Universal Language Selector

Developments in sprint 24

- Compatible with Narayam
- Monospace font issue
- Behavior of Cancel button
- Show common languages on Worldwide
- Dropped compatibility with IE7 (may work, but with degraded visual appearance)

Integration

- Use Translate for all or most translations for more consistent process and less work
- Can create message group from Central Notice now
- Next steps (21 September)
 - Status based usage
 - Deal with edge cases

After CLDR integration

- Broken for some languages with no plural forms set in CLDR data in 1.20wmf11
- Unnoticed because of incomplete test coverage
- Fixed in 1.20wmf12

VisualEditor and languages

Bullet points and planning based on meeting

- VisualEditor highly depends on browser technology
- Only the more recent browsers are supported
- Currently input methods are insufficiently supported
- Analysis to start 2 October
- Resolving issues to start 16 October
 - Localisation team to support VE team with test cases and (some) QA
- By end of October, most pressing issues should be resolved
