Nos. 1-14 exist with inverted overprint or surcharge. The 1, 3 1/2, 5, 7 and 10 rubles with red overprint are trial printings (value \$40 each). The 20k on 14k, perforated, and the 1, 2, 5, 15, 70k and 1r imperforate were overprinted but never placed in use. Value: \$80, \$30, \$40, \$40, \$40, \$40 and \$60.

These stamps were in use from Aug. 1 to Oct. 15, 1919.

Counterfeits of Nos. 1-14 abound.
