WORLD WIDE SERVICE OF SALVATION ARMY

Salvation Preached in Forty Tongues

The Salvation Army covers the world. Wherever the cry of distressed humanity is heard, it answers, "We are here." It has planted the cross in heathen soil, and has fought for all people on the globe...

Already 9,698 corps and posts of the Salvation Army are established in sixty countries and colonies. Its workers are preaching salvation in forty tongues. People of seventy-one different nationalities serve in its ranks. It has 1,191 social institutions, 605 day schools and 16,519 officers and cadets, and every year the Salvation Army finds its world growing bigger.

From the moment the first guns of the world were sounded across Europe, the Salvation Army was on the battlefields. Germans entering Belgium found the Salvationists there. At Marchiennes, two women officers were sized as hostages. When they were released a day or so later their first act was to open a shelter for families whose houses the invaders had destroyed...

In Italy, when thousands of refugees fled before the invading Hun, the Salvation Army was there ready to help. So it was in Serbia. So it is in Russia where even the Red Terror and Bolshevism failed to daunt the Salvation Army...

In China, the work of the Salvation Army, which began only a few years ago, is now well advanced. There are a dozen Salvation Army corps in China, a girl's industrial home, a training school for officers, and a printing press from which is issued the Chinese copy of the "War Cry."

In India, outside of the work of relieving the impoverished and converting the criminal, the Salvation Army has performed noteworthy service in the establishment of hospitals and dispensaries by which the frequently recurring visitations of the plague are fought. There are almost a dozen Salvation Army hospitals in India.

In Korea the relief of famines has been the Salvation Army's greatest fight. South Africa is an old Salvation Army battle ground, the Army having established itself there in 1883. Industrial homes, women's shelters, prison relief and training schools are only a few of the Army's activities there.

Practical christianity is the way the Salvation Army sums up its work around the world. Everywhere in service to the Allied Cause its workers display the perseverance, patience and self-sacrifice which are so familiar to those who have had the opportunity of observing Salvation Army activities anywhere. A striking example of the self-sacrificing bravery of the typical Salvationist is that of the sinking of the steamship "Empress of Ireland." There were 140 Salvation Army workers aboard, and when the sea gave up its dead, not a Salvationist was found with a life belt on.

The money raised by the Salvation Army during its Home Service Campaign will be used in enlarging the work at home.

CONVALESCENT HOME FOR GASED MEN

Camp Travis Salvation Army Hut Becomes Rest Billet

The Salvation Army recreation hut at Camp Travis, San Antonio, has been converted into a convalescent home for gassed soldiers. The need for some provision for these boys has come to the attention of Salvation Army officials through the Red Shield Club rooms which the Army maintains in many cities for discharged men.

"Now that these boys are going back into their former occupations, the full effects of gas poisoning are just beginning to be understood." Lieut. Col. George Wood said recently. Col. Wood is in charge of Salvation Army activities in the Southwest.

"Many find that they are physically unable to keep up their work. Some of them who have tried to continue working beyond their strength, have already developed tuberculosis—the disease which threatens all of them because of the weakened condition of their lungs. It is imperative that they receive care before they contract this disease."

Dr. Theodore Y. Hull, one of the best known heart and lung specialists in the country, has accepted the post of chief of staff for the Home. Under his direction the gassed convalescents will be given the best of care and attention.

"Such gassed men," Dr. Hull said, "need the same kind of treatment that is given to consumptives in the early or even second stage of tuberculosis, but under no circumstances should they be sent to an institution for consumptives. They need rest, good food, freedom from financial care, some light work and facilities for recreation and entertainment which will not tax their strength. An institution planned, built and operated along the same line as the better institutions for the care of incipient tuberculosis cases would be ideal for their treatment."

All discharged men who wish to take advantage of this home are requested to send in their applications to Lieut. Col. Geo. Wood, 1504 Commerce St., Dallas, Texas

"We consider San Antonio has an ideal climate for the treatment of these cases," Col. Wood said. "The elevation is not too high and the men will be near a large city to which they can go from time to time for diversion."

"If the Salvation Army finds that more soldiers need the treatment than can be accommodated in the Camp Travis hut, it is planned to provide an institution for this purpose on the outskirts of San Antonio. This institution will be built on the cottage plan, each cottage large enough for two or three cases. A central administration building will contain the kitchens, dining rooms, etc."
