SUPPRESSION OF THE SLAVE TRADE.

The Earl of Aberdeen said, he had to lay on the table of the hones the treaties which had been agreed and signed by the ministers of the five great powers, for the more effectual suppression of the slave trade, the regretted to say that France had not exchanged the ratification of this iteaty, nor was he able to state the precise time when that ratification might he expected.
