeping;
- falsification of the fact of holding the Second youth Delphic games in Dusseldorf (Germany) in 2003;
- the attempt to obtain international registration of trade marks on him personally not taking into account the interests of the International Delphic movement and business partners.

In connection with the mentioned above we consider necessary to warn you against holding the Second Delphic games in Malaysia together with Mr. Christian Kirsch and the International Delphic Council headed by him, which operates on the territory of Germany.

At the same time we are ready to provide you with additional materials to study the real state of affairs in the International Delphic movement at present.
