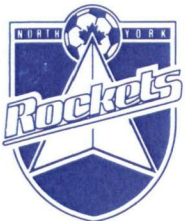

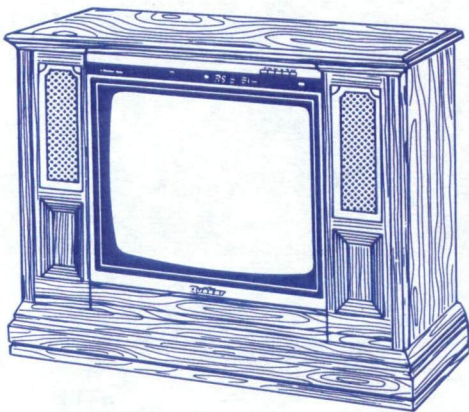

RULES TO CONTEST

1. The fourth official for the match will officiate as contest judge at all shoot outs and will give score sheet to game referee so same may be forwarded to the League office for distribution.
2. A ball must come to rest inside goal and ball must have entered through specified targets.
3. A ball must come to rest inside goal and ball must have entered through specified targets.
4. A team may substitute one of its Super Shooters due to injury or poor performance.
5. A score through gold target will represent three points, a score through silver target will represent one point. The team with the most points will be declared the winner. A win represents five bonus points. If there is a score tie, both teams will receive two bonus points. A scoreless tie or loss will receive no bonus points. As an example, a team shoots one gold and one silver, which equal four points and the other team only scores one silver representing one point. The losing team receives one point, the winning team receives nine points. If two teams in the League are equal on points, the team with the most wins first place. If that is equal the team with the most goals will receive first place. Points scored individually by each player will be accumulated on a game by game basis to be able to declare the east and west best SUPER SHOOTER. We have attached an eastern example for the end of season which illustrates team points and individual point getters.

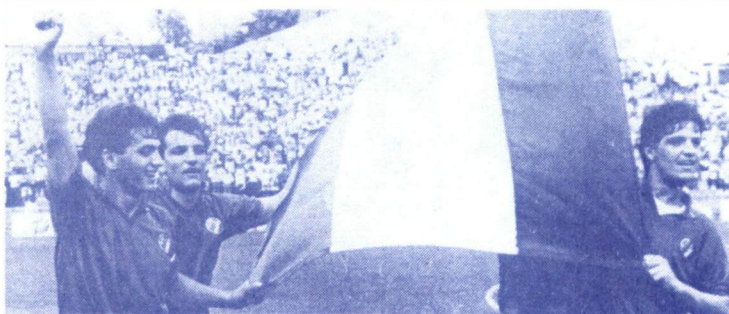
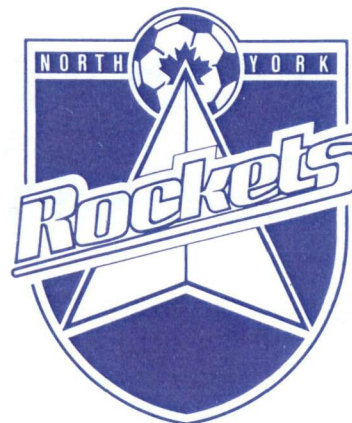
THE ROCKETS ROCKY ROAD

One thing the newly established Canadian Soccer League has been able to offer in its inaugural year is an excellent level of soccer, perhaps emphasizing more athletic qualities than technical skills, but nevertheless excitement has not lacked during the majority of the games. Improvement is still the goal of all CSL teams' owner and the upgrading of both the facilities used as well as the show featured on the soccer fields is an urgent priority. A team committed to such changes are the Rockets, an organization which has earned praises and respect on and off the field for its well disciplined conduct, but which has yet to make its mark on the field. The Club, considered by many the Cinderella team in the League, has been established by a group of businessmen all in their first experience with professional soccer. Promising to launch a new generation in soccer, they recruited management, technical staff and several players in their first contact with pro soccer. Obviously there is no substitute for experience and as the Rockets earn that knowledge and wisdom of the profession, the team results will improve.

Club co-owners, Gus Mandarino, Basil Policaro, Tony Ciamarra, Joe D'Urzo, Mario Rollo and Mario Giangioppo have regrouped management, players and coaching staff providing clear and firm directives to allow the Rockets to carry on their program and objectives. In the meantime the Rockets are focusing their energy in an effort to assemble qualified coaches in their organization and subsequently establish, under the leadership of at least two of the world's best technical directors, a coaching seminar to teach the unexperienced Canadian coaches the technical elements of professional soccer.

Coaches and trainers may assess their realistic level of knowledge of the game and participate in such program which shall be based entirely on the famed course offered at Coverciano, Italy. A more detailed presentation of all relevant information shall be published by the Rockets organization in September. (The technical staff of the Rockets is in their first contact with coaching professional team, in the same situation are several players, directors and managers, and for all of them the involvement with the organization is a learning experience.) The

Rockets are firm believers in local talent and intend to continue with their policy of "launching a new generation in soccer" but some adjustments have been made. The team has brought not less than four experienced and well established players who can not only contribute a strong balance on the field but provide leadership and example for the younger players.



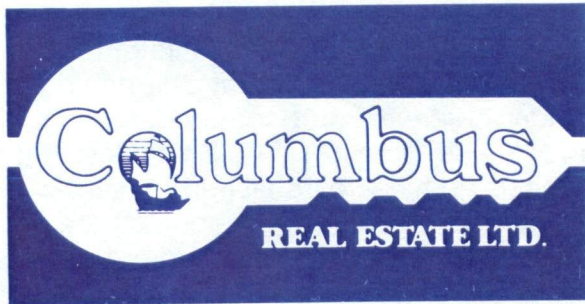
A SALUTE TO GREAT SOCCER

The recently completed Fifa Under 16 World Cup brought to Canada, and particularly Toronto, perhaps the finest soccer ever seen in this part of the world. Amazingly the participants were all under 16 years old and yet performed with the class and skill of the much praised senior counterparts. The Soviet Union won the competition but in all fairness both Italy and Nigeria played far superior soccer. MIROSLAV VUCINIC – Midfielder

Born in Jugoslavia – Age 27

One of the Rocket's imports, Vucinic, arrived from the Jugoslavian First Division where he played for BEOGRAD. He plays inside forward with preference to start his action from his own midfield. His dribbling and shots are formidable, while his discipline and dedication are a model to all young players. His play is constantly improving and as he reaches an efficient understanding with team mates Metsaros and Cubilles, the trio is expected to become very prolific for the new Rockets.

JORGE ESPINOSA – Sweeper

Born in Chile – Age 31

A master of the game, Espinosa is capable of playing outstanding soccer with great style and with minimum effort. Position and ability to anticipate the play are qualities which make Espinosa a great player in the CSL and certainly a very valuable addition to the Rockets. The arrival of Alberqueque, Vucinic and Espinosa has turned the Rockets into a well-balanced, skillful and experienced team which may seriously contend for top position during the second part of the young CSL season.

MARCO DE LUCA – Forward

Born in Toronto – Age 19

An outstanding individual who has the discipline, dedication, skills and desire of the best athletes. A product of the Woodbridge Soccer Club, Marco is determined to make soccer his career and has even spent time learning his skills in Italy. Now with the young Rockets he is one of the merging forces and the type of player capable of bringing new dimensions and success to the team. An overpowering shot, skillful in the air and excellent speed confirm in De Luca the ability of a great player.

LORENZO STAMPATORI – Midfielder

Born in Mississauga – Age 19

A skillful midfielder in his tender age Lorenzo promises to become one of Canada's best soccer players. Position and ability to read plays gives Stampatori qualities which are essential for any playmaker. As he develops better qualities in his passing and shooting, he will undoubtedly gain the necessary confidence and respect to assure him a starring role with the Rockets.

OSCAR ALBERQUEQUE – Midfielder

Born in Peru – Age 28

"Magic", as he is called by his faithful fans, represents one of the brightest story in Canadian soccer. 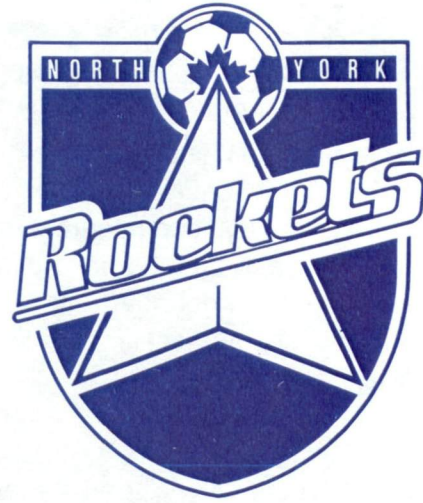

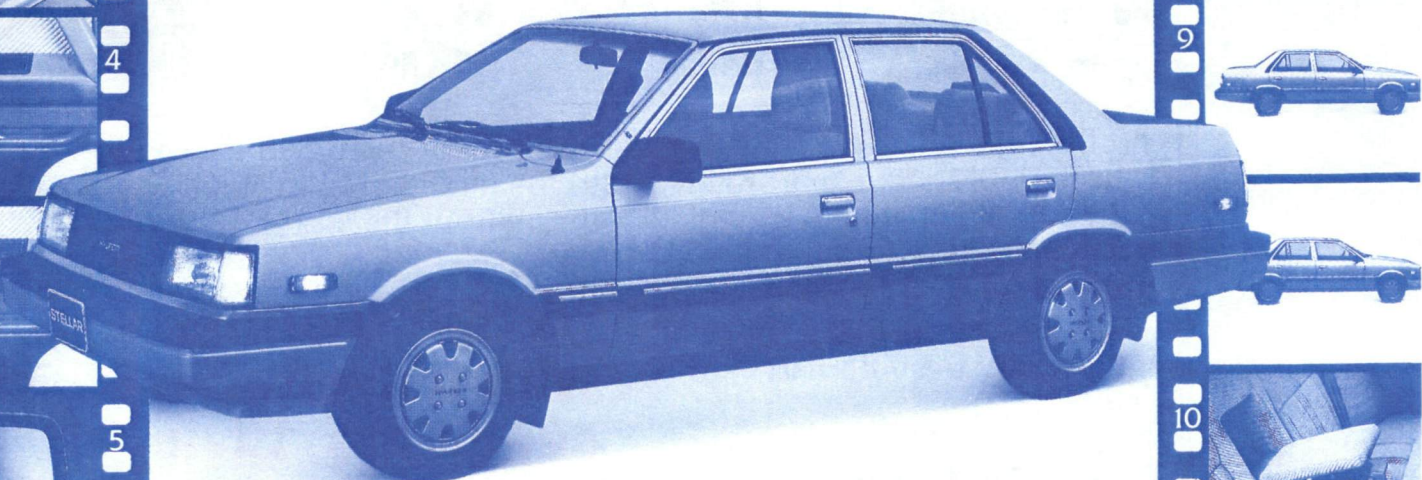
