Wikimedia is an international movement committed to the dissemination of free knowledge. This commitment is pursued by collecting, developing and proliferating free content in all languages of the world. One of Wikimedia's projects is Wikimedia Commons, the largest collection of exclusively free media content on the web.

It features almost 12 million photographs, diagrams, maps, audio and video files under free licences.

Every Wikimedia project depends on collaborative work. Anyone can participate and freely use, freely edit, freely copy and redistribute content. These projects are ad-free and funded through donations and volunteer efforts.

This calendar is a great example of using and redistributing freely available photographs. It features impressive images of European monuments, taken from the public photo contest "Wiki Loves Monuments 2011".

The contest was organized in September 2011 in 18 European countries. More than 165 000 pictures of European monuments were uploaded by more than 5000 participants. All uploaded images were freely licenced and can be used on Wikimedia Commons and Wikipedia.

The concept of free knowledge is further promoted by the commitment of the volunteer photographers who participated in Wiki Loves Monuments.
