




Pros

- Easy to add more sections to the navigation later on
- Doesn't waste screen space by having navigation always present

- Too many items will be cumbersome for the user to scan
- Implementation may not be smooth across all platforms because it is a custom pattern

Dashboard





Pros

- A user has easy access to the most important tasks
- The dashboard gives an overview of the application's functionality
- Gives the user a place to start if they don't know what to search for
- Easy to change or add to

- Takes up a full screen
- Have to go home to switch to a new task (but drop down menu approach is just as many clicks)
- Grid is hard to scan, needs icons
 - Solution is to do a list view (example: Where)



Scrolling Tabs




Pros

- Quick navigation without taking up a lot of screen real estate
- Gives the user a good sense of where they are within an app
- Allows for having more than 5 sections

- Typically used for categories, so might not be useful in our case for main navigation
- Horizontal scanning isn't as easy as vertical

Platform Specific Approaches

Pros

- Very familiar approach for users
- Limits user frustration and learning curve
- Allows the user to focus on the content quickly because they are following an already learned pattern
- Easier to get an app featured that follows platform guidelines
- Less need for user testing since you are following an already proven pattern
- Helps the app feel like a part of the OS

Cons

Platform patterns may not efficiently solve our case

iOS tabs





Pros

- A tab bar is well-suited for use in the main app view because it's a good way to flatten your information hierarchy and provide access to several peer information categories or modes at one time.
- One tap to change modes
- Navigation is obvious


- Limited to 5 tabs
- Takes up a lot of screen real estate
 - This is could be solved by having the navigation hide while scrolling to read content (example: Pinterest)

Android action bar





Pros

- Easy access to key functionality
- Provides a good anchor point within the app for users
- Allows branding to be present
- Can long click on icons to get a label

- Newer pattern so not all users may be adapted yet
- Limited number of actions present on screen in portrait mode (the rest fall under the overflow menu)



Split Controls + Overflow




Pros

- Gives room for an overflow menu






