While she was touring with The Starlits, she met Adam Rabuck, the front man and guitarist extraordinaire of Dirt Bike Annie. They immediately became good friends and played shows together around Florida when Dirt Bike came on tour. Years later, Adam emailed Heidi to let him know his family was moving to Florida from New York. Once here, he started hanging around the practice shed with Heidi & Jenny. After different lineup changes tweaks and polishing, Harlot O'Scara came alive. But they still needed a drummer. After a couple days on Craig's List, Adrian Baptist answered the ad and came for an audition. It was a perfect fit. After three songs he was offered the job.

As fate would have it, Tim Hubbard now owner and operator of Stiffpole Records asked the band to join the label.
